[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clock housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock housing showing my new design, it being understood that the floral border is continuous;

FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right-side elevational view being generally a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view taken generally on the line 3-3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is an enlarged partial section view taken generally on the line 5-5 of FIG. 1.

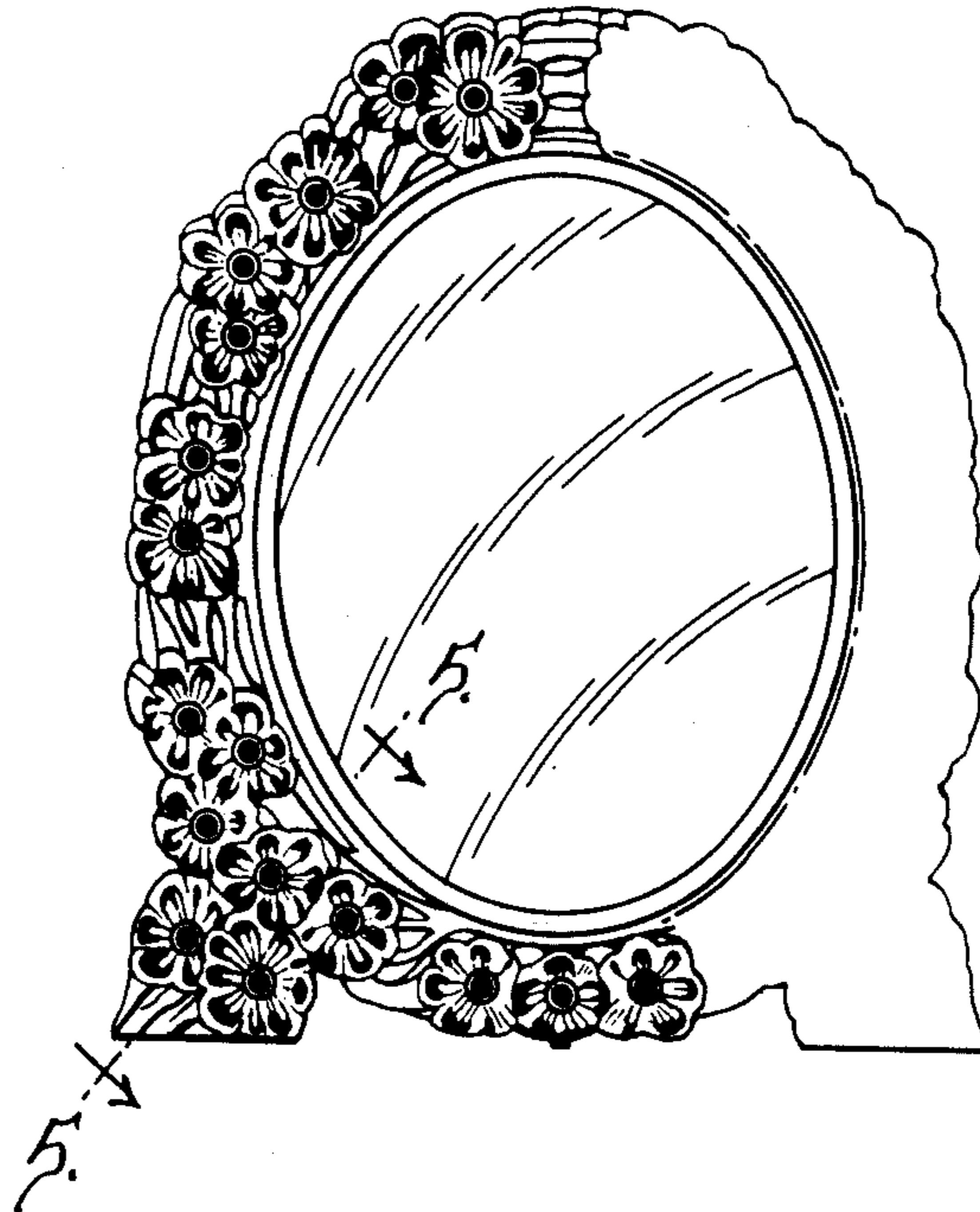

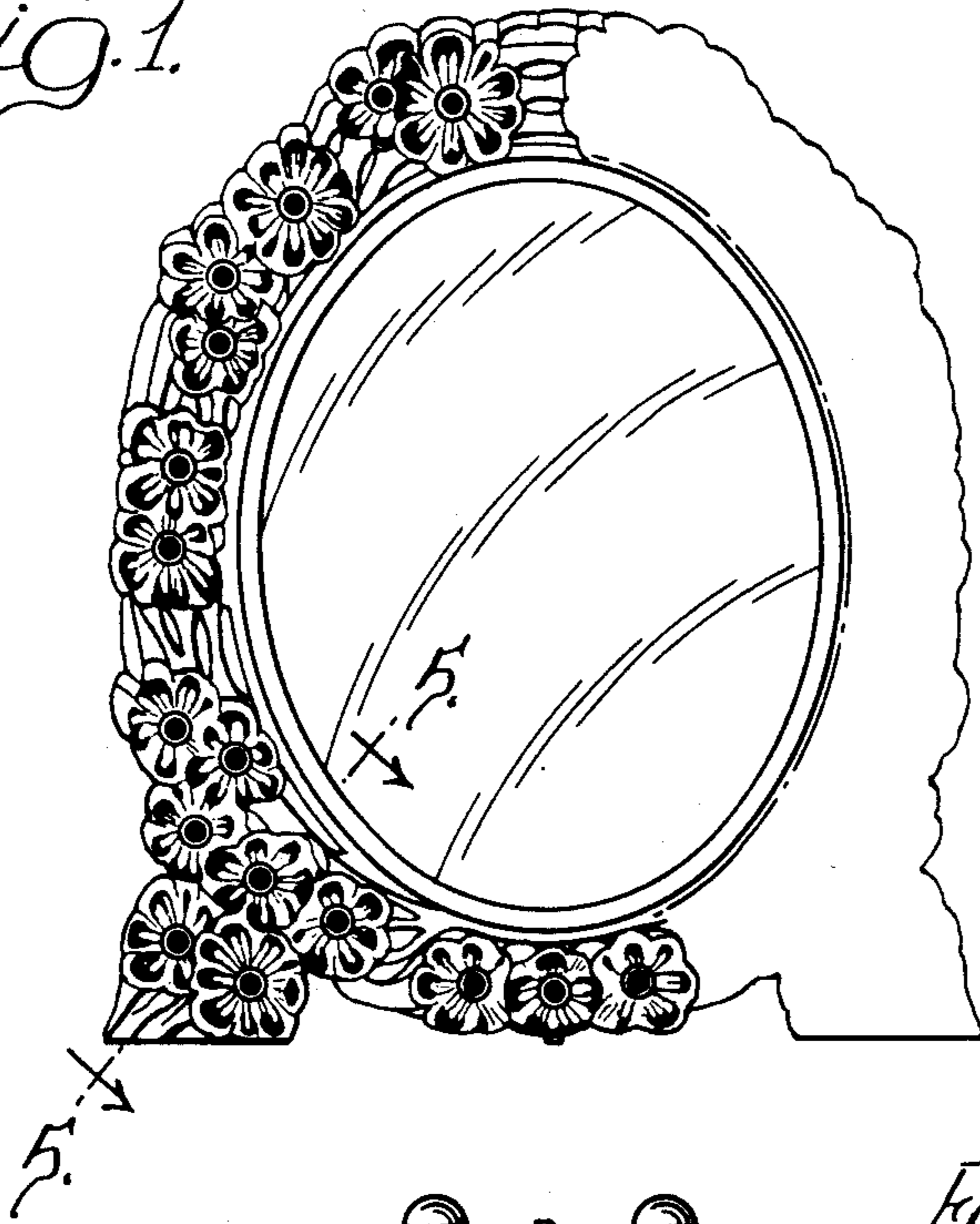

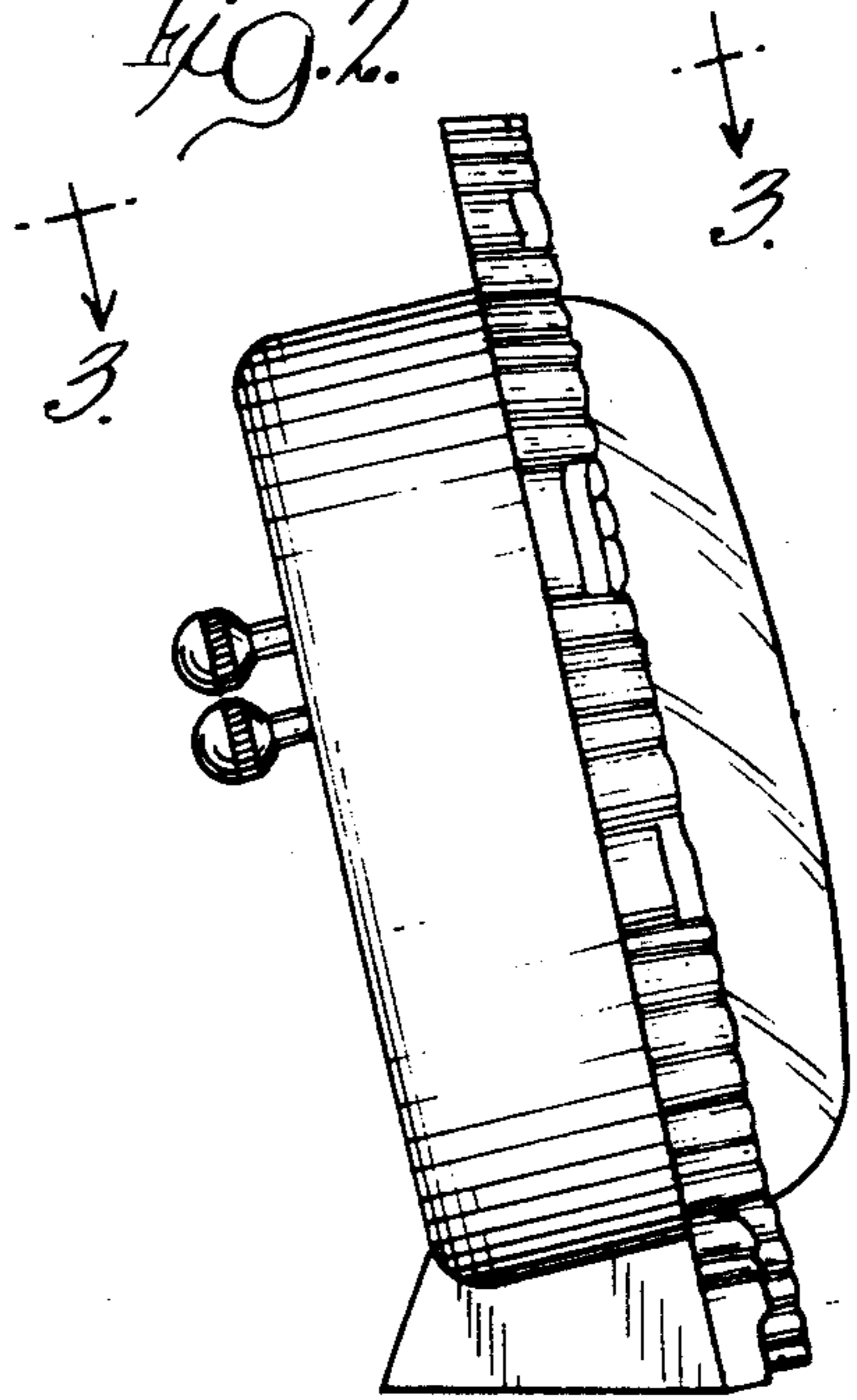

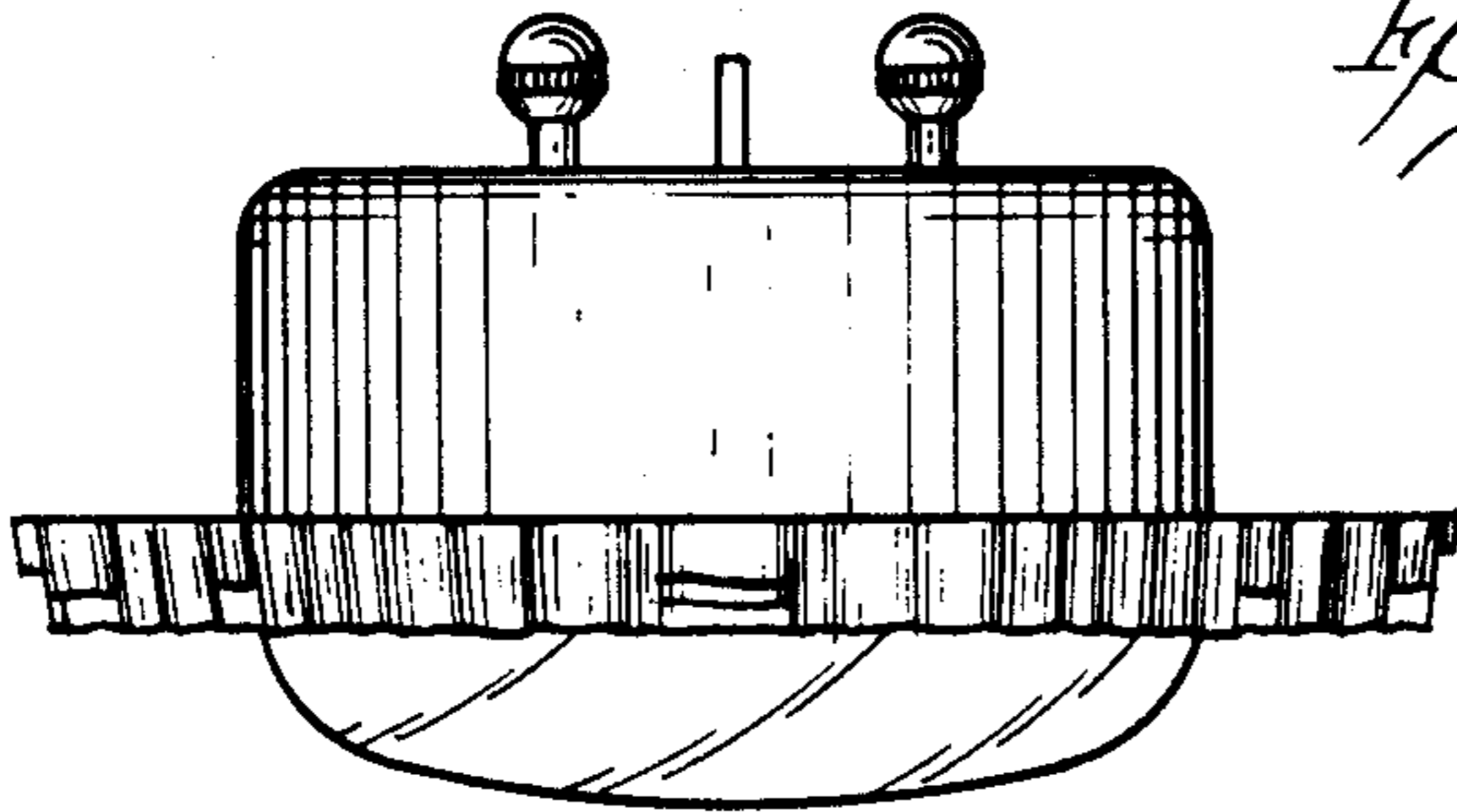

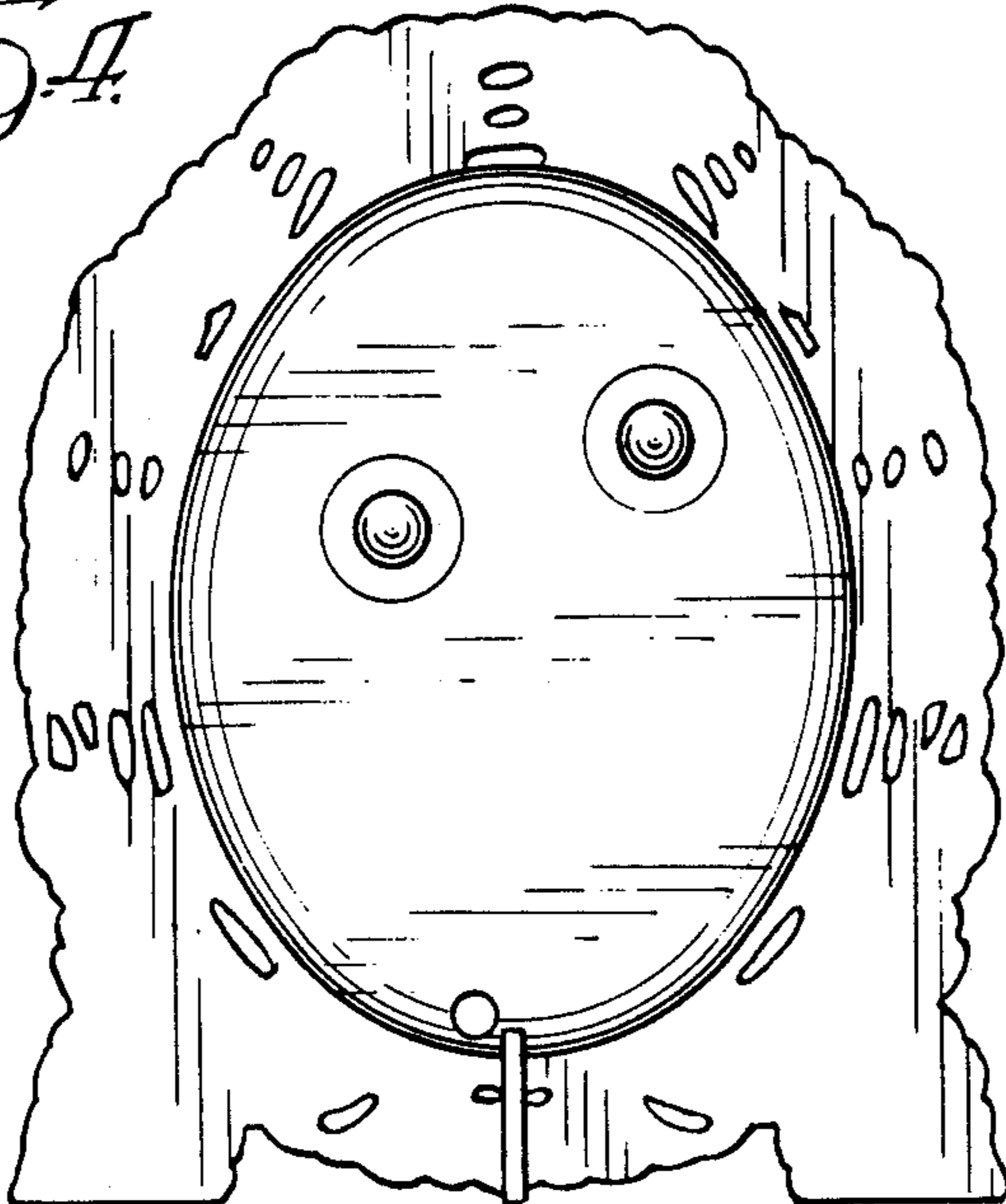
