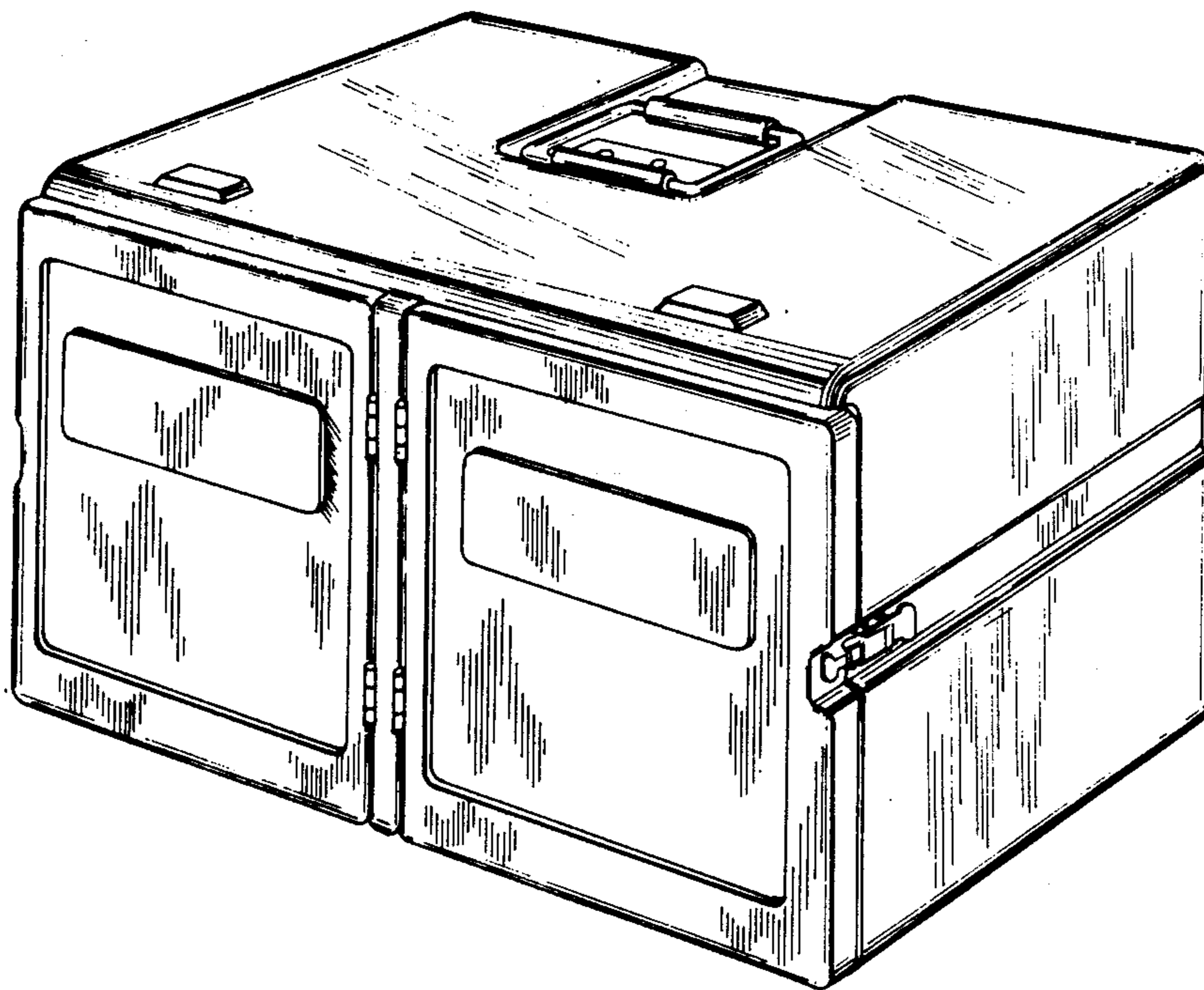

a mirror image thereof.



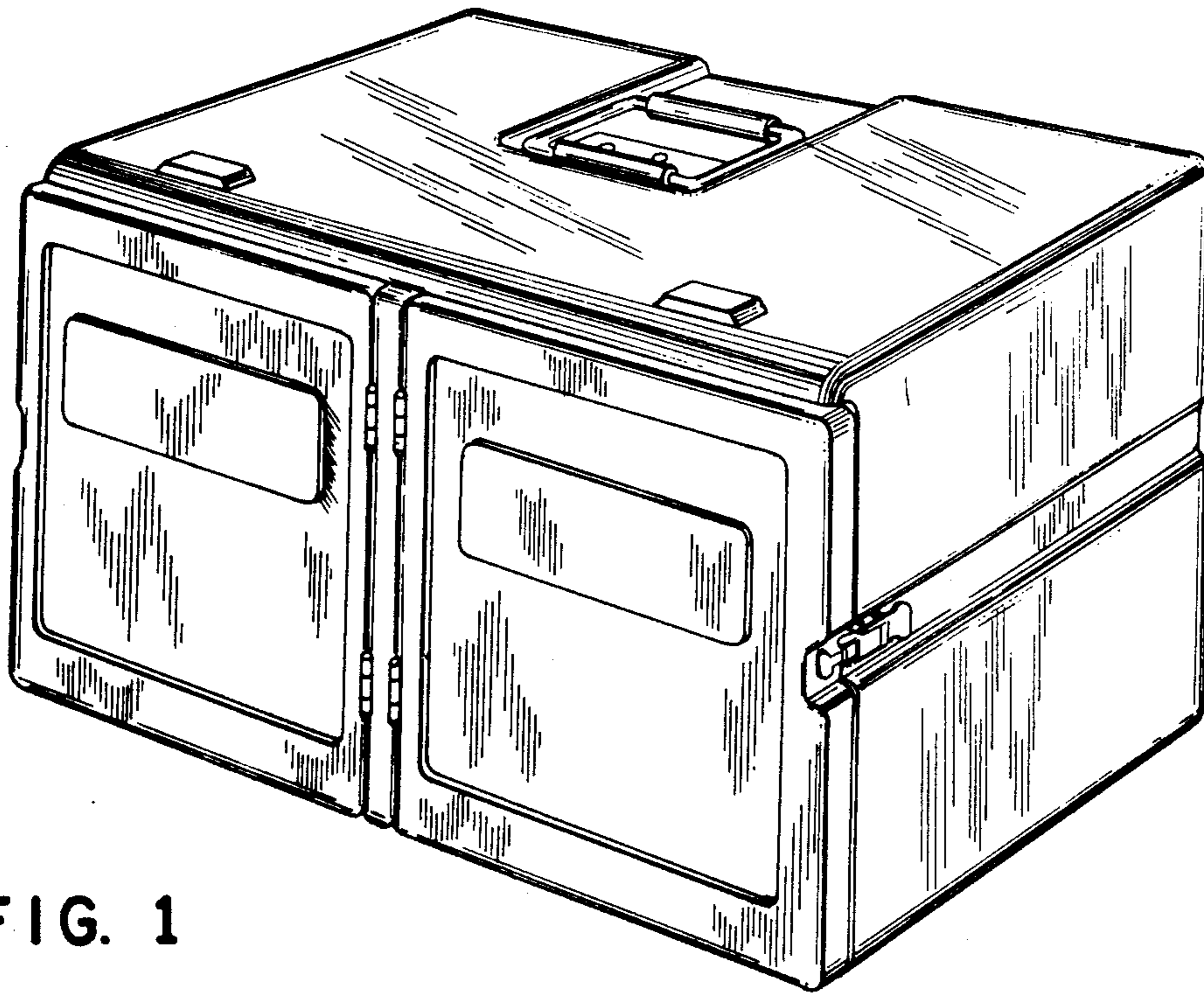

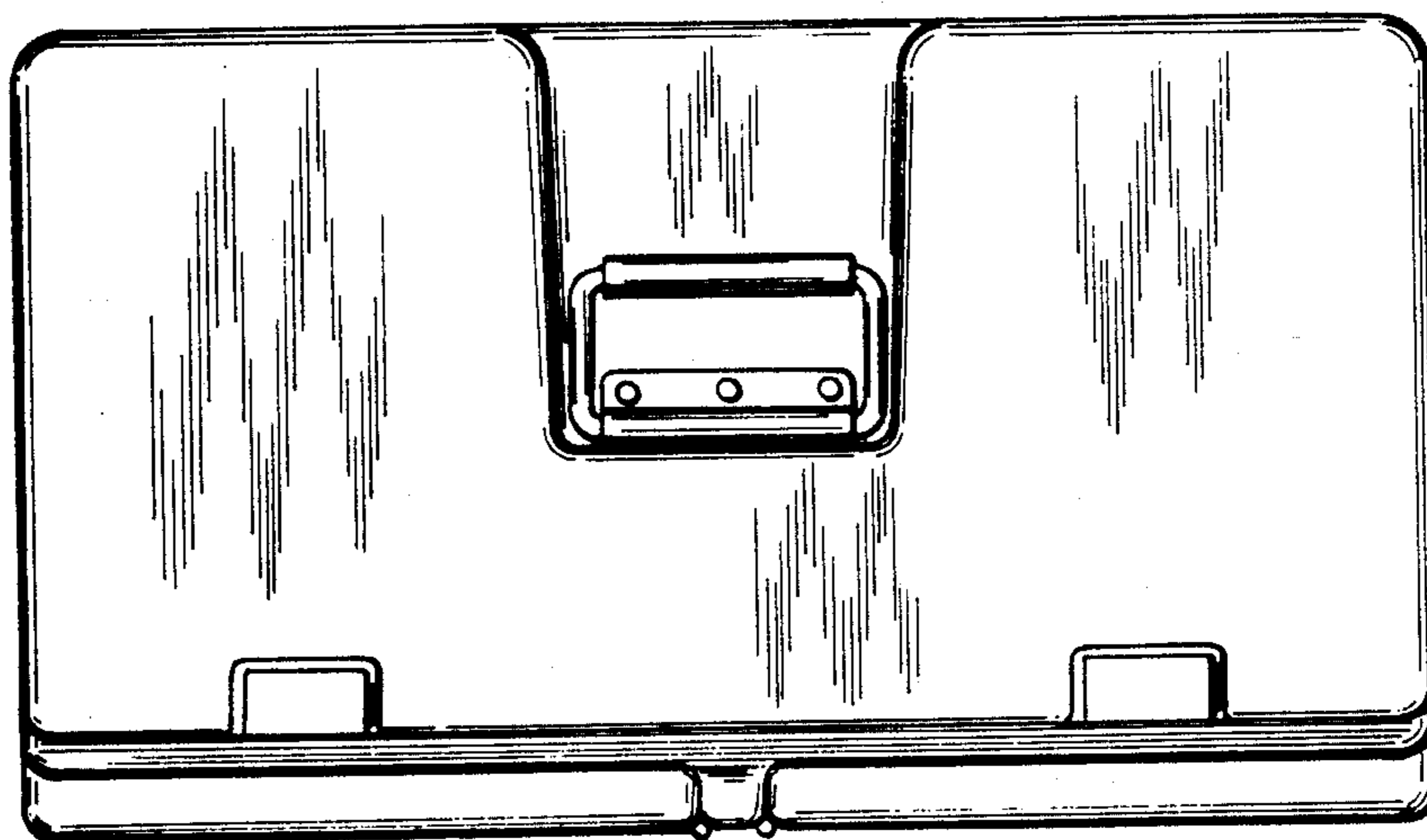

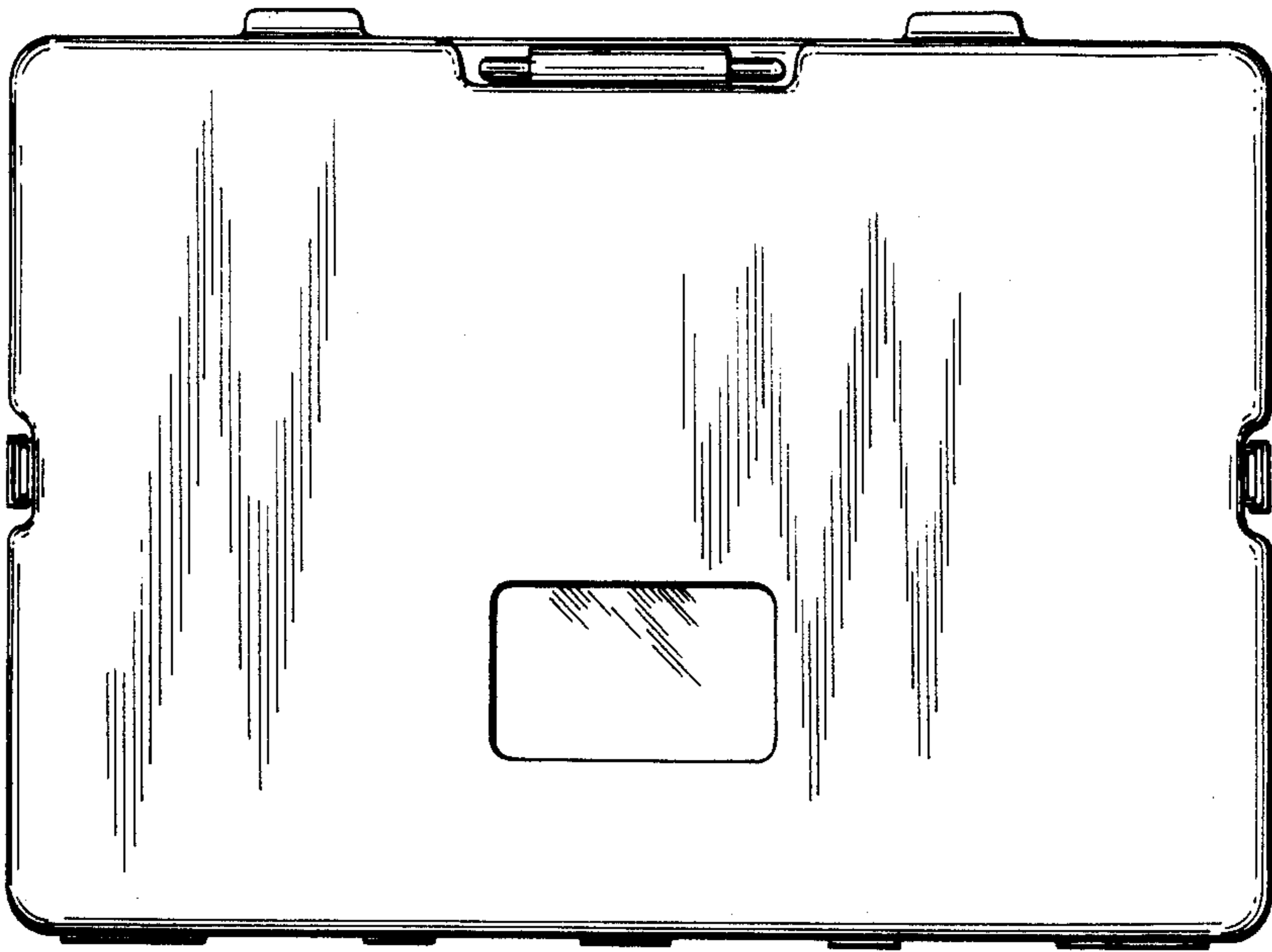

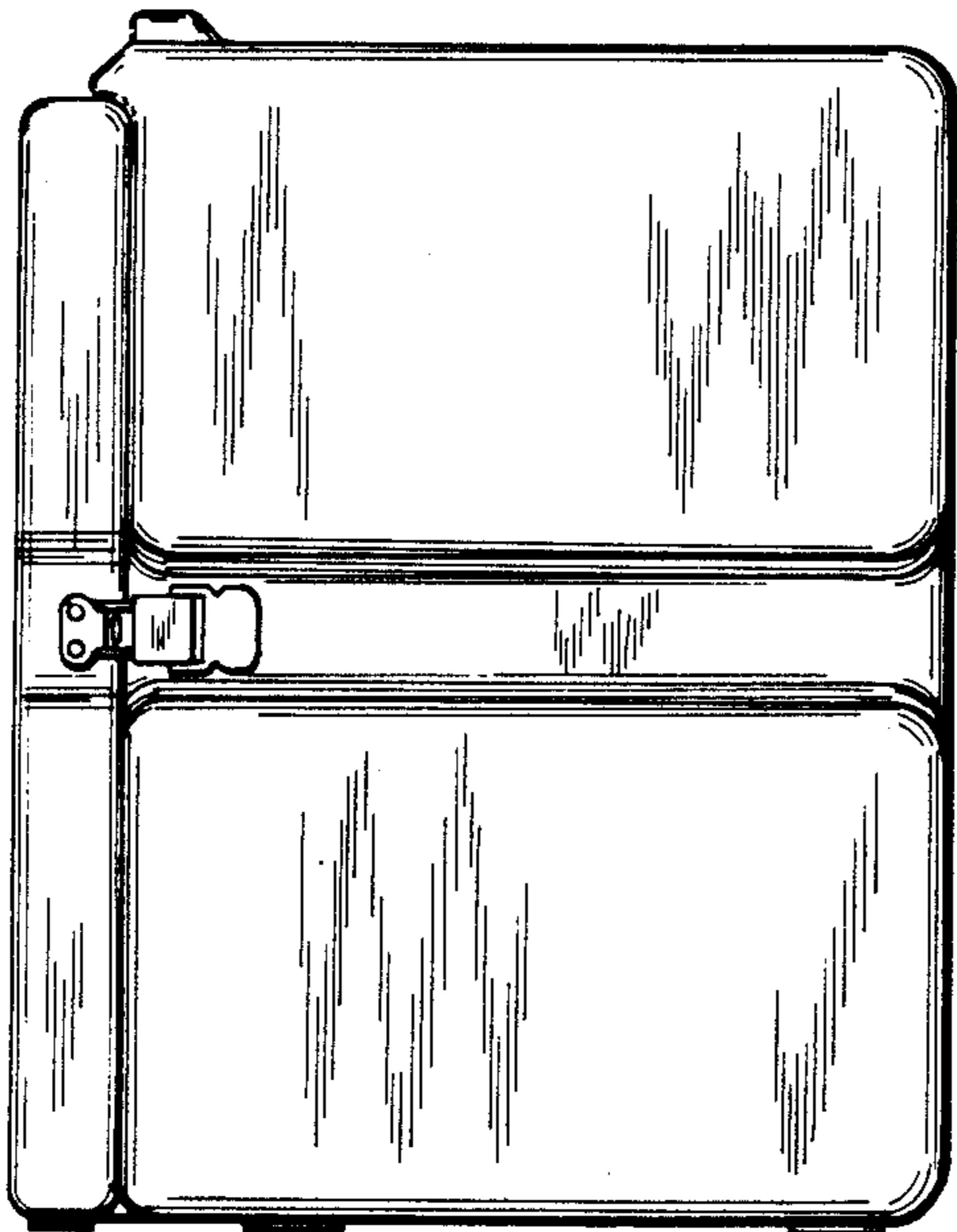
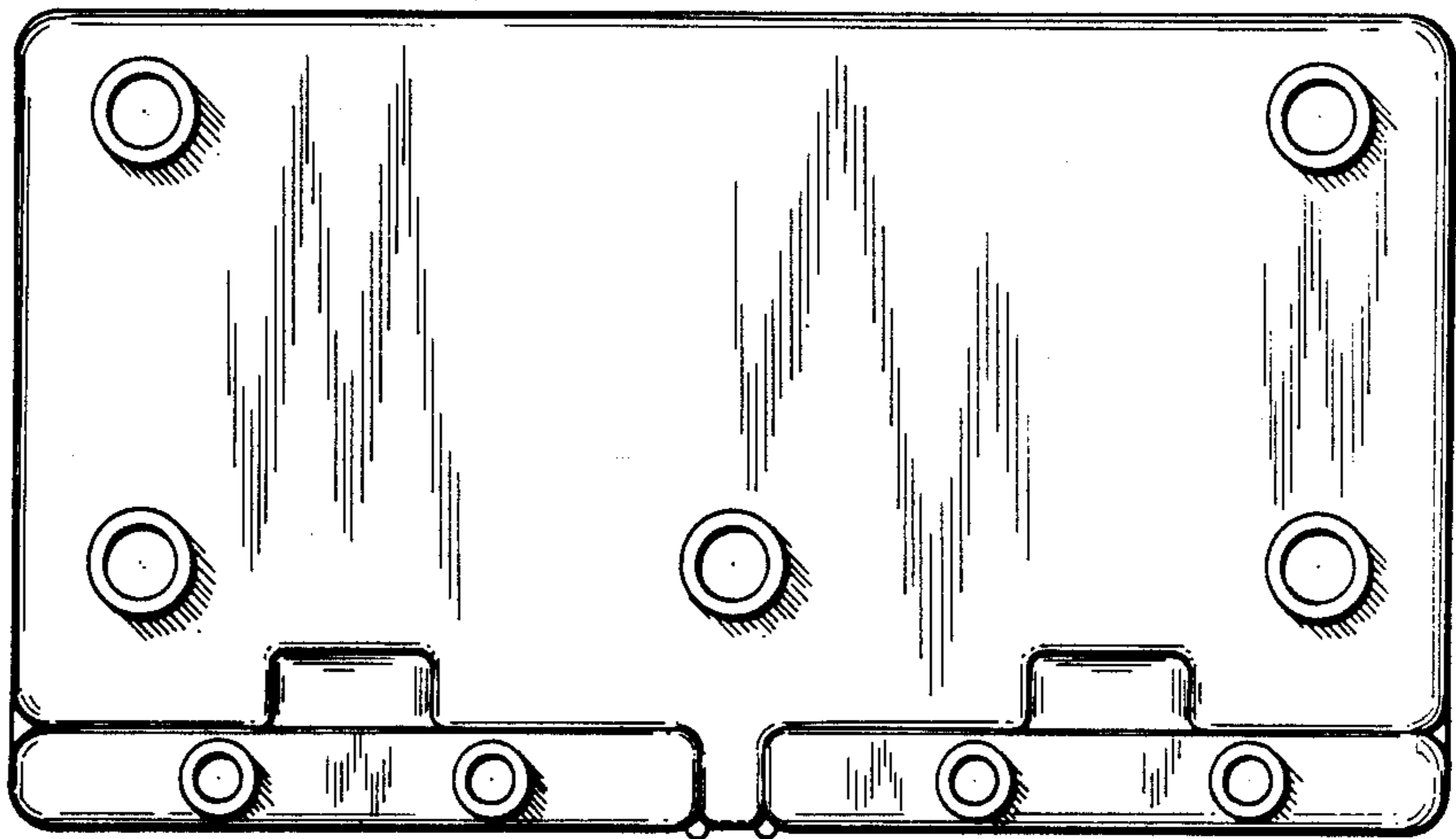
