DESCRIPTION

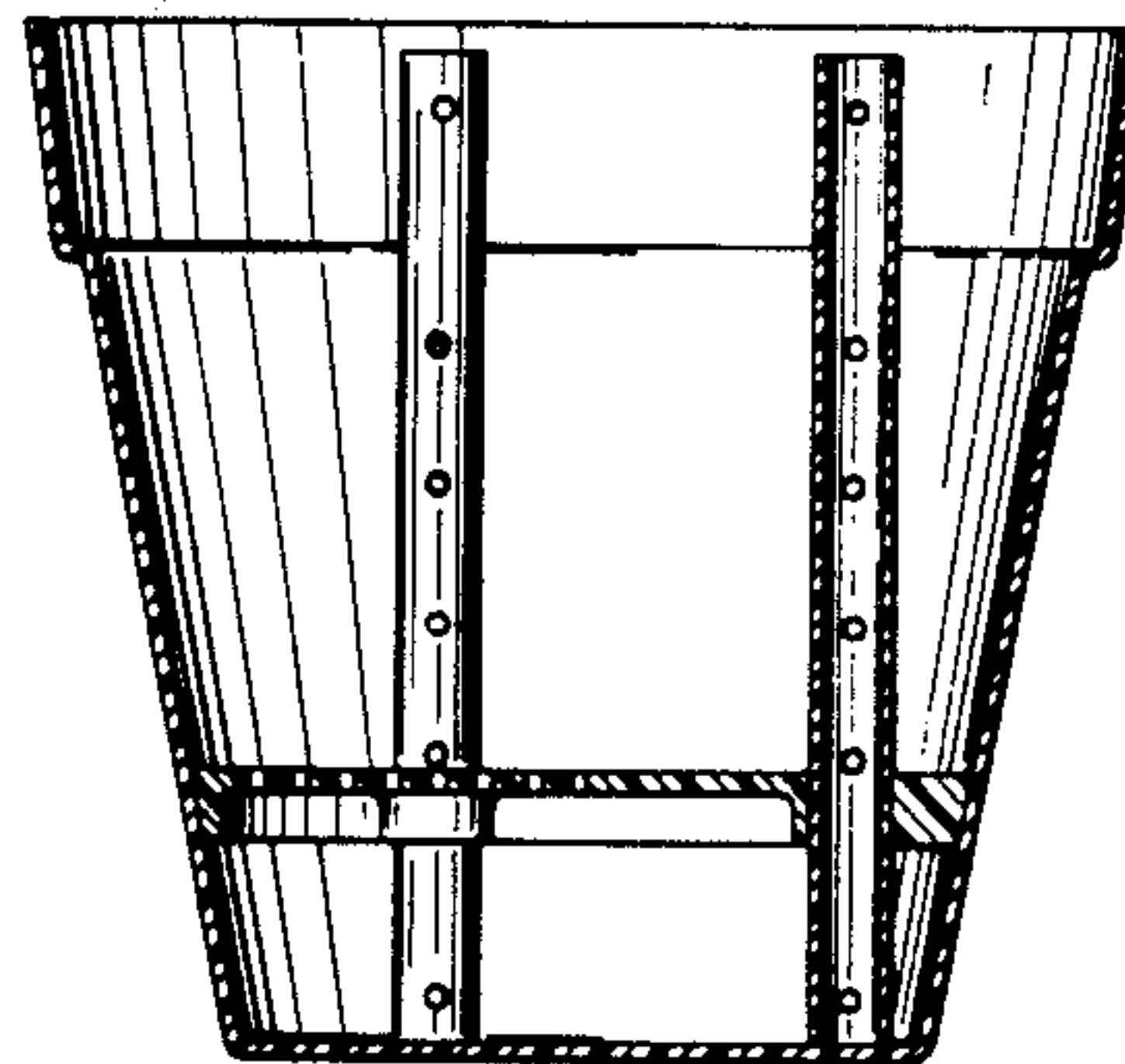
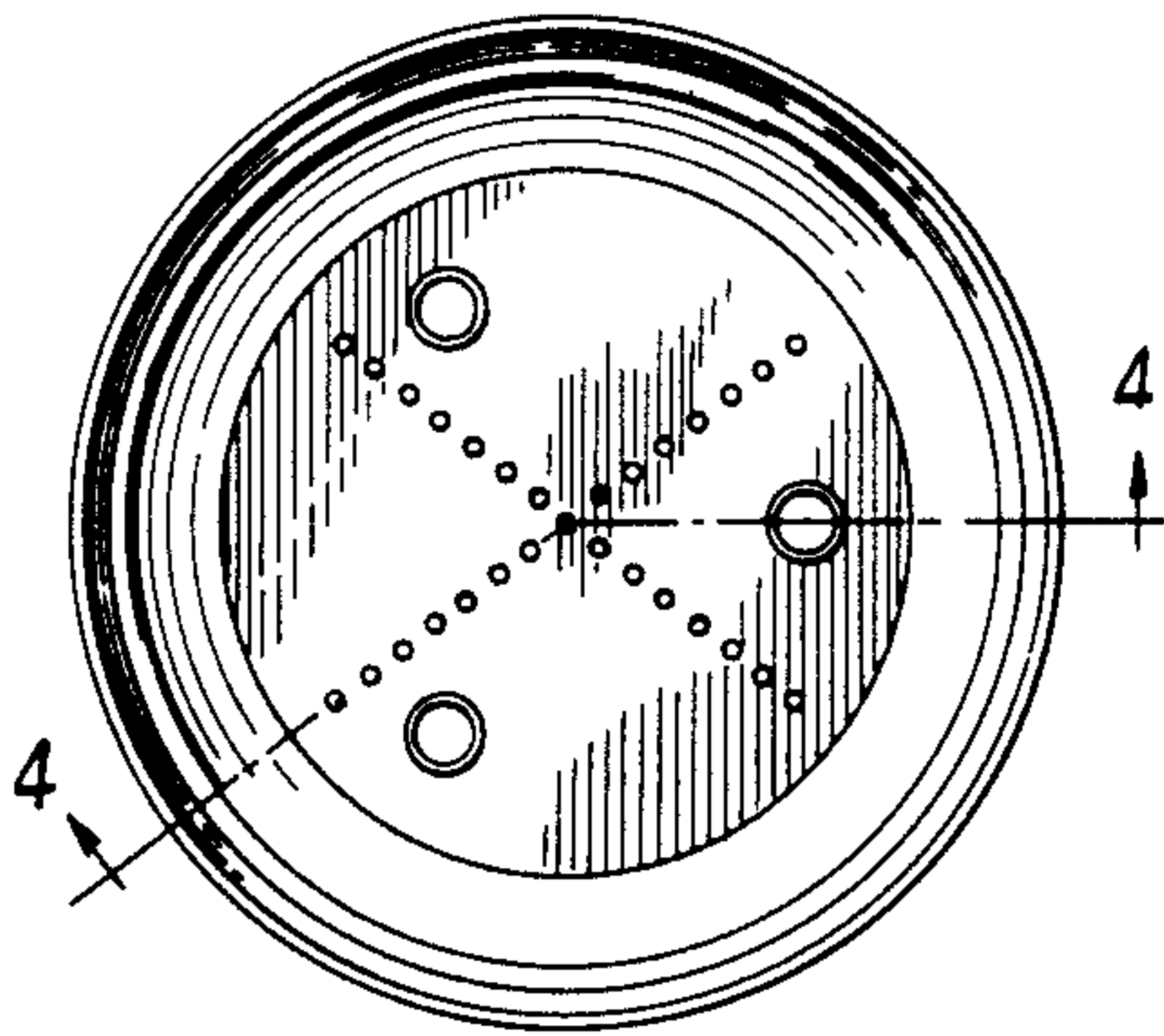
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the combined flower pot, internal support and tubes therefor of my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the support portion of my design.



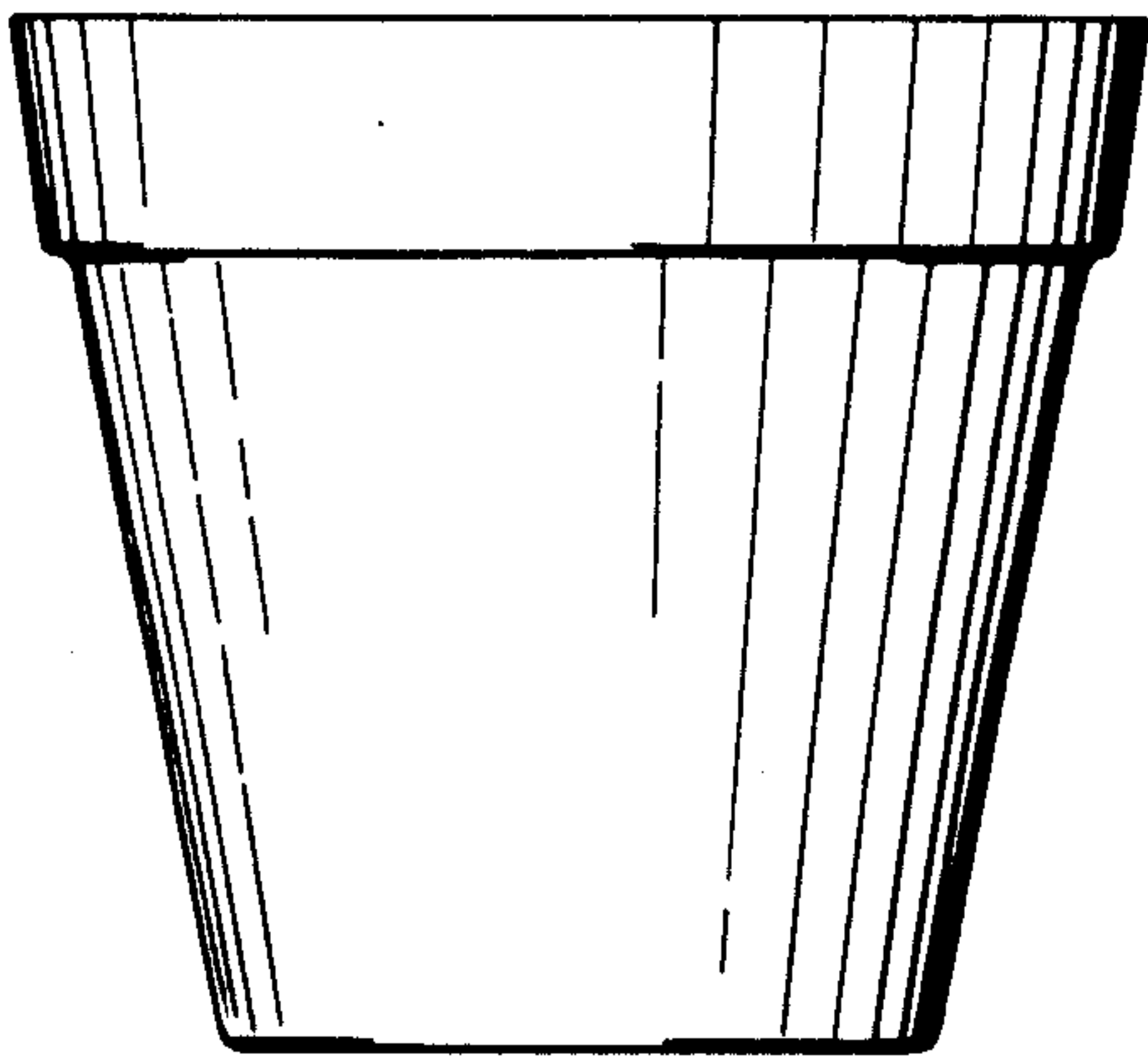

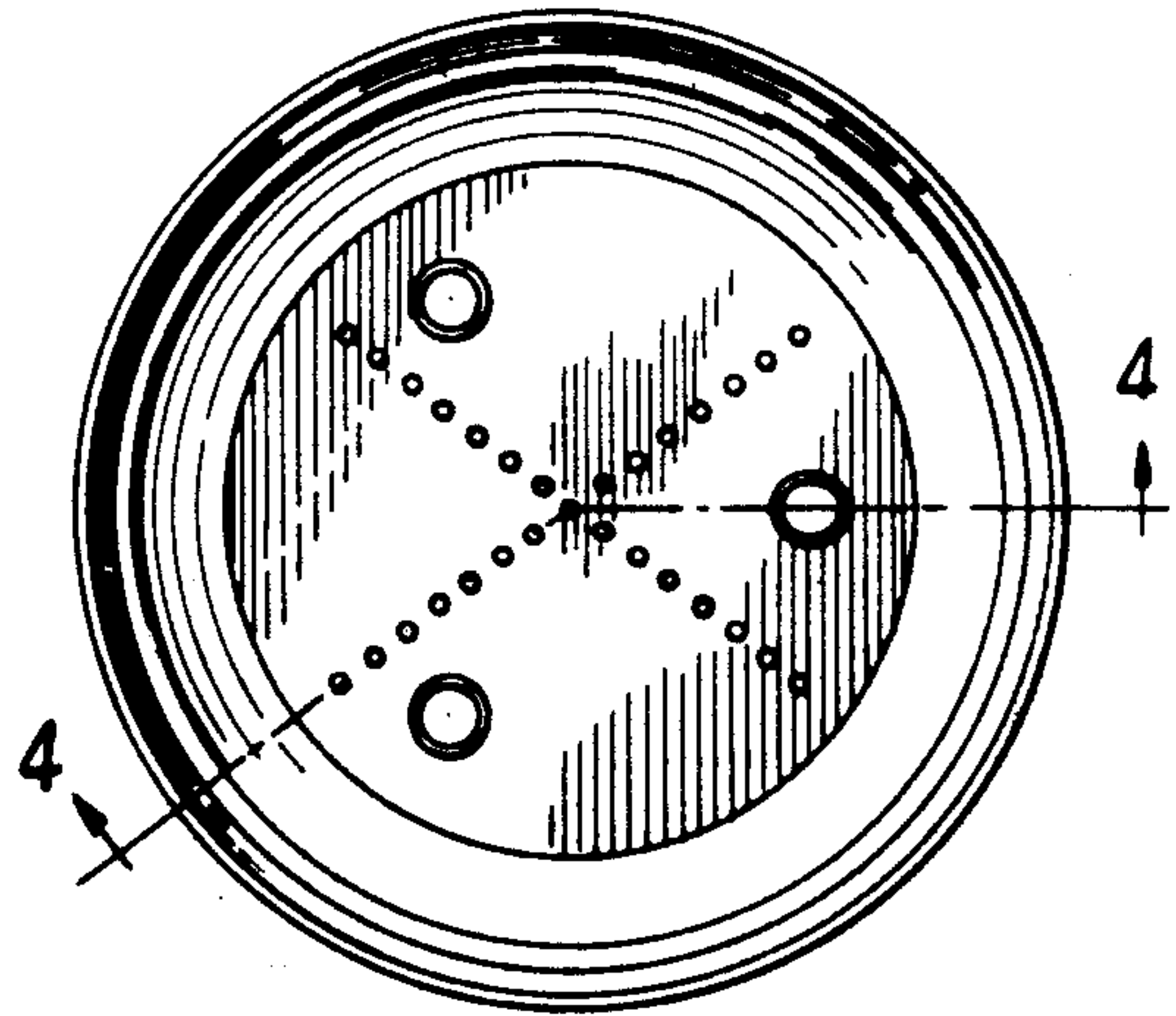

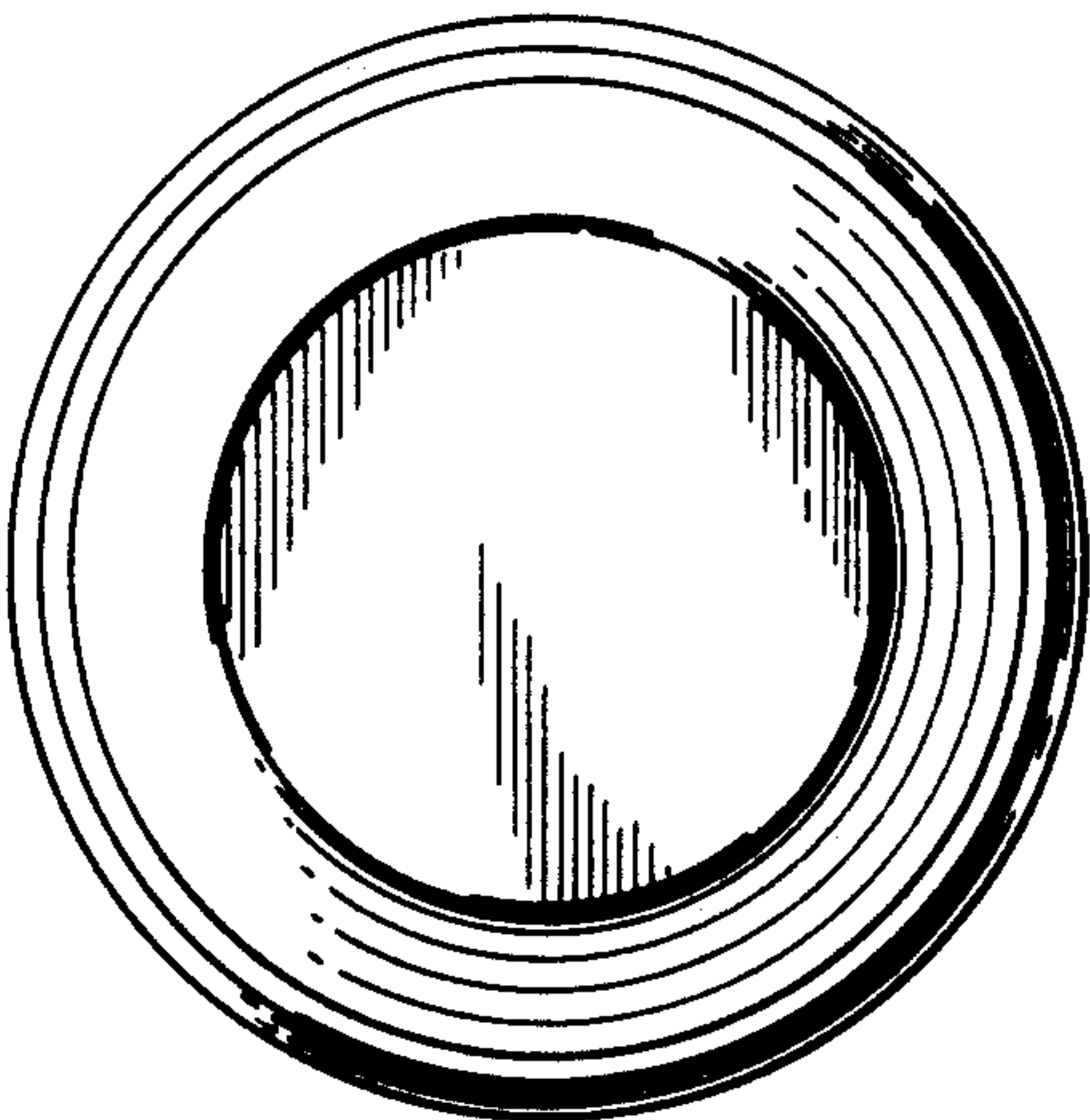

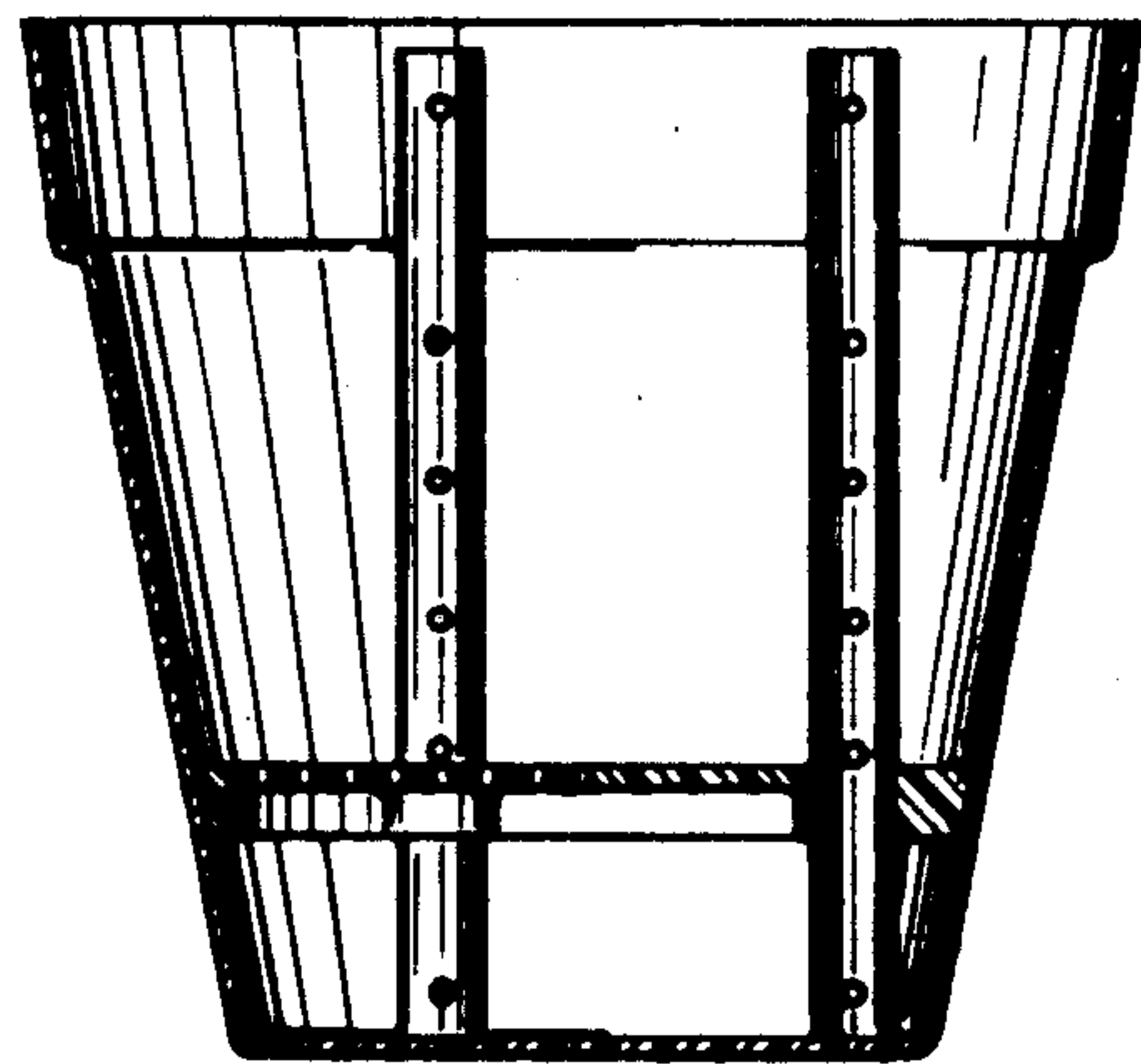

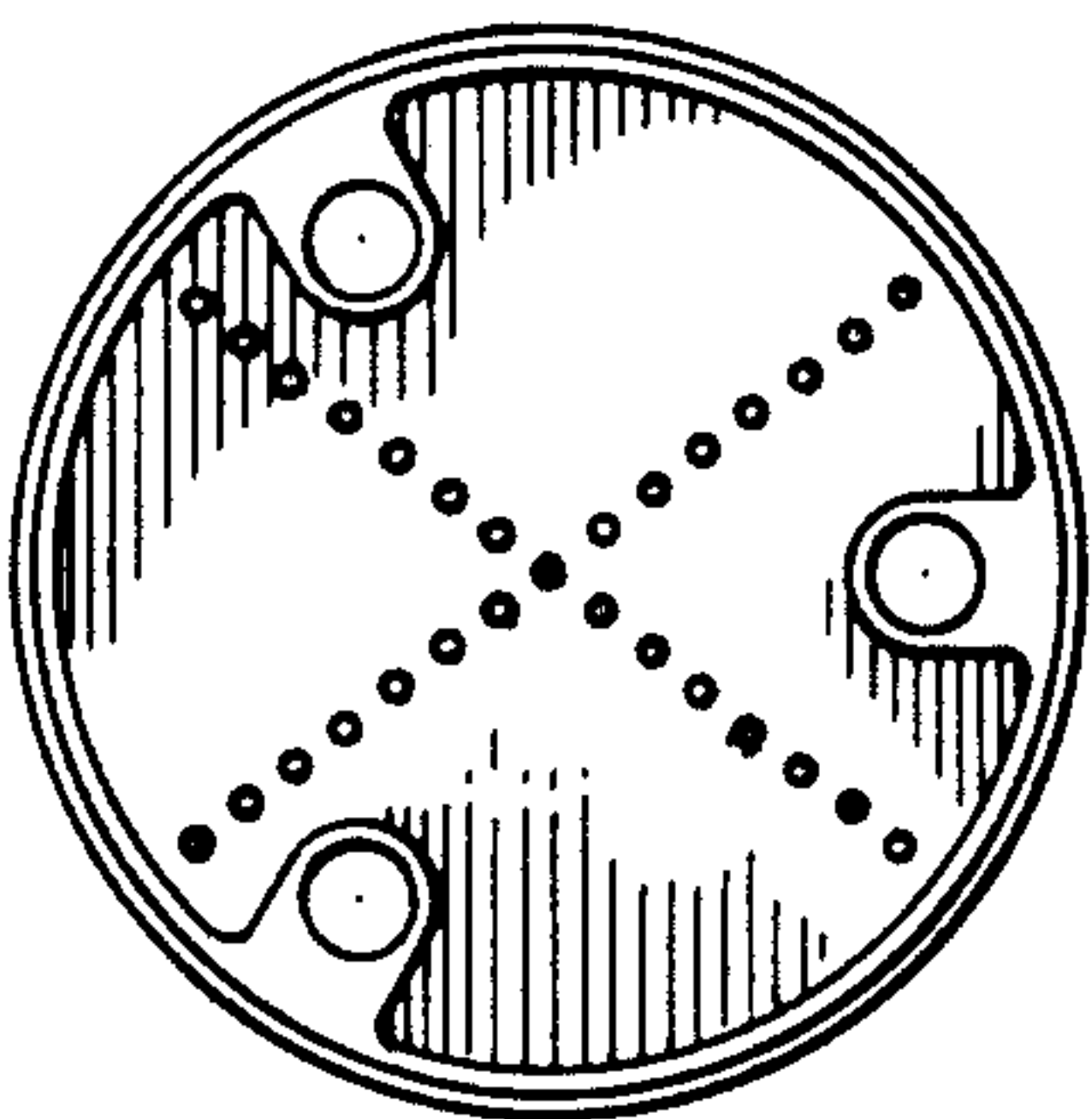
