FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a photographic strobe-light or similar article, showing my new design;

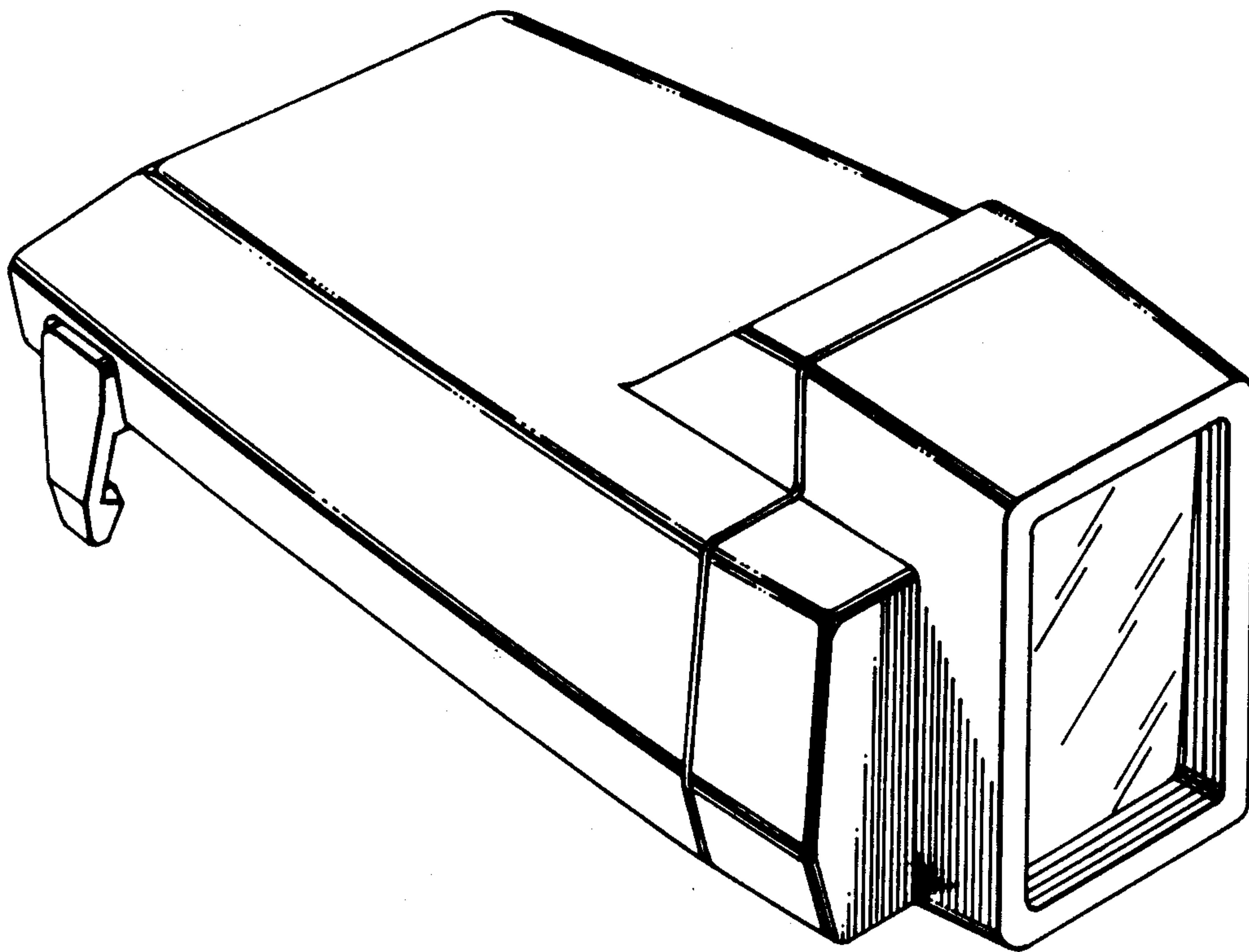
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



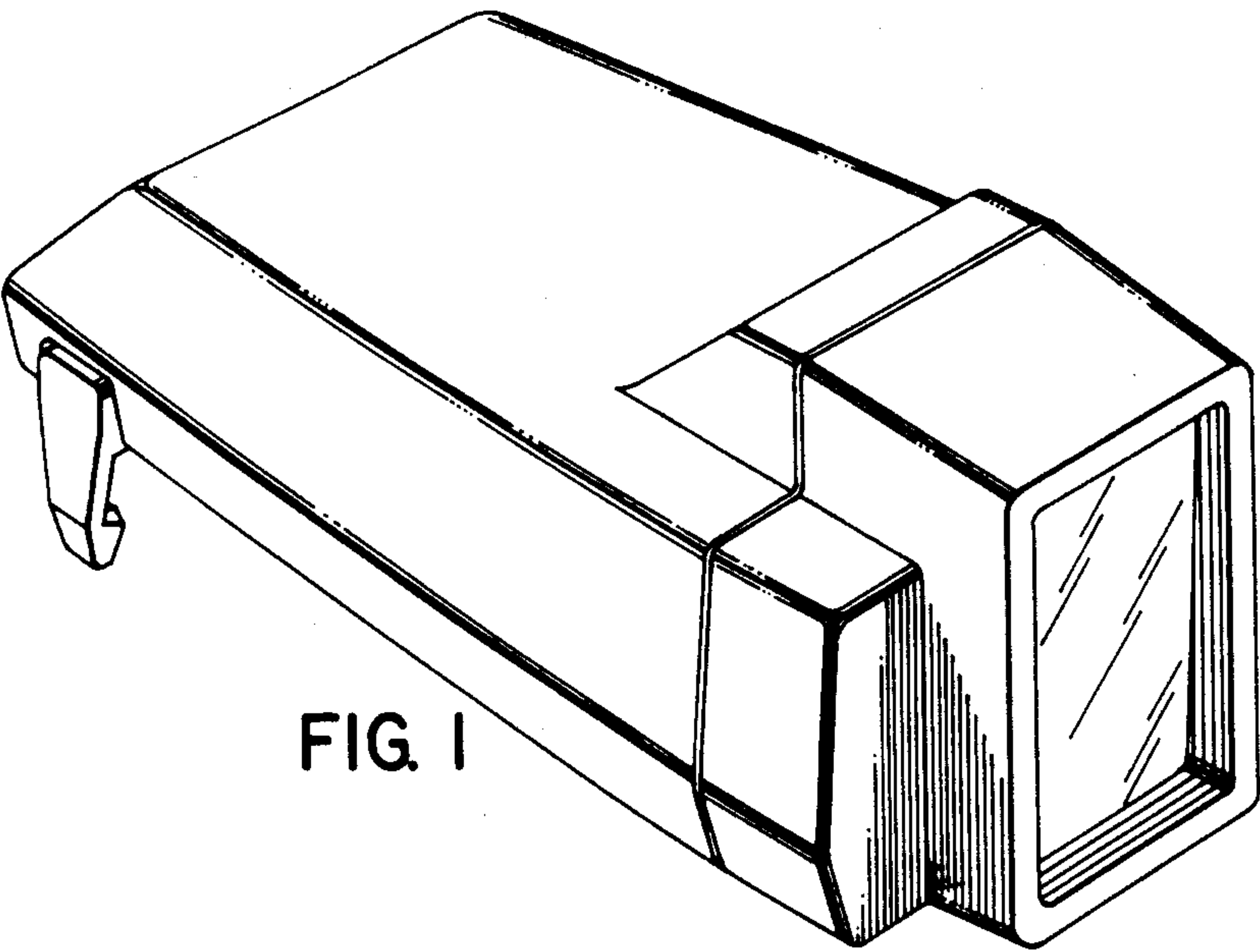

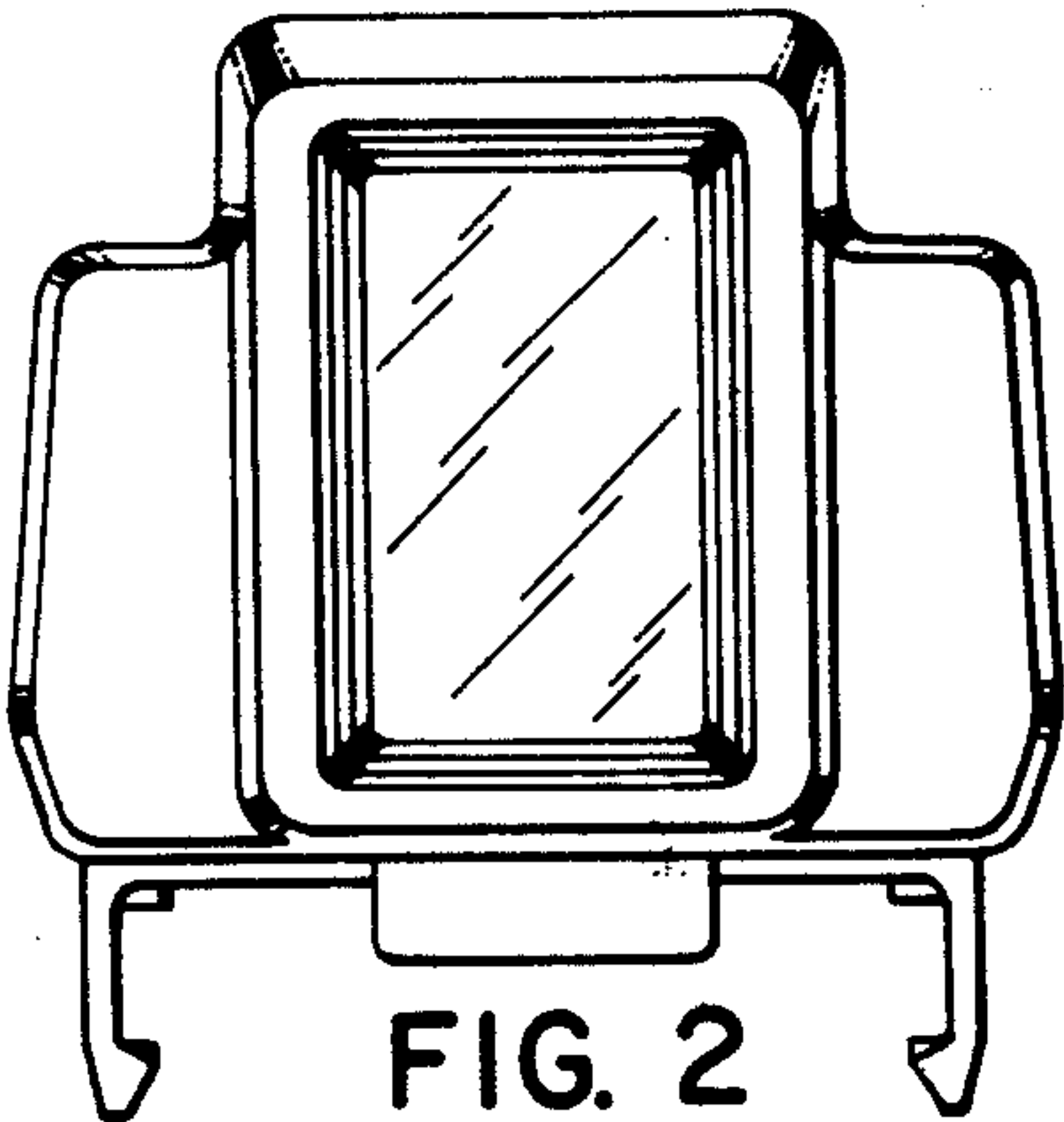

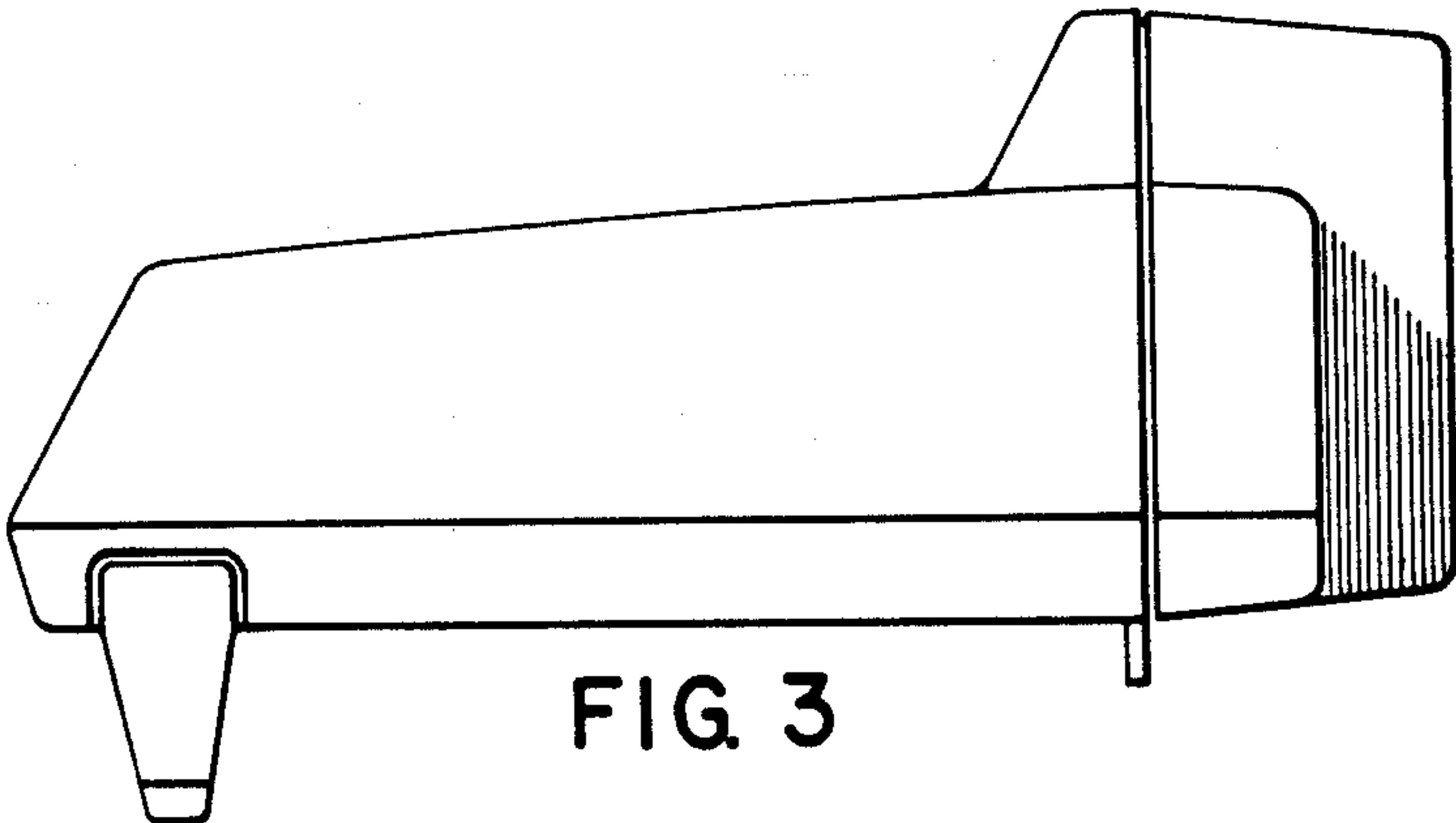

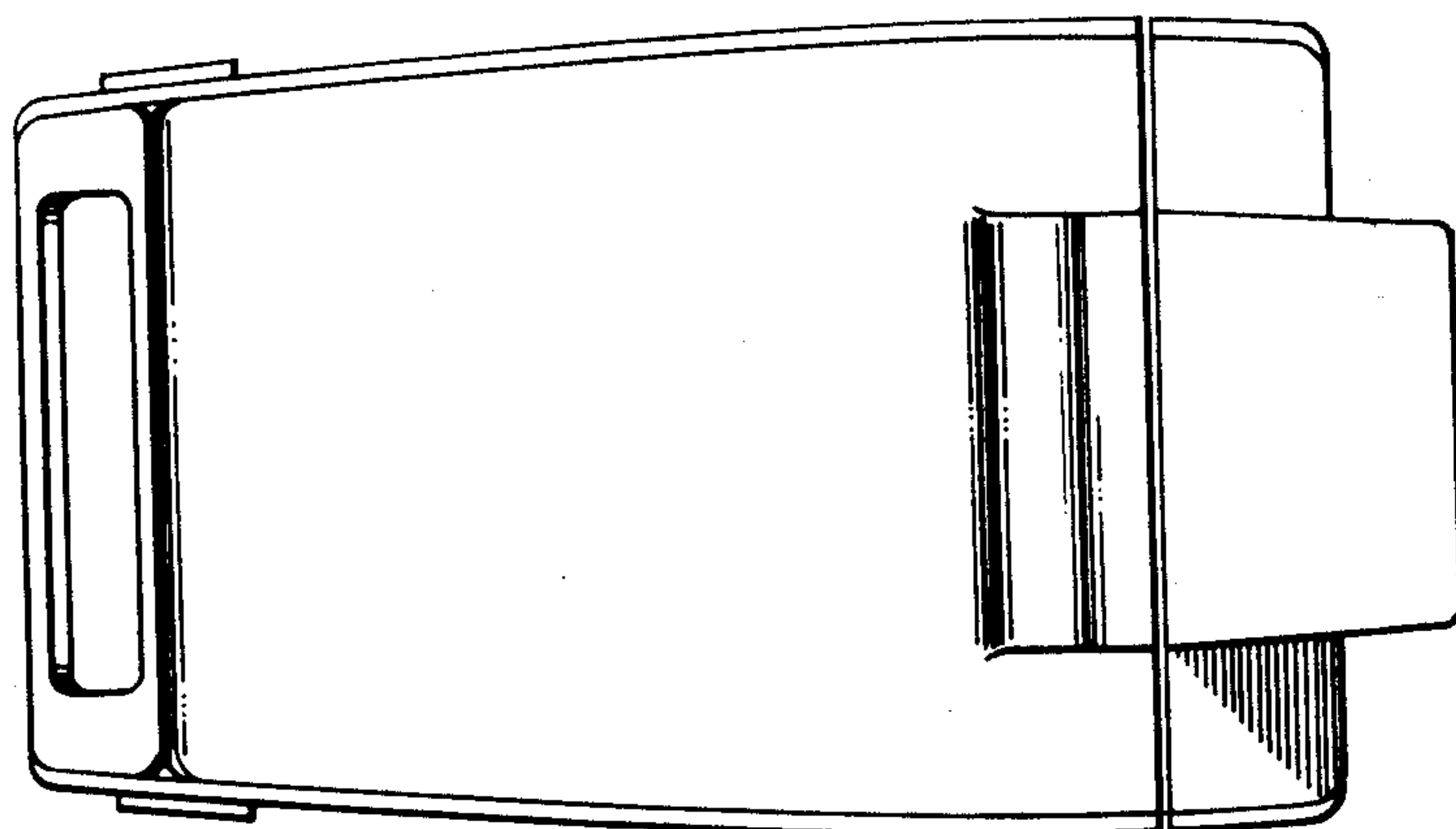

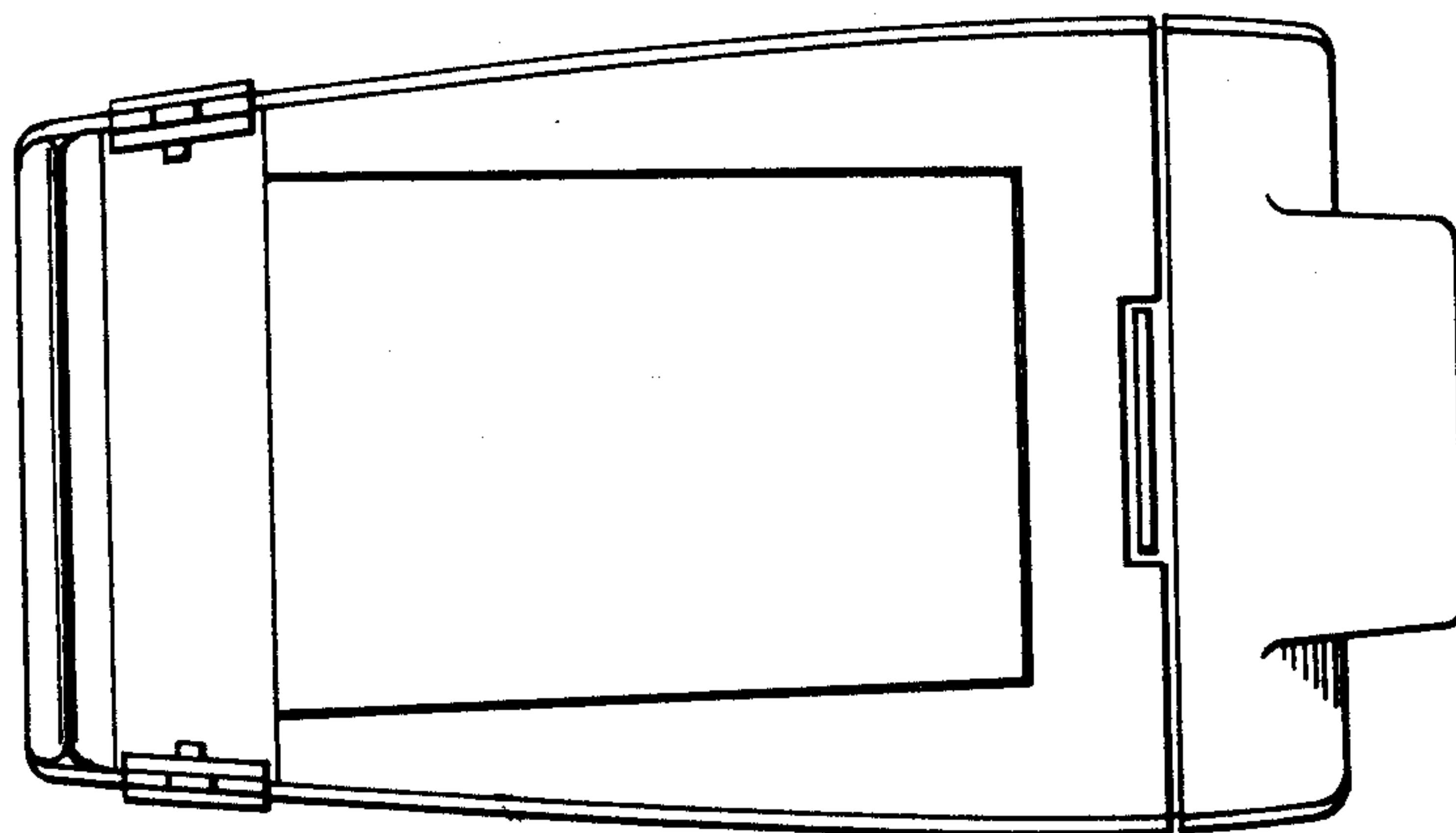

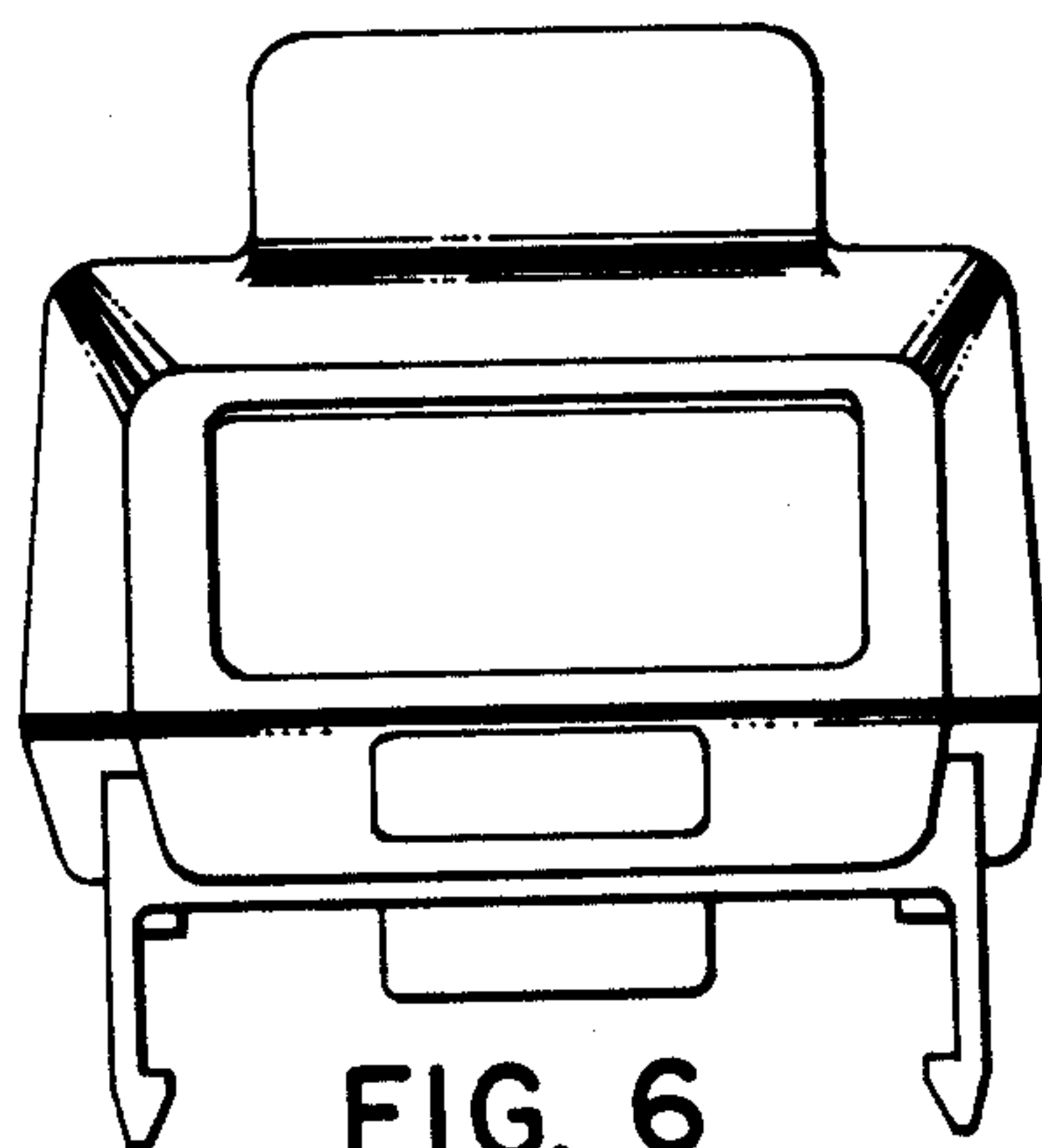
