FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shadow box for displays showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

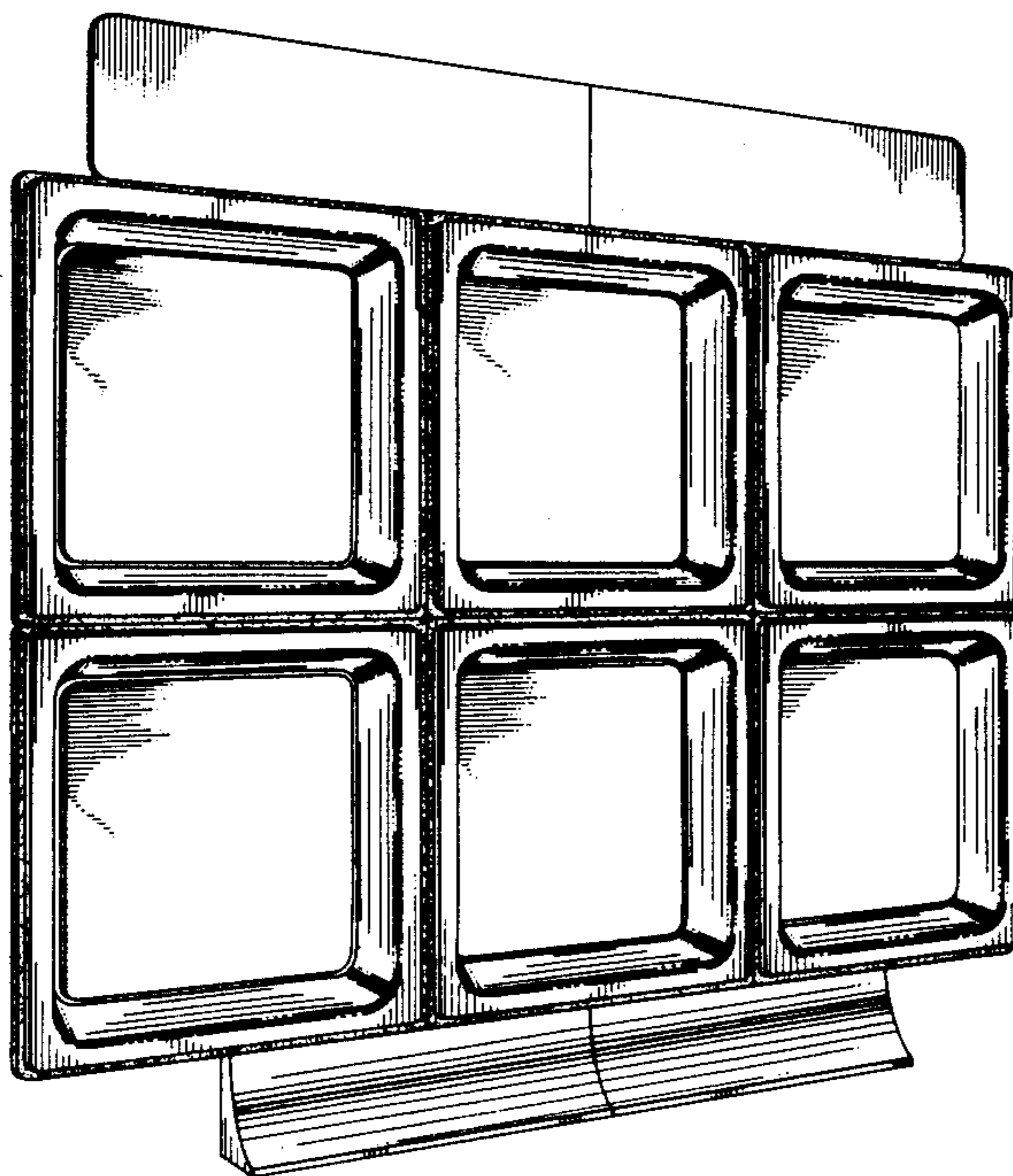

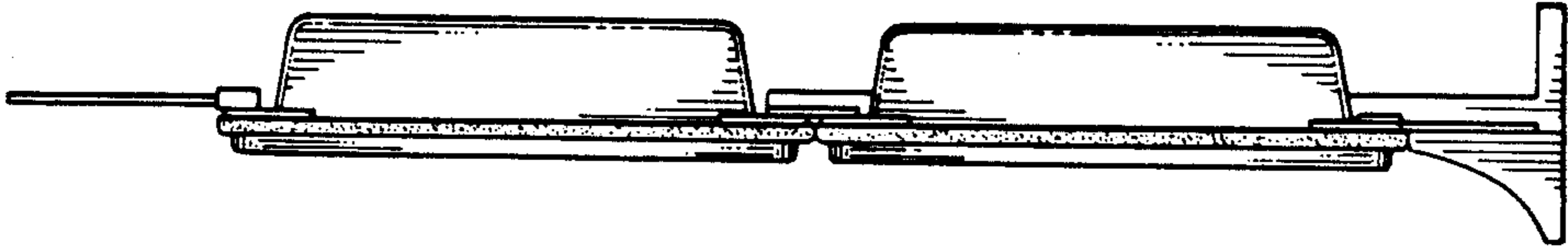
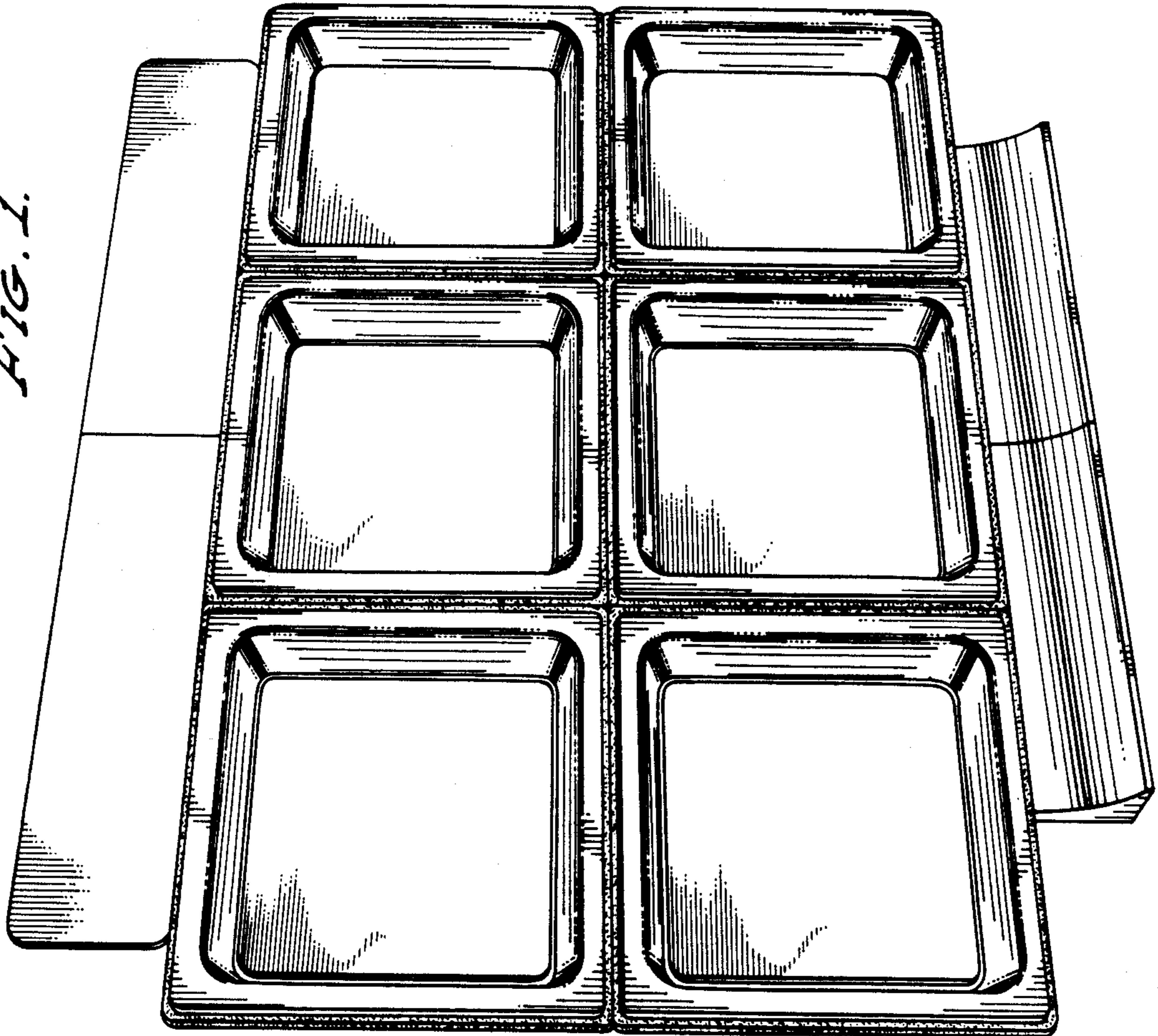

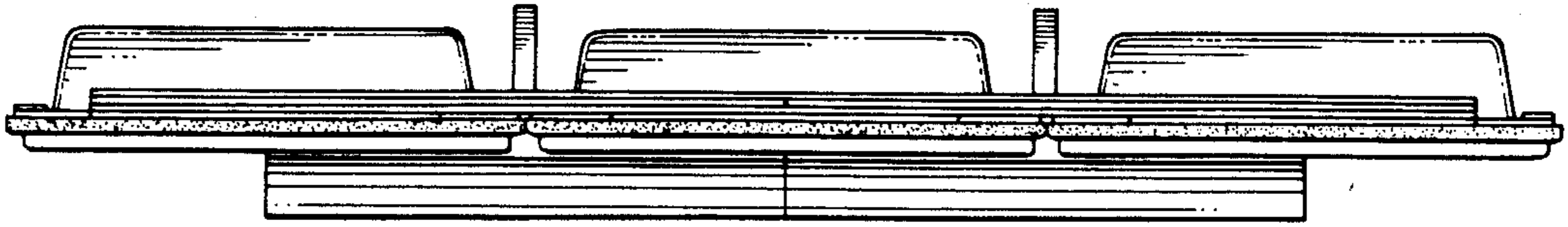

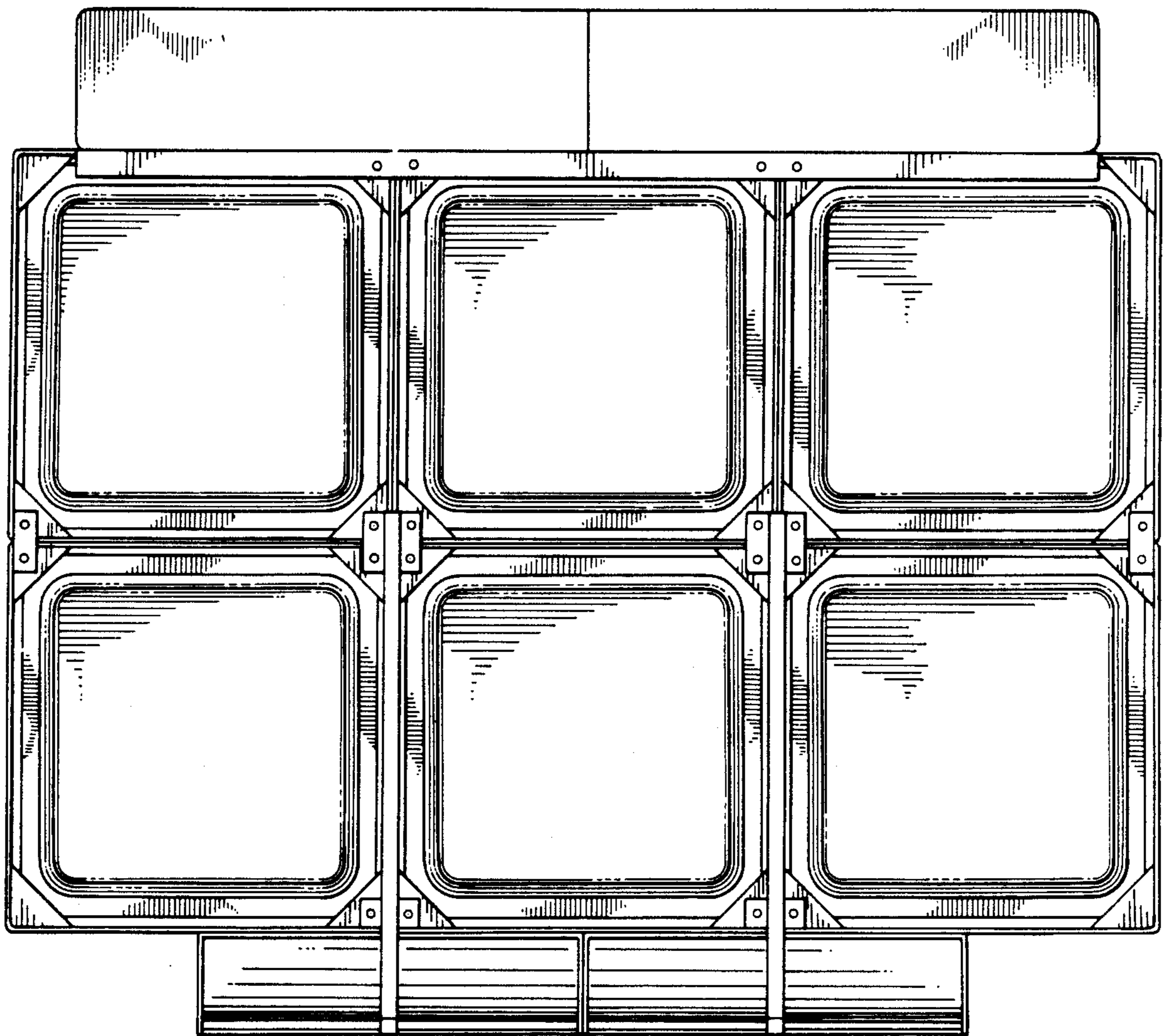

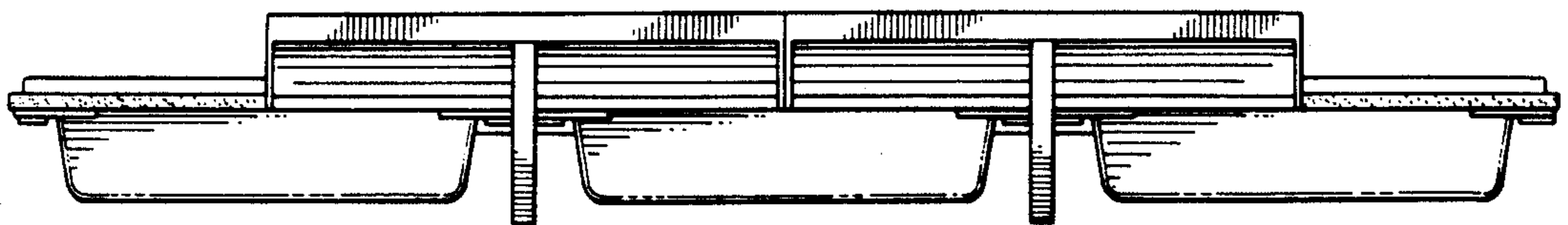
