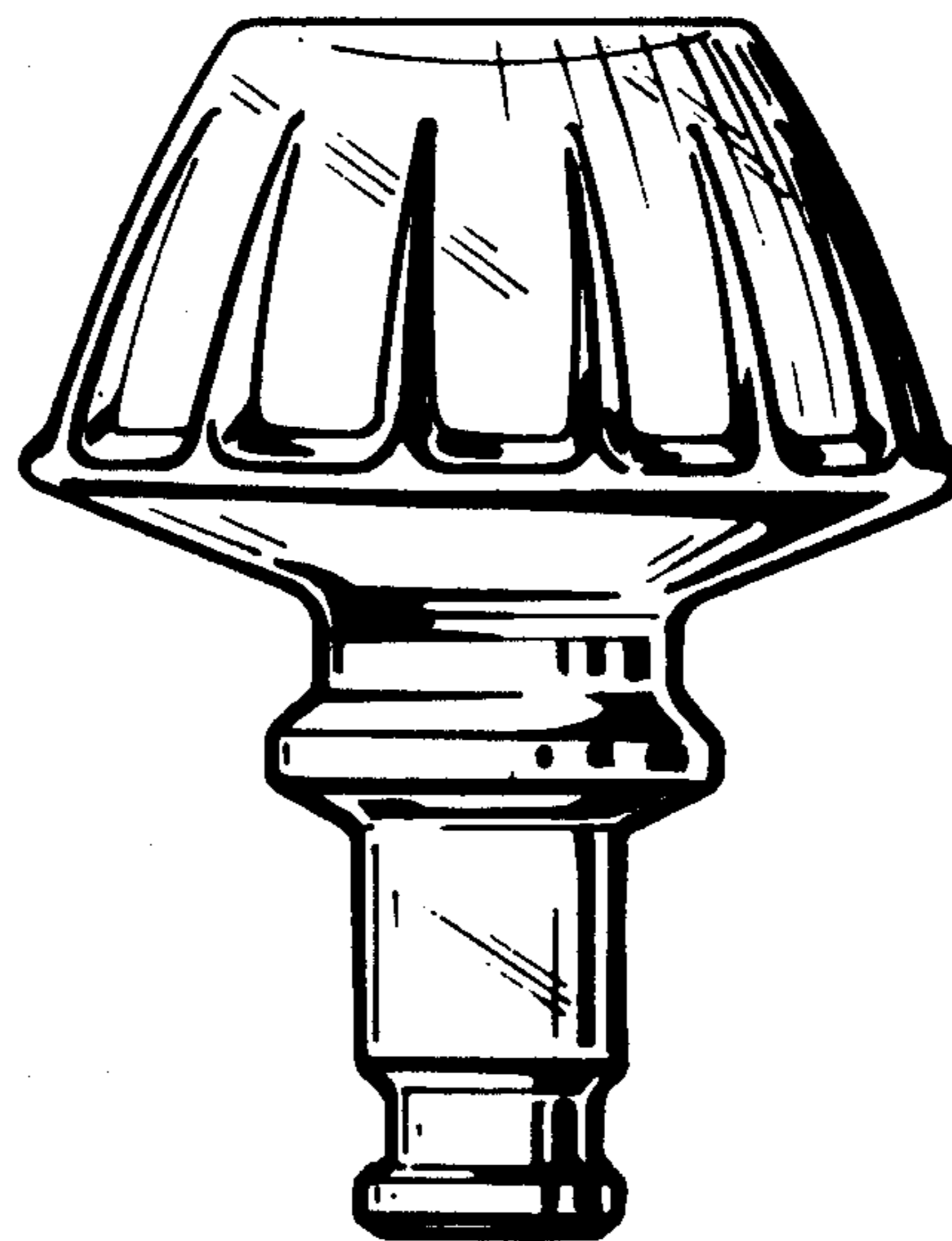
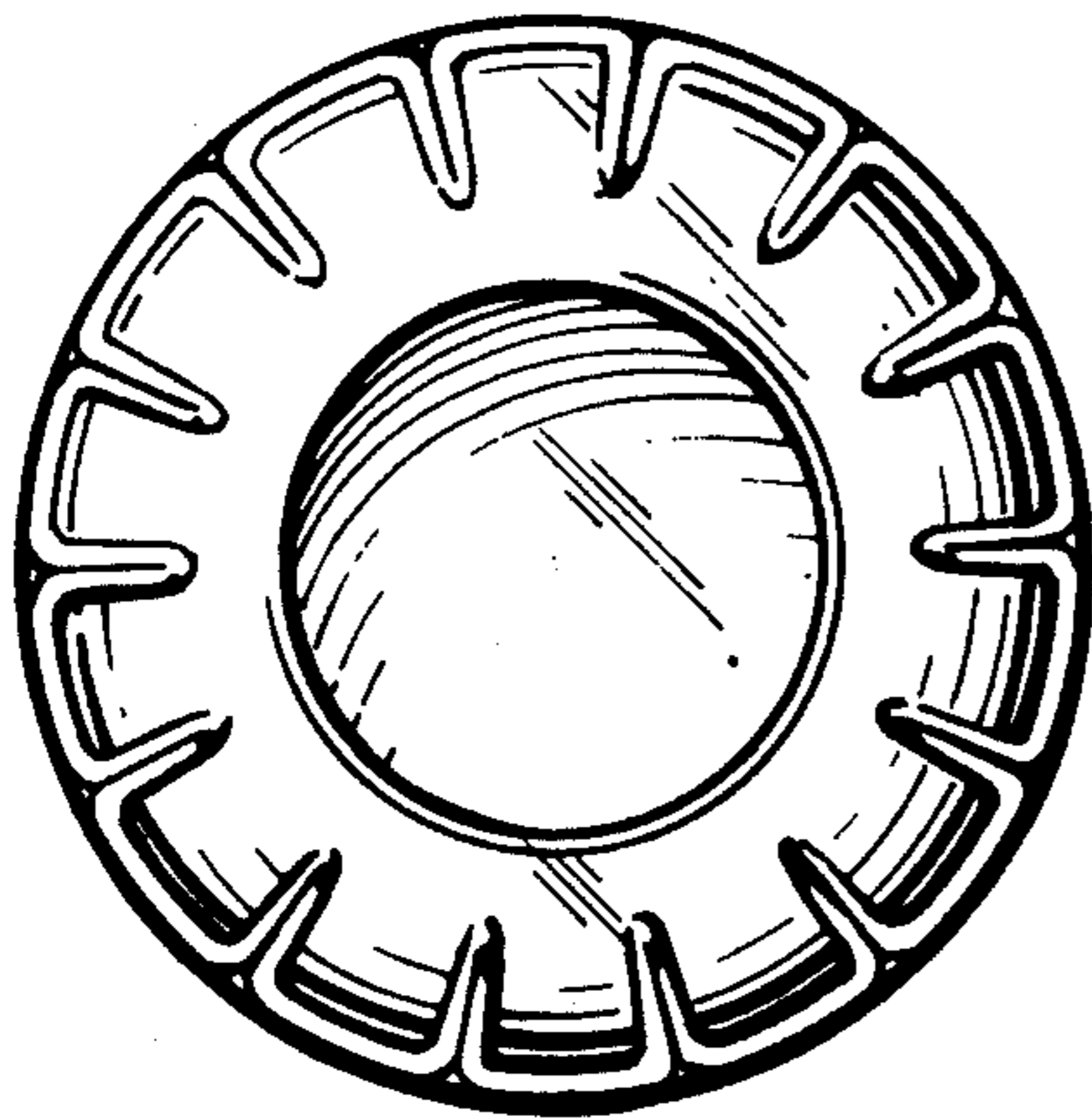
The ornamental design for a stopper, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



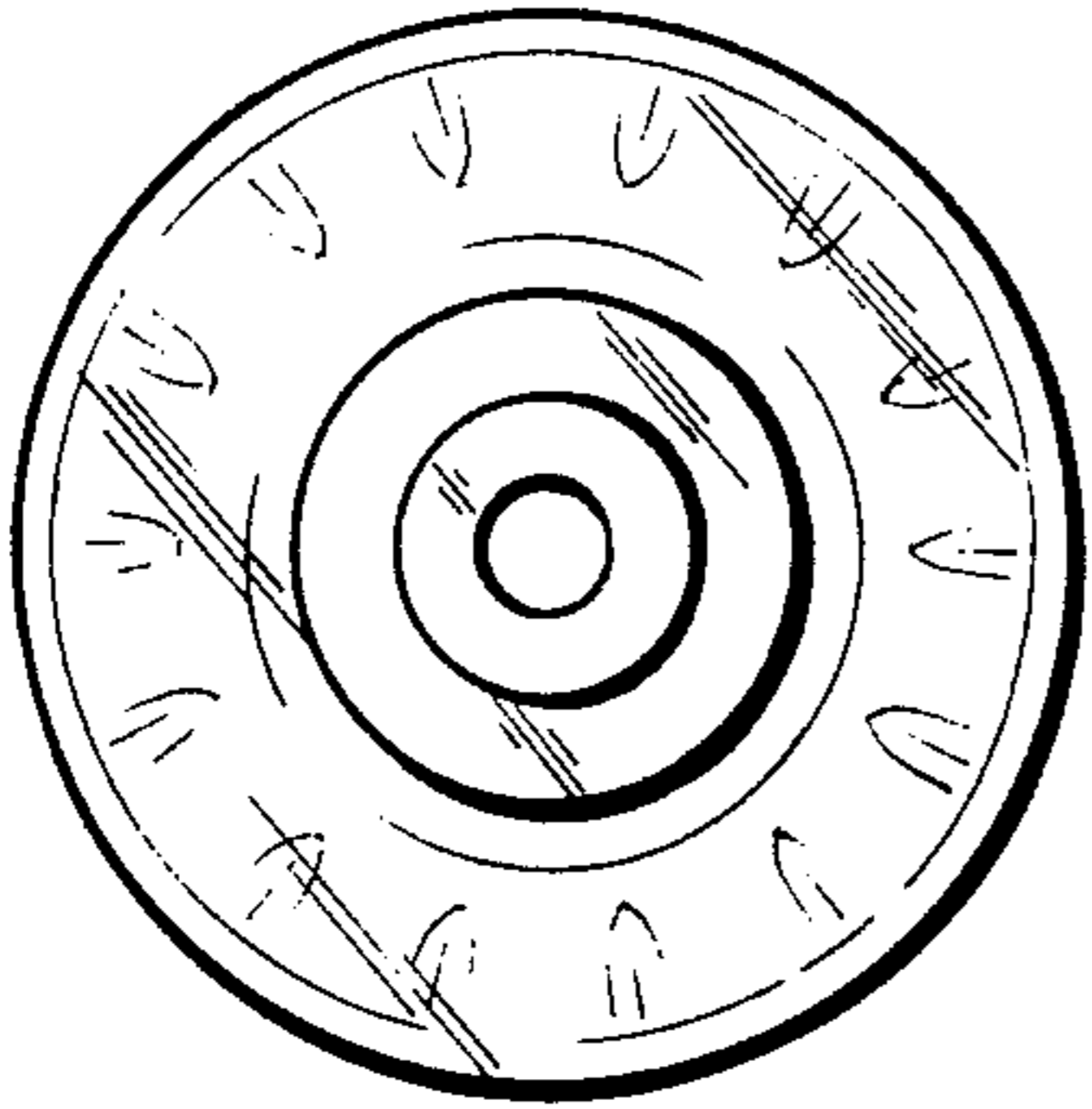

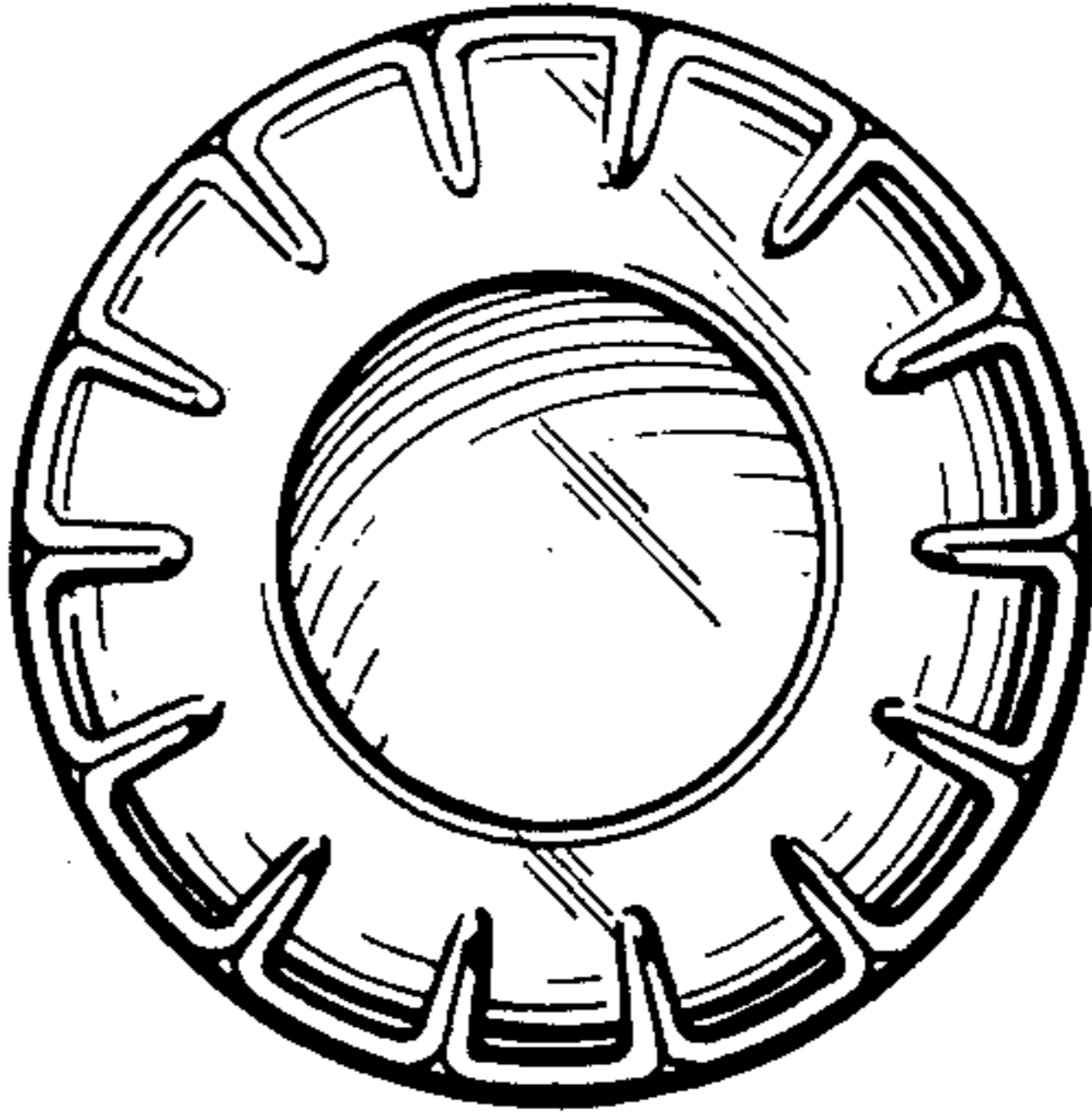

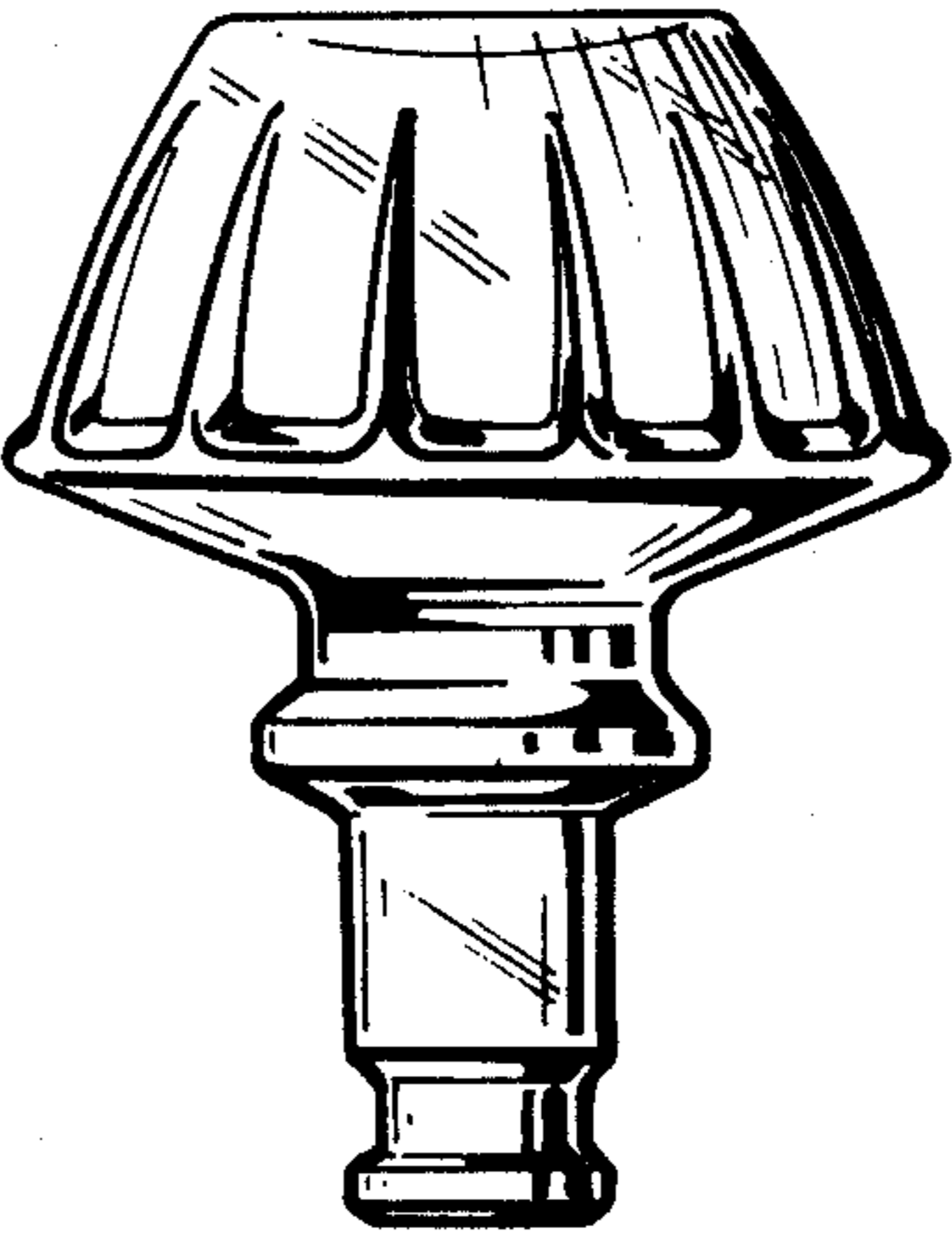
