FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

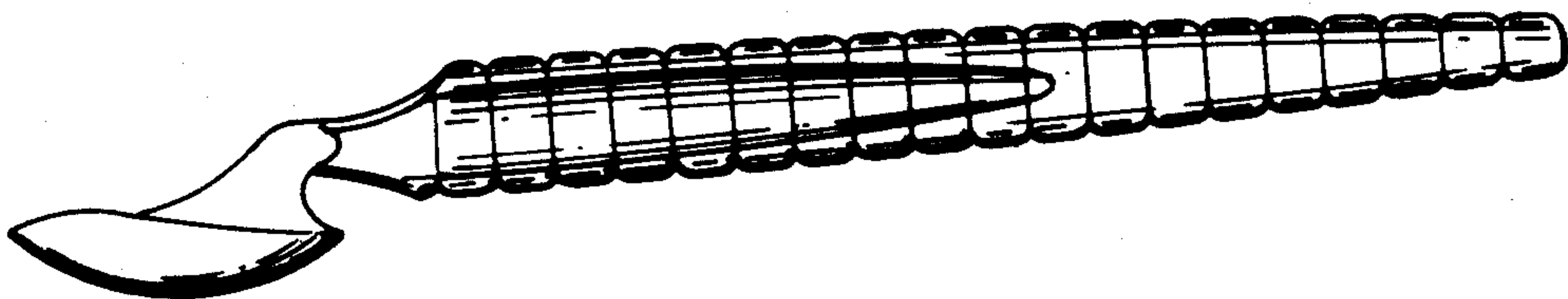
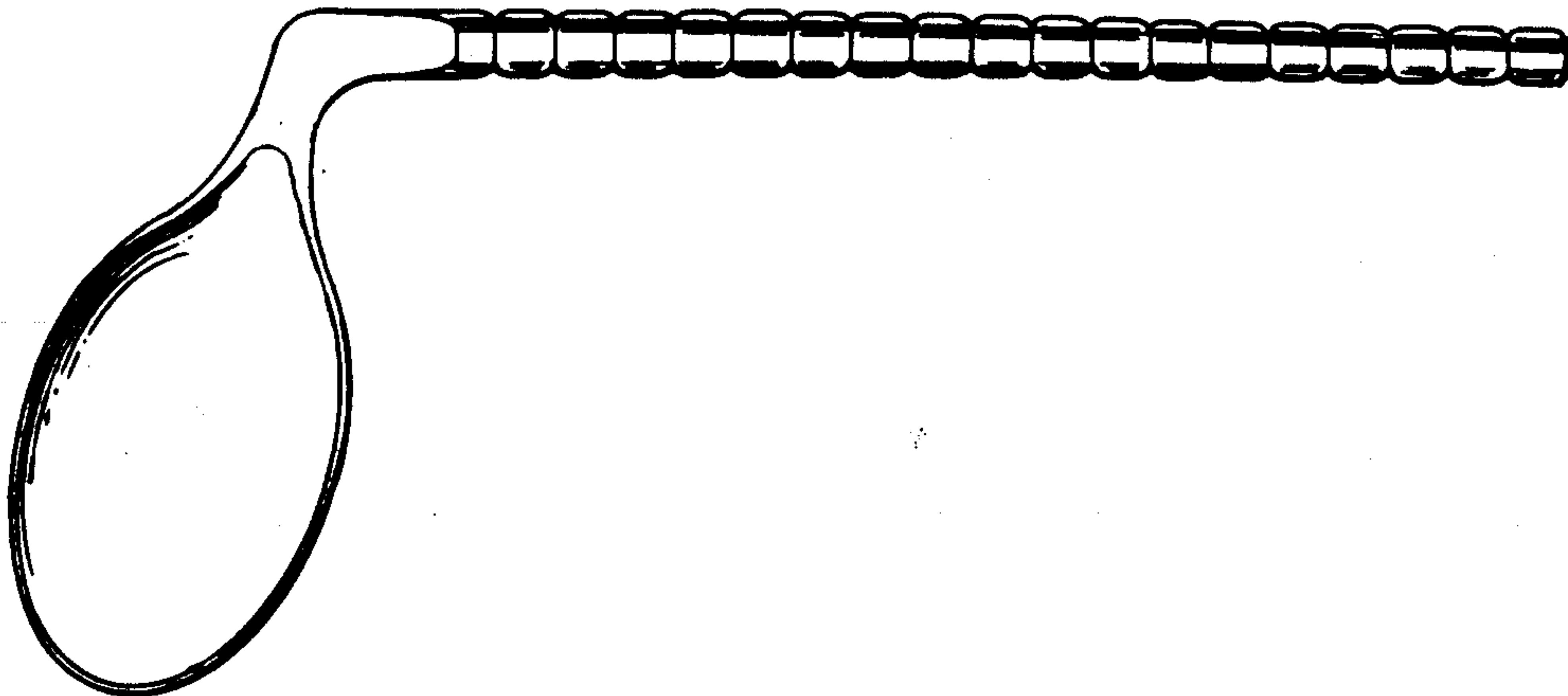
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is an elevational view as seen from the right of FIG. 1.



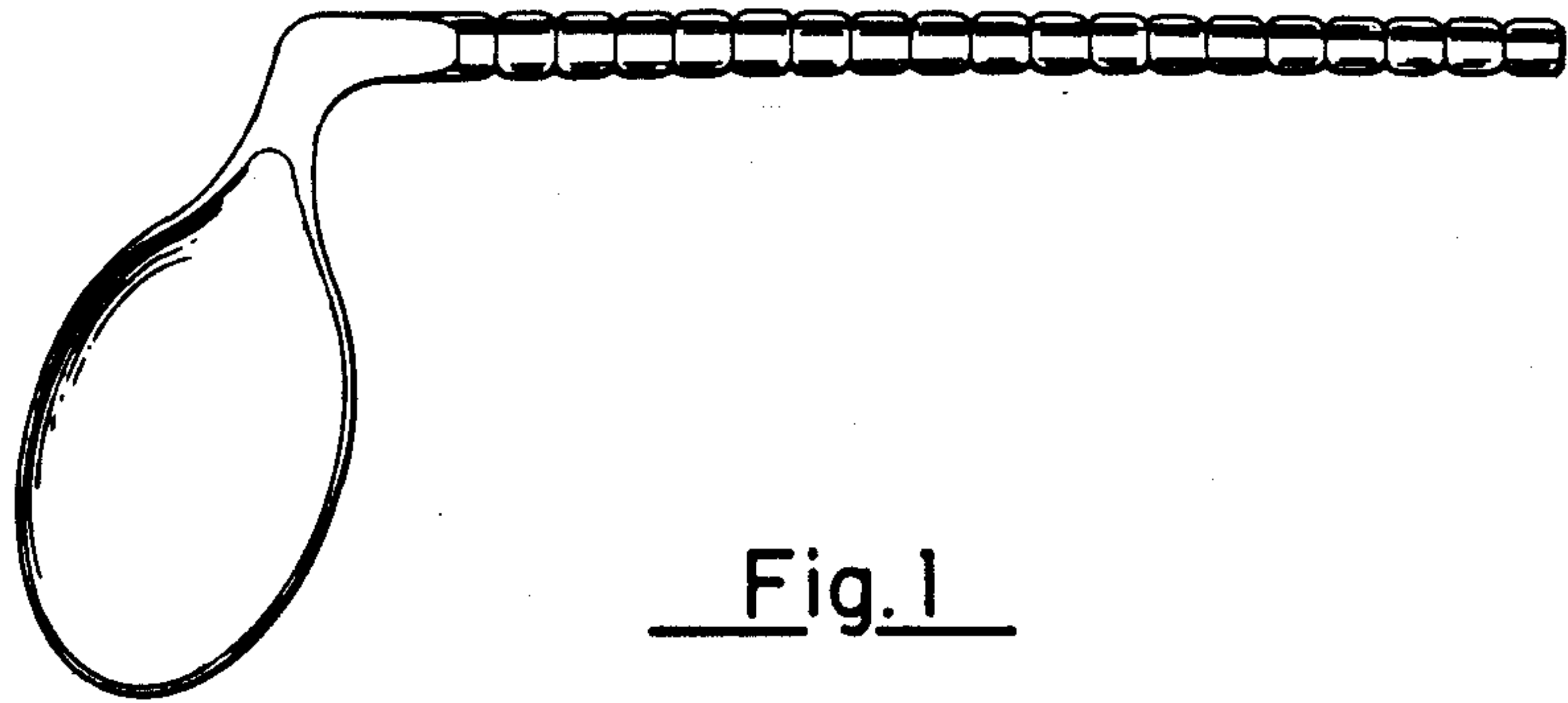

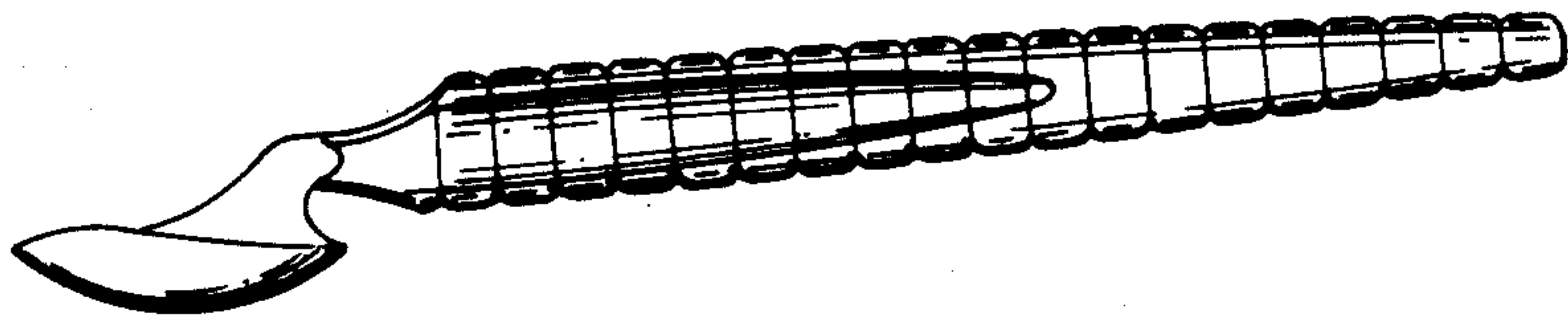

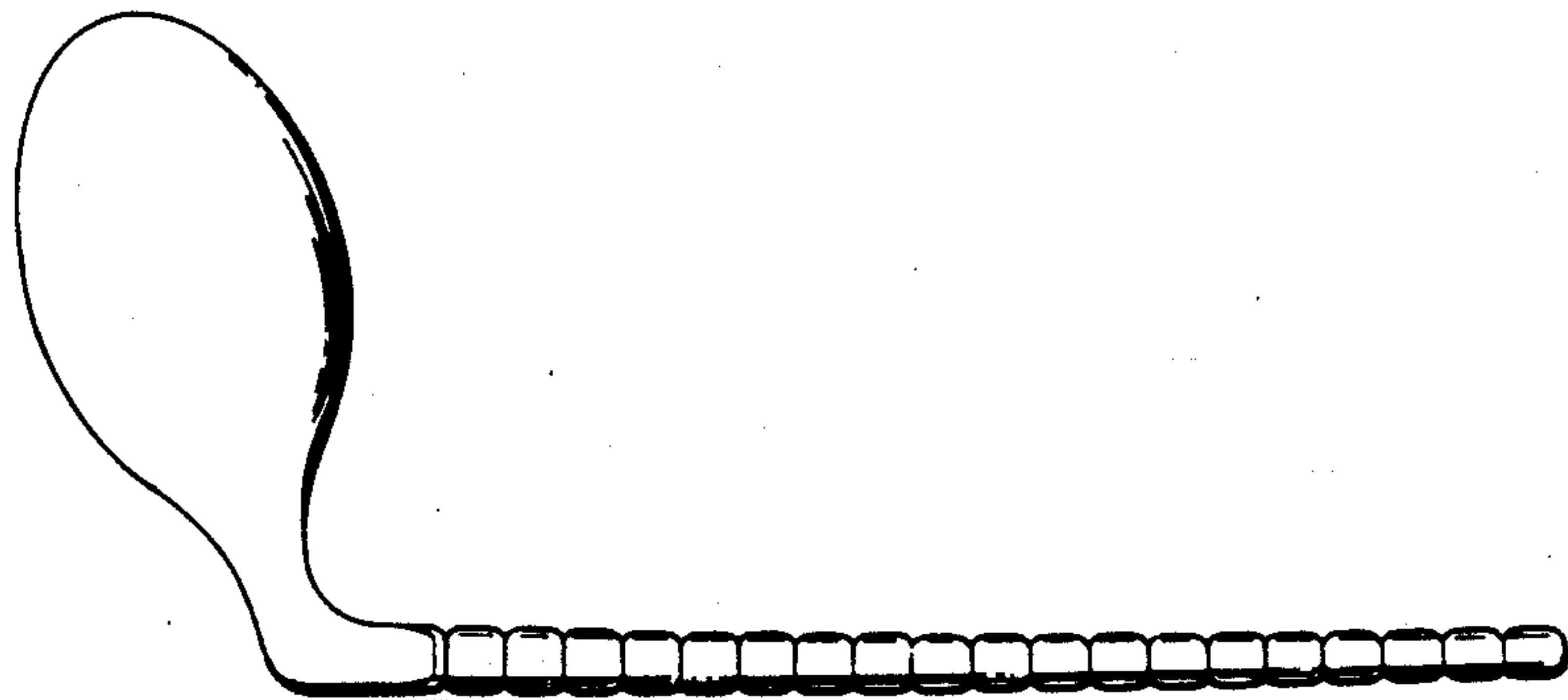

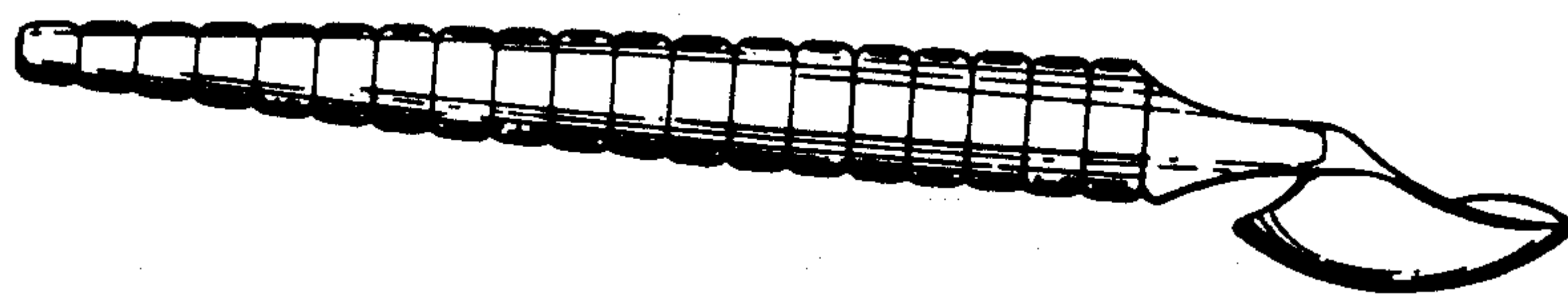

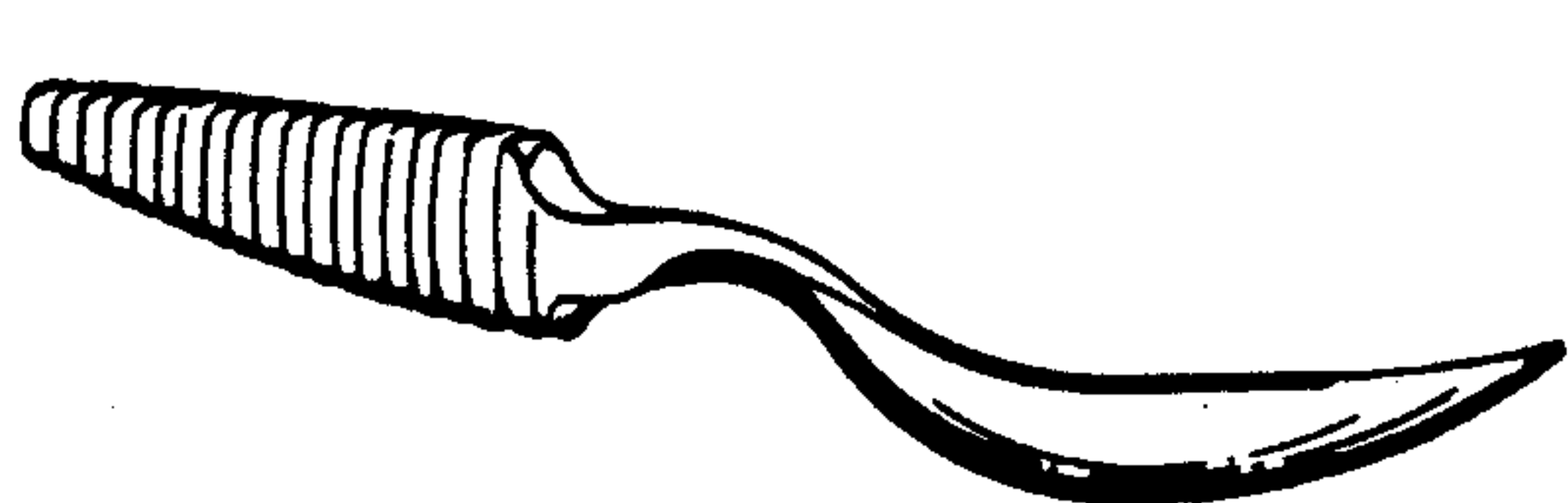
