DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle showing my new design;

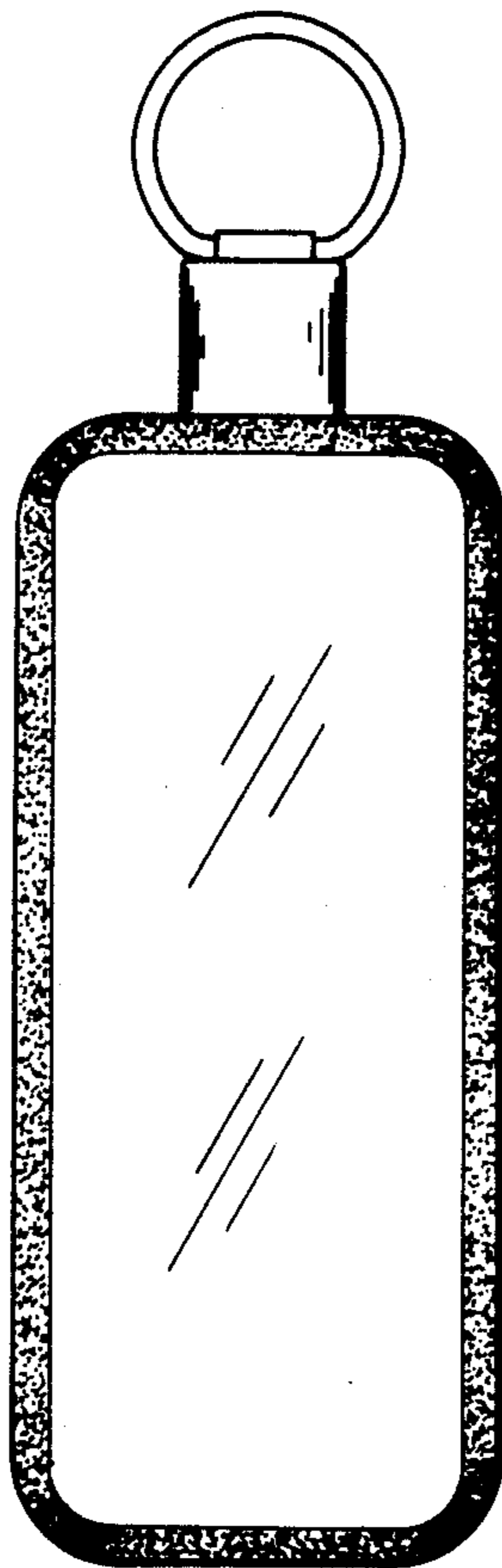
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view showing the end opposite that seen in FIG. 2; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.

The drawing is stippled to indicate contrasting surfaces.



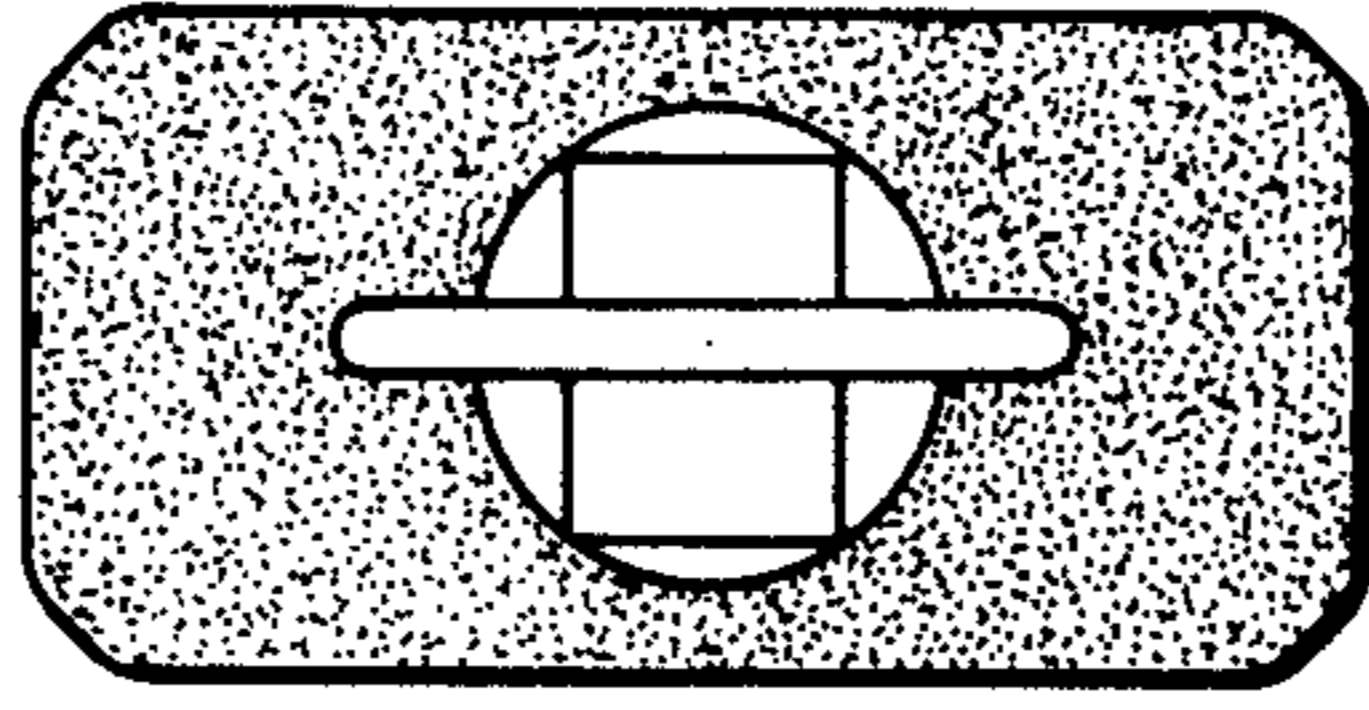

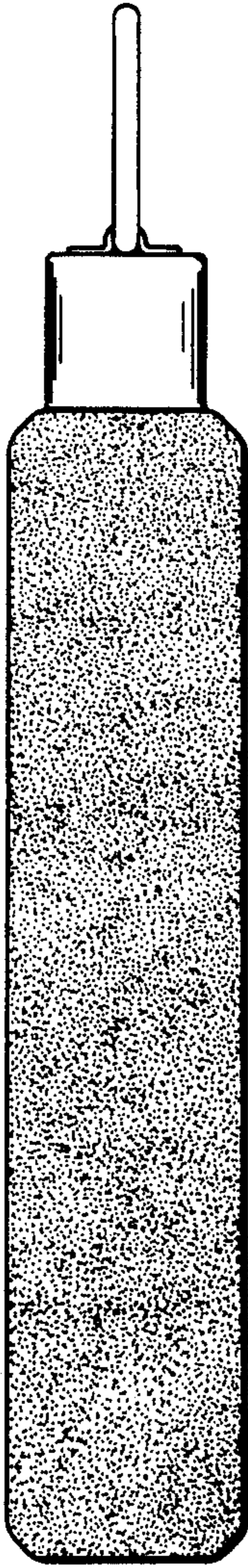

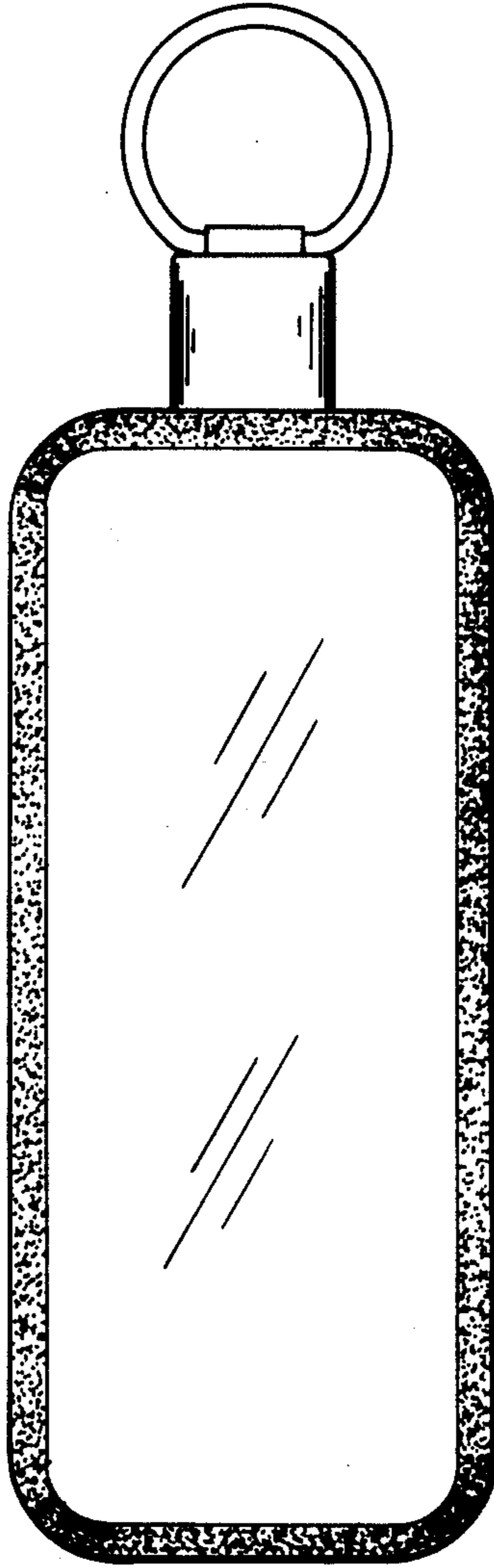

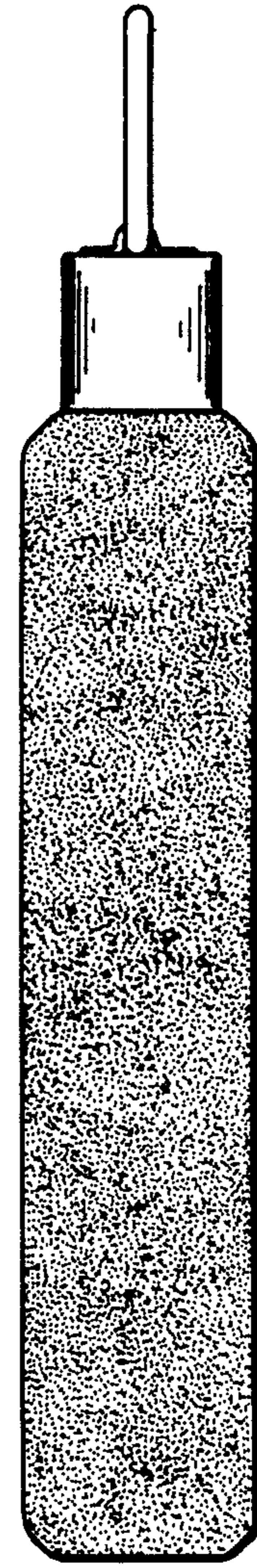

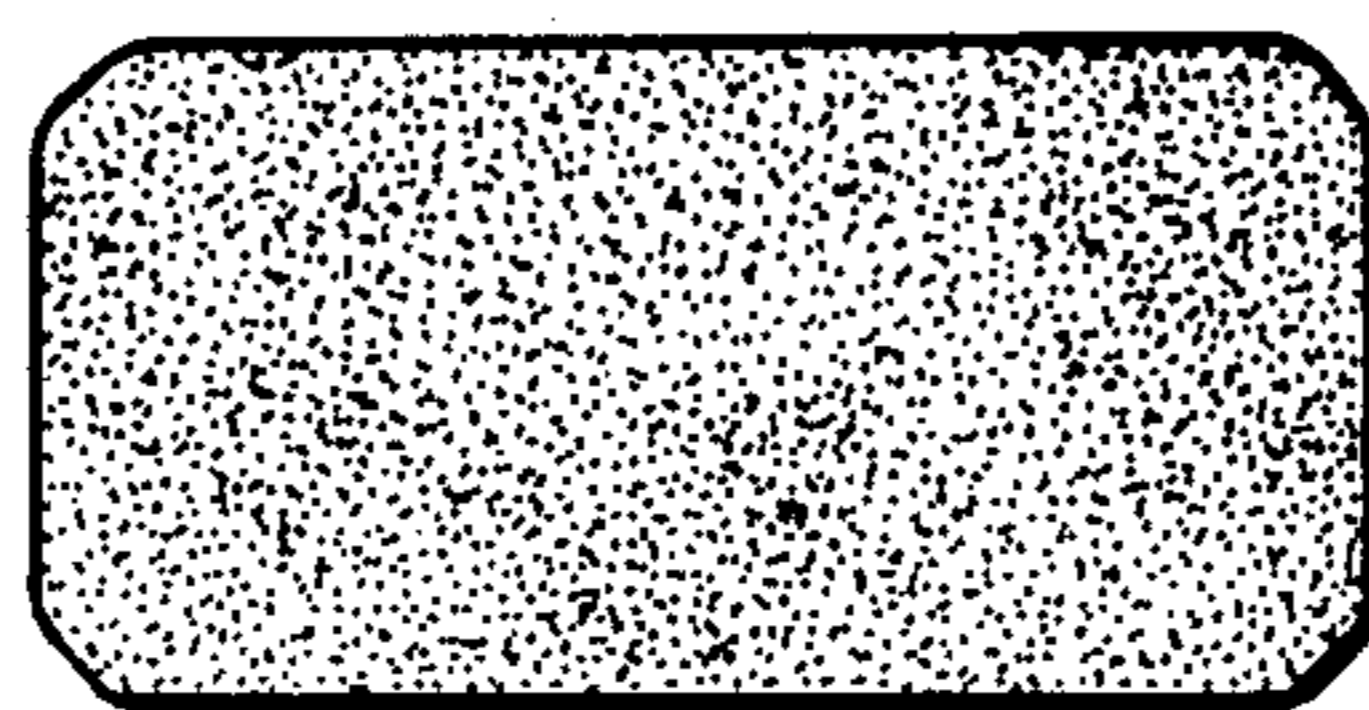
