The ornamental design for a leg and knee zone immobilizer, as shown.

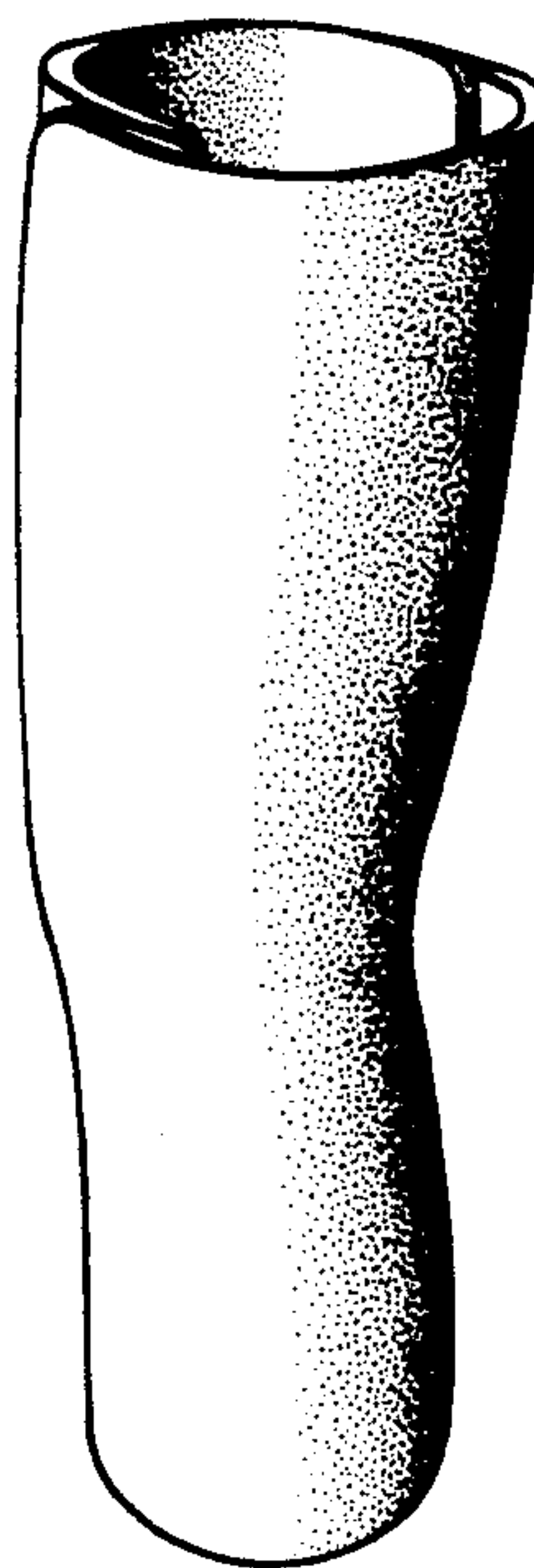
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.



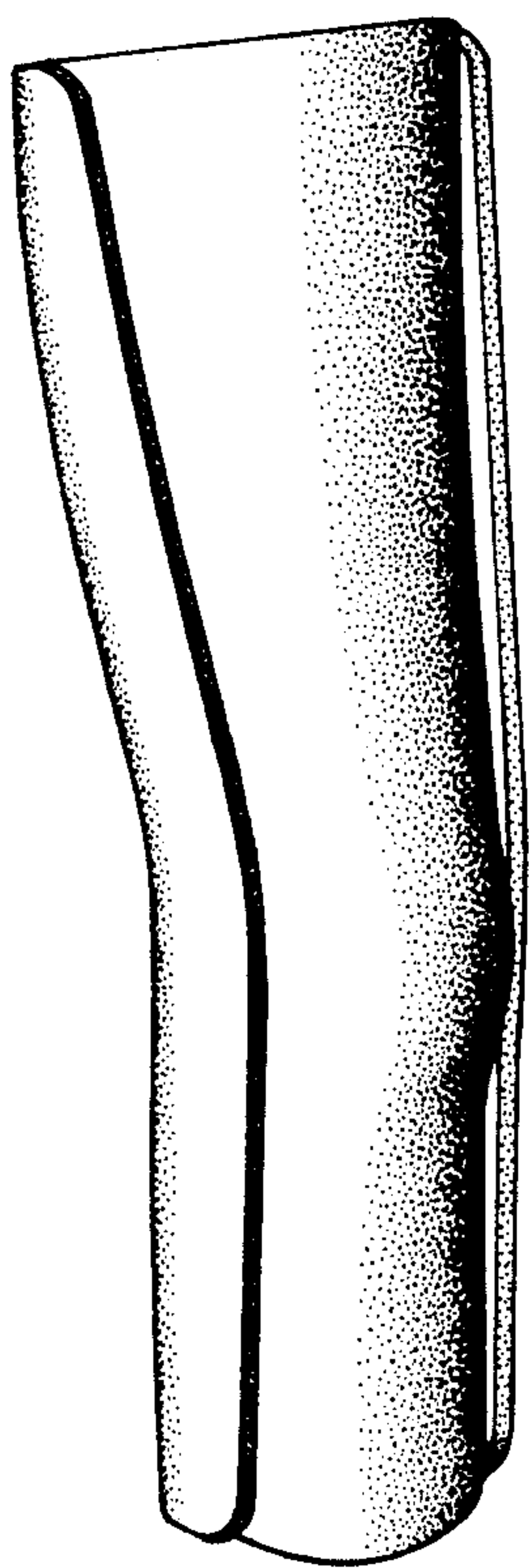

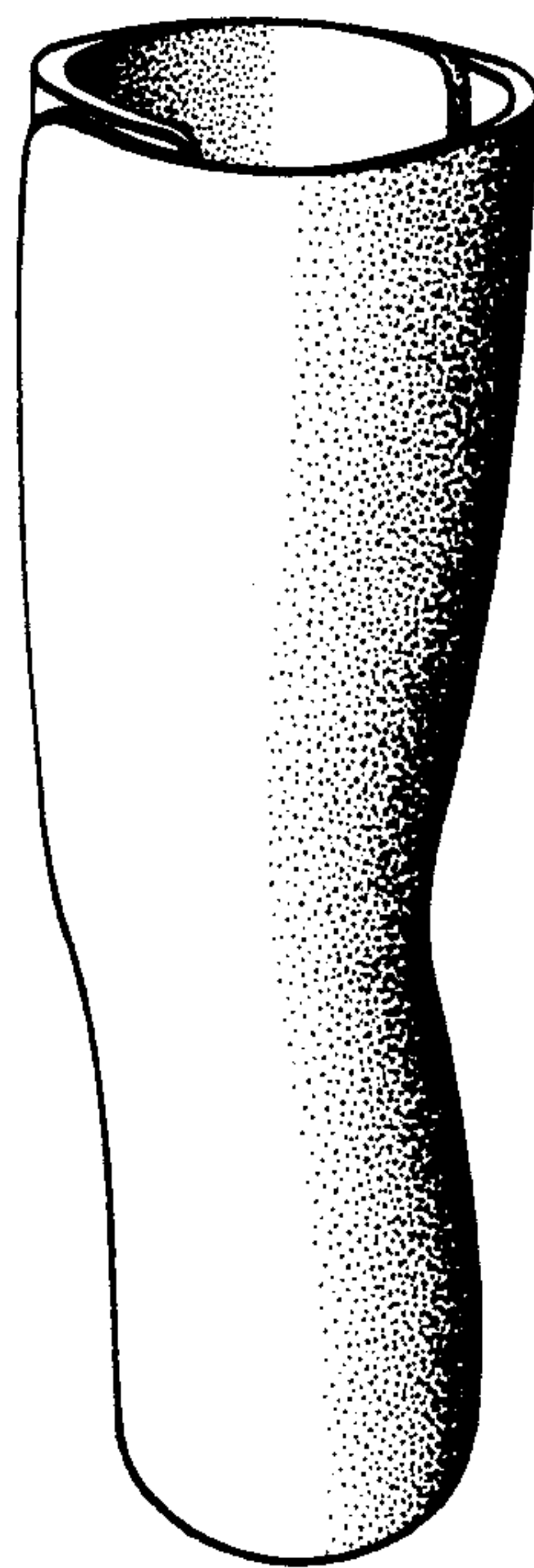

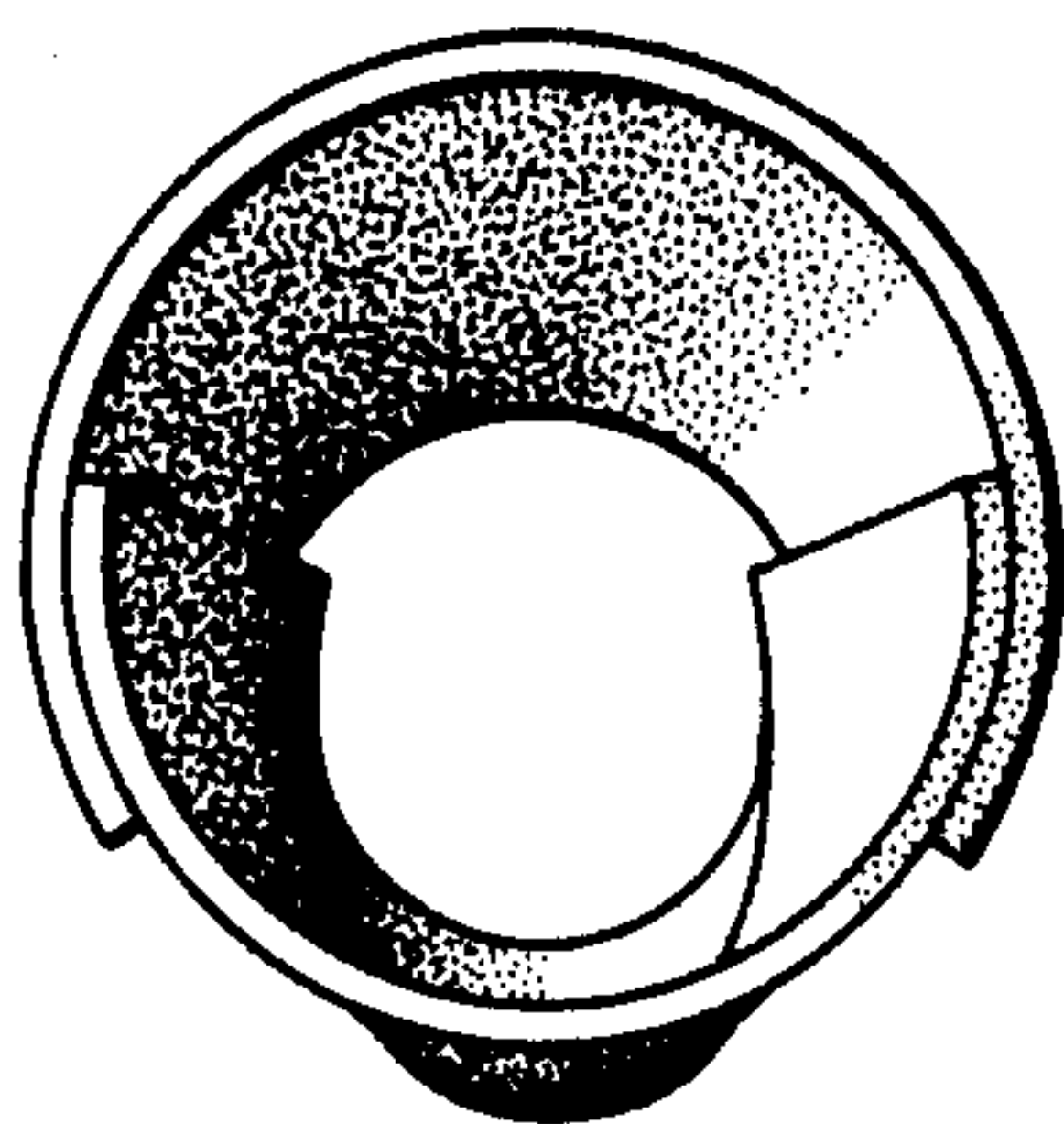

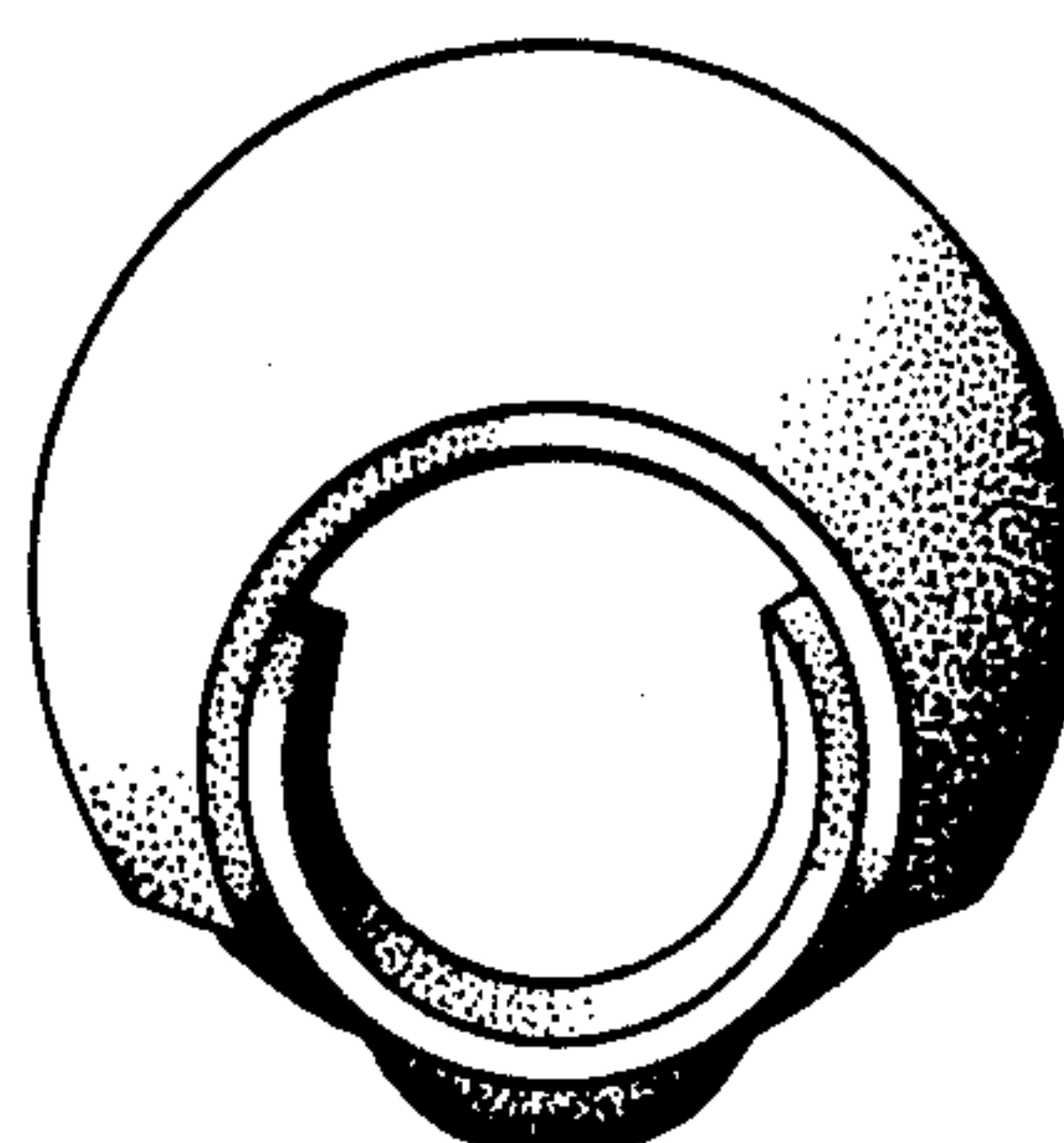
