[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined jar and closure, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined jar and closure showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. The side opposite that seen in FIG. 2 is the same in appearance as the side shown.

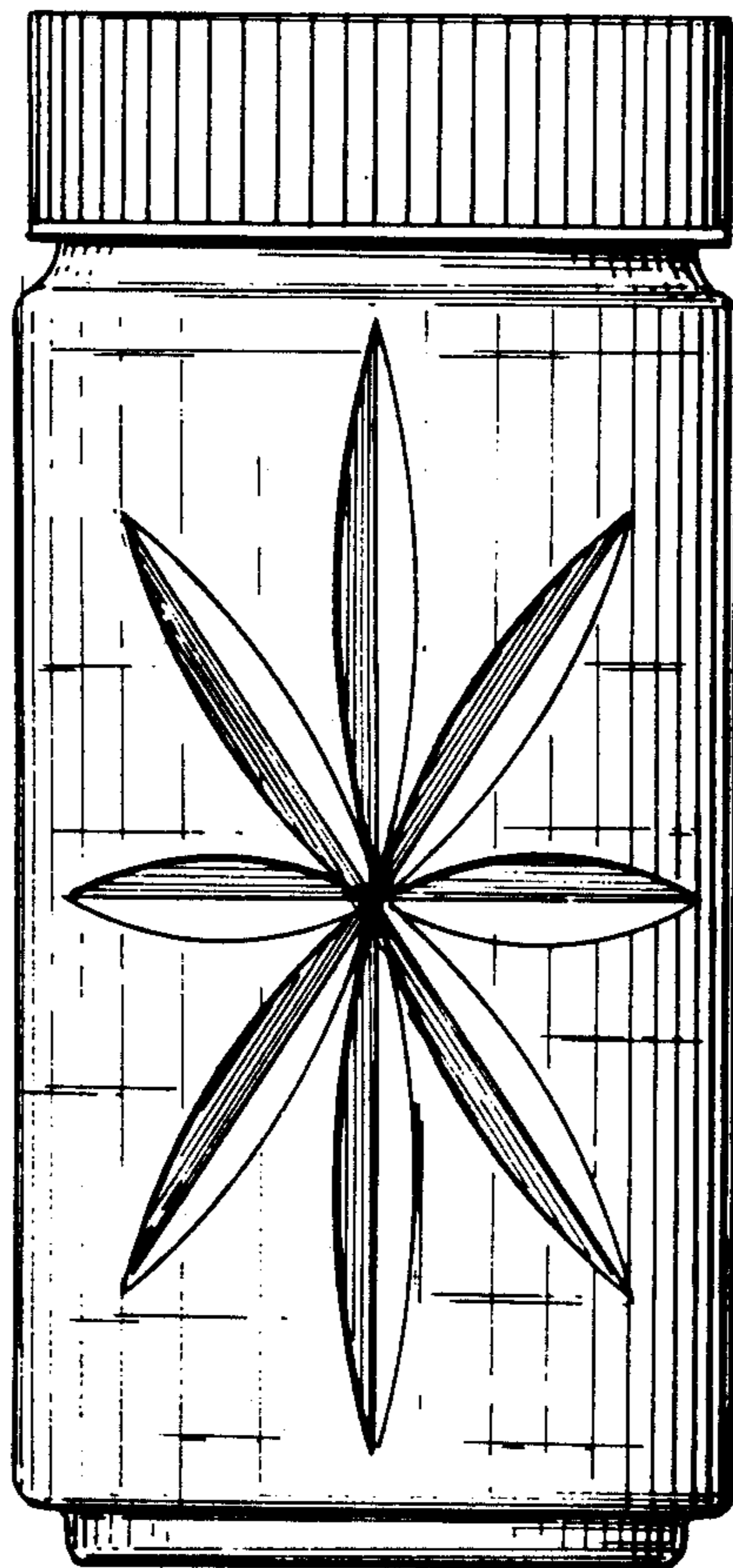

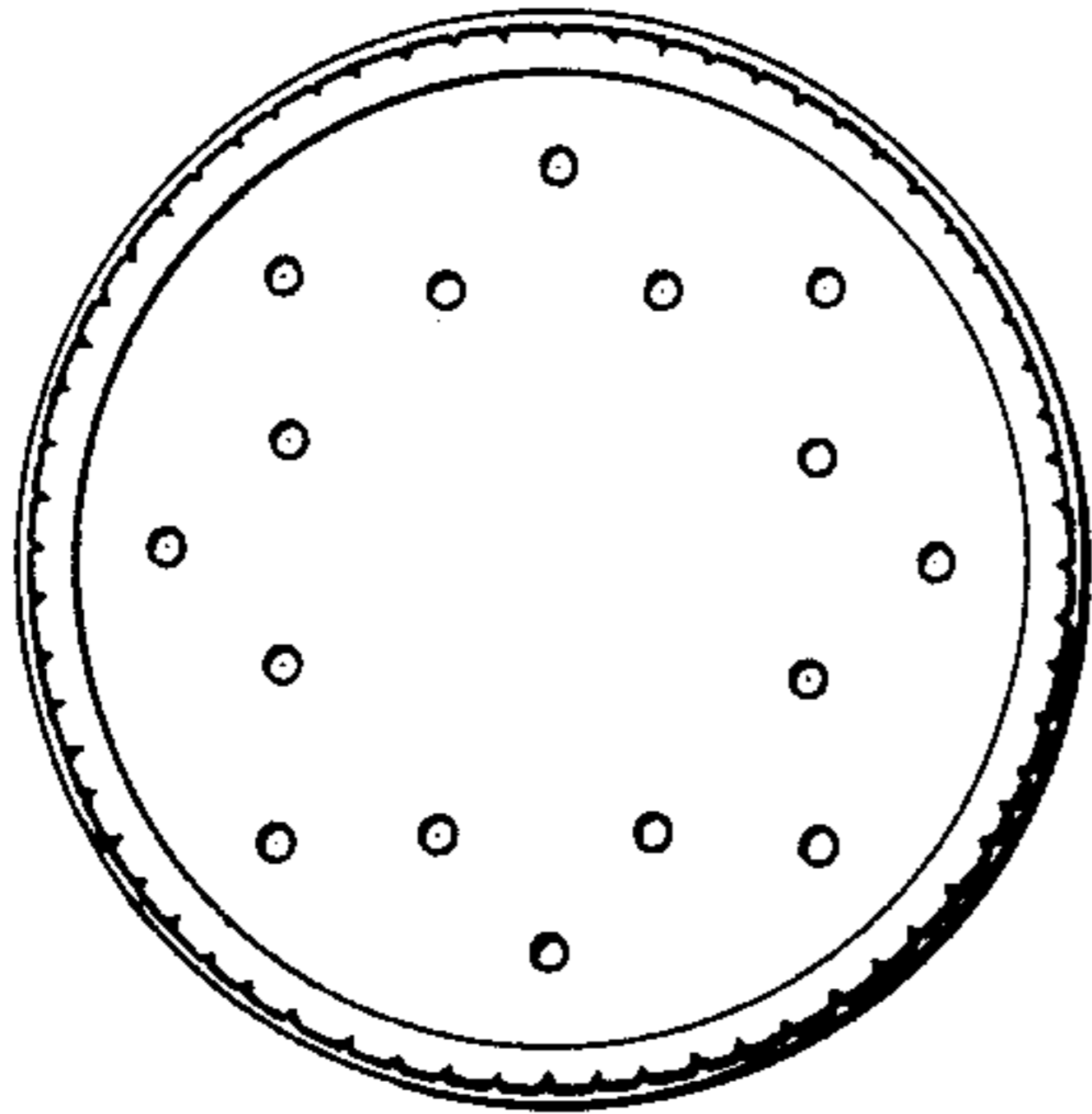

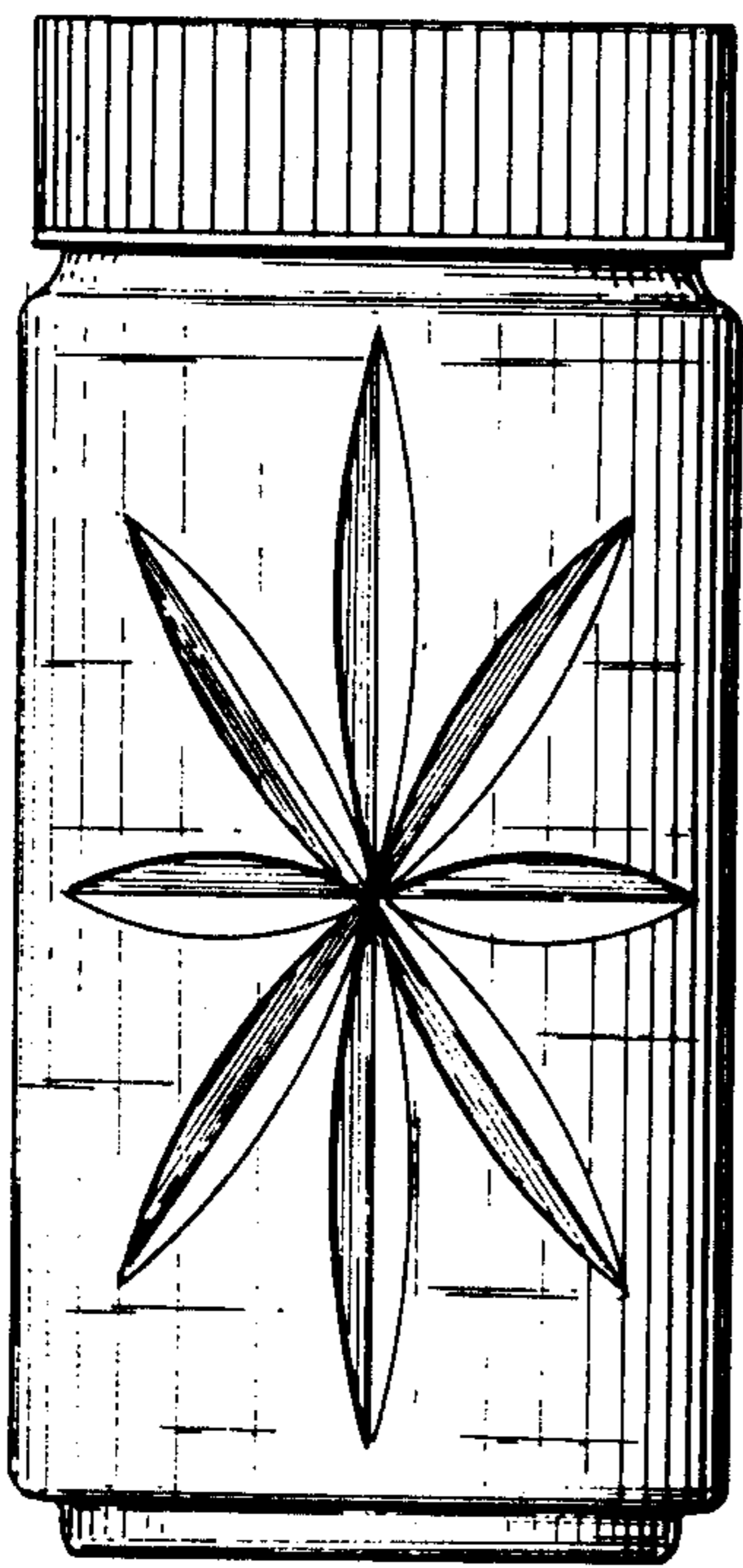

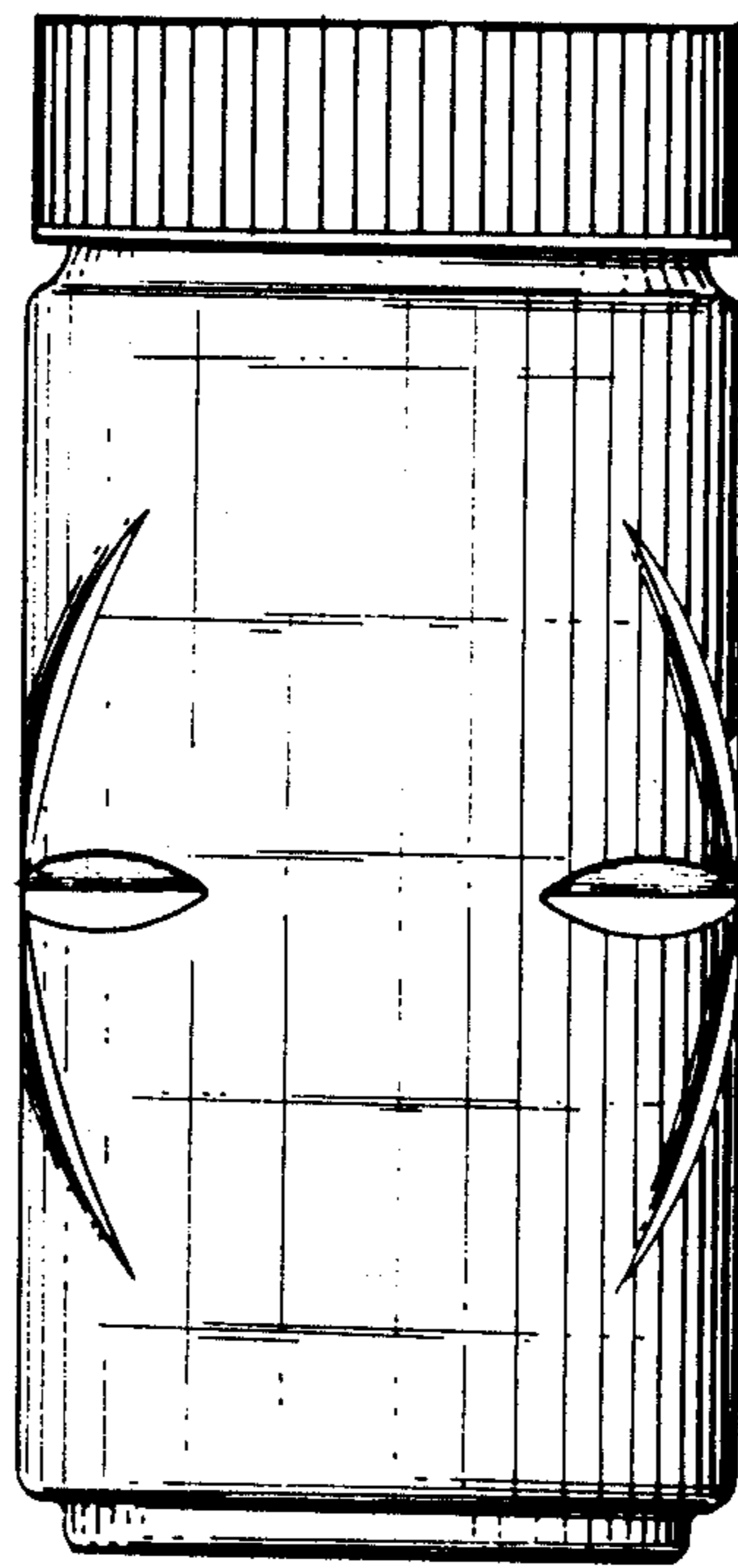
