The ornamental design for a steam cabinet, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a steam cabinet showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, taken at a reduced scale;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the steam cabinet with the door open;

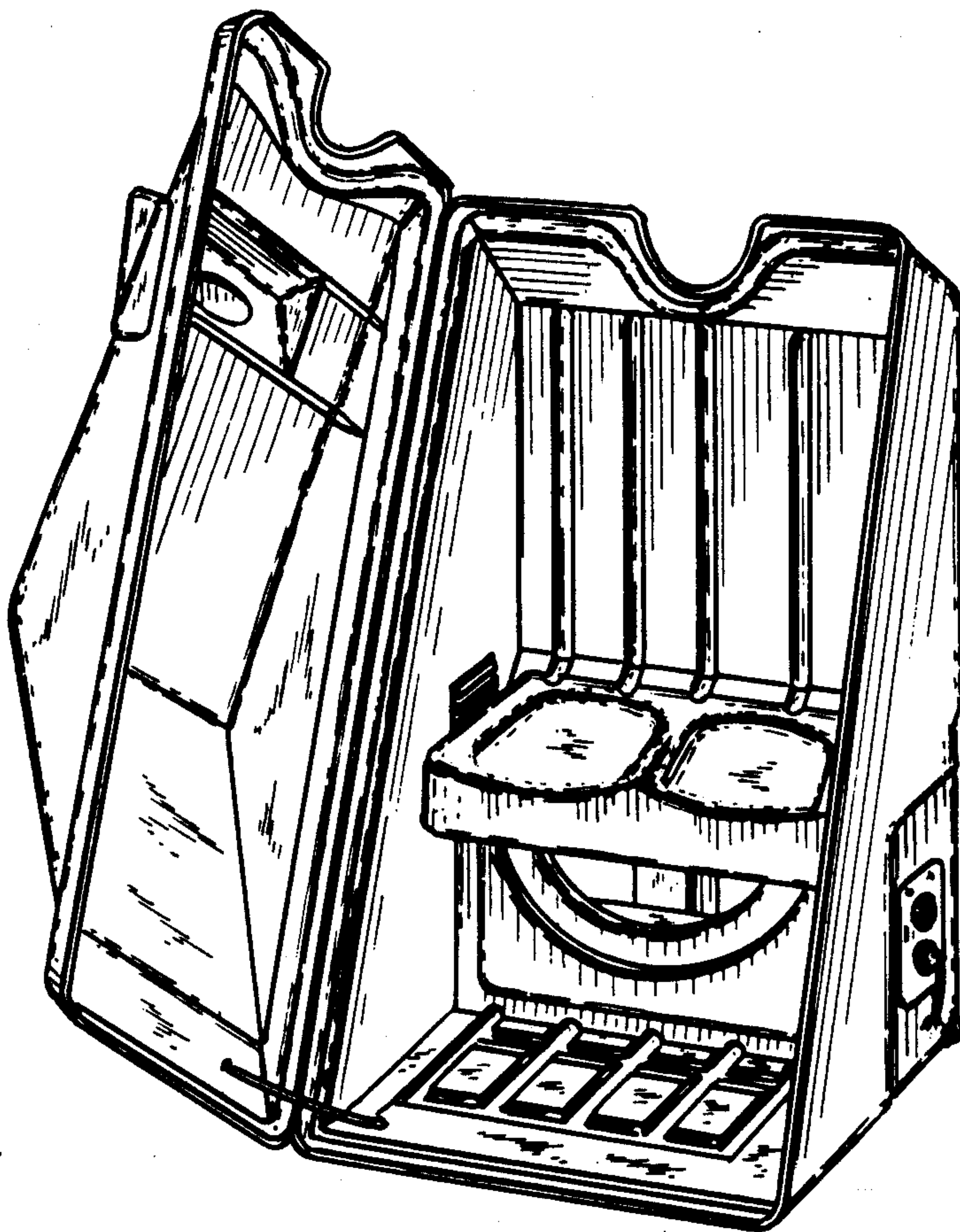
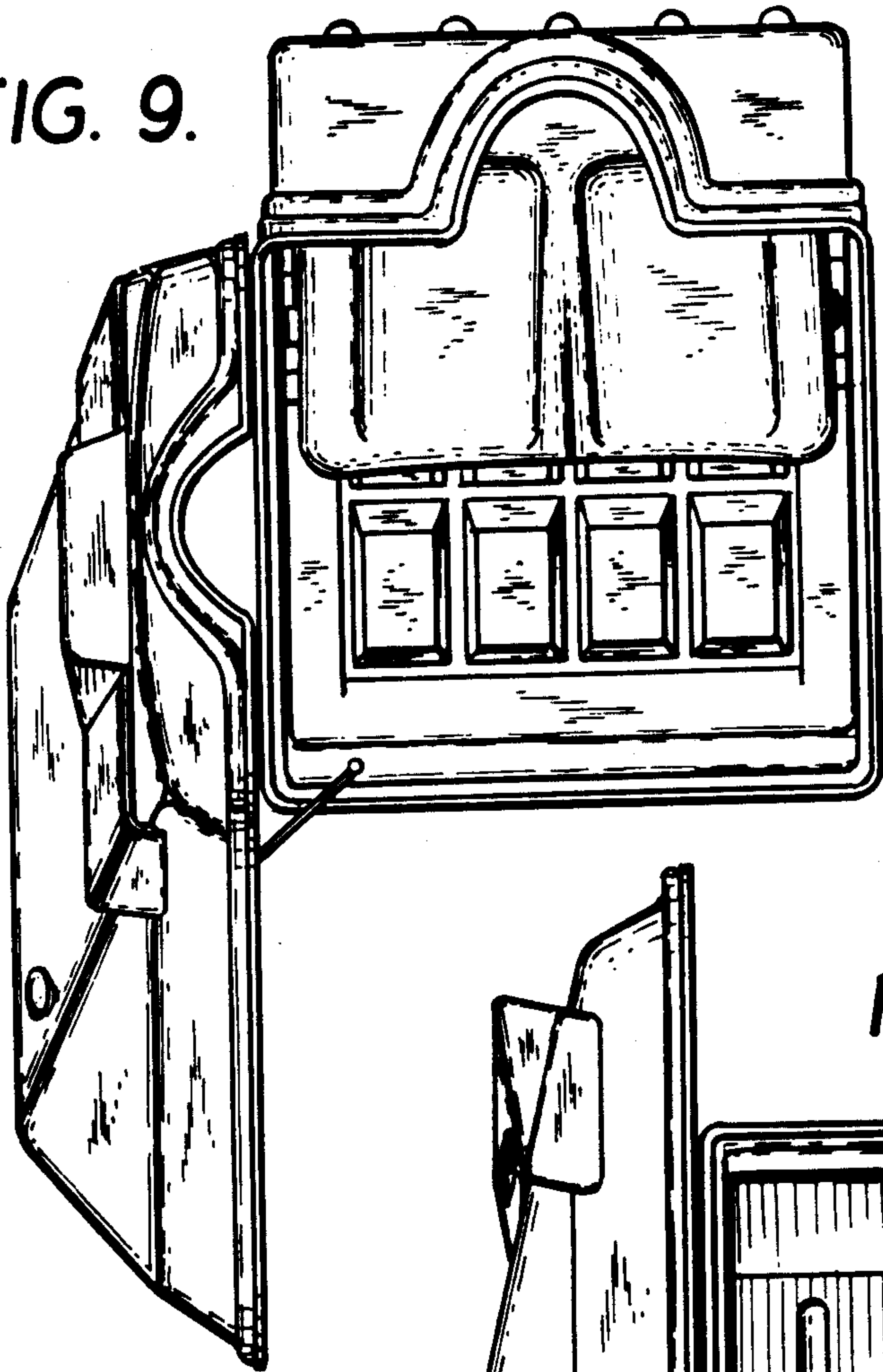


FIG. 9.**FIG. 10.**

FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the steam cabinet shown in FIG. 8; and

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the steam cabinet shown in FIG. 8.

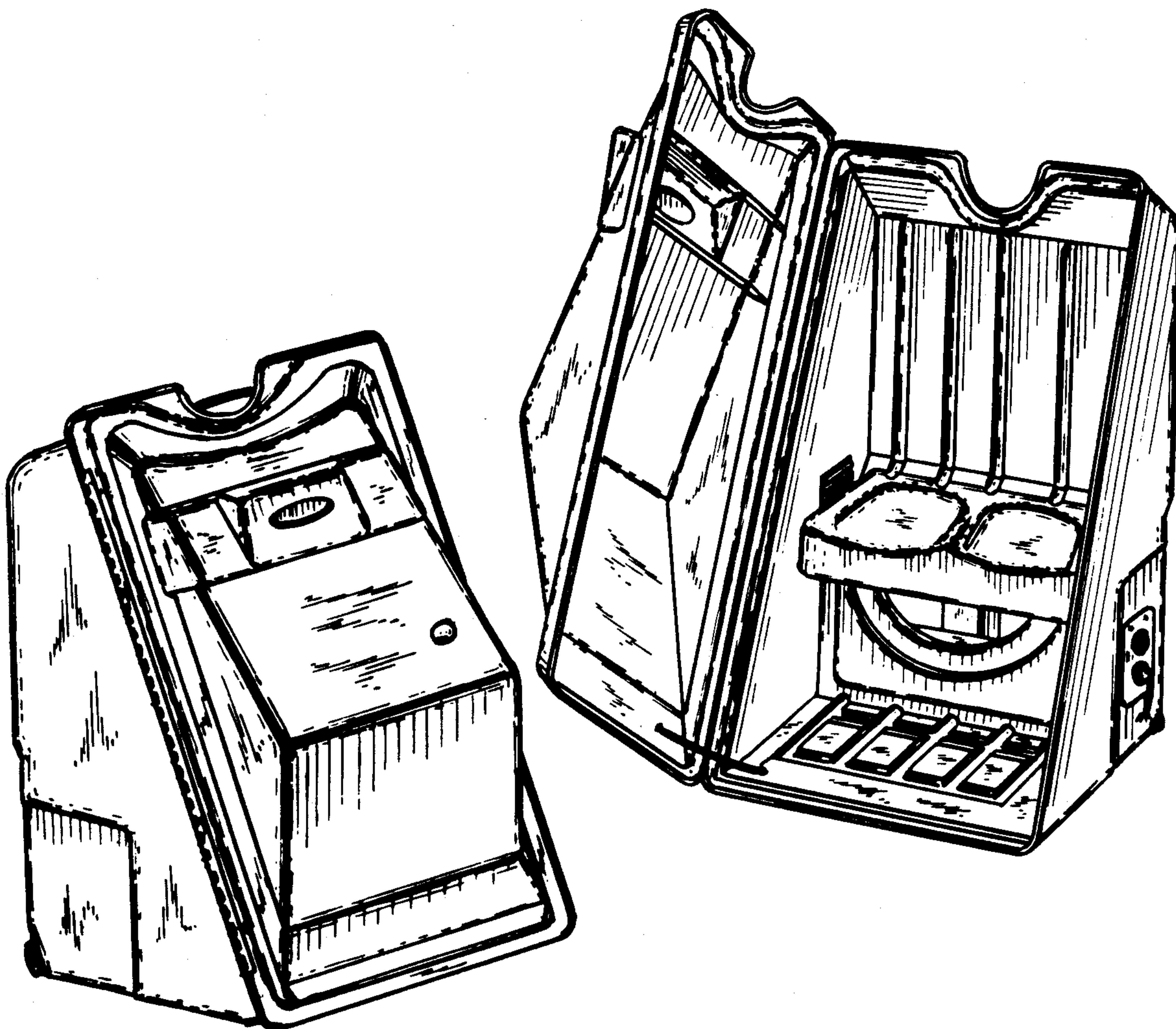

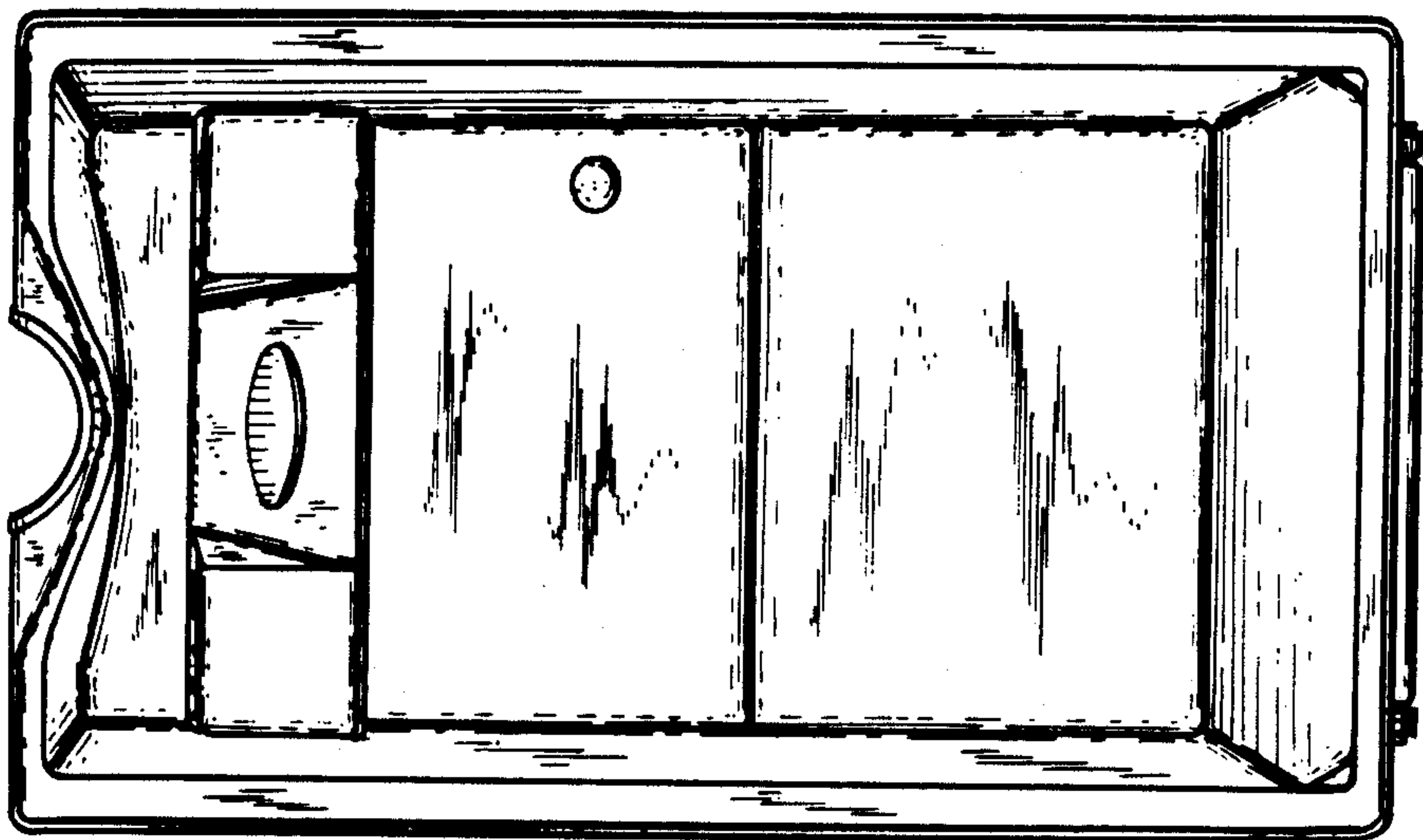

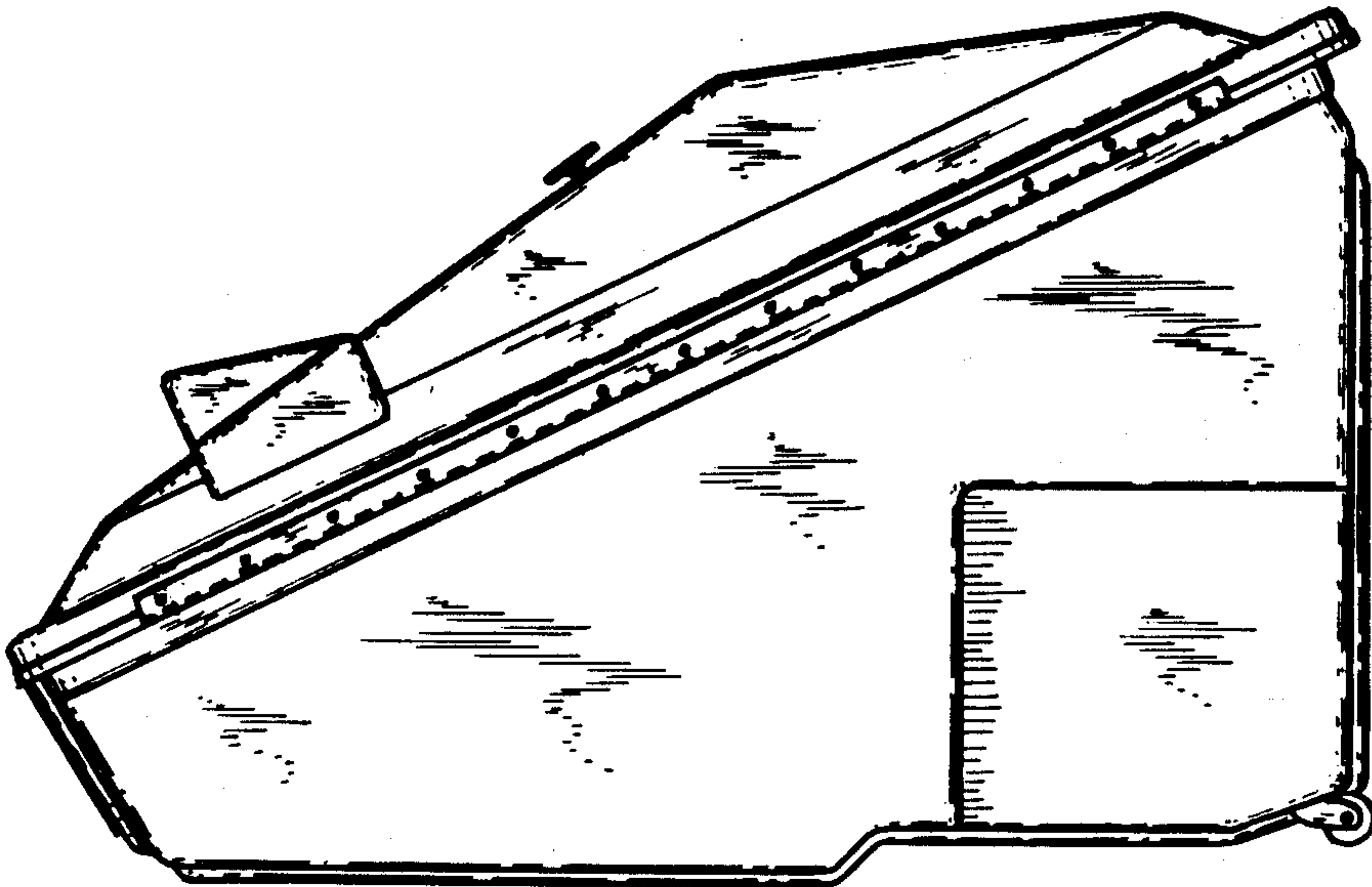

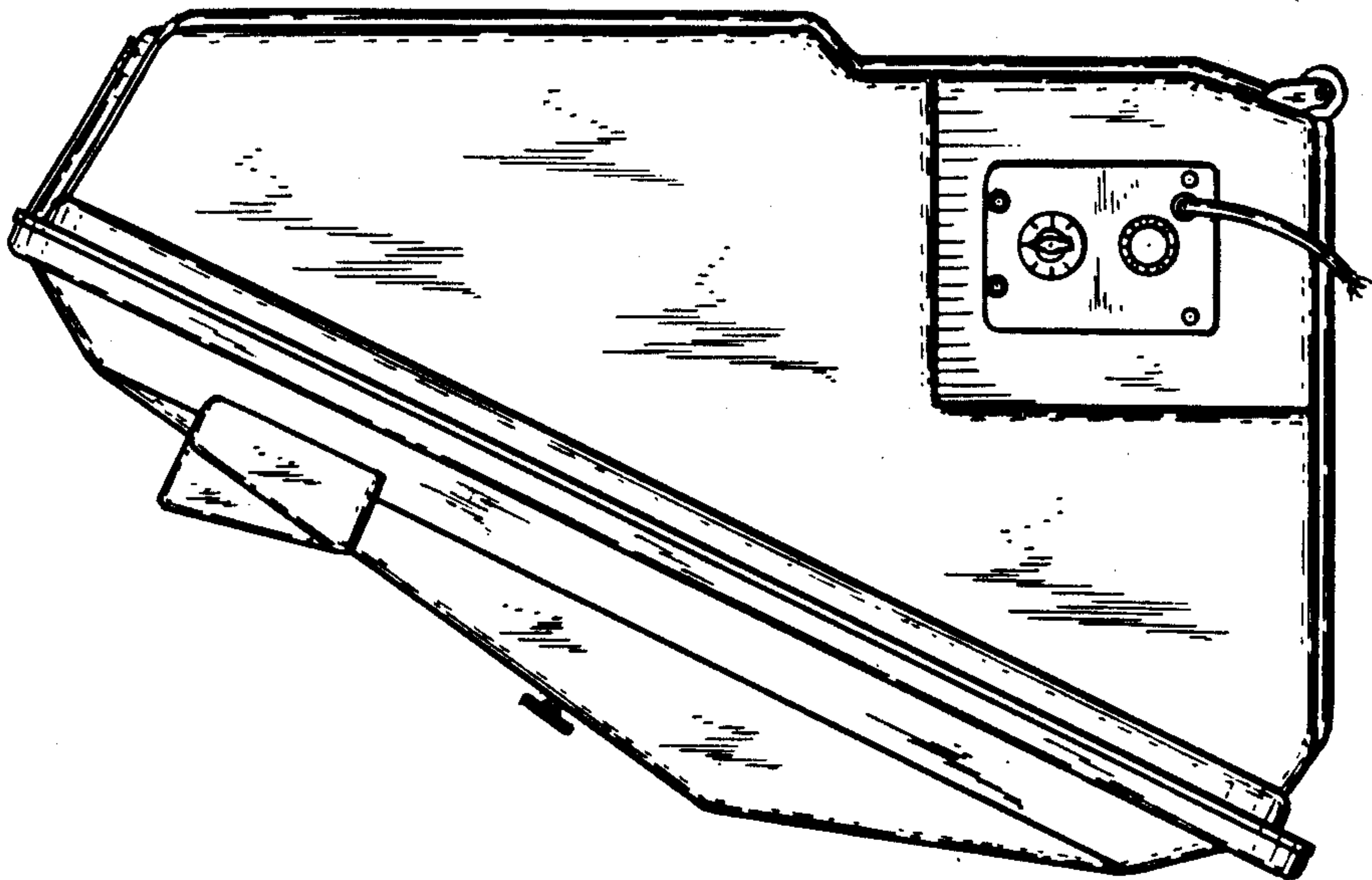

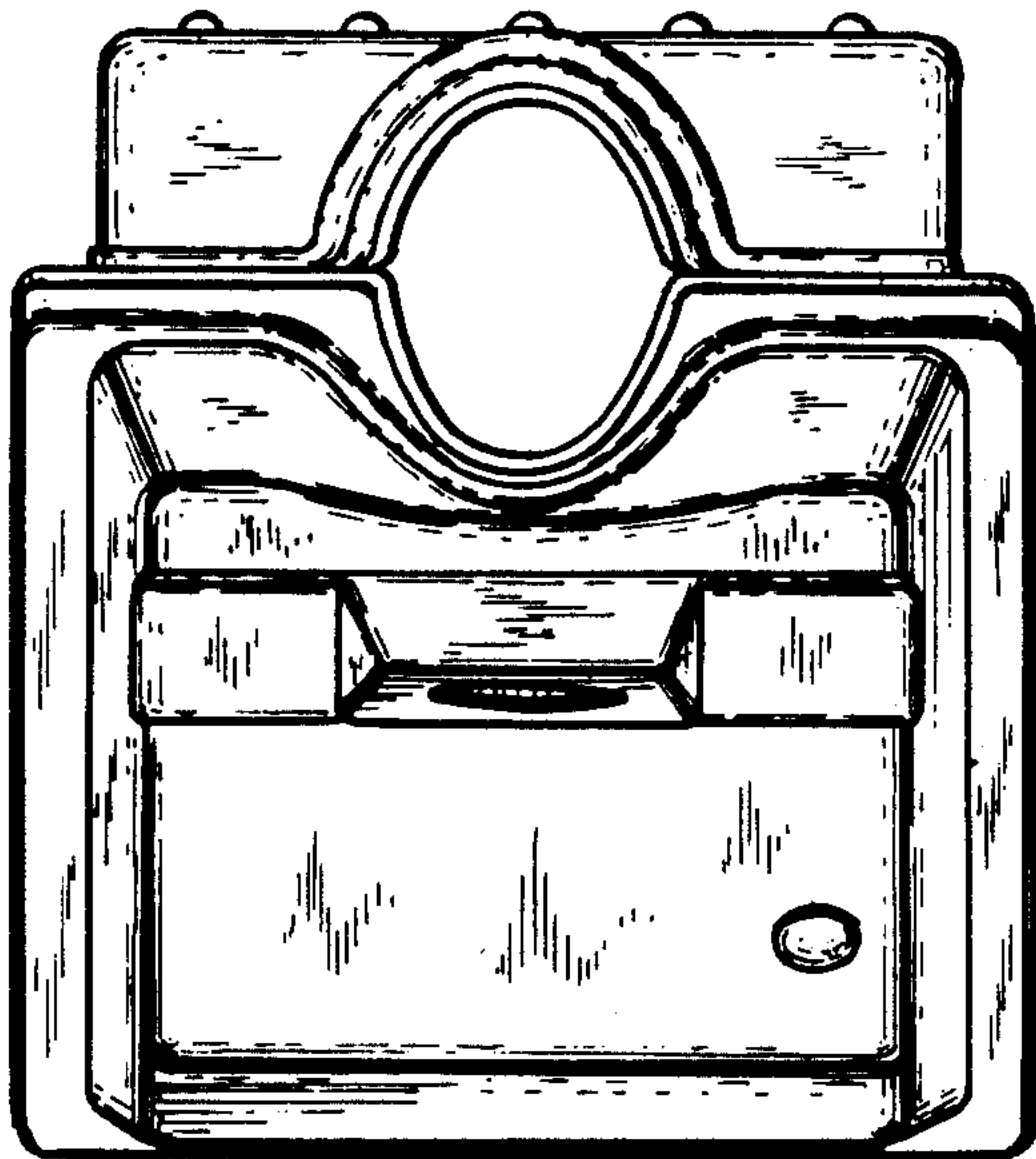

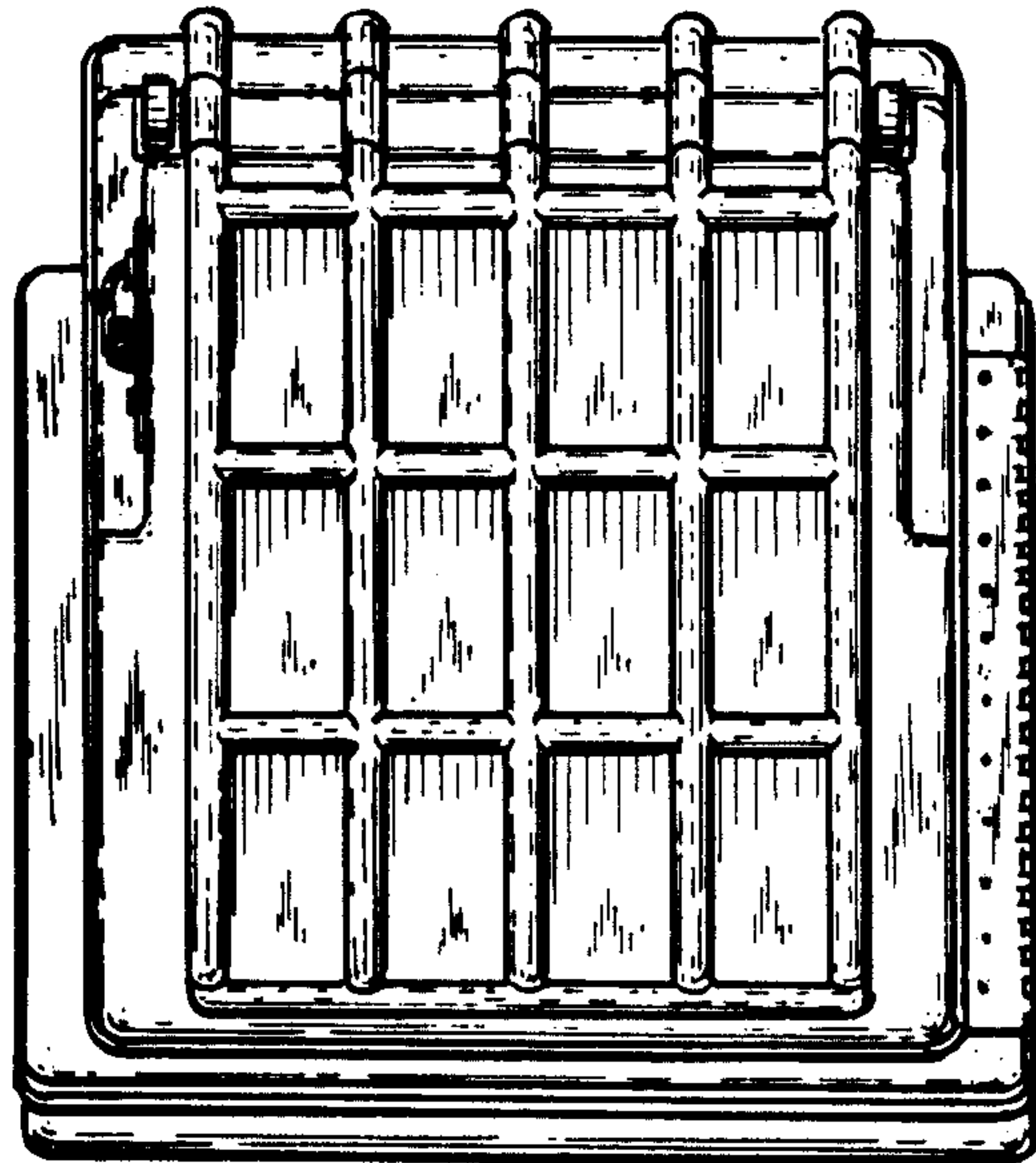

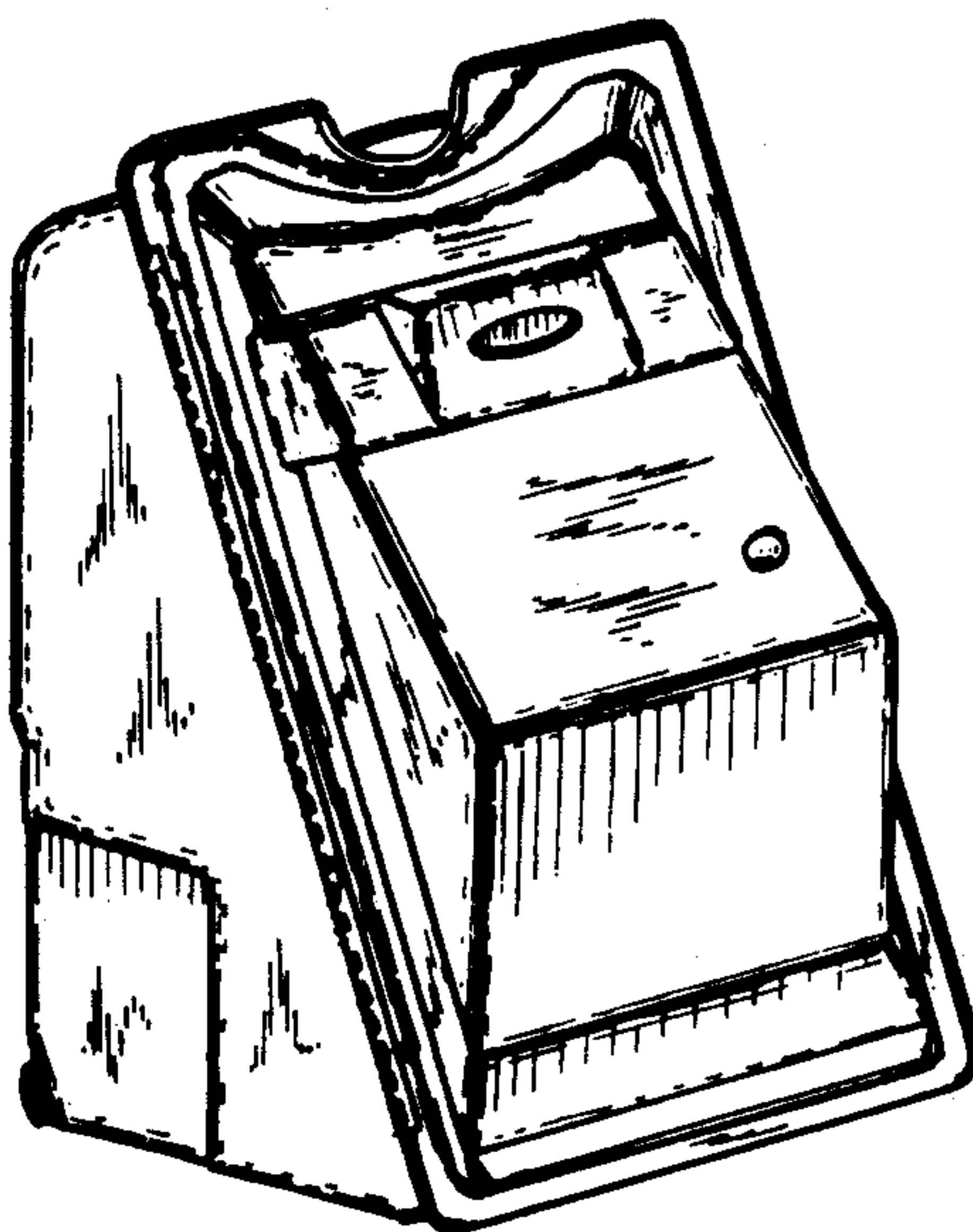
