FIG. 5 is a rear view of a frog-like fish lure, showing my new design.

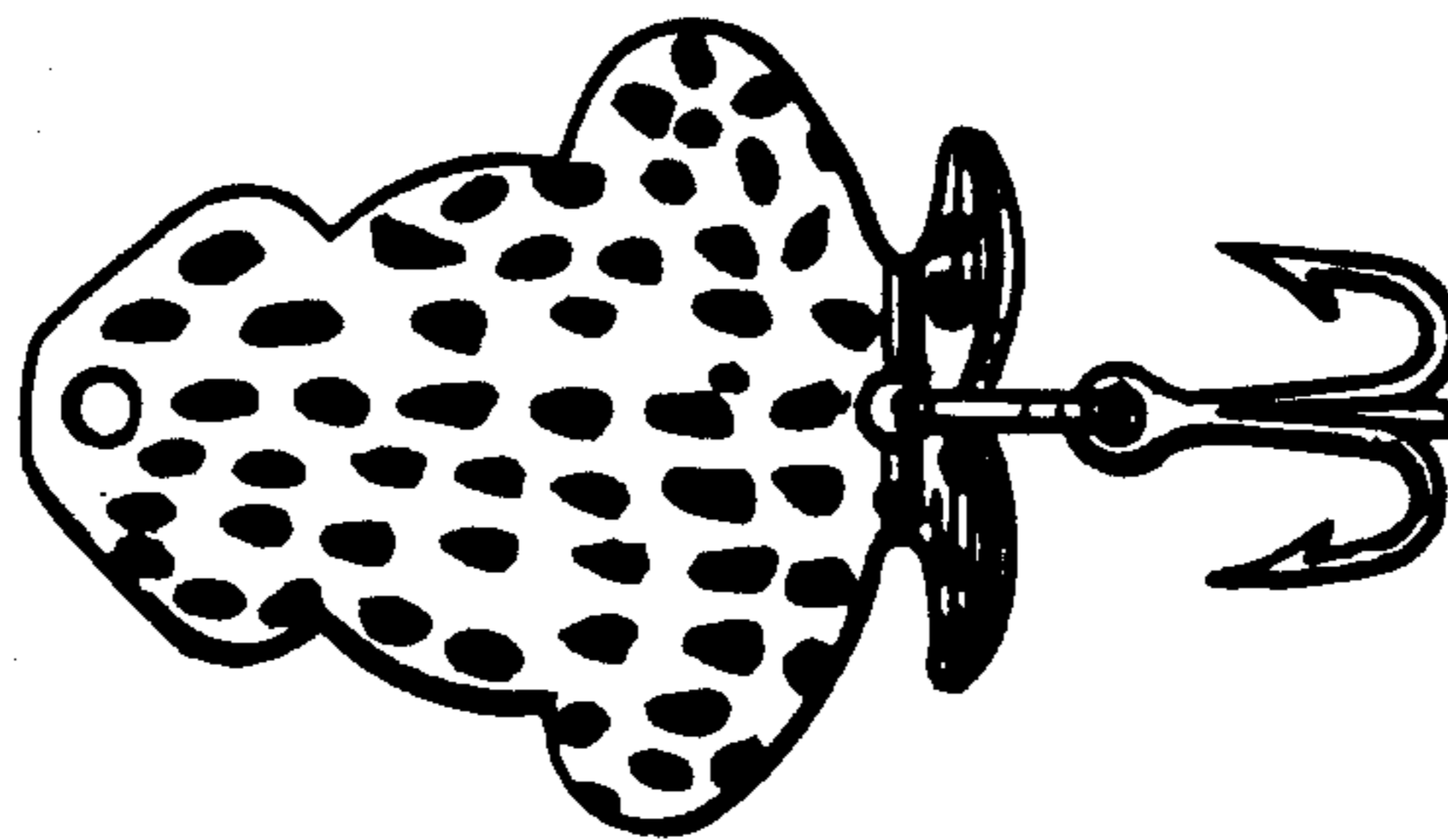

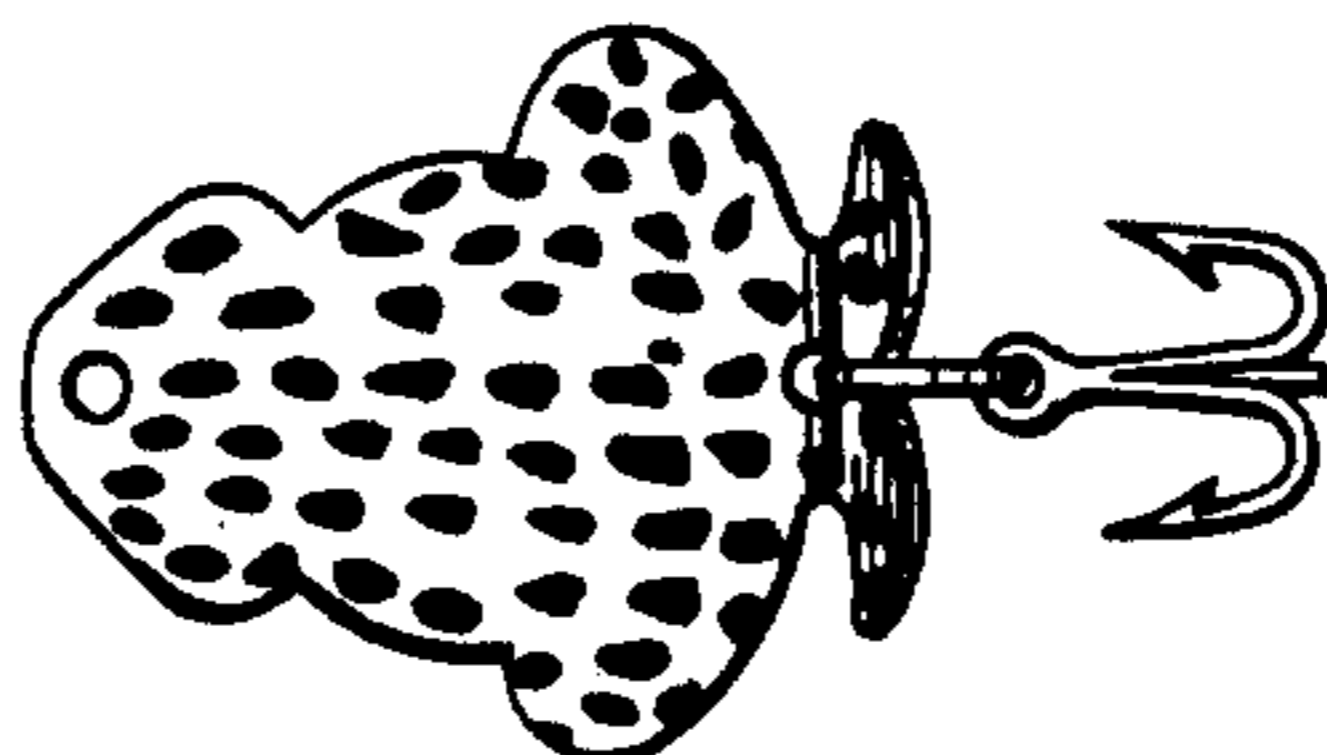

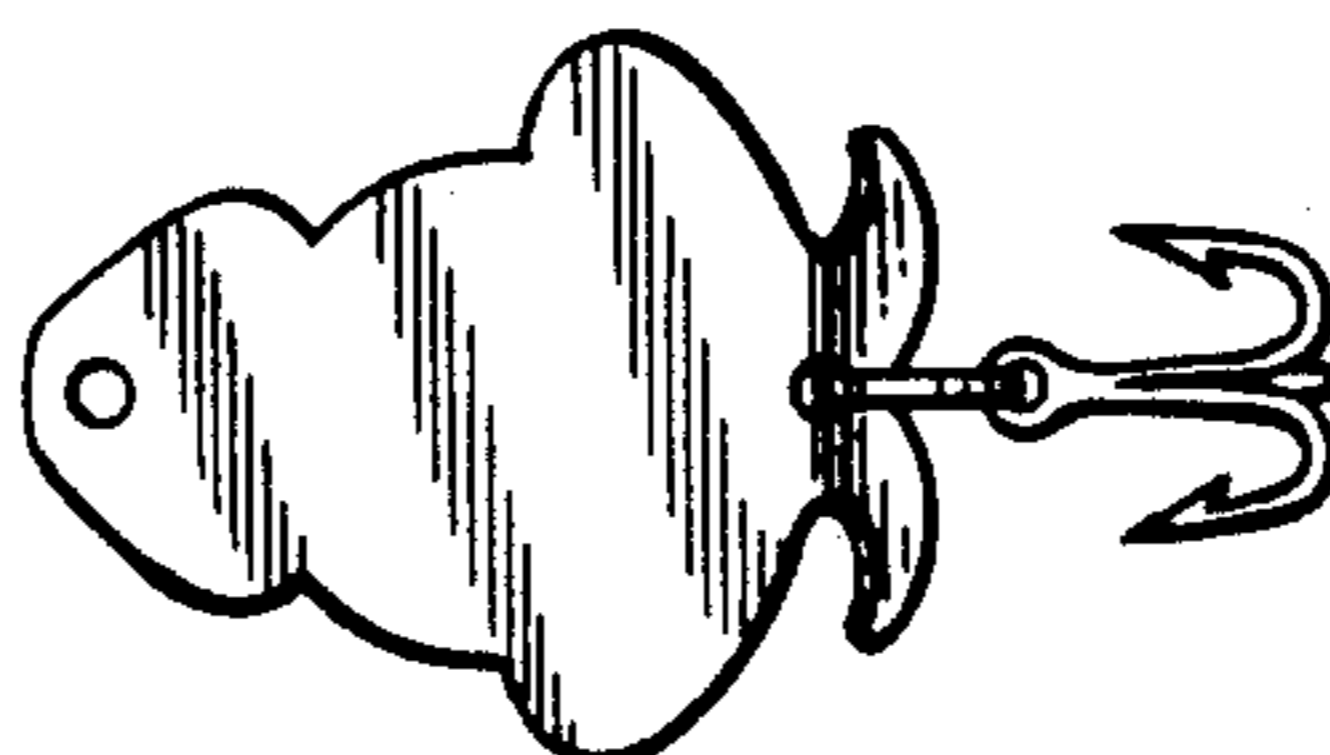
