FIG. 4 is a side elevational view opposite to that of FIG. 2.

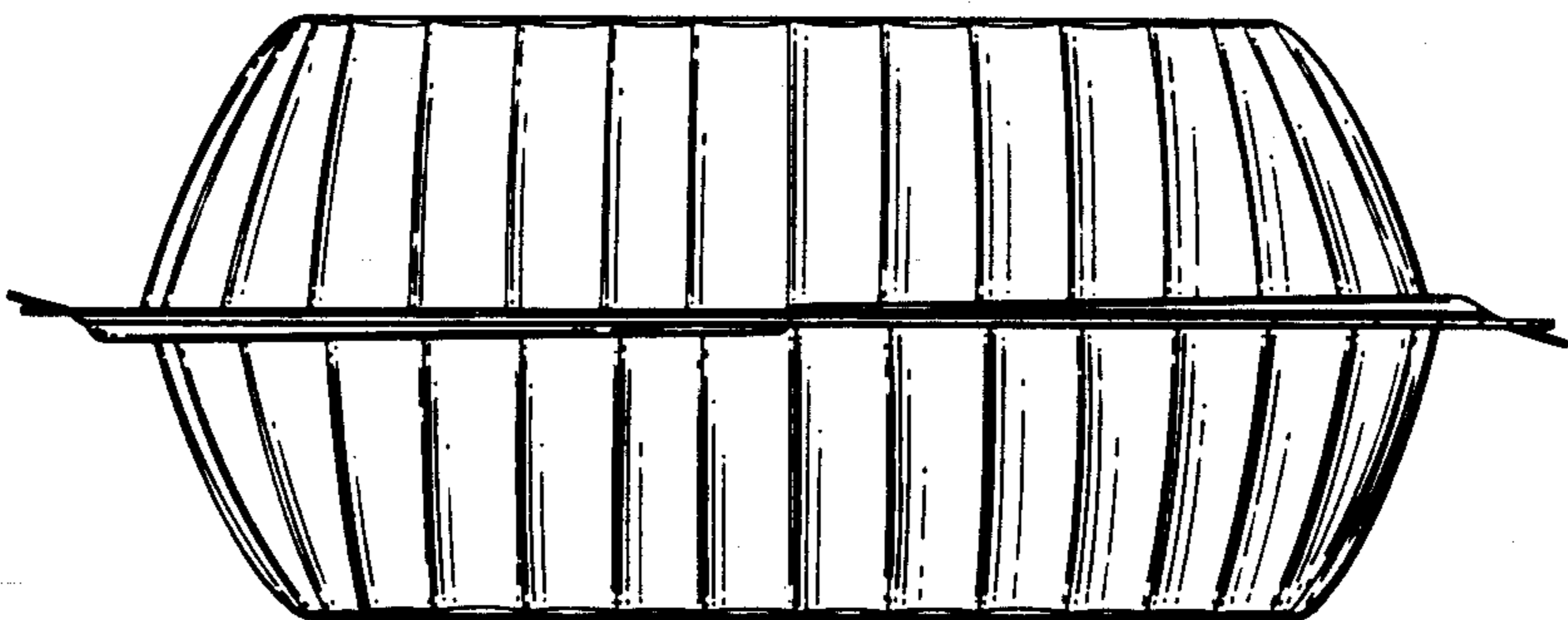
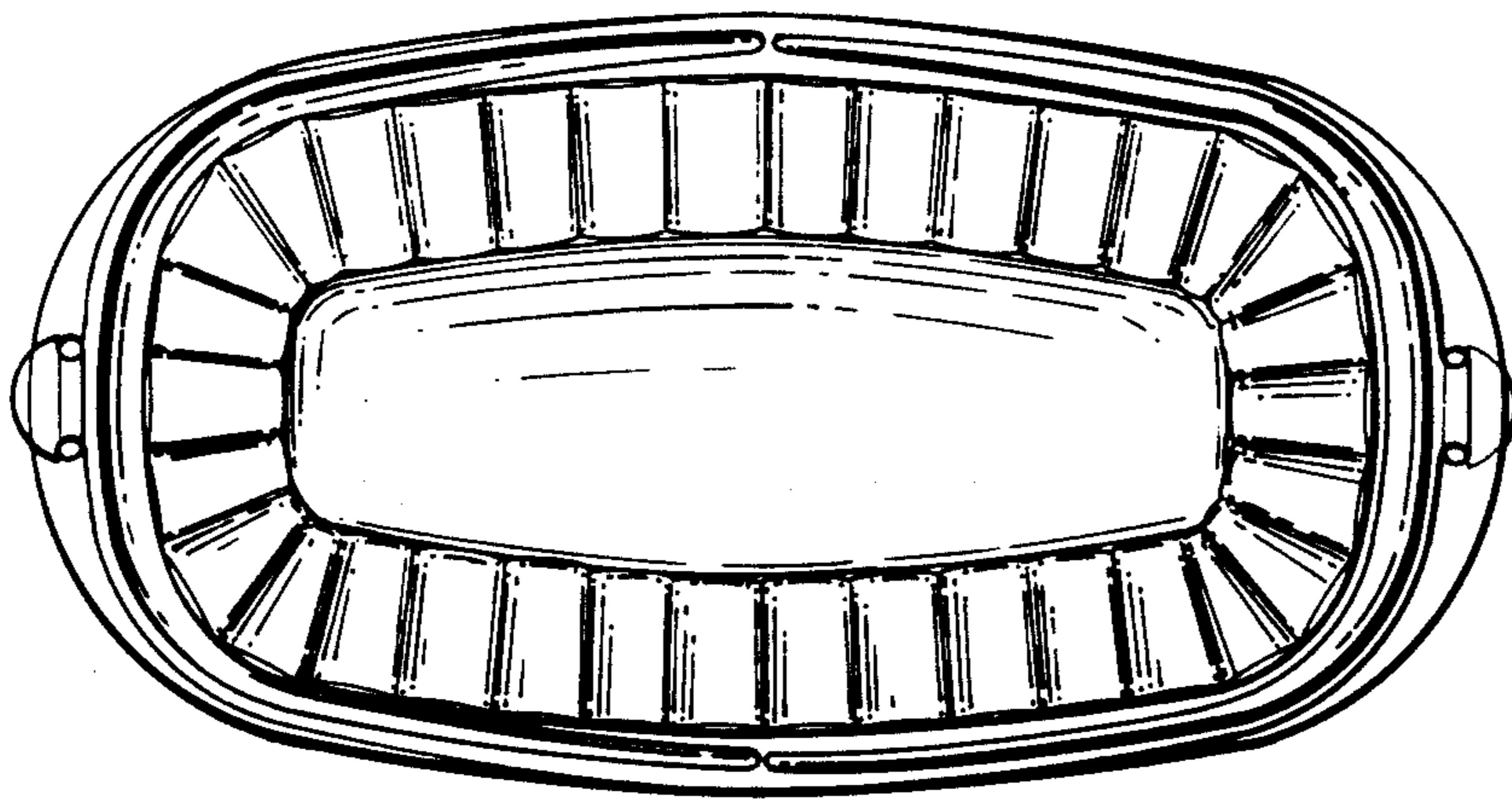
FIG. 5 is an end view thereof.

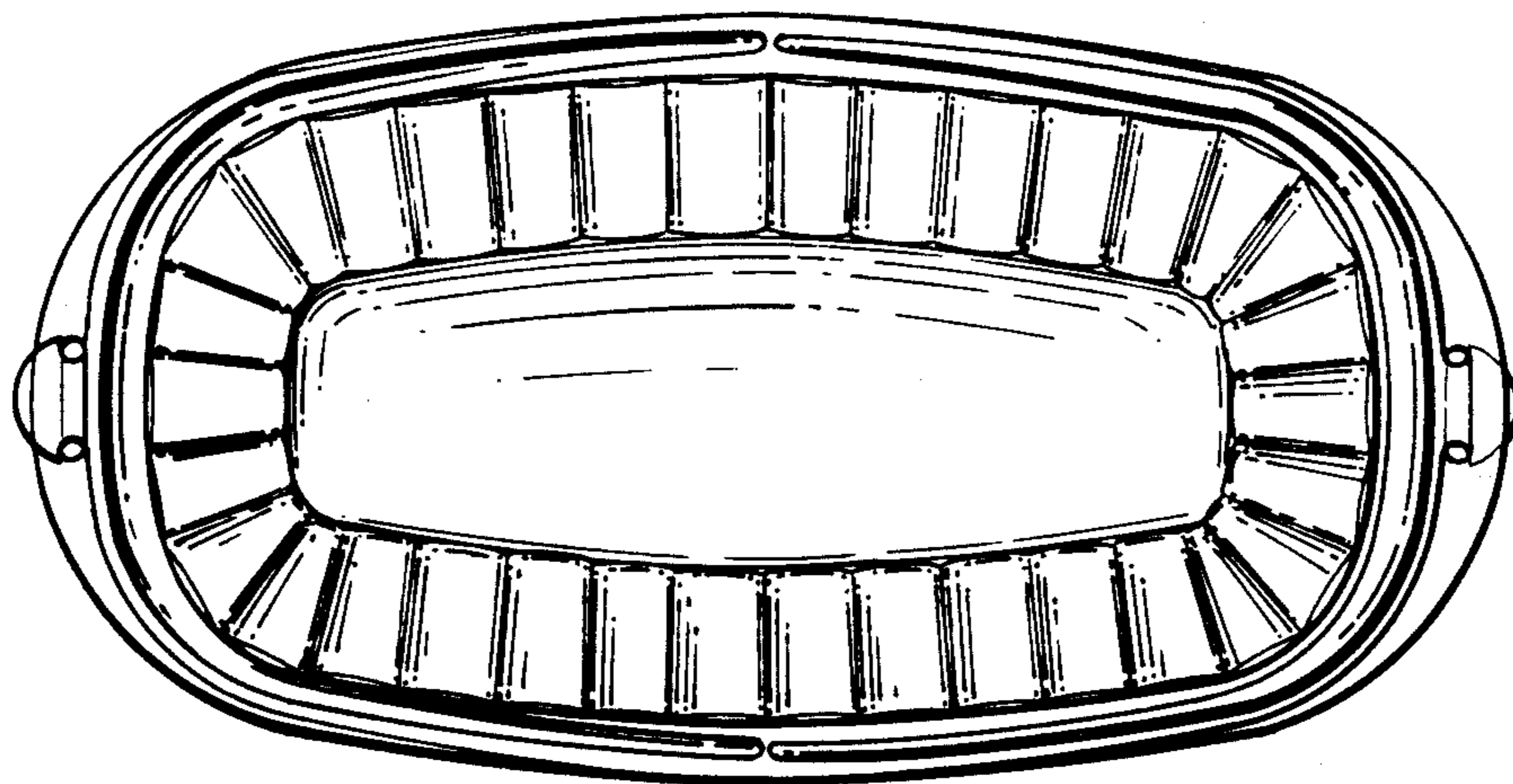

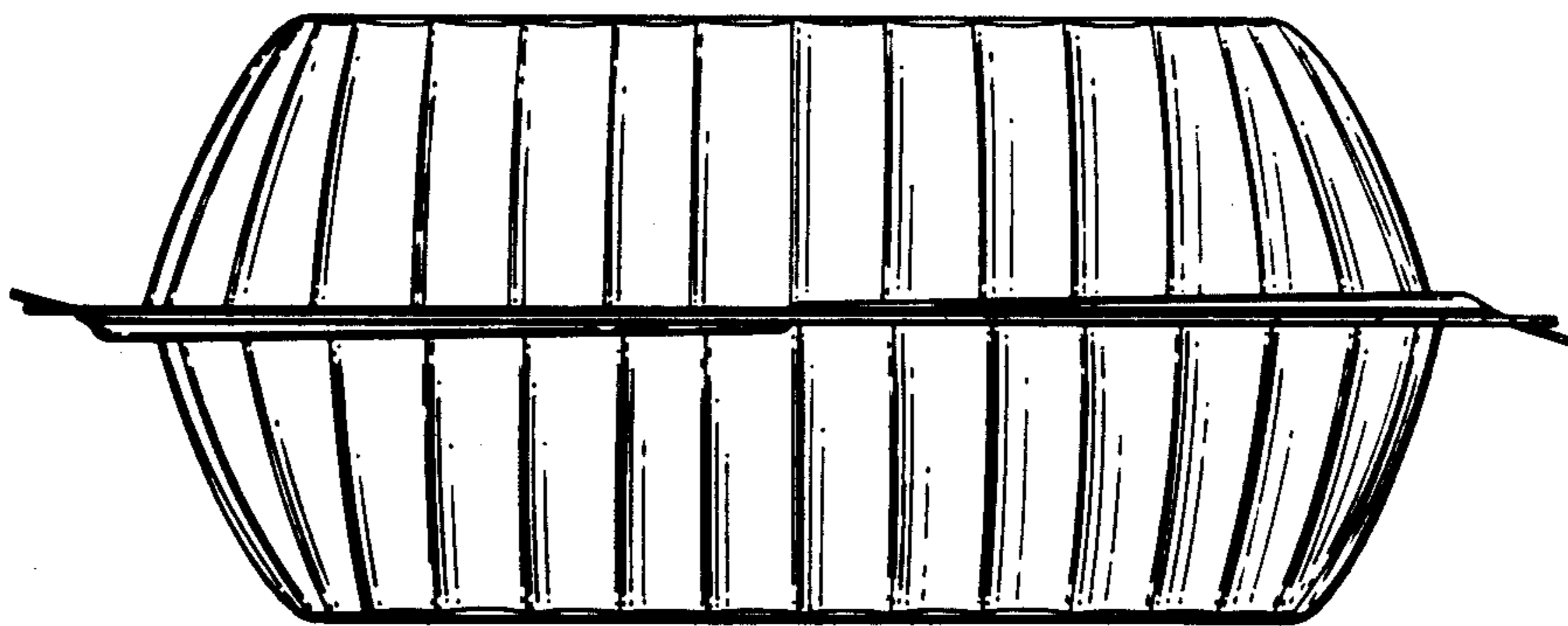

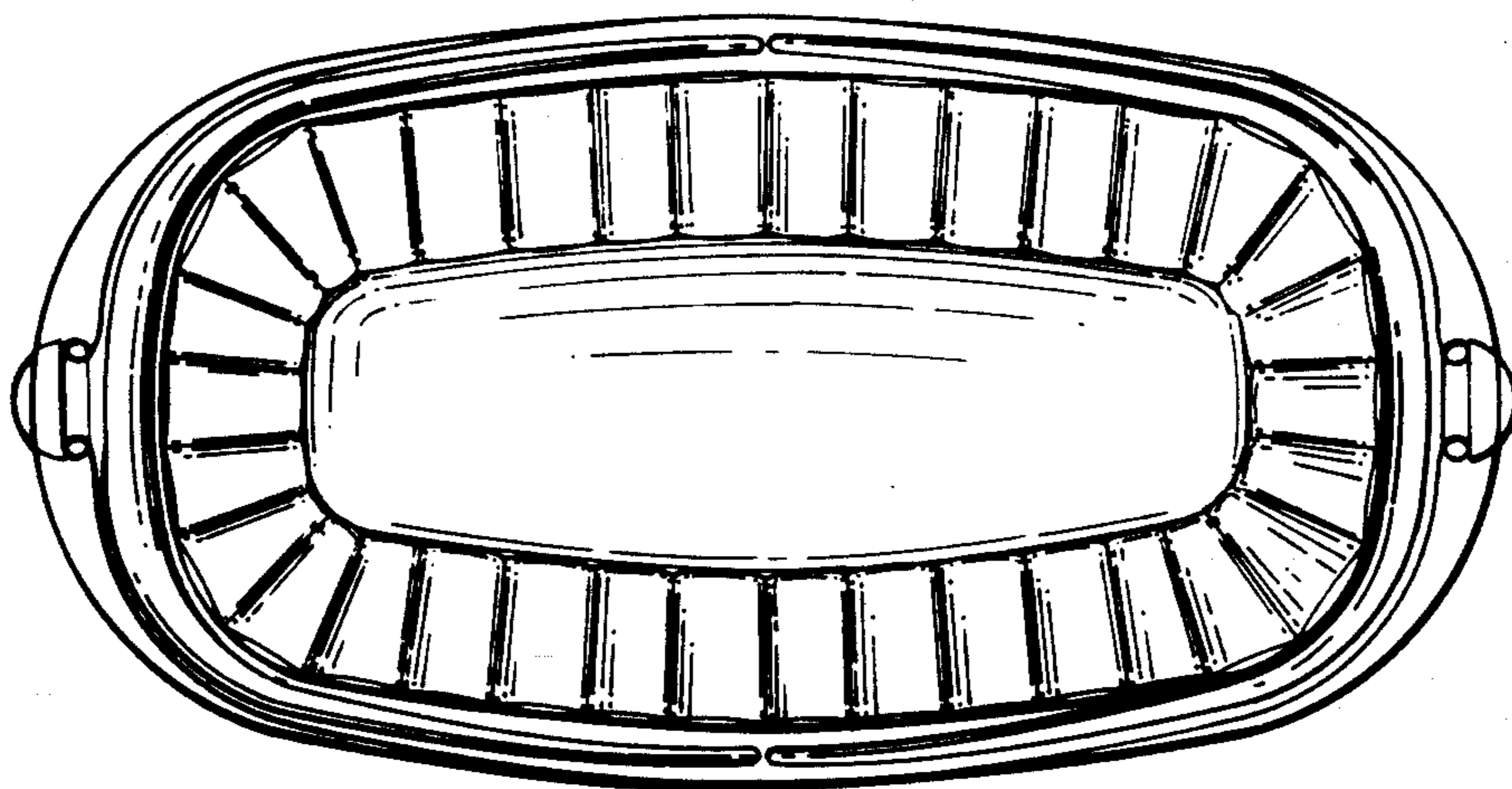

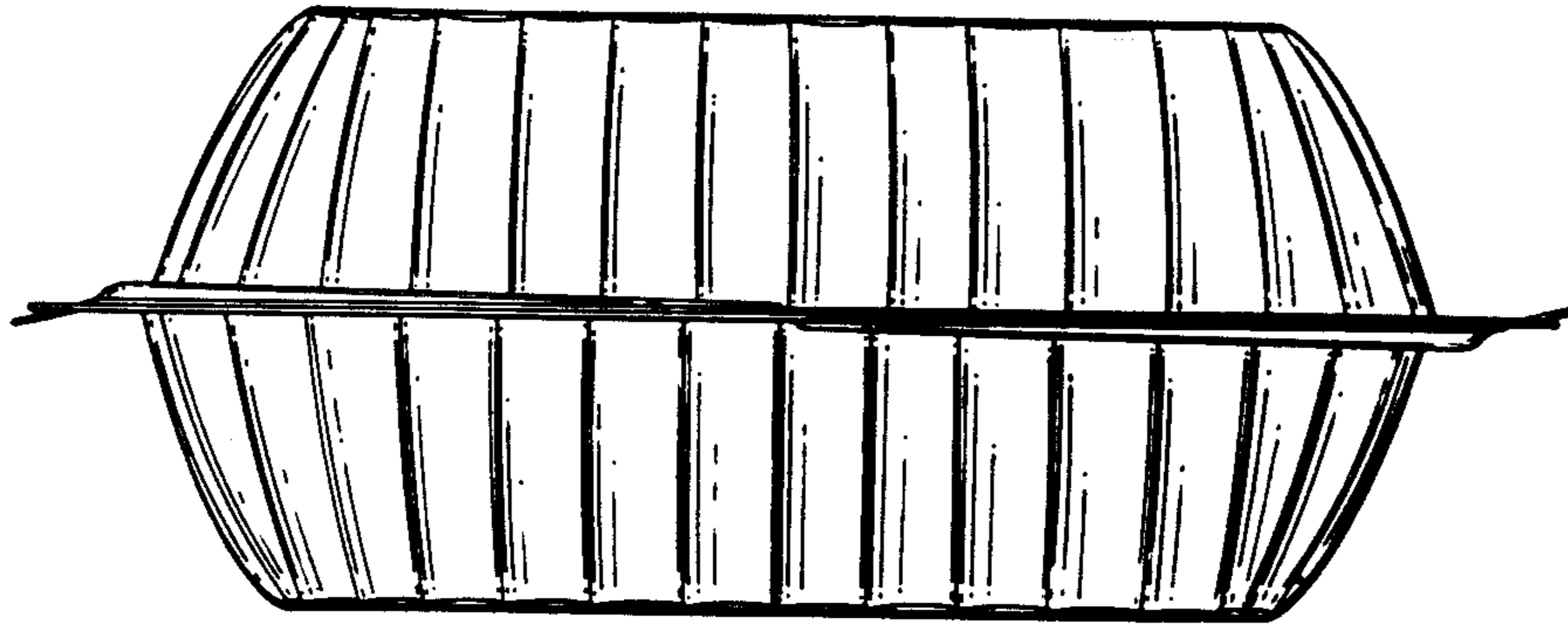

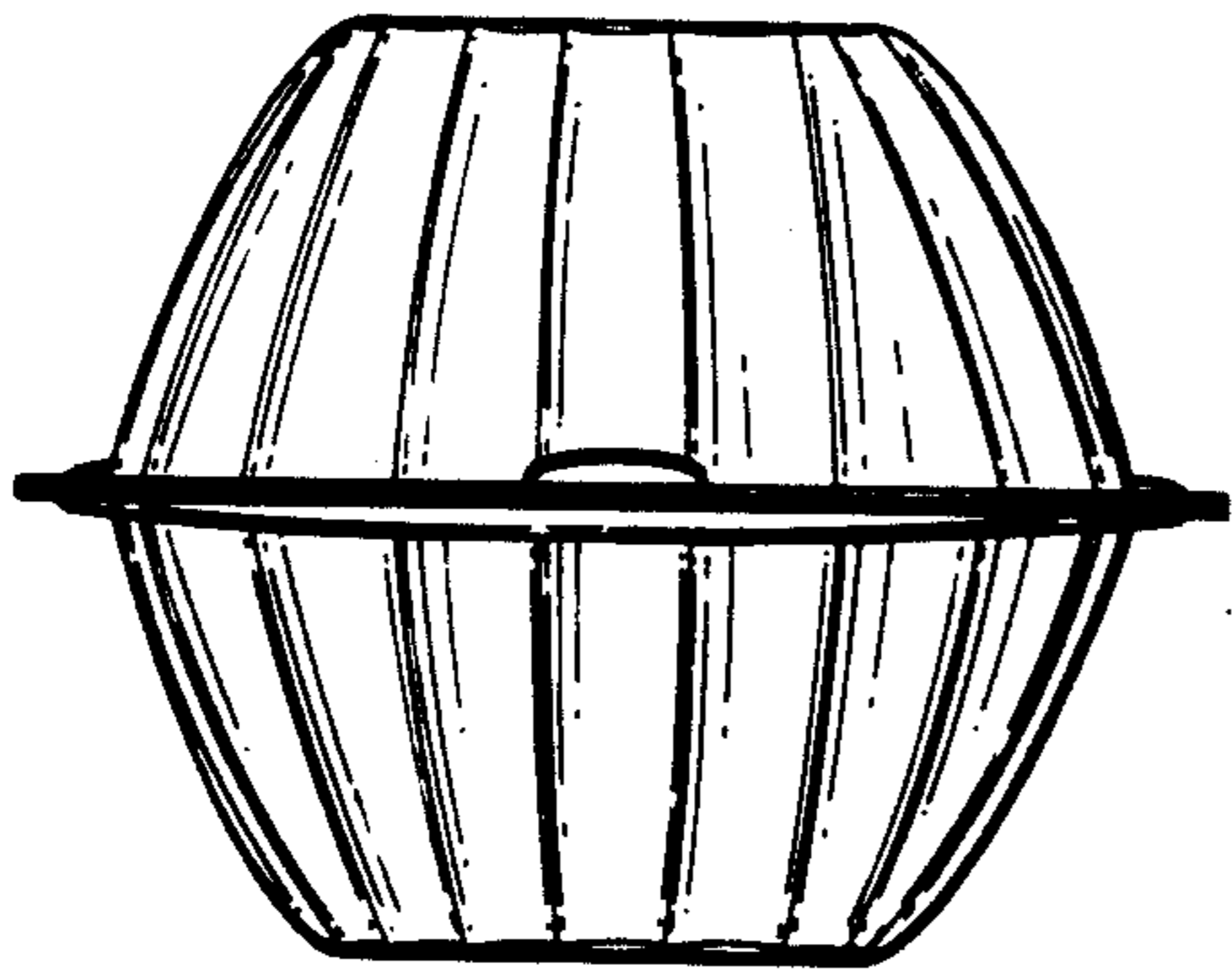

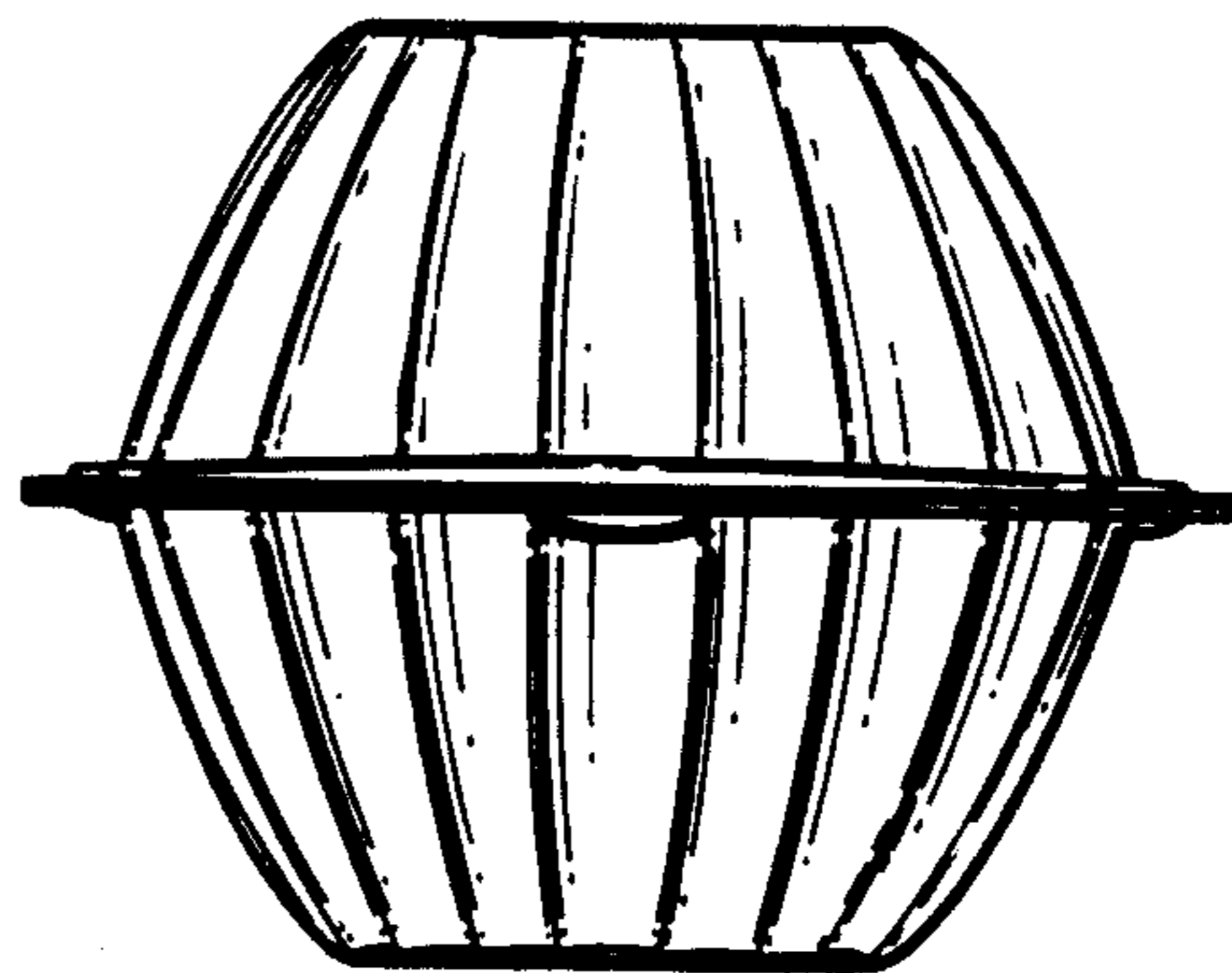
