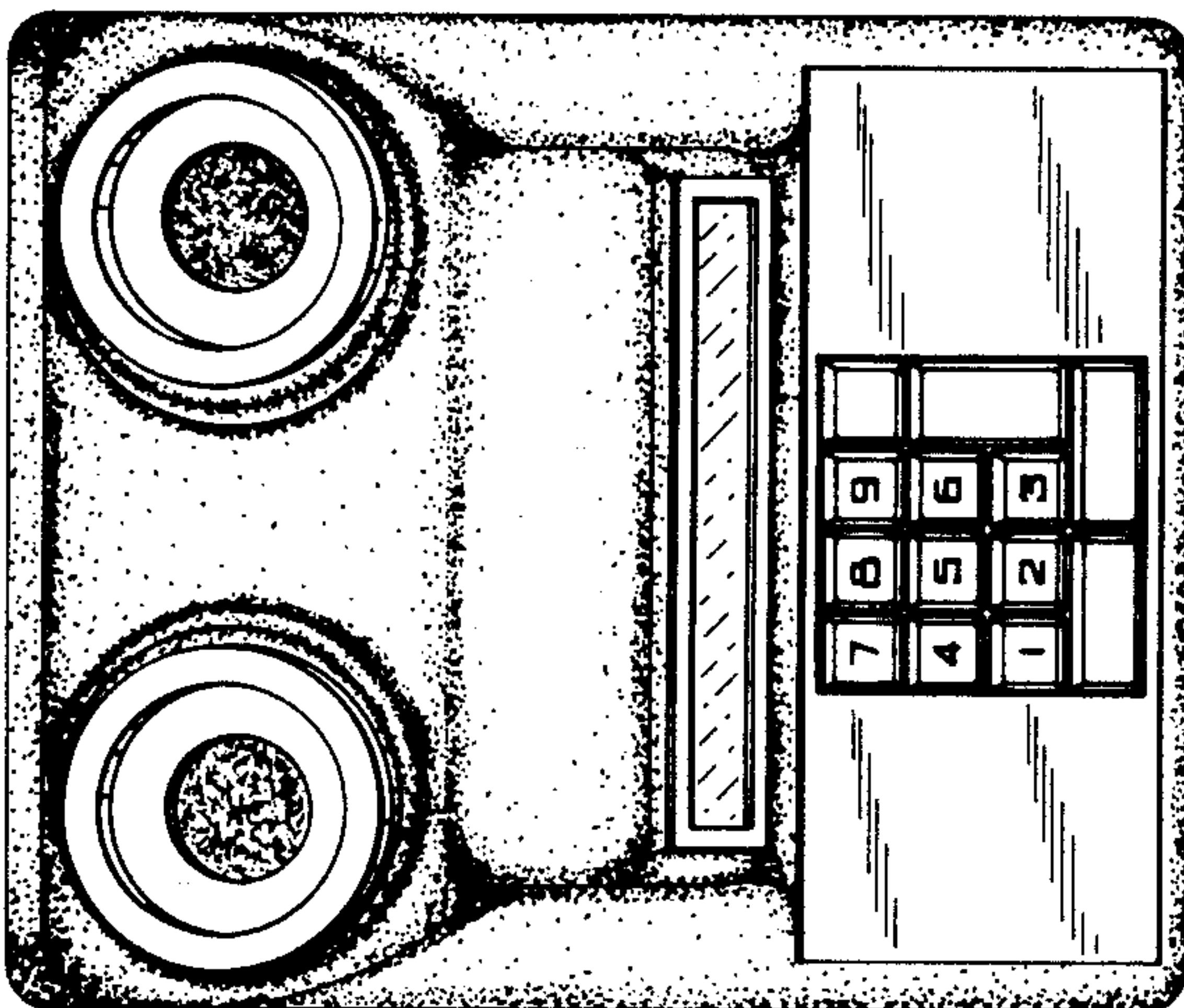
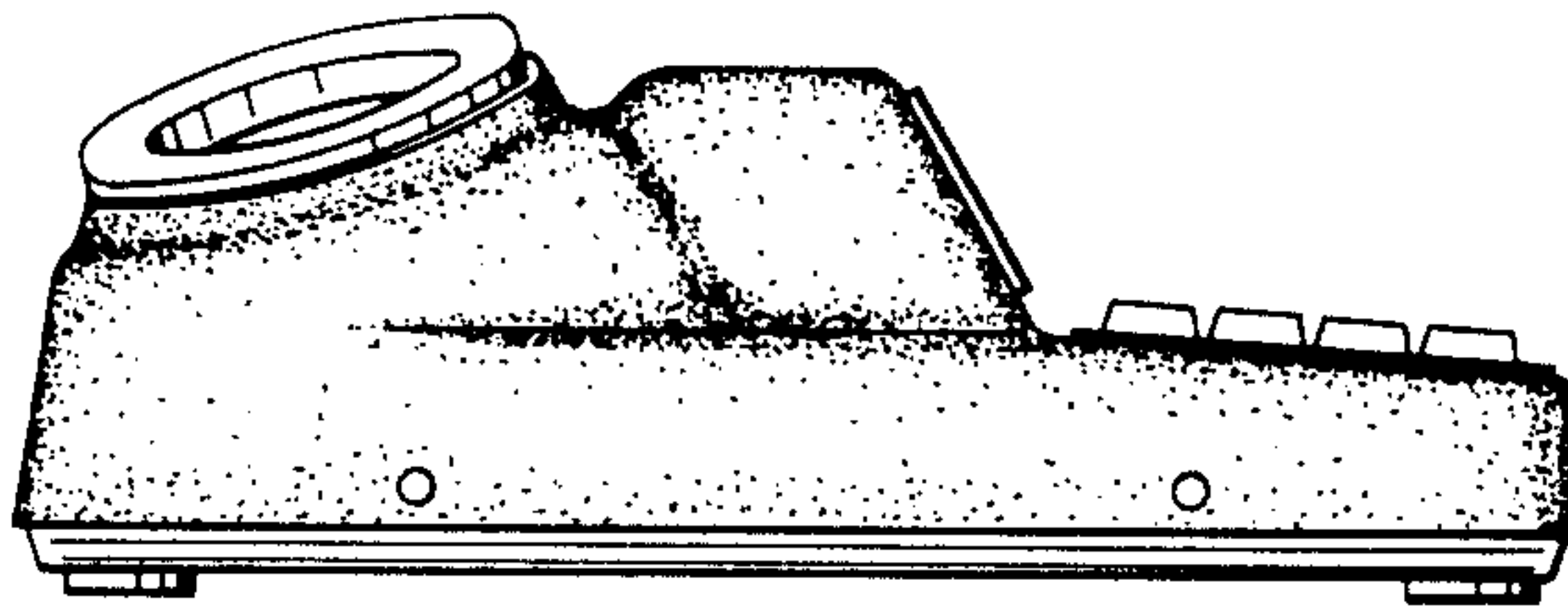

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a data collection terminal showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a rear elevation thereof.



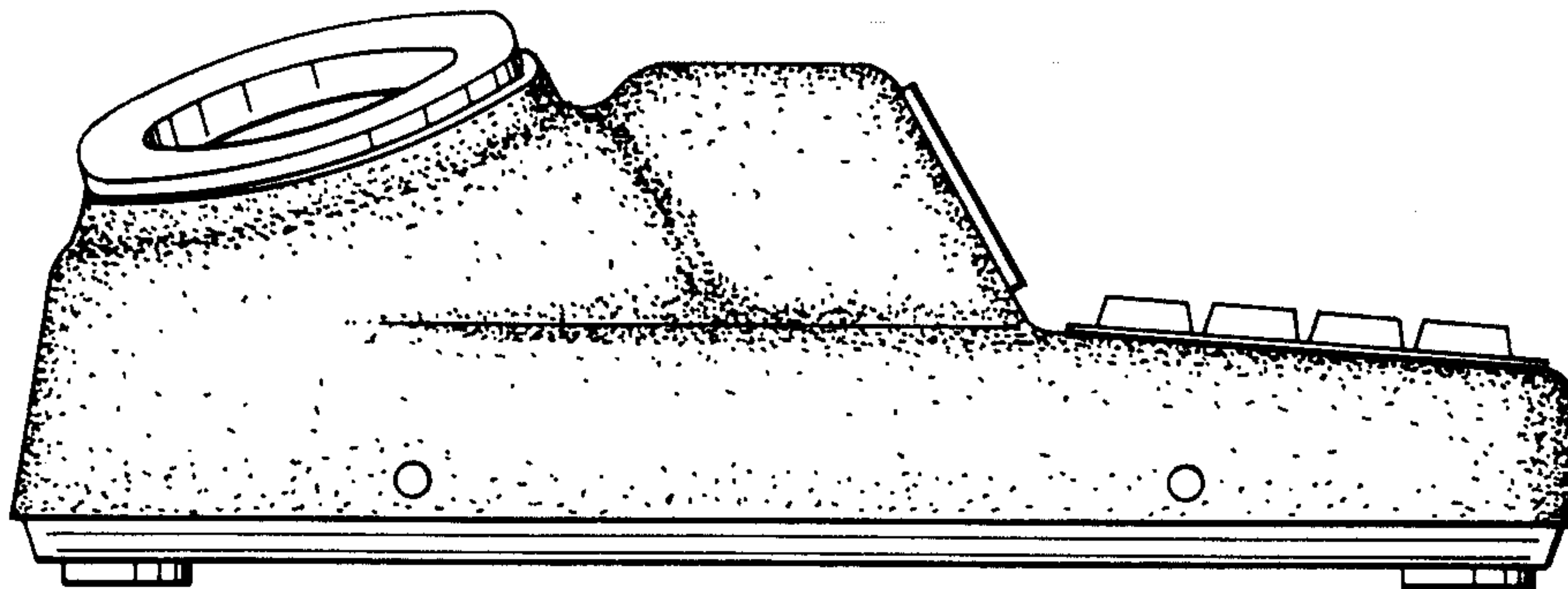

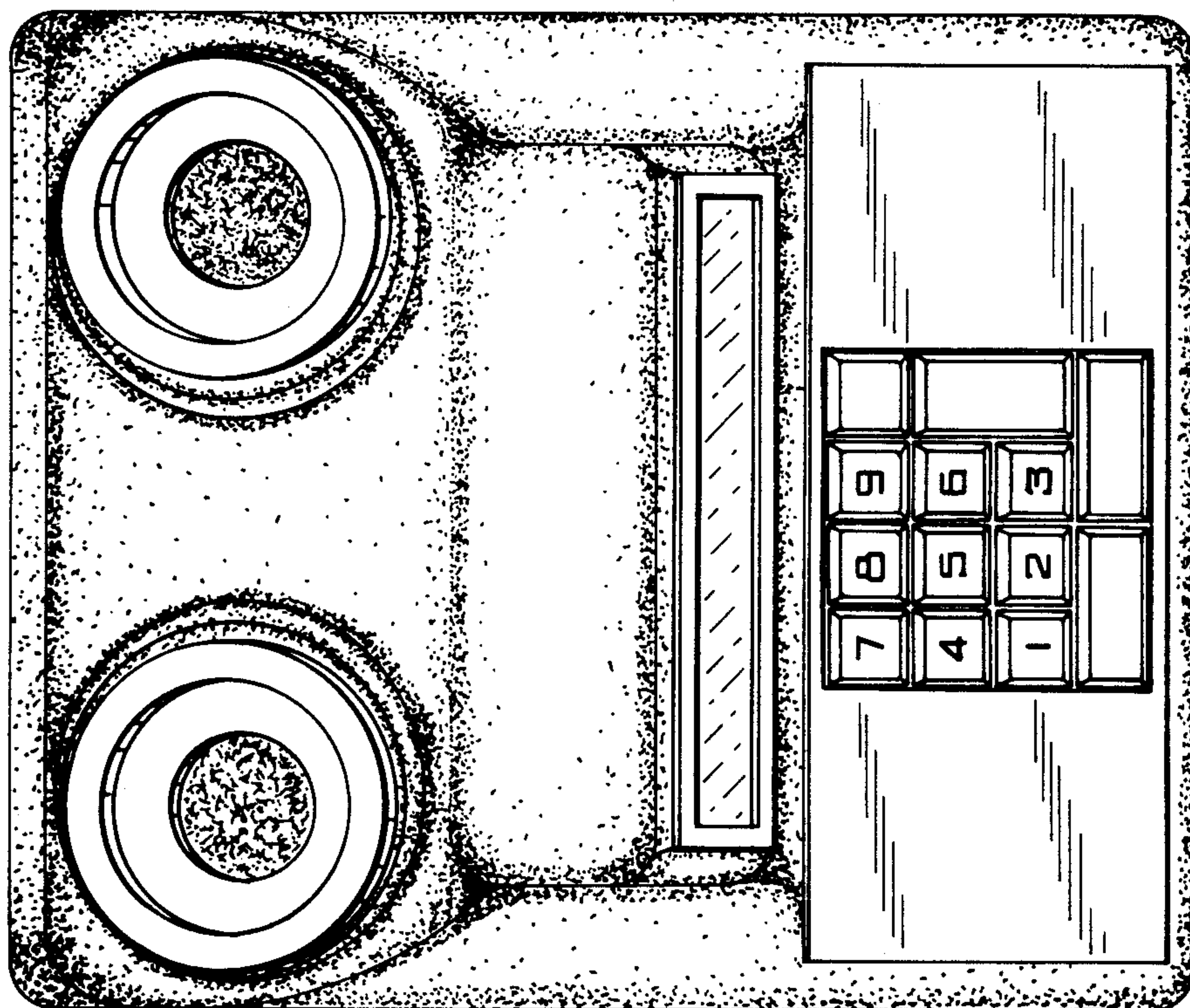

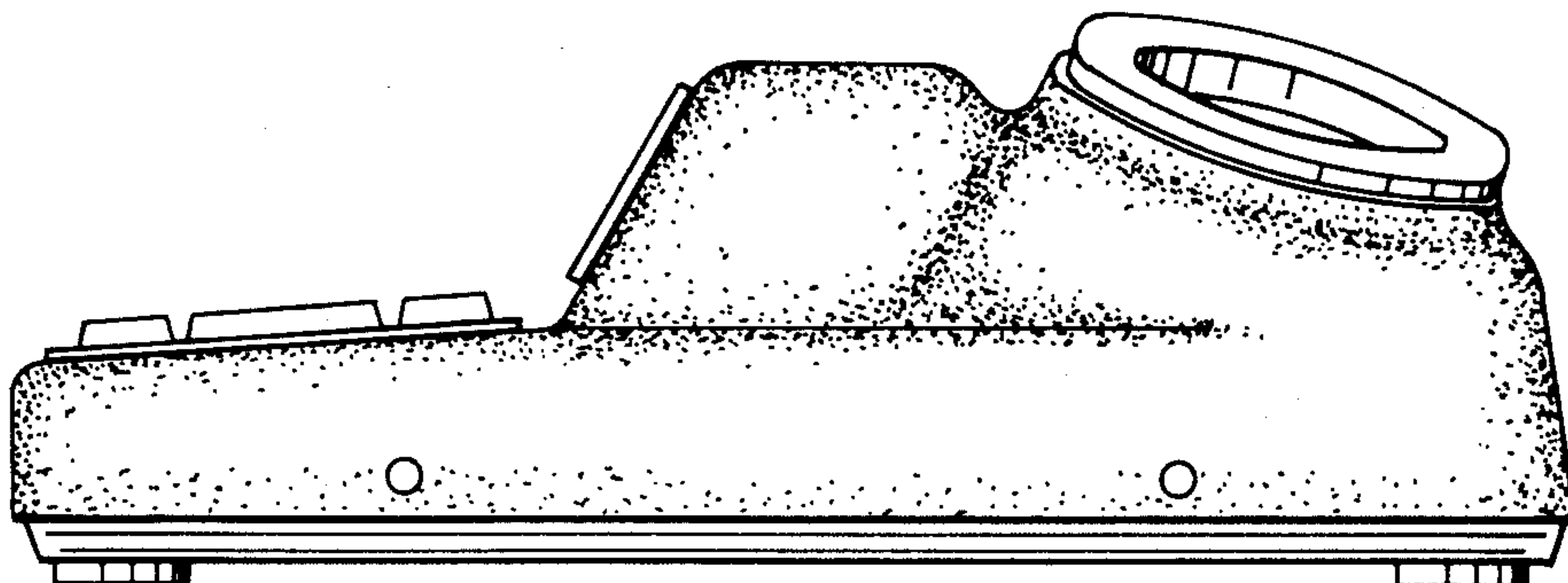

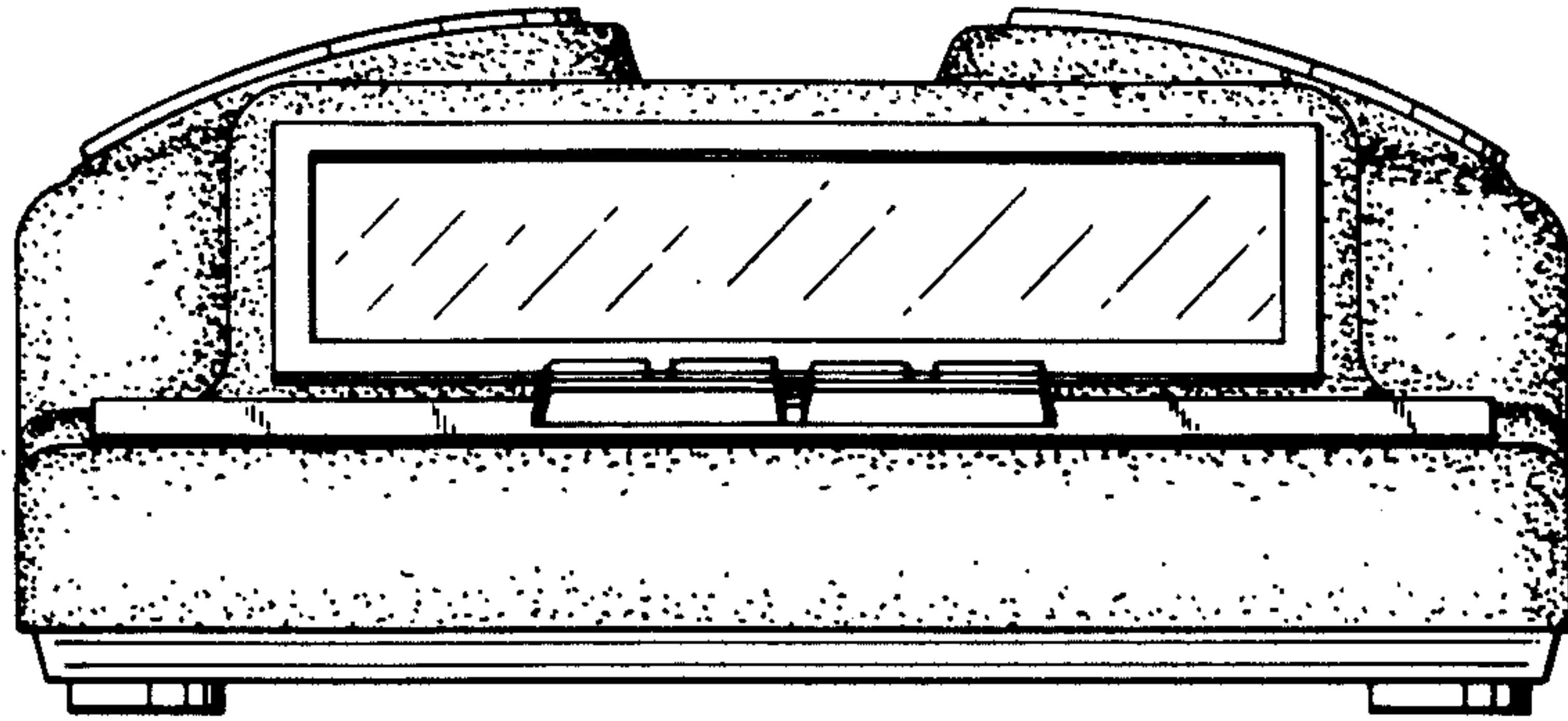

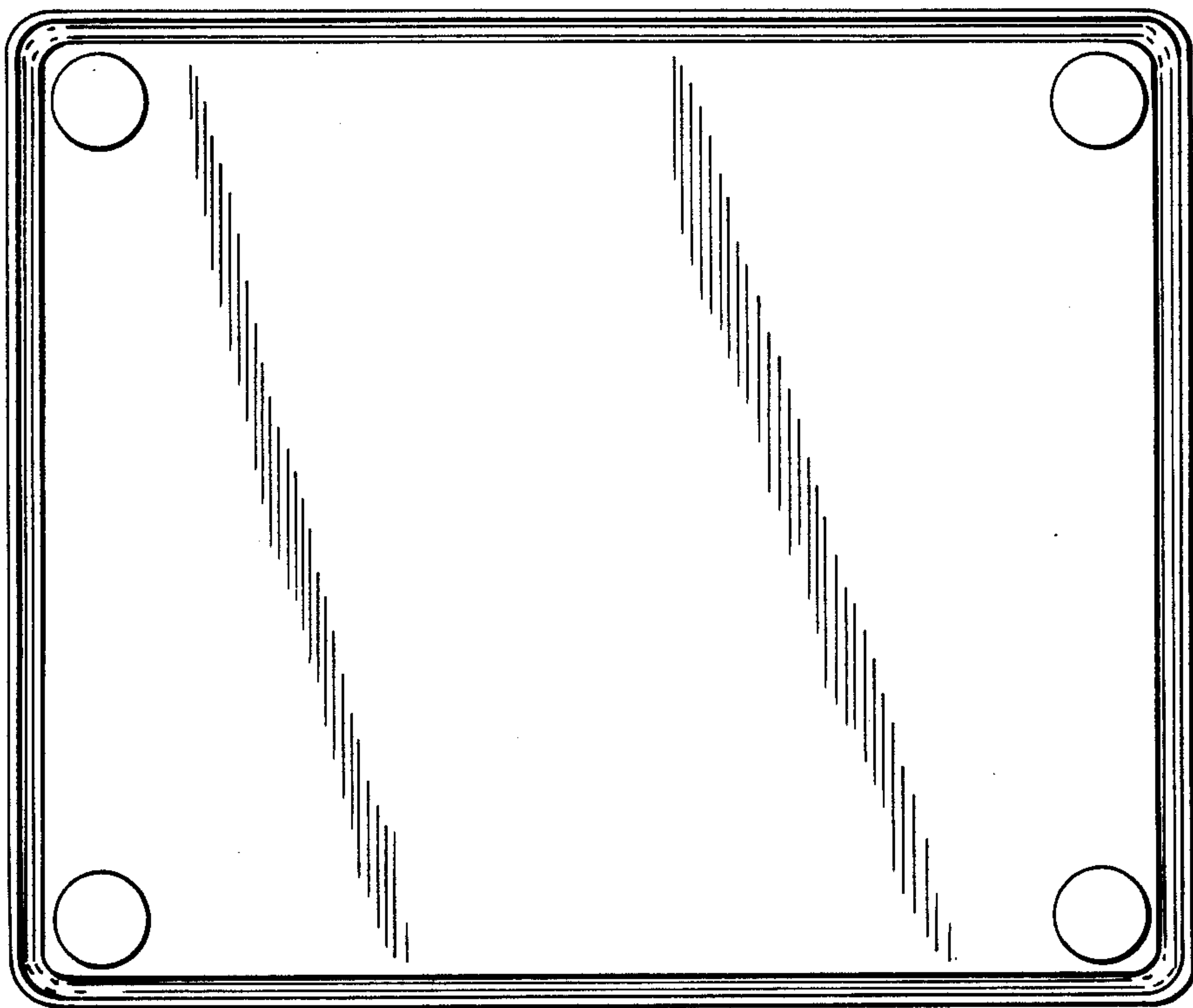

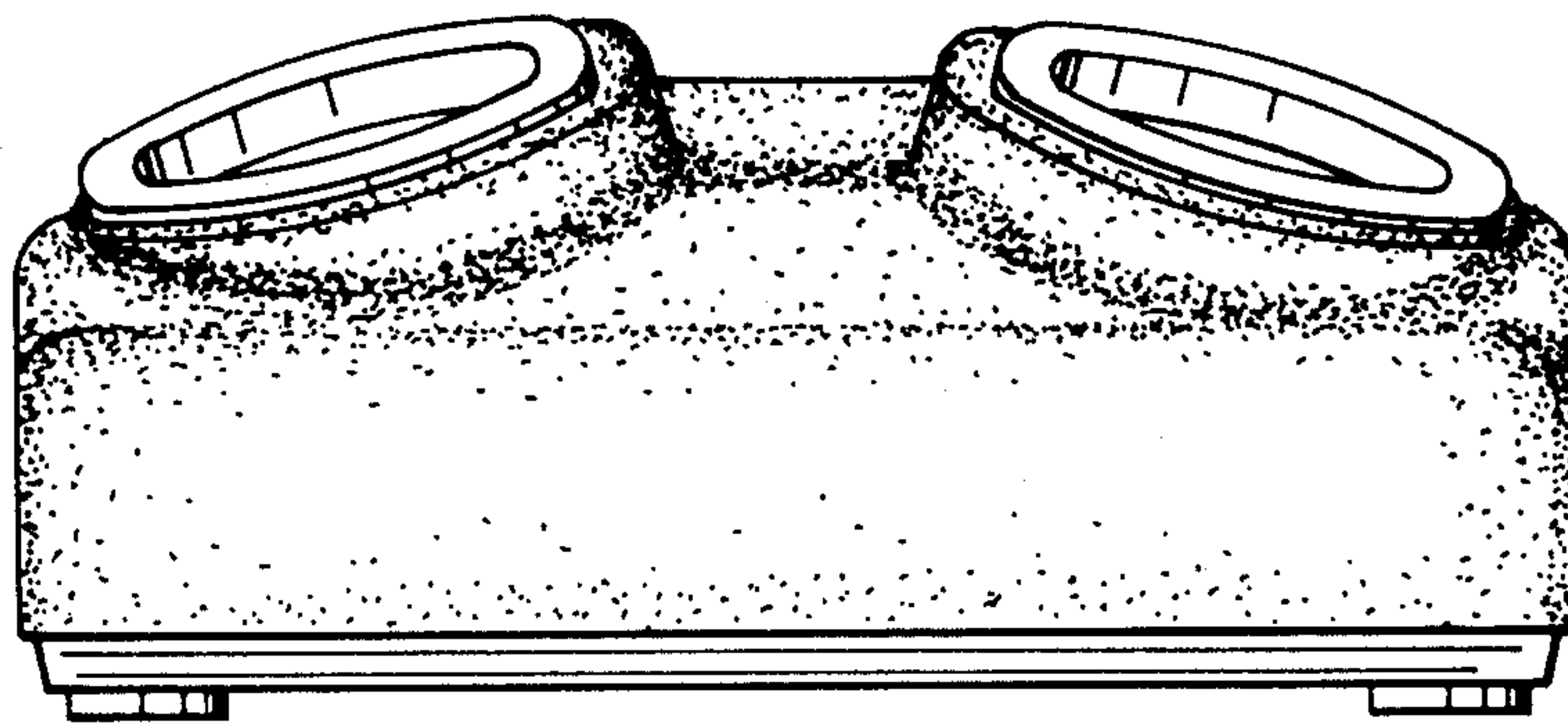
