### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, substantially as  
shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toothbrush showing our  
new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 3—3 of  
FIG. 1 thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is an end view taken in the direction of the head  
thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is an end view thereof taken in the direction of  
the handle.
