The ornamental design for an ankle zone immobilizer, as shown.

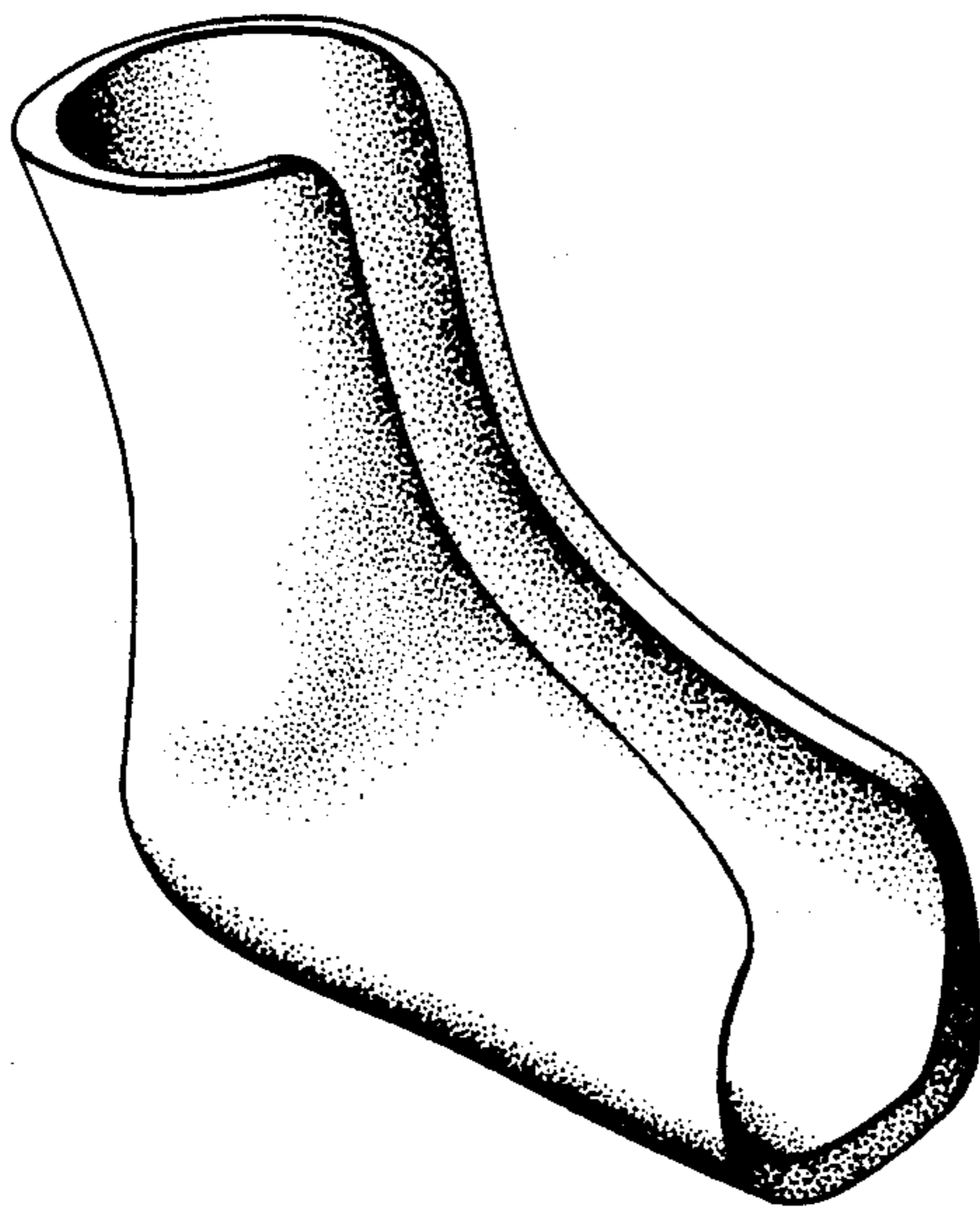
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



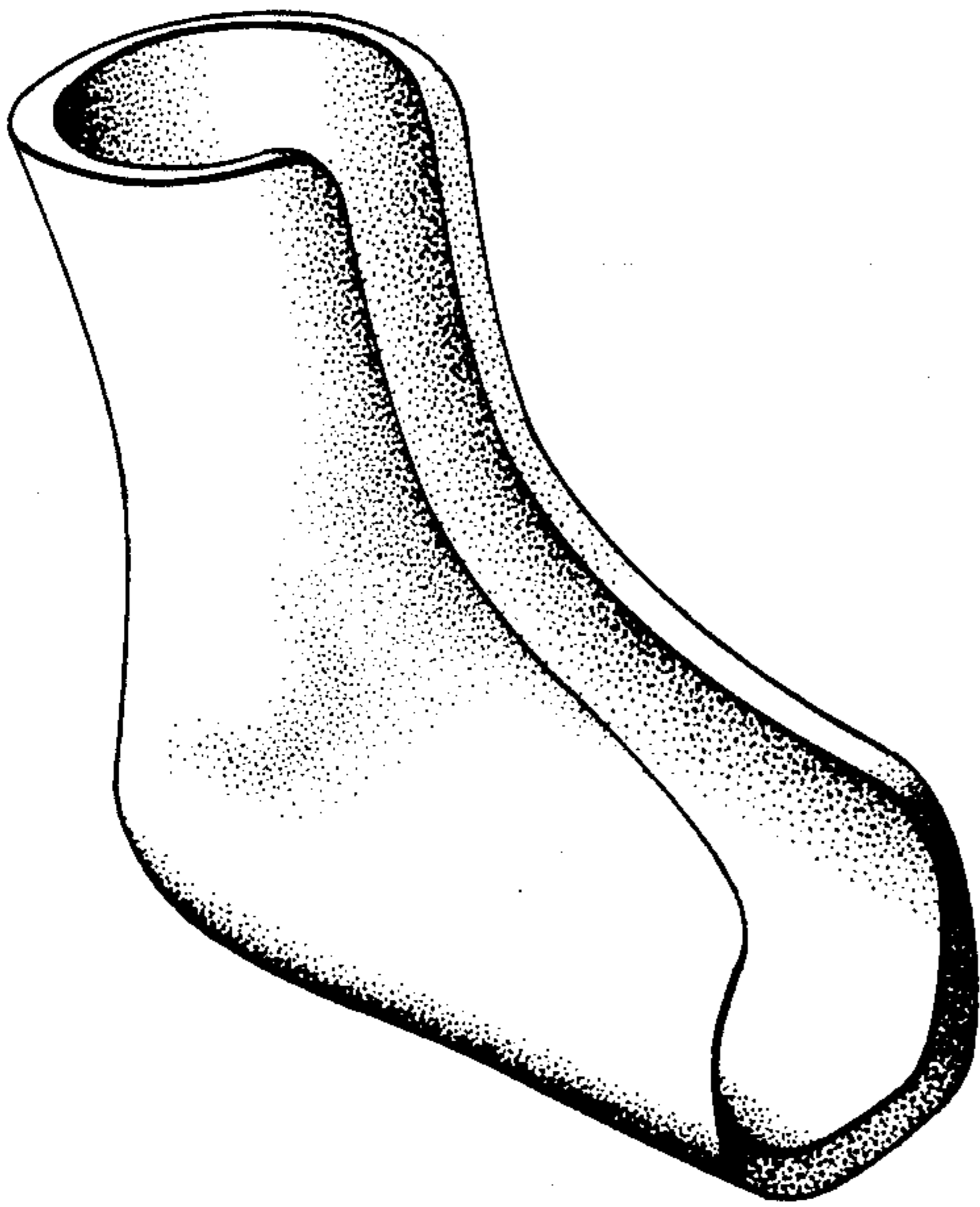

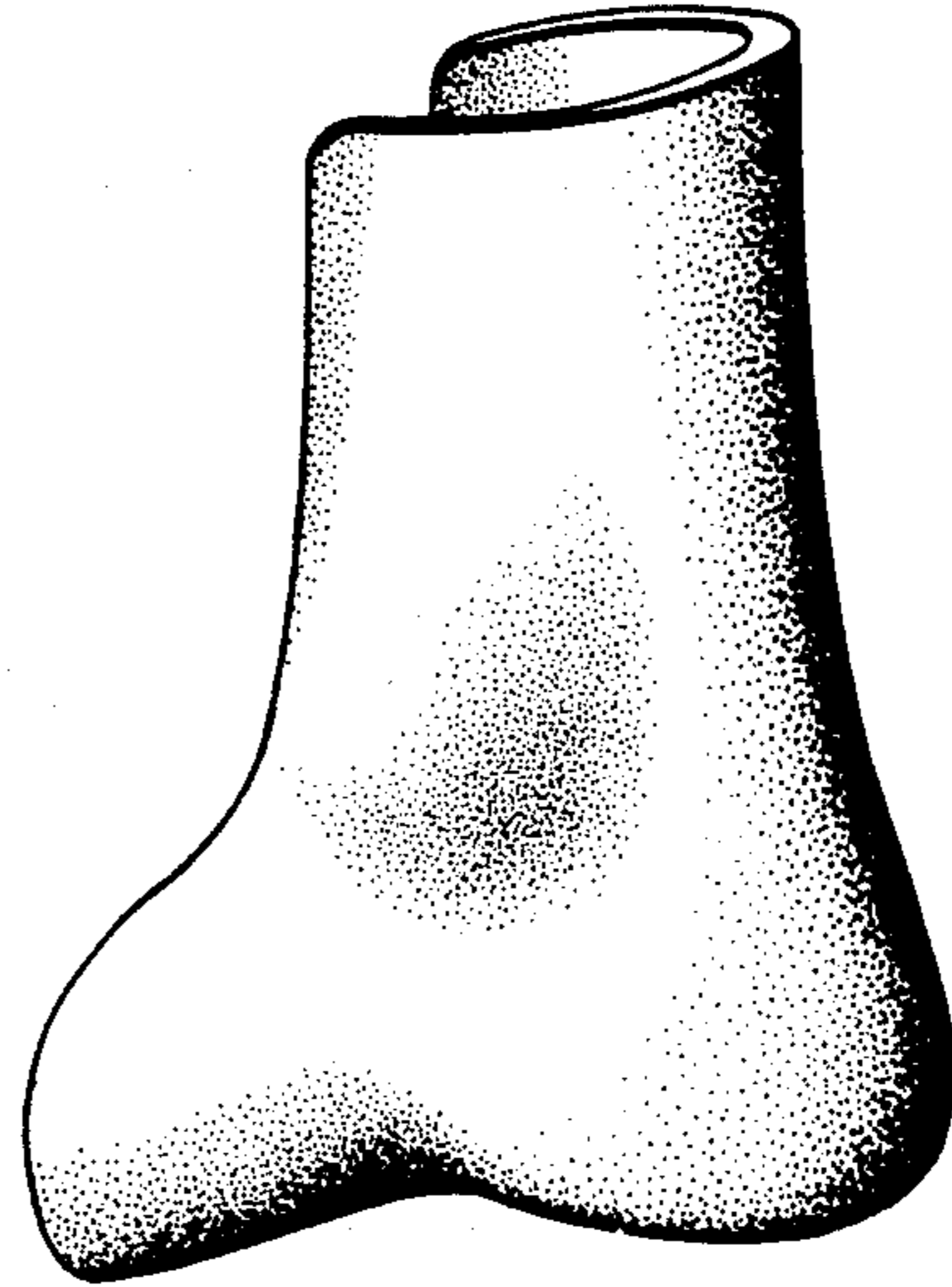

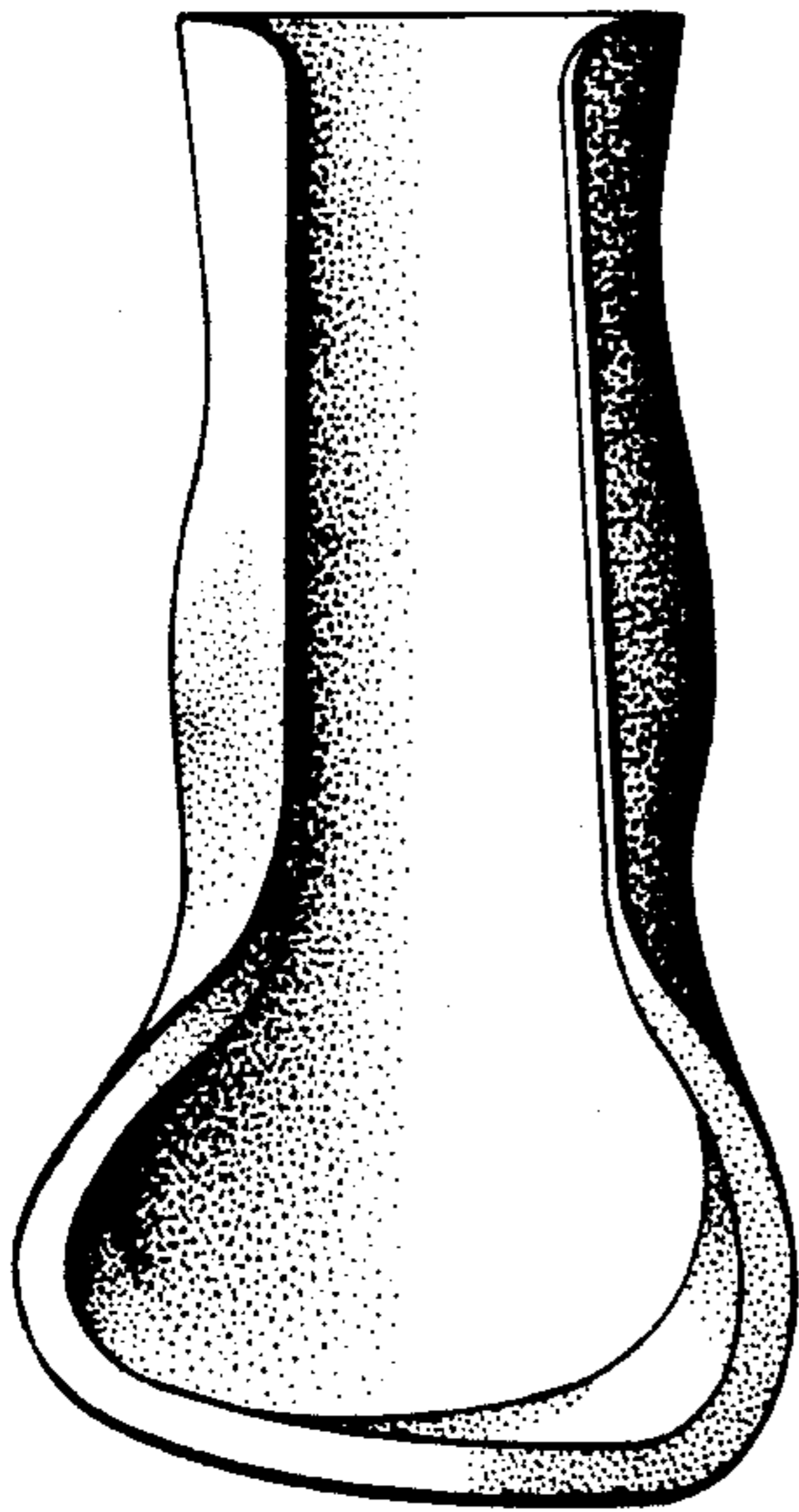

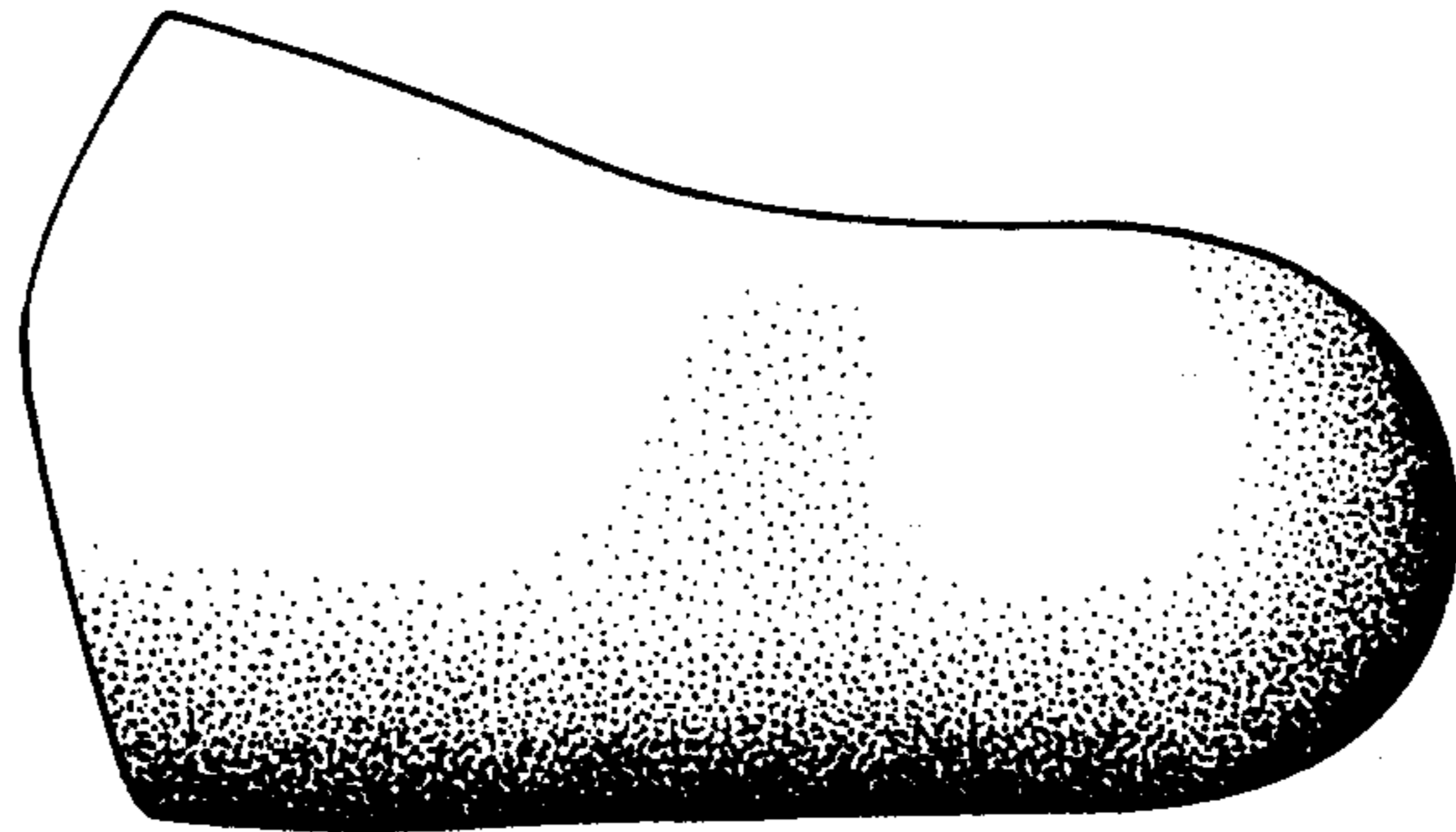
