DESCRIPTION

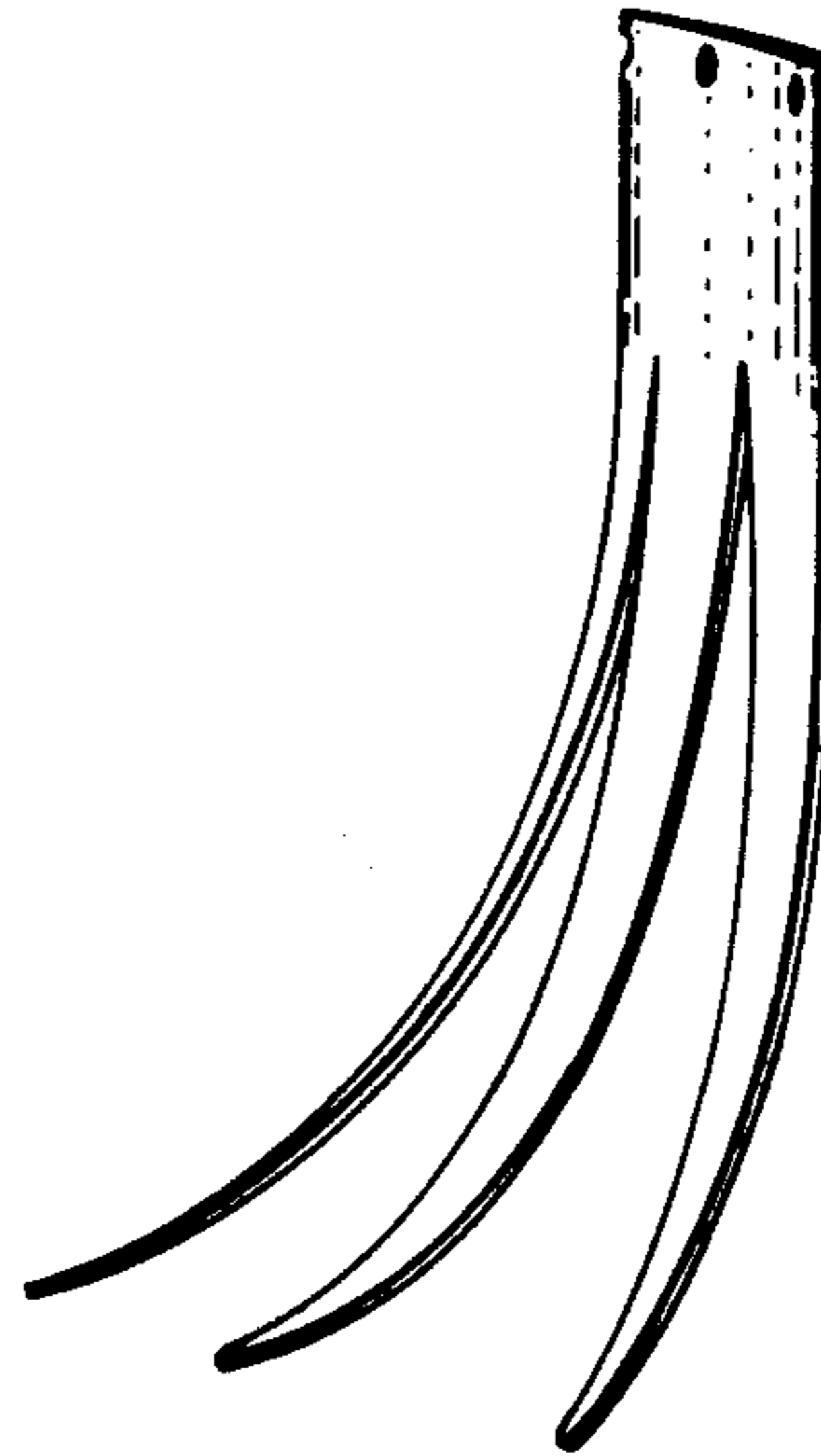
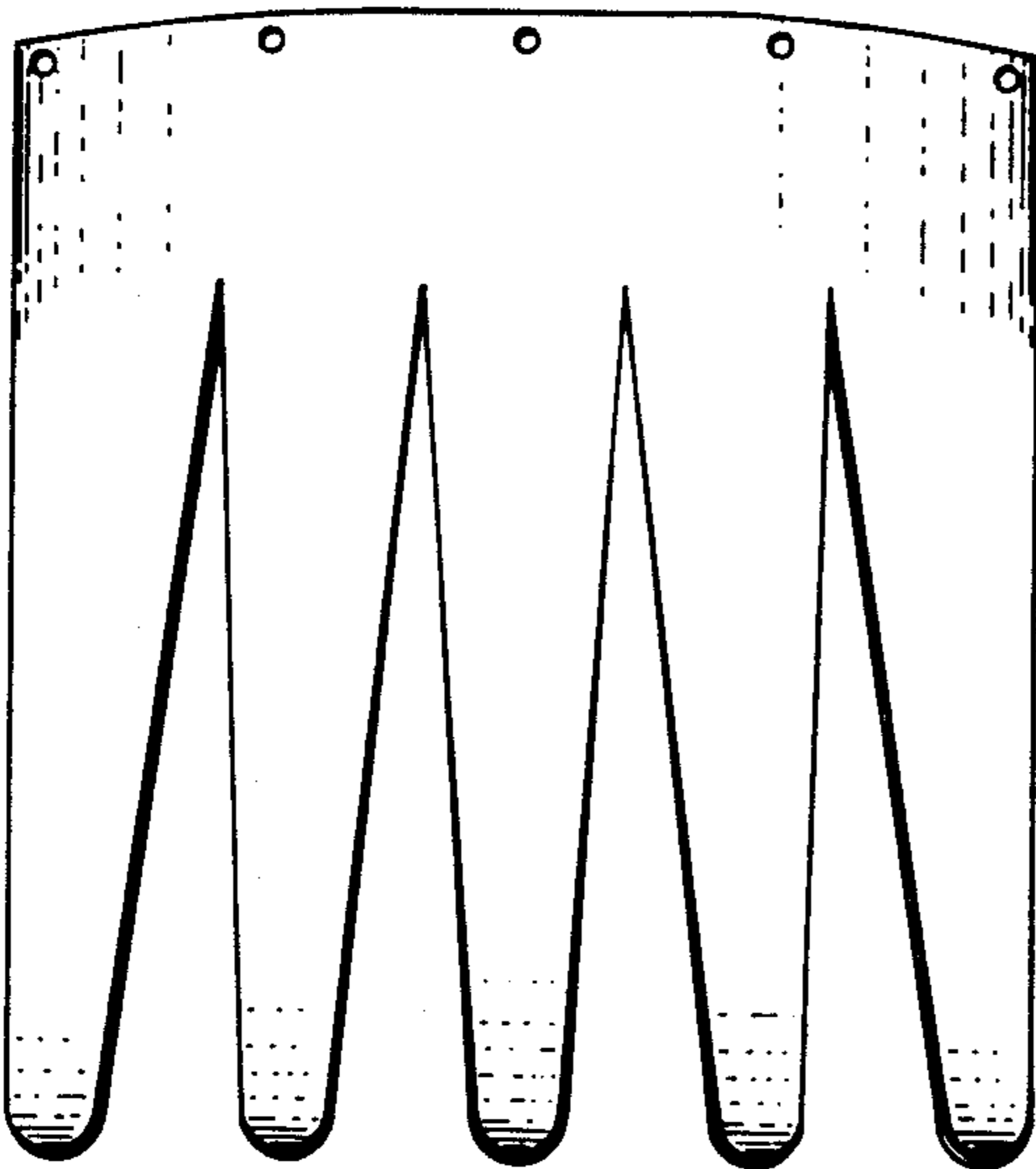
FIG. 1 is a plan view of a headlight visor showing our new design.

FIG. 5 is a perspective view on a reduced scale.



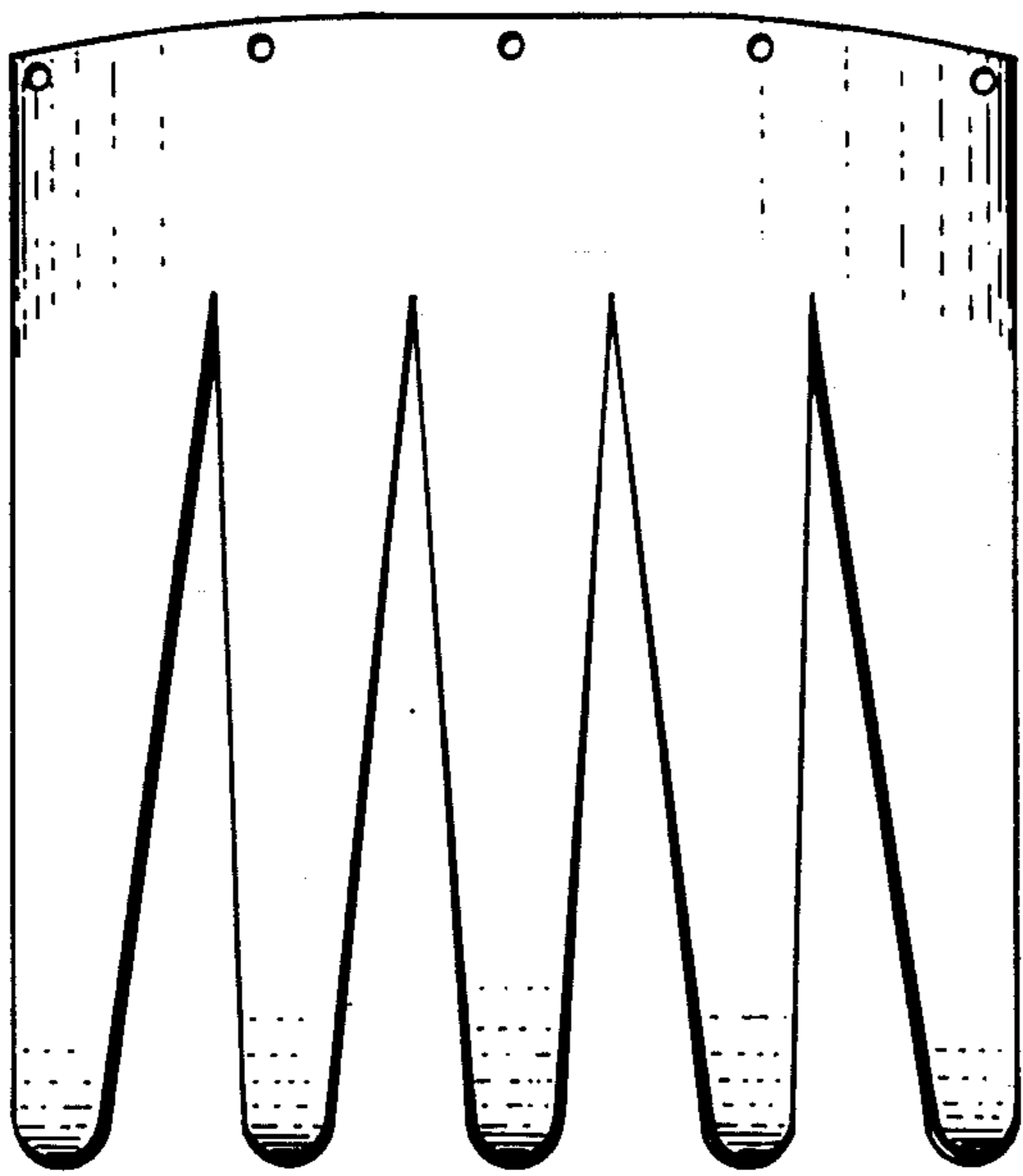

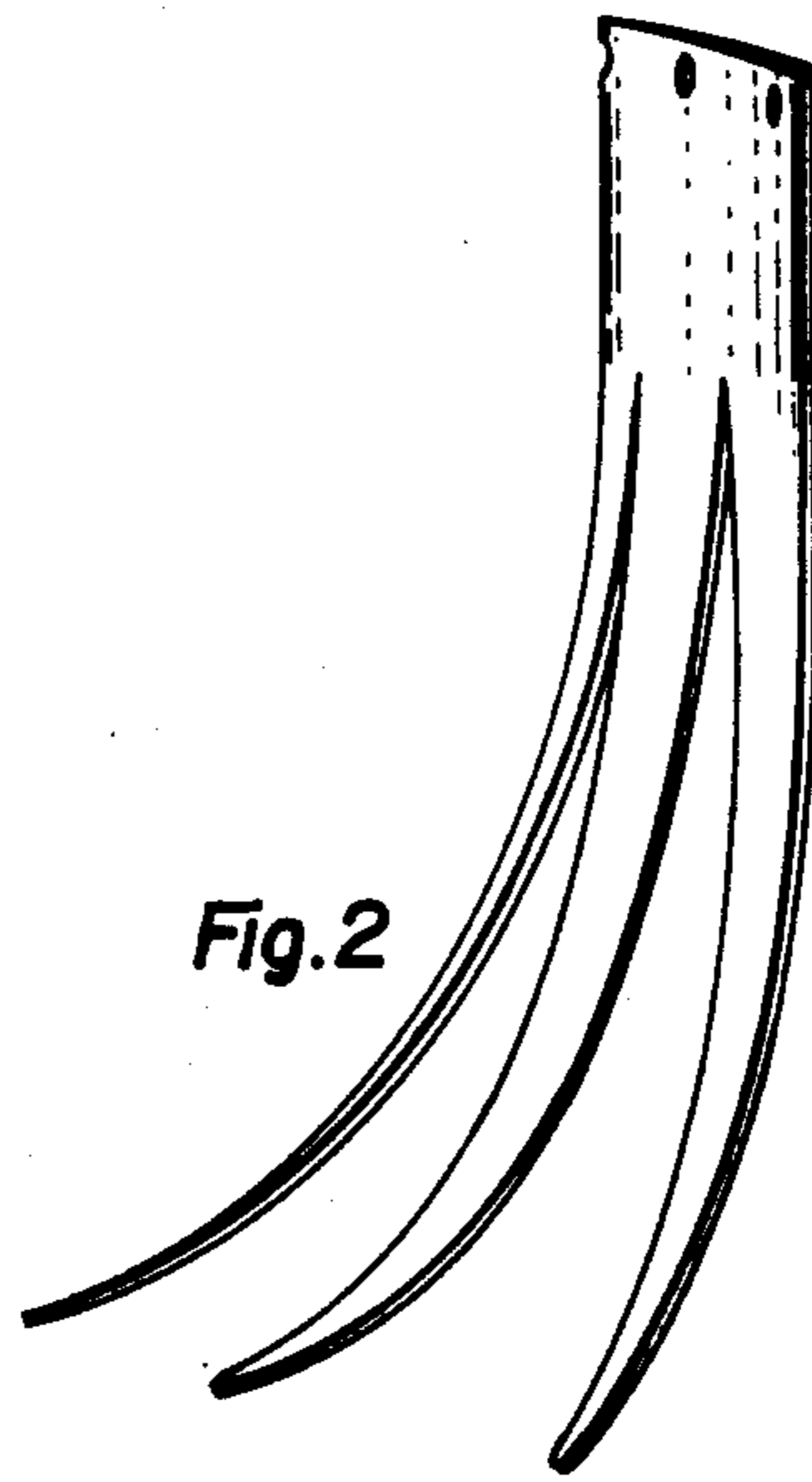

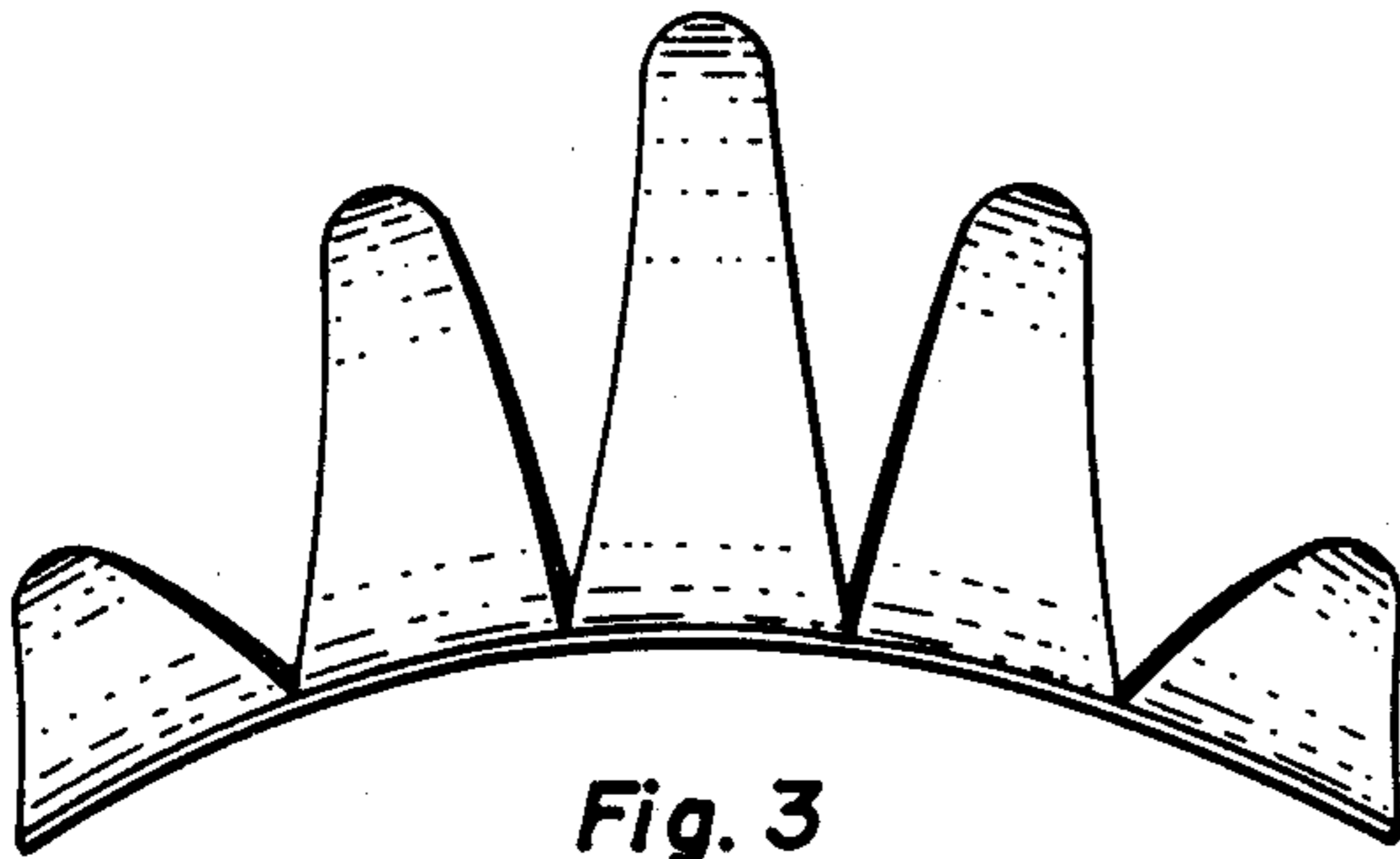

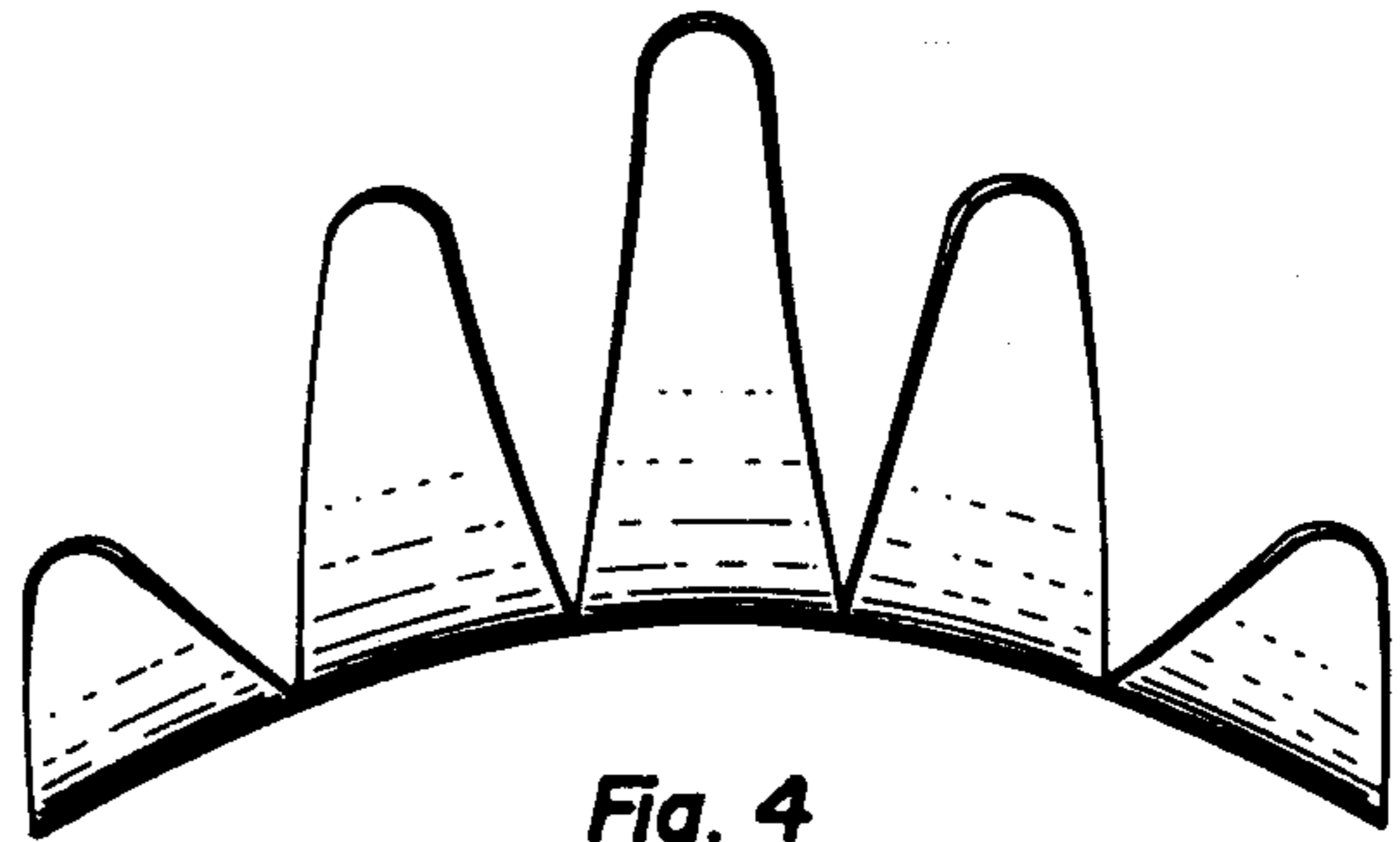

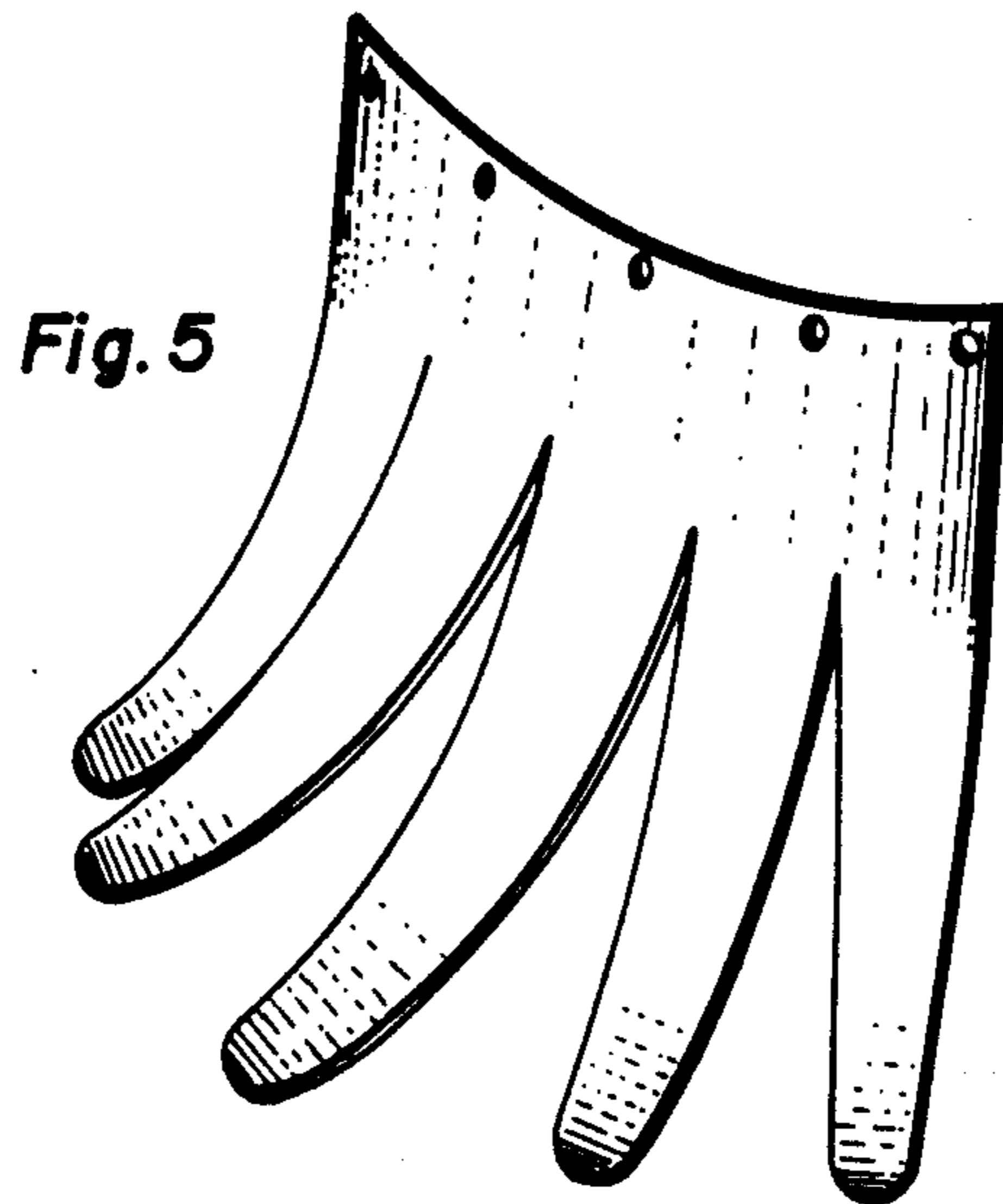
