FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 3.

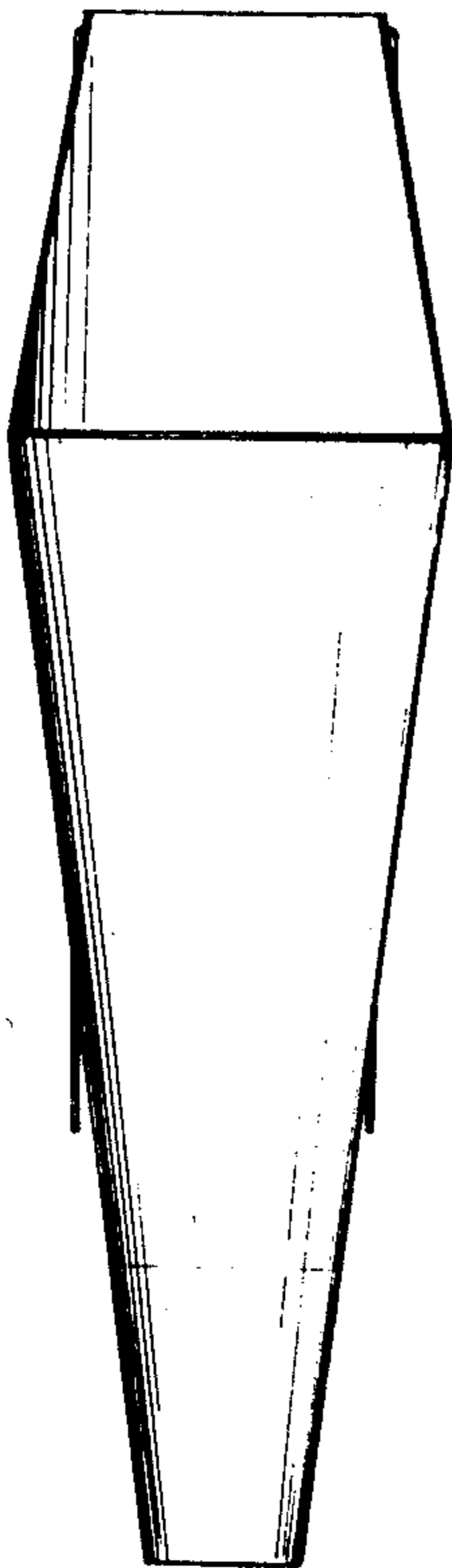

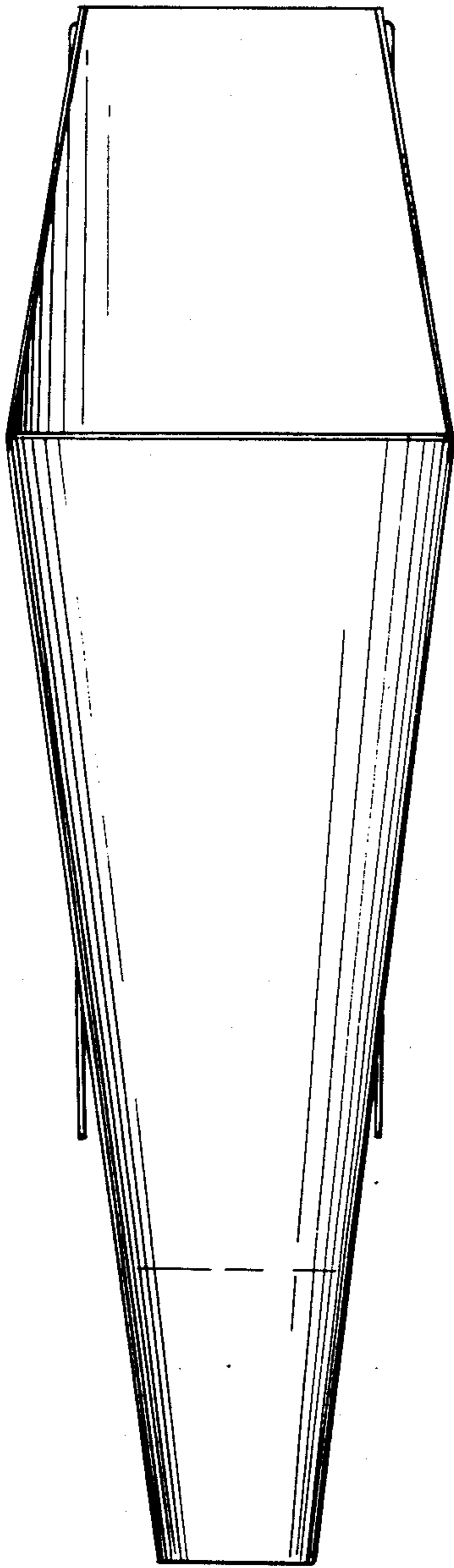

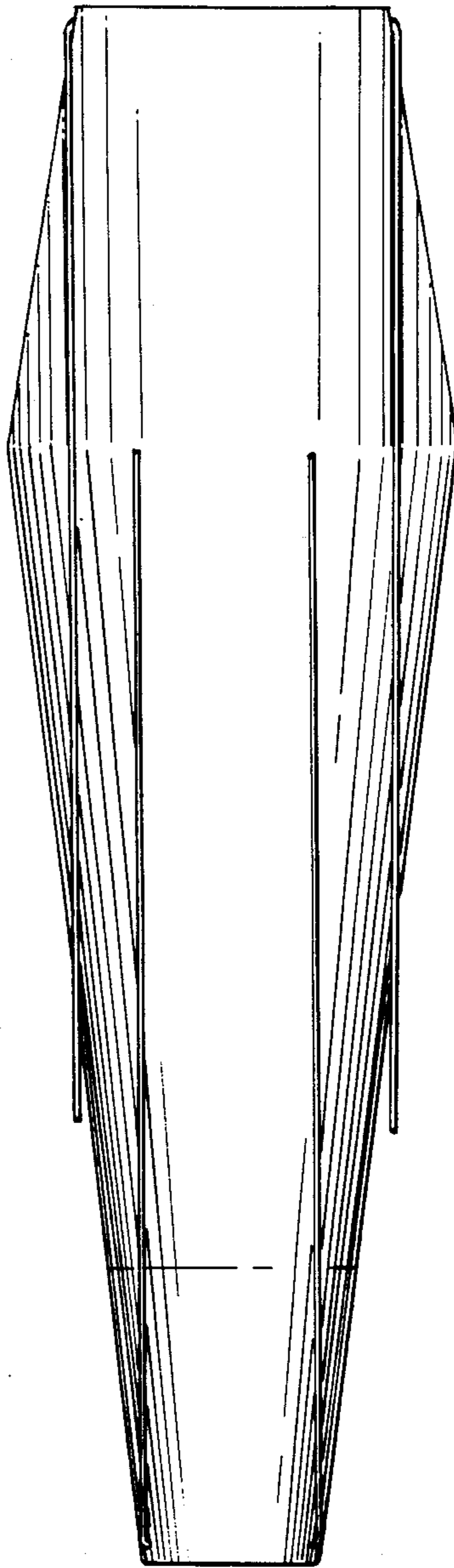

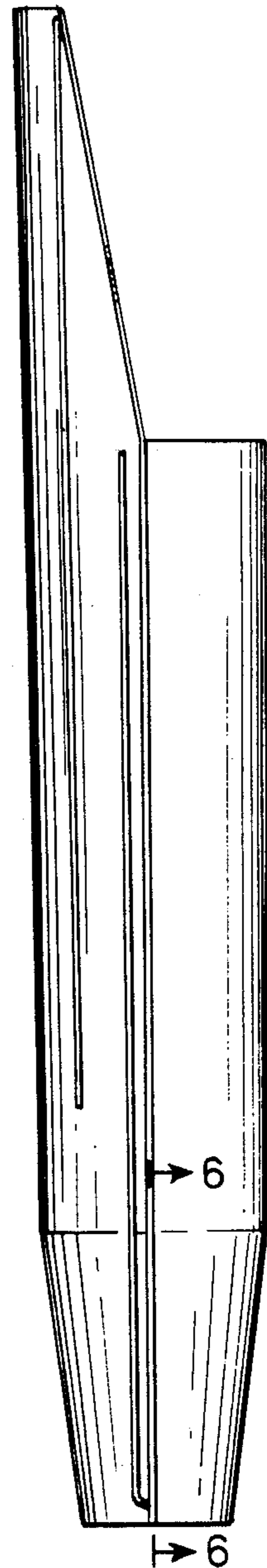

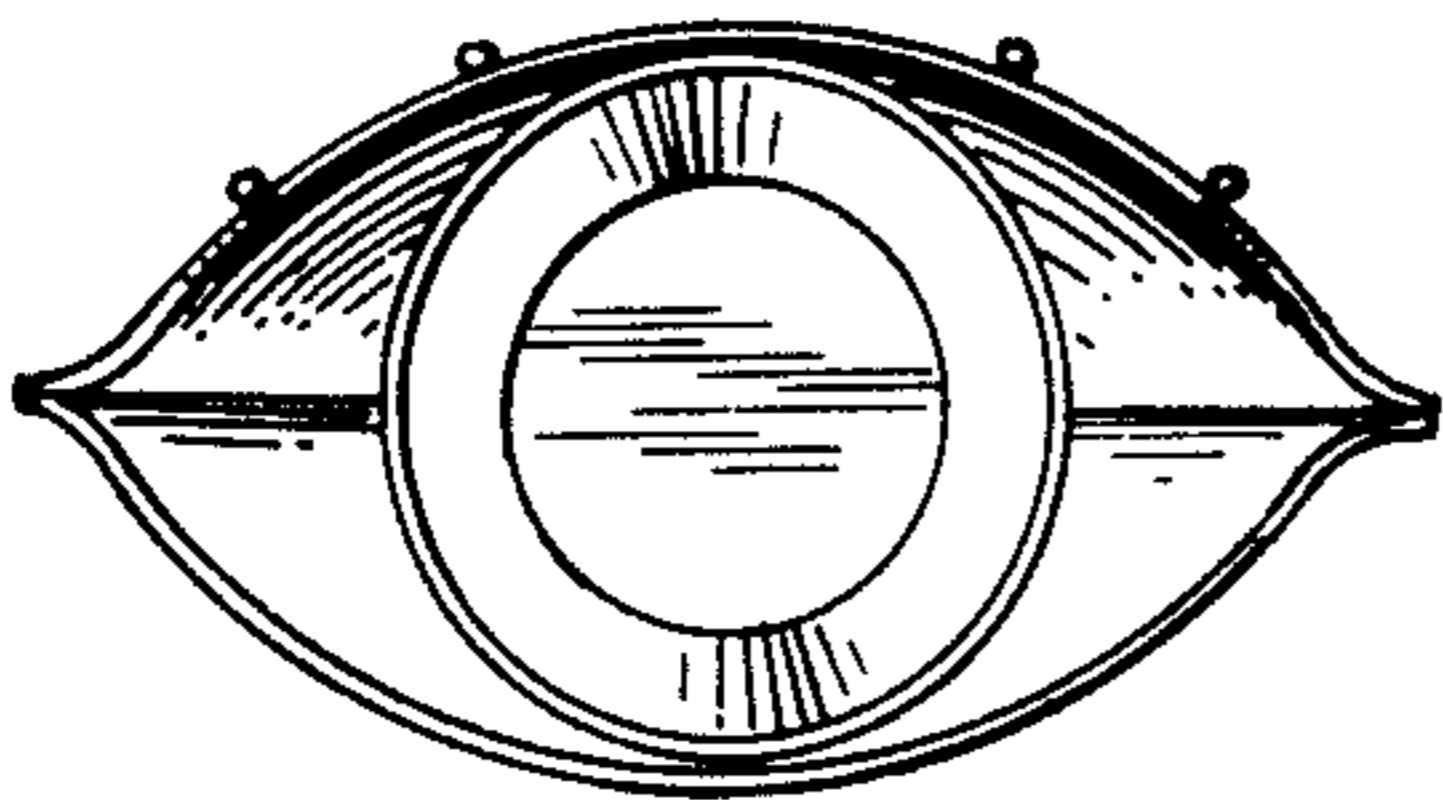

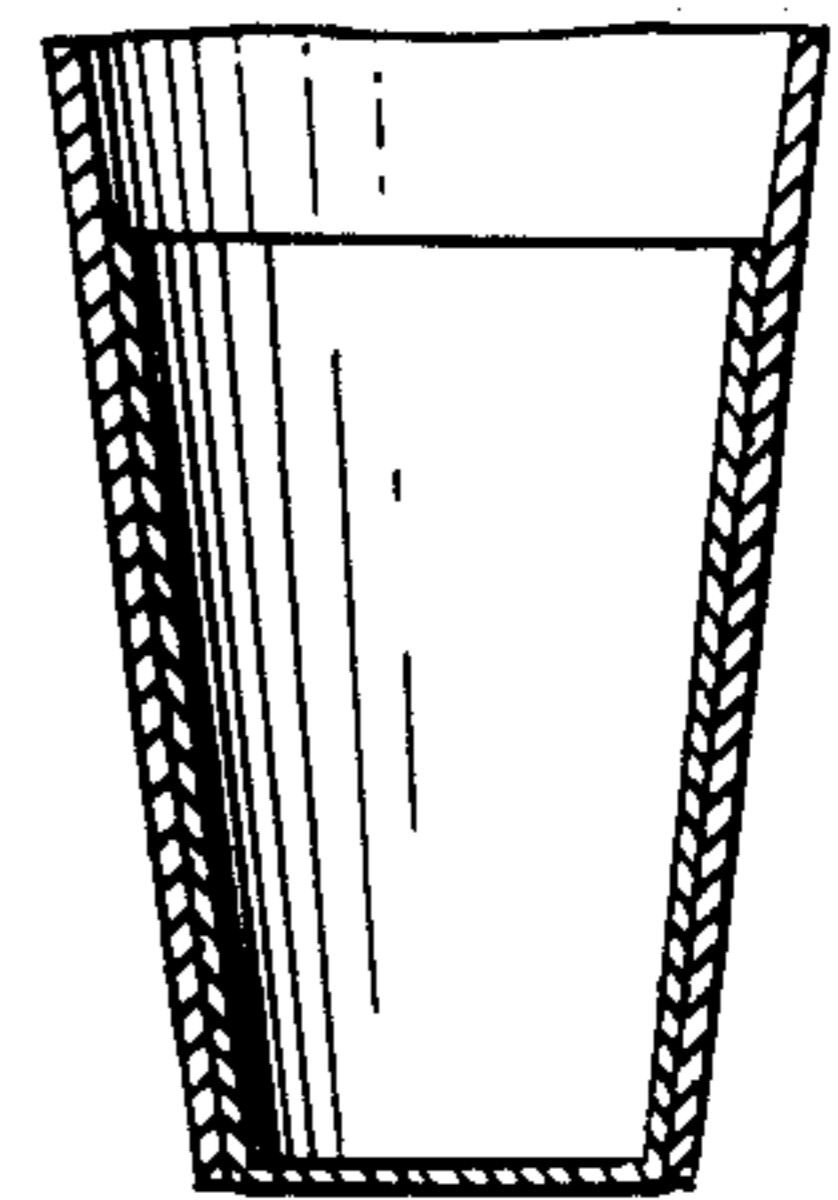
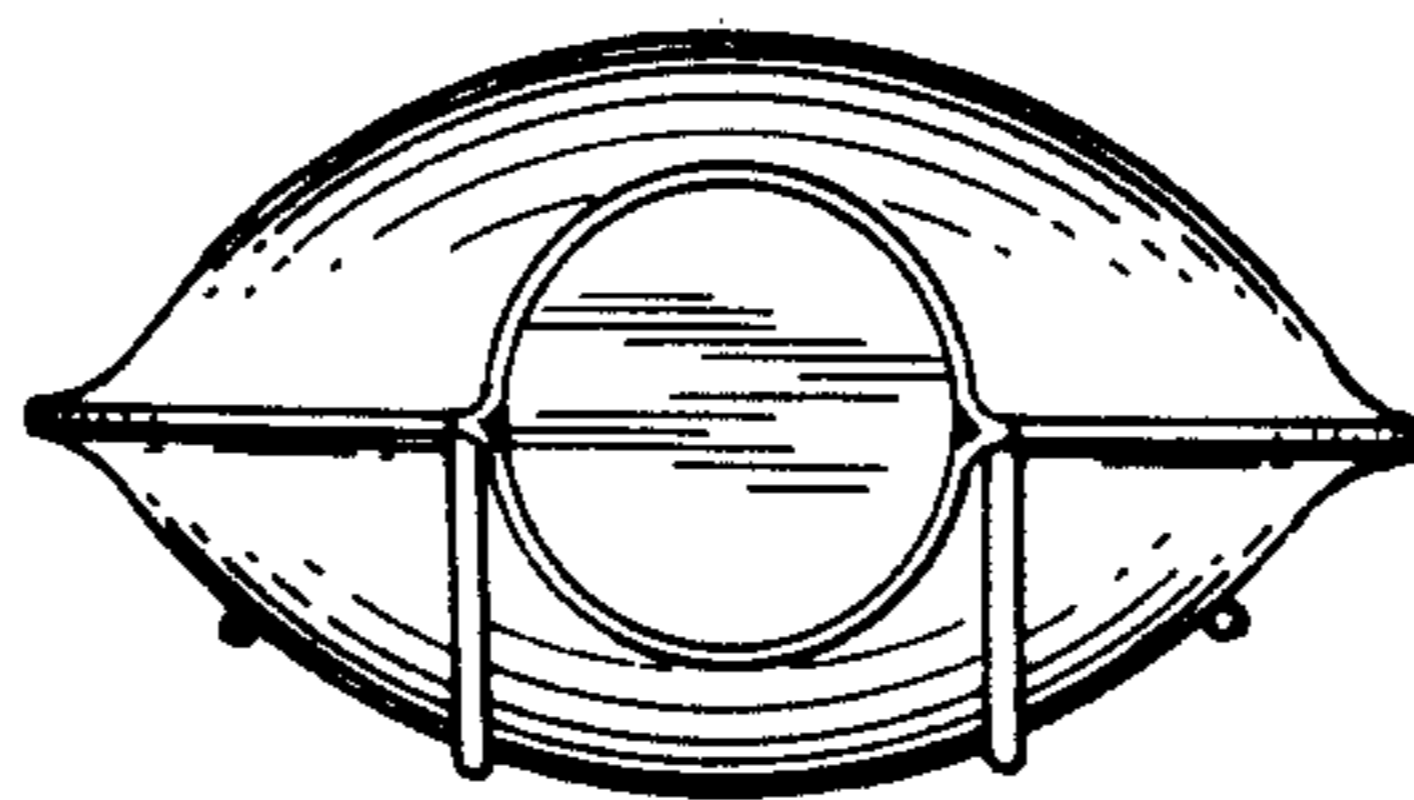
