The ornamental design for a golf bag club separator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf bag club separator showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

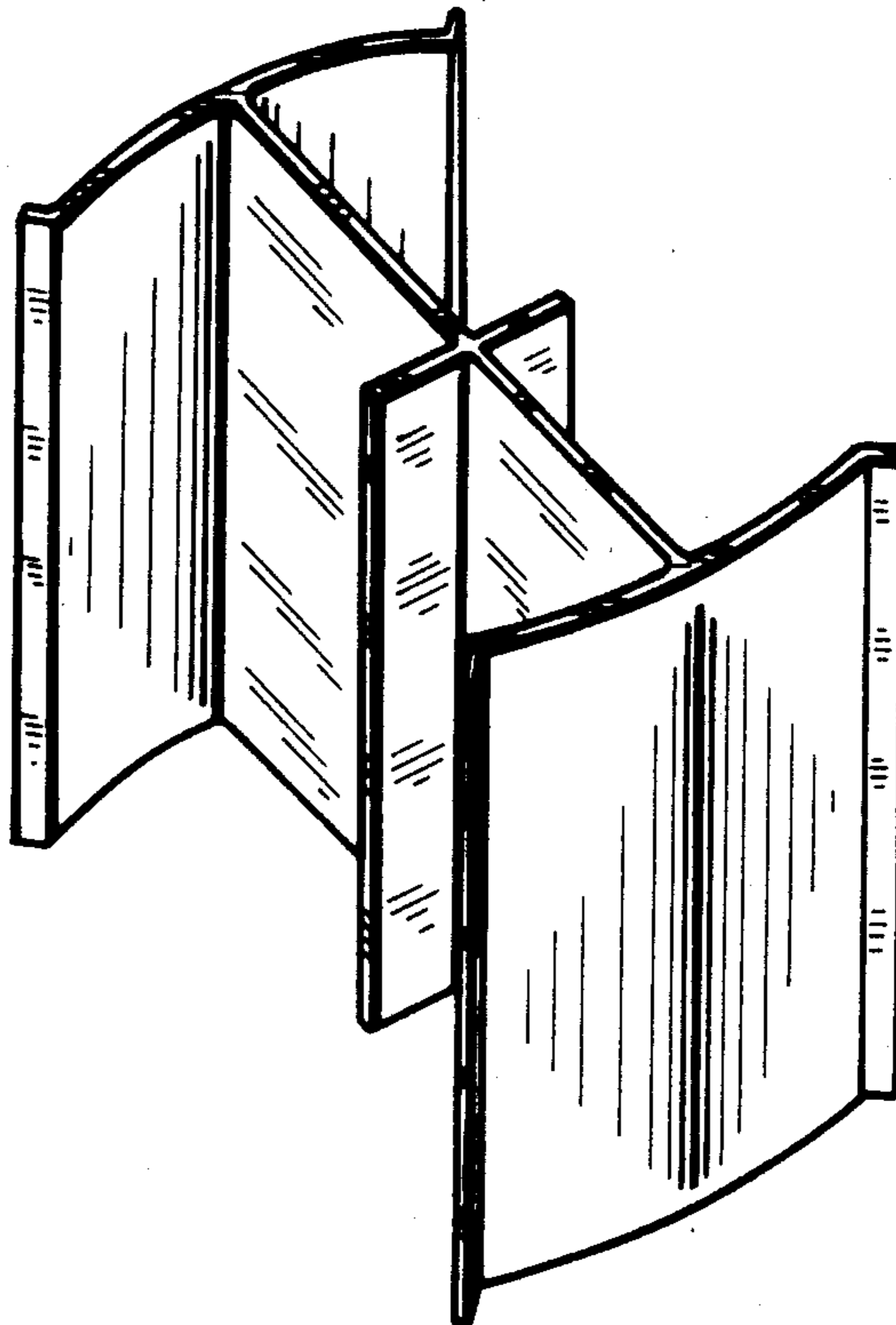
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a modified form of the golf bag club separator.

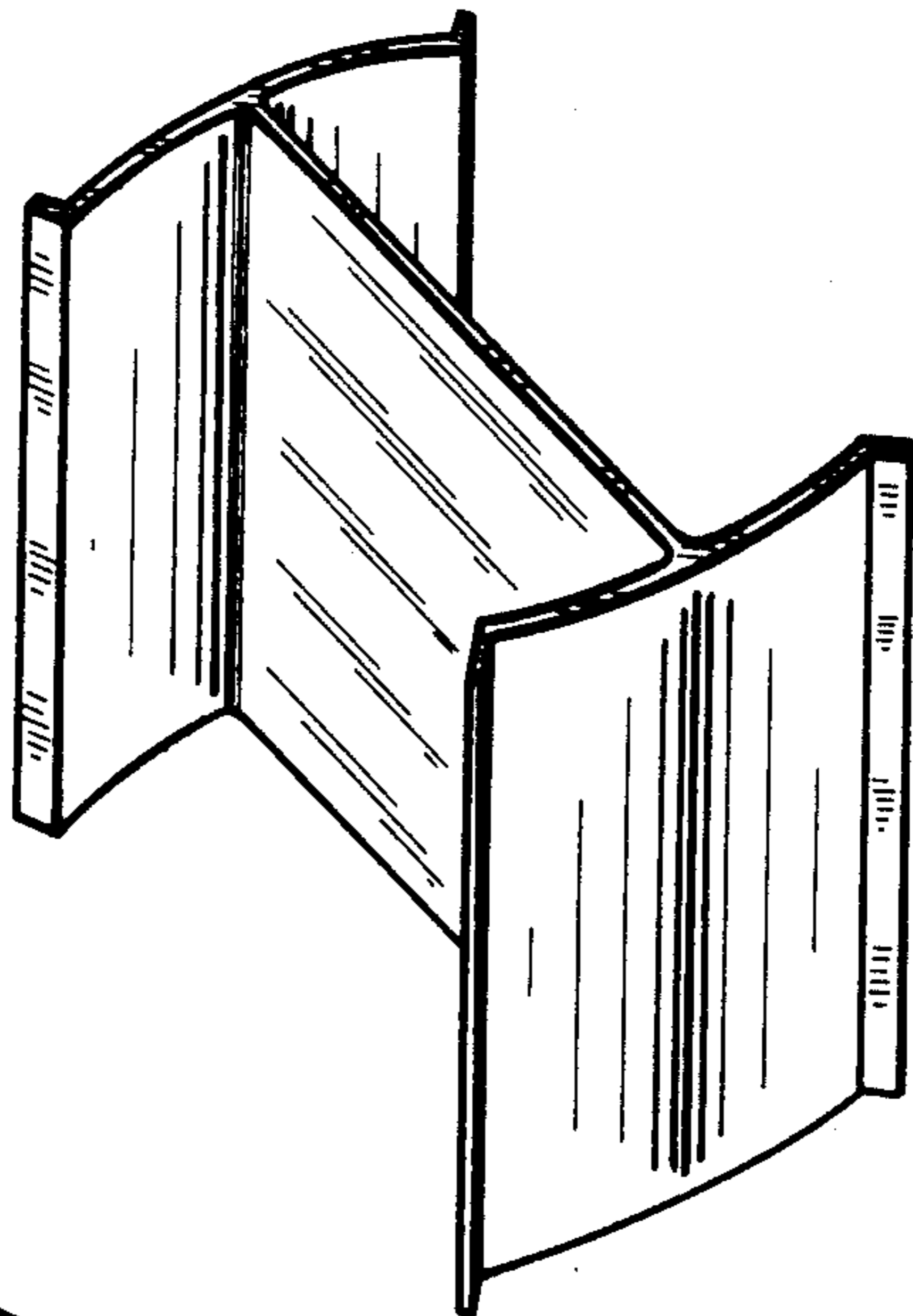
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

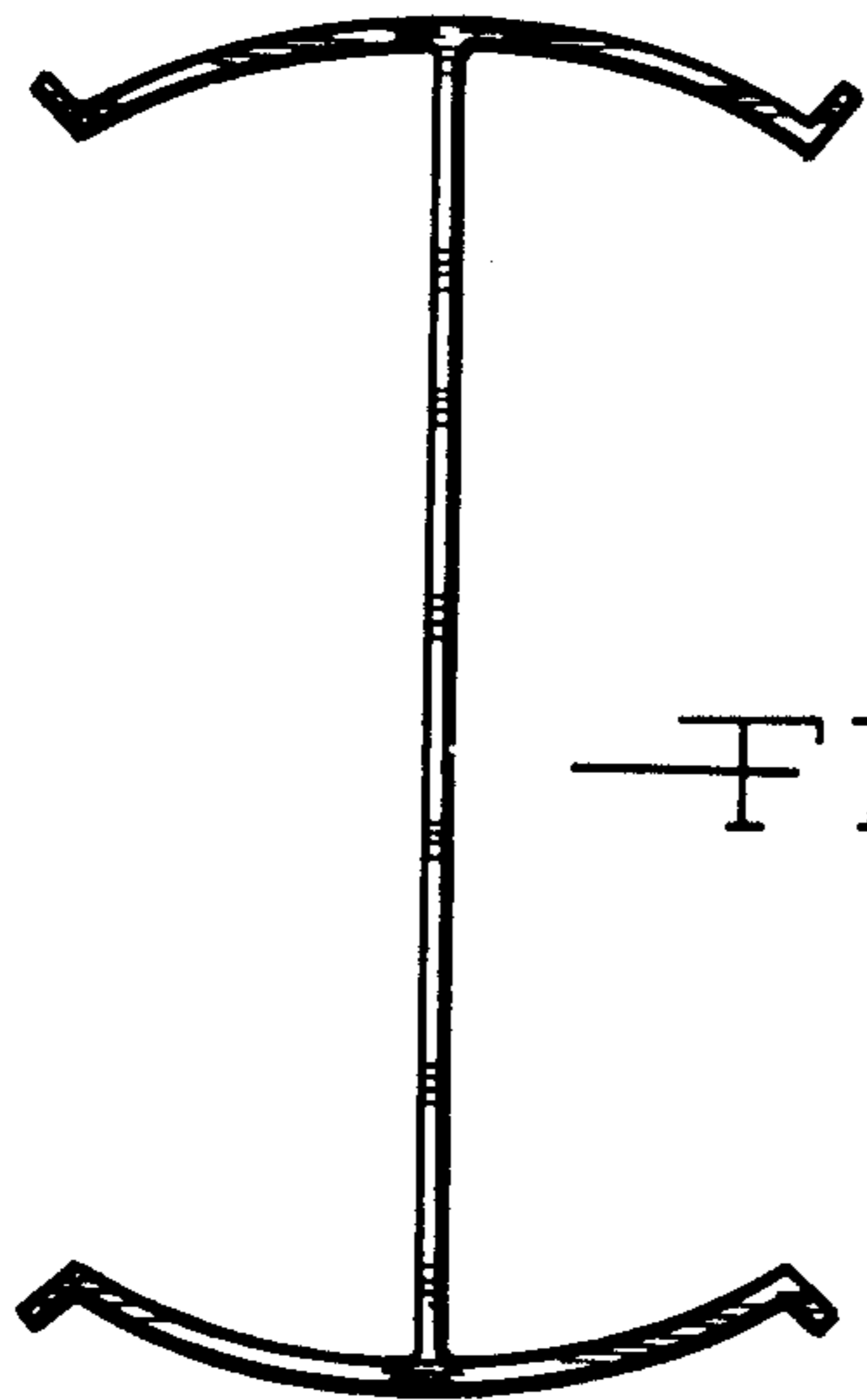
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of another modified form of the golf bag club separator; and

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 8.

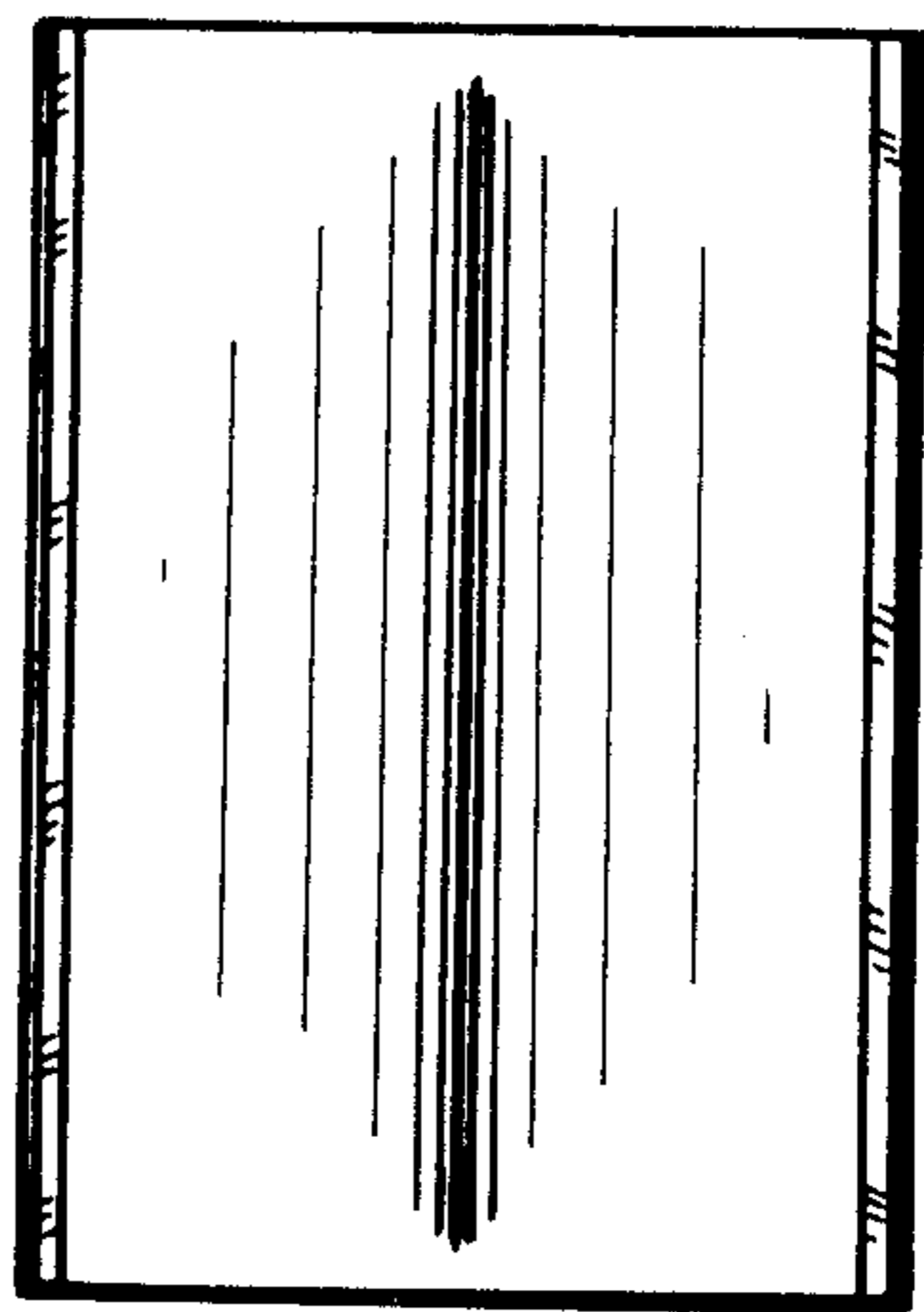




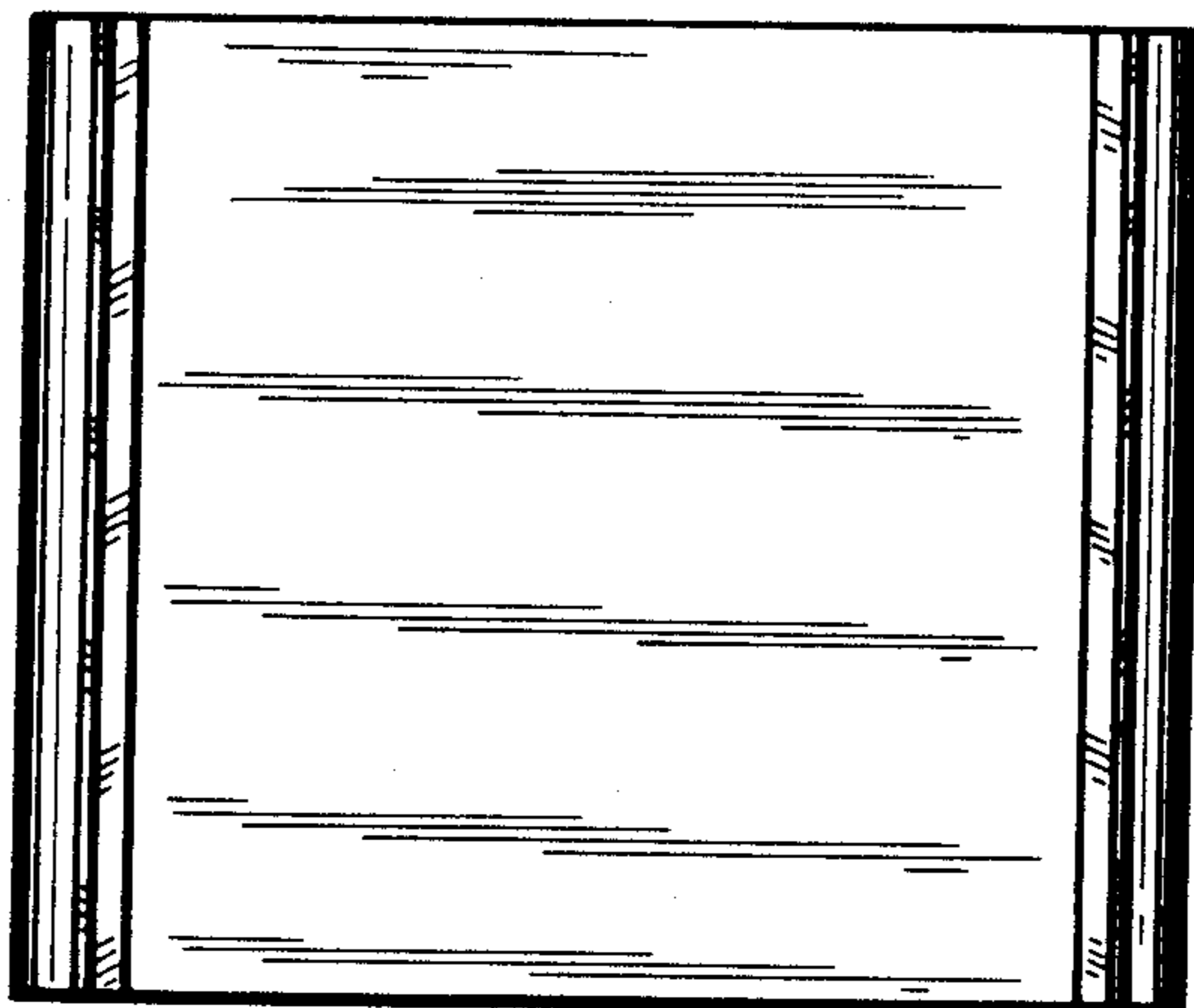

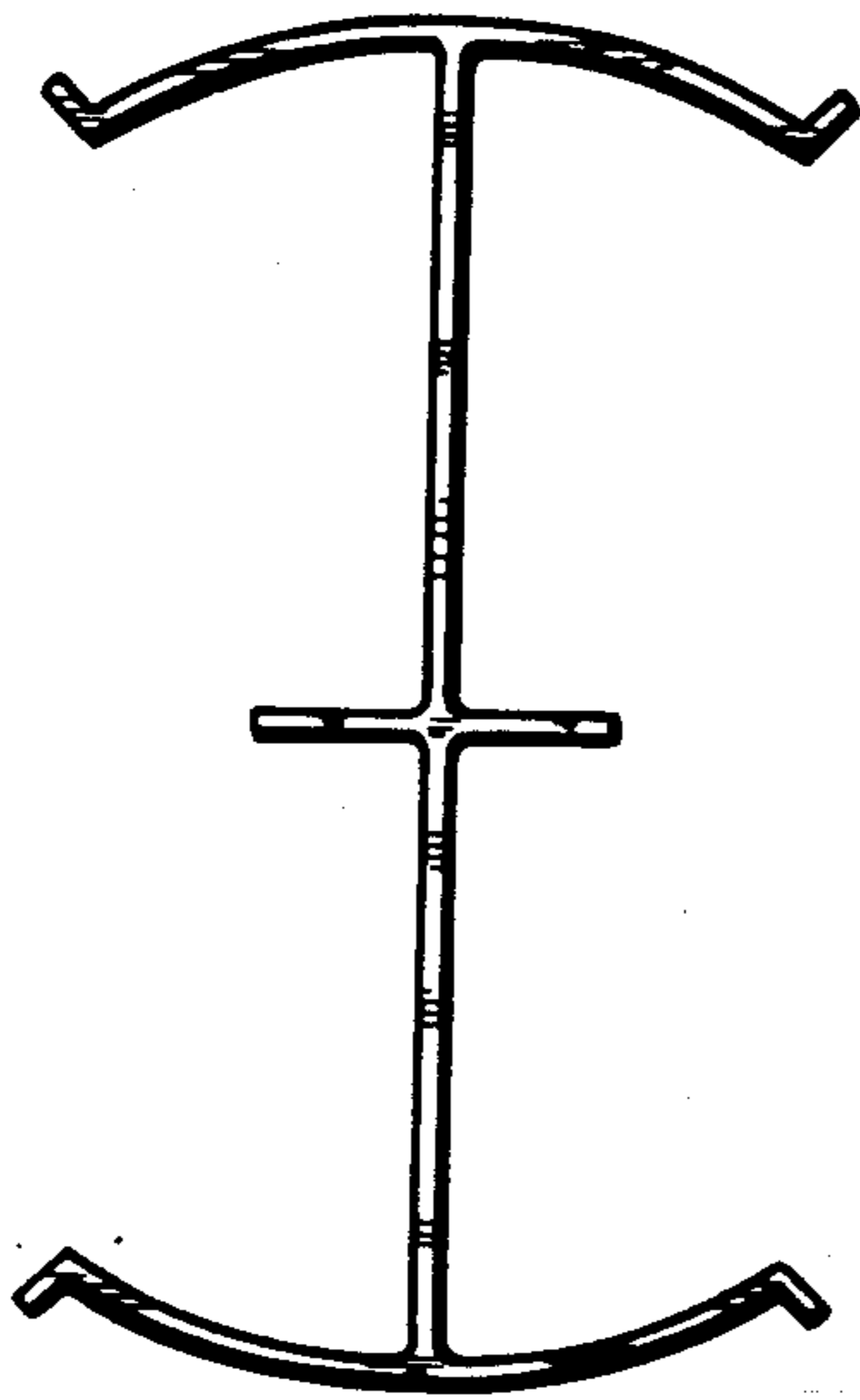
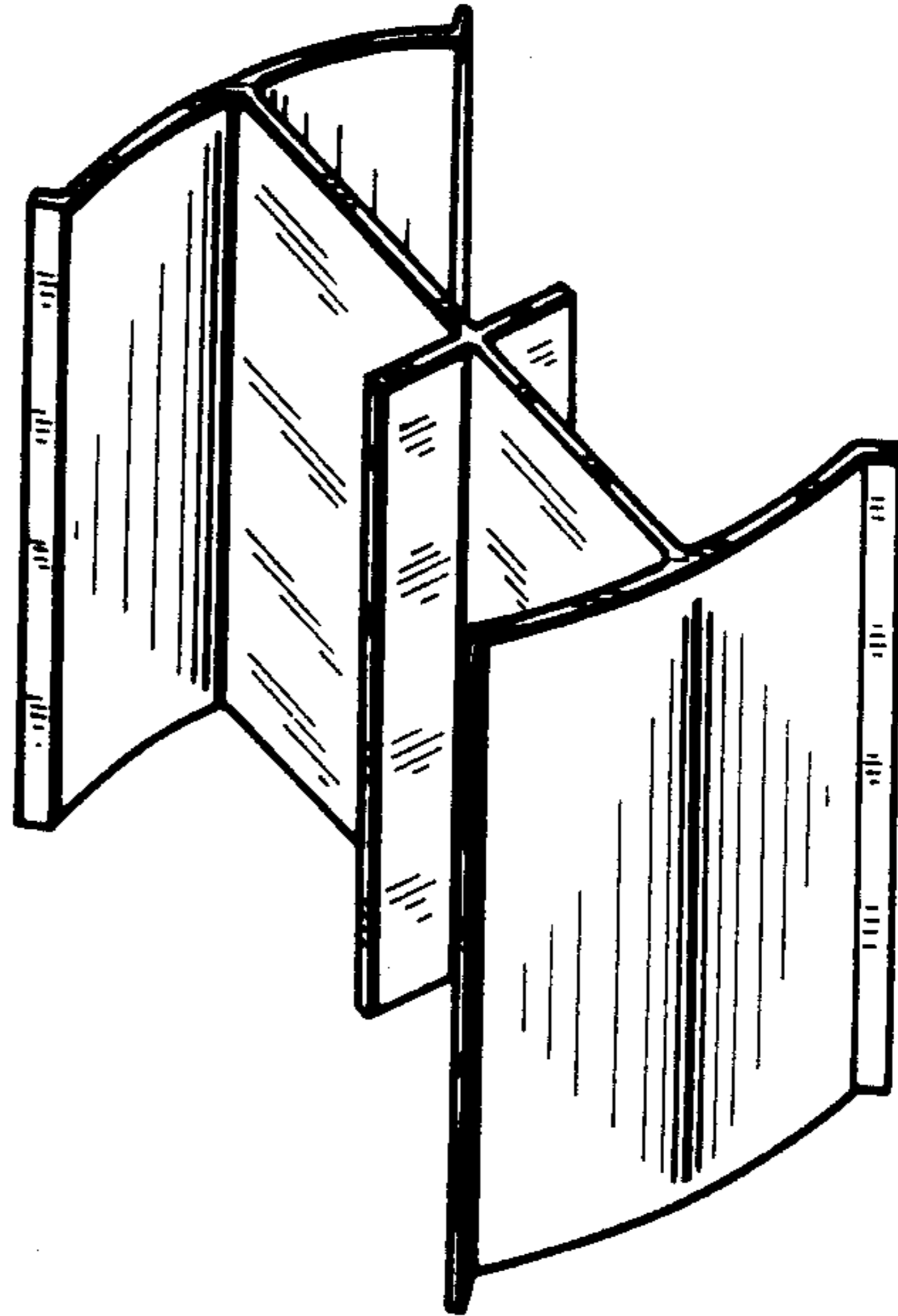
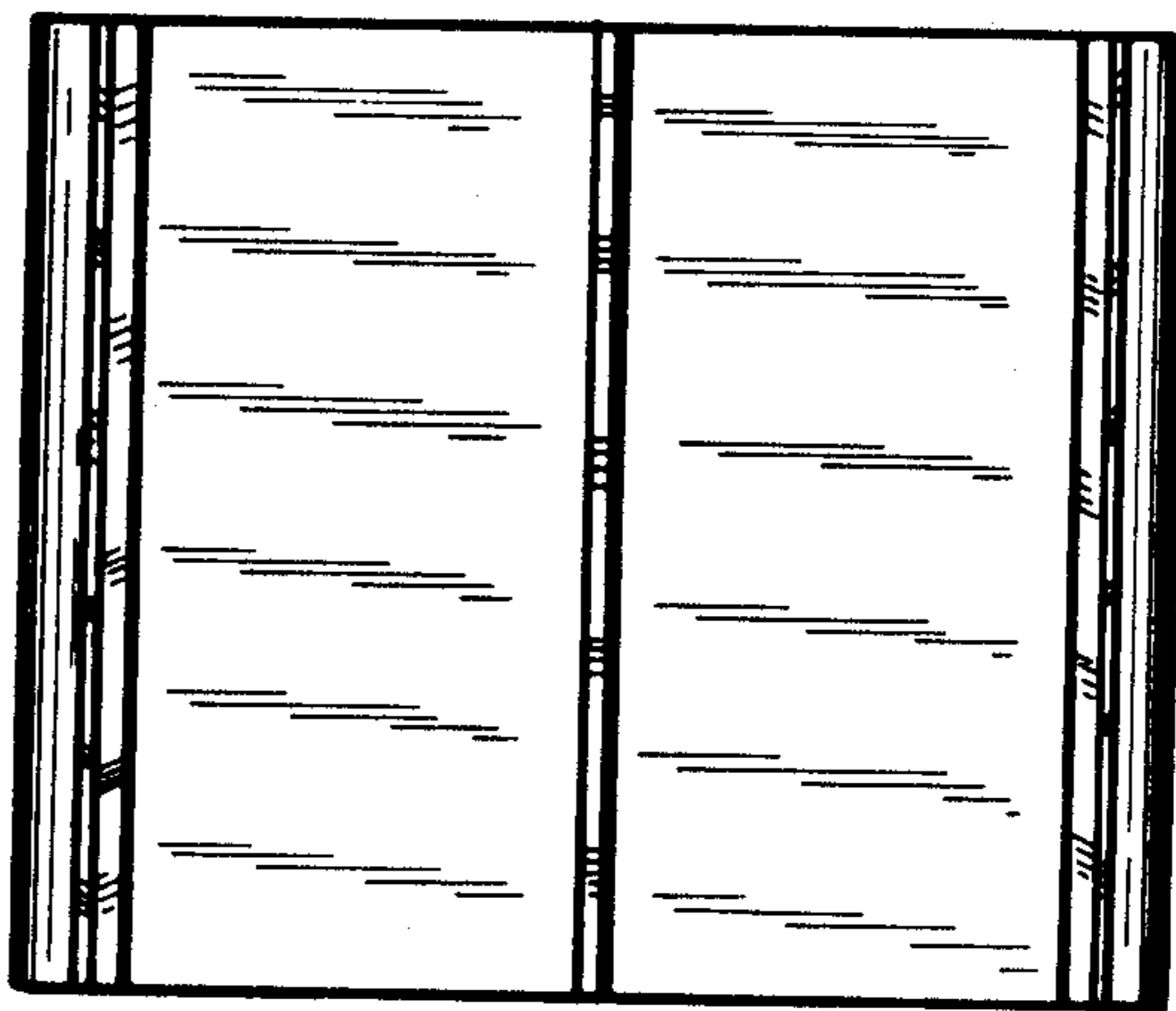

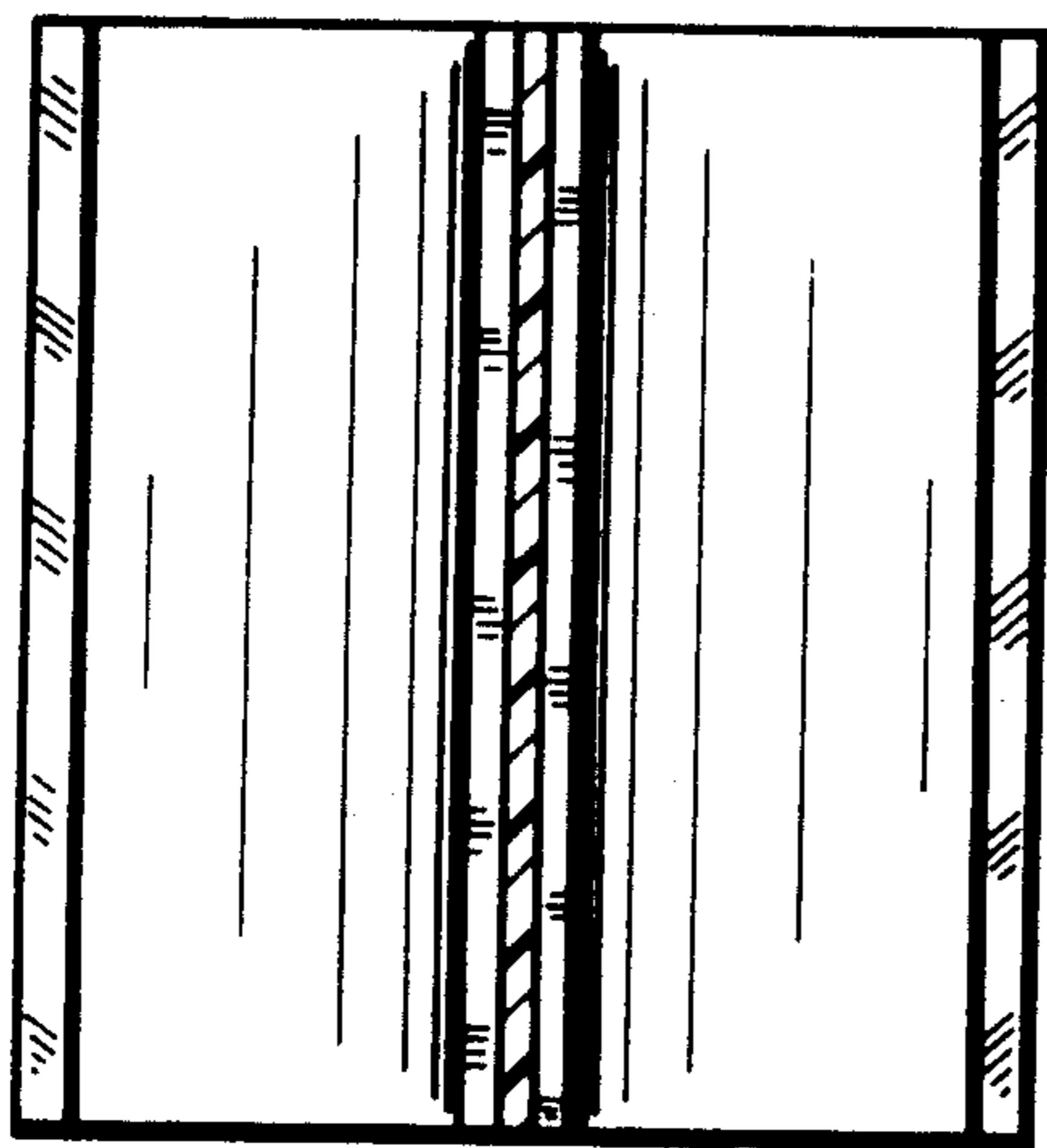
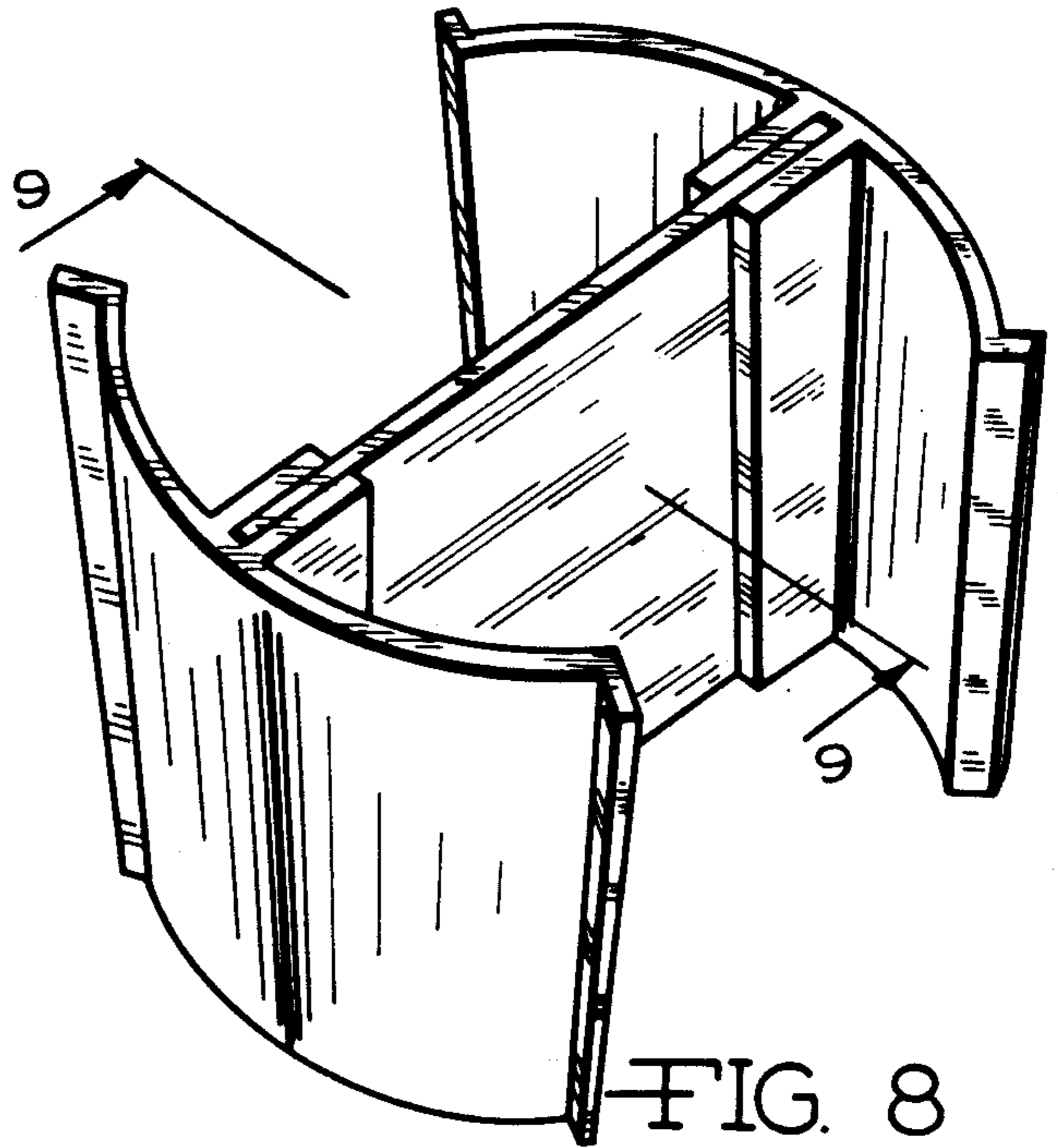
