FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

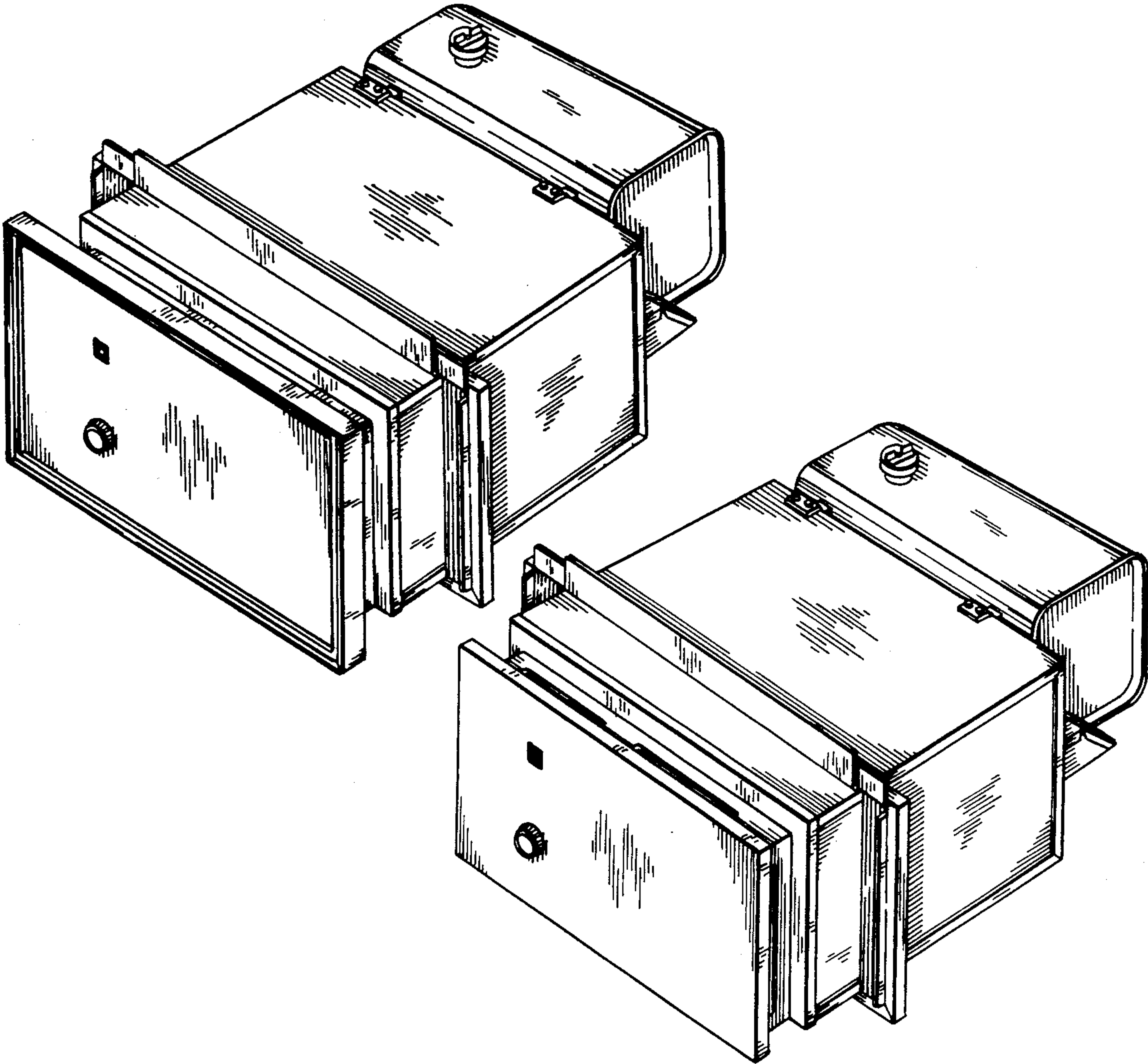
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevation view of said second embodiment thereof.



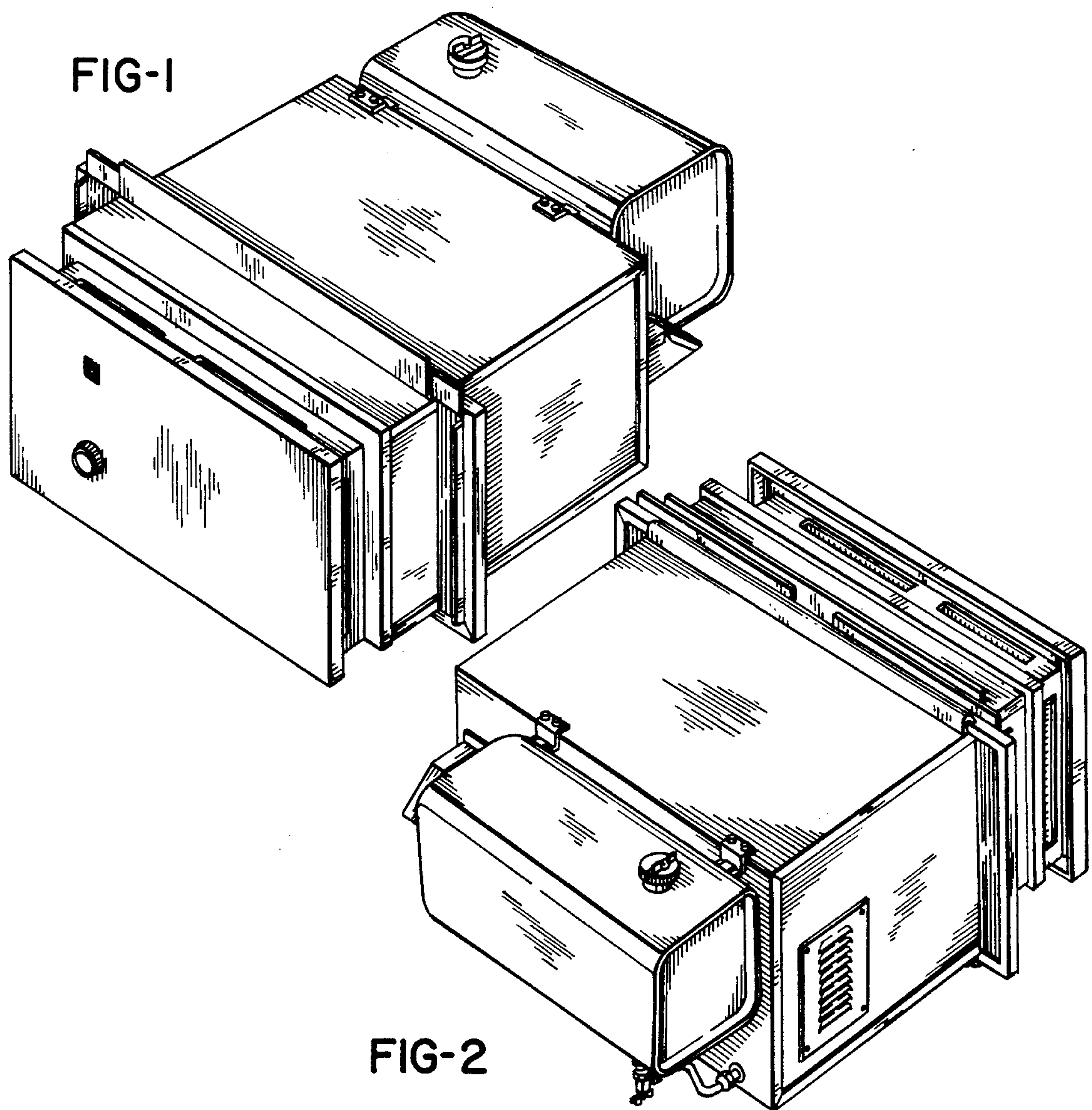

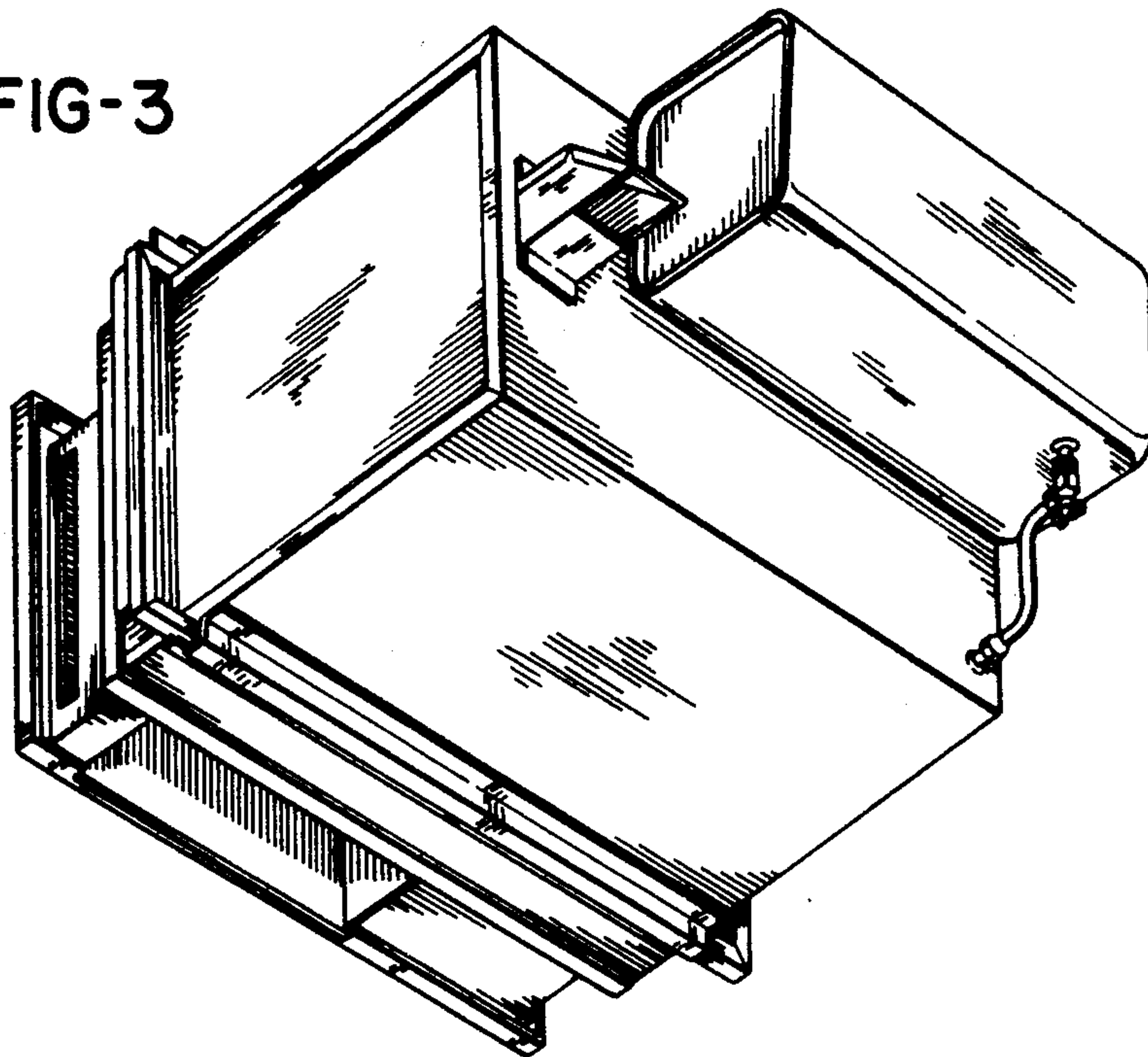

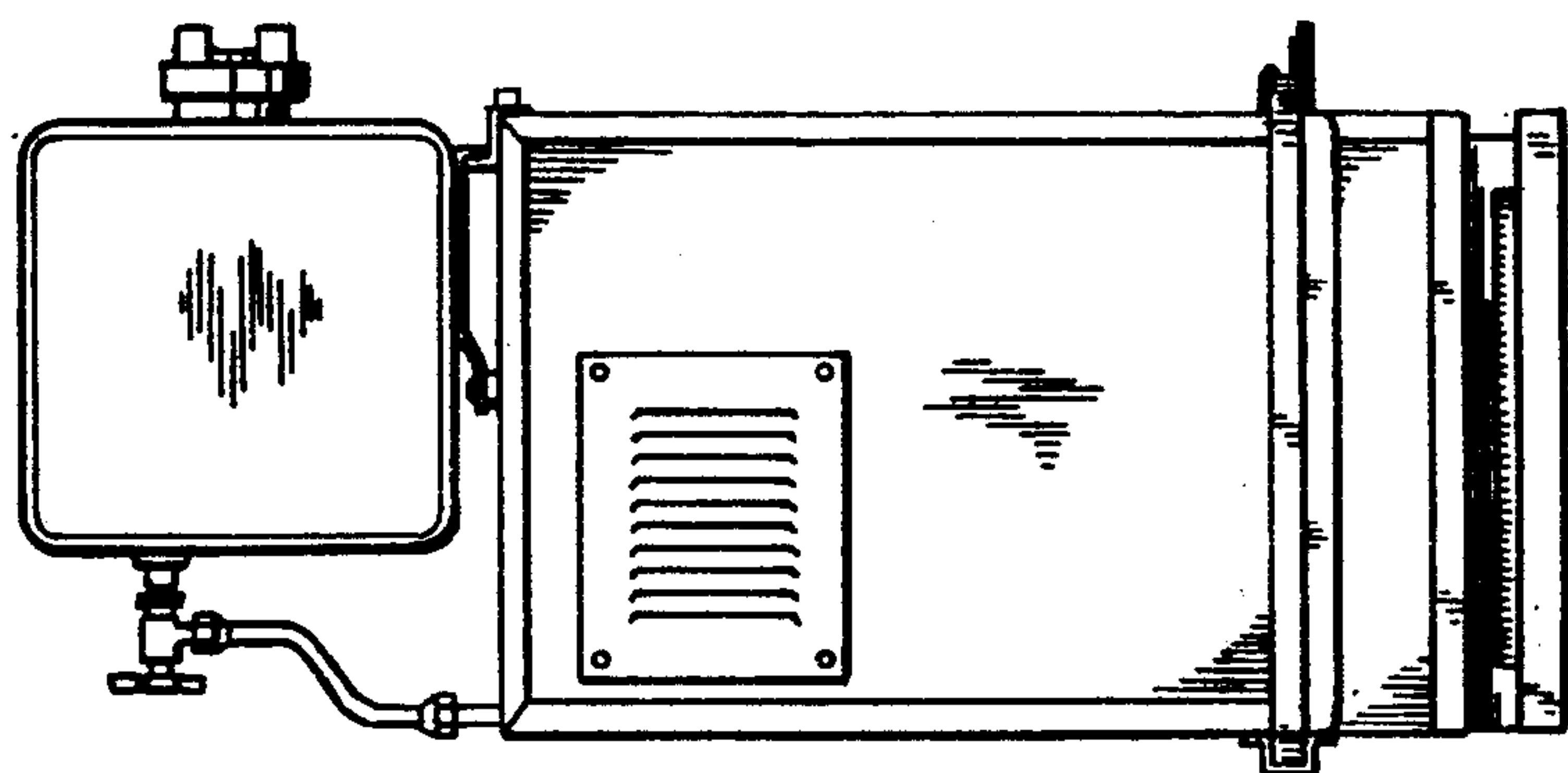

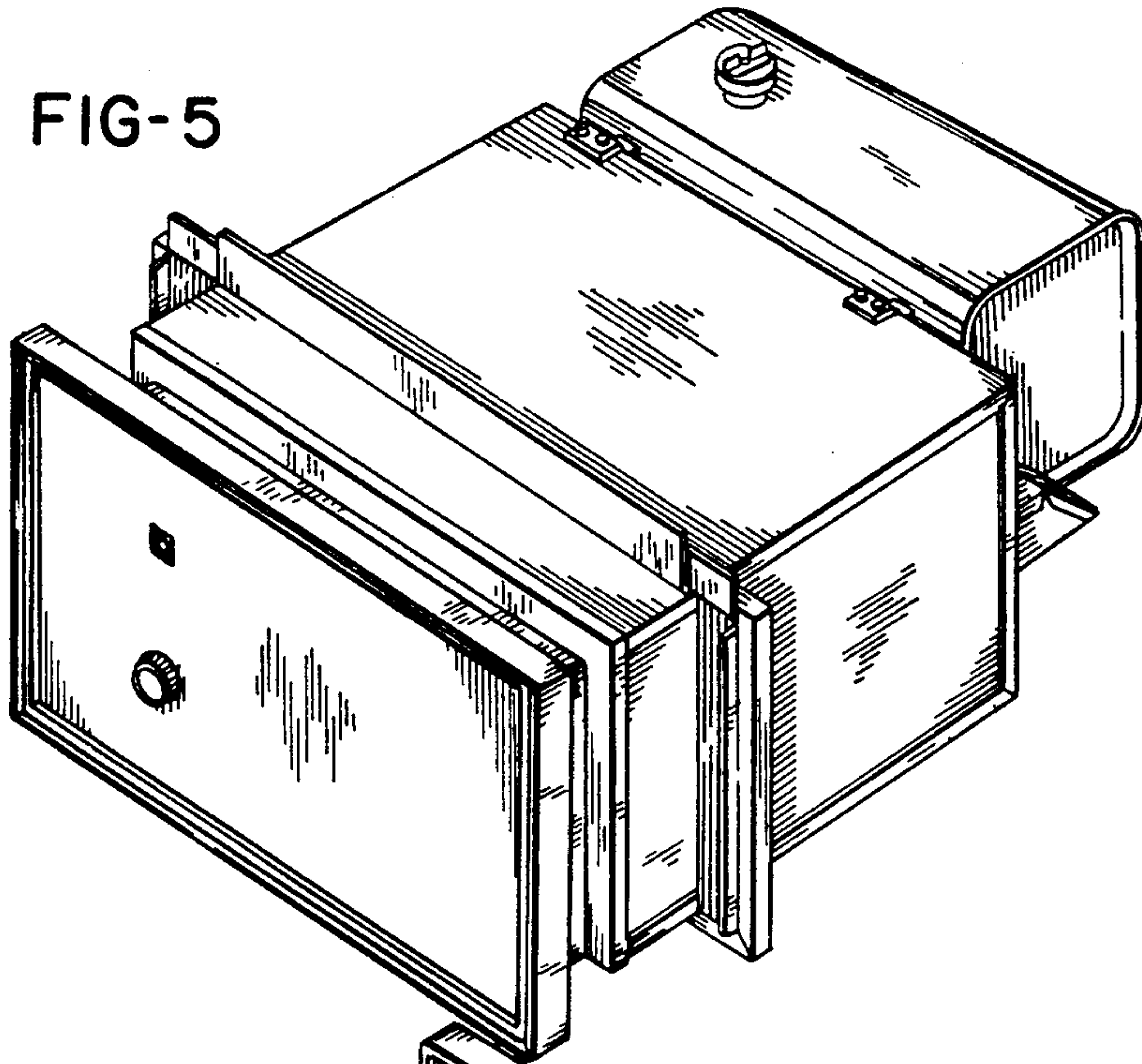

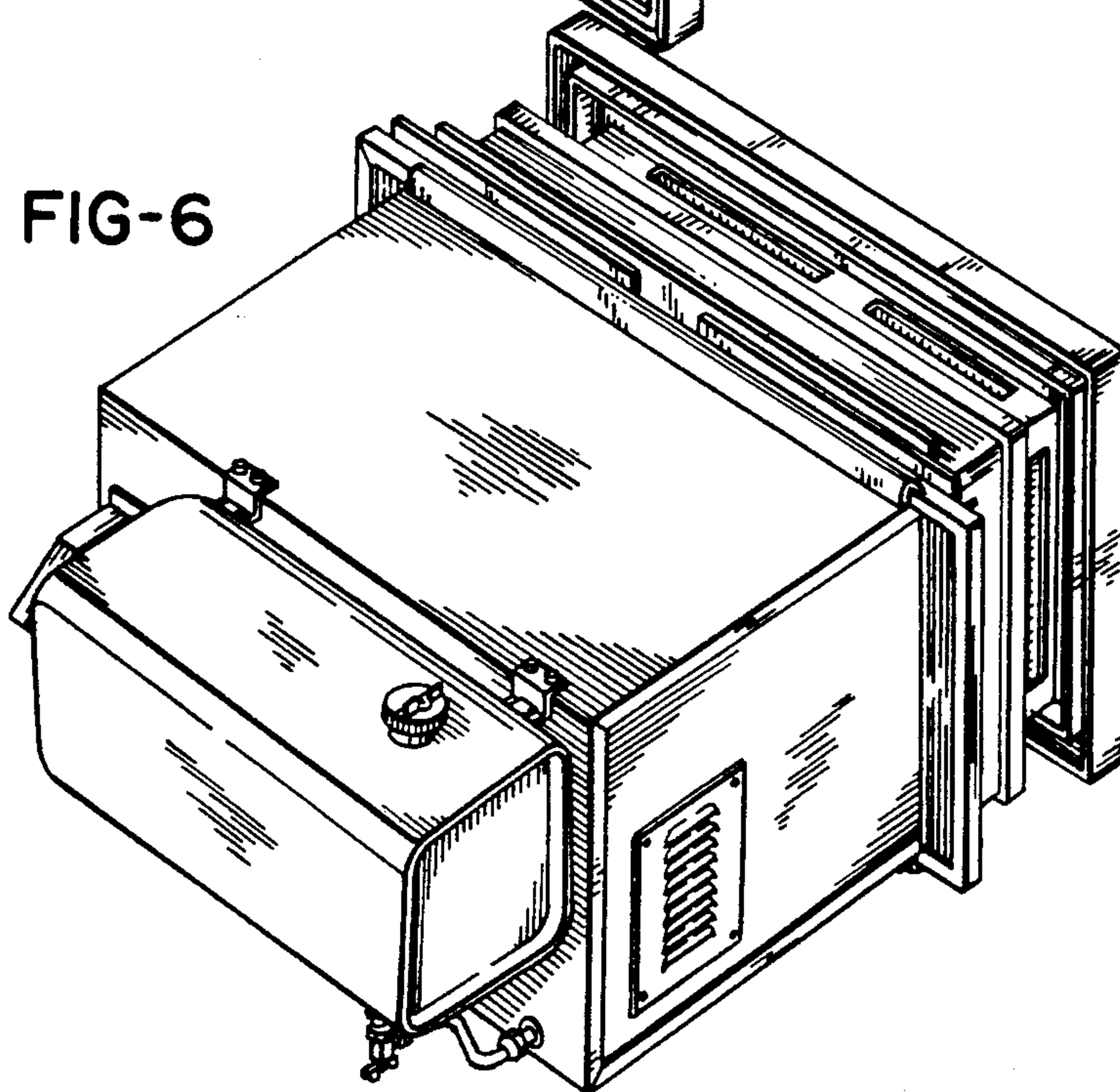

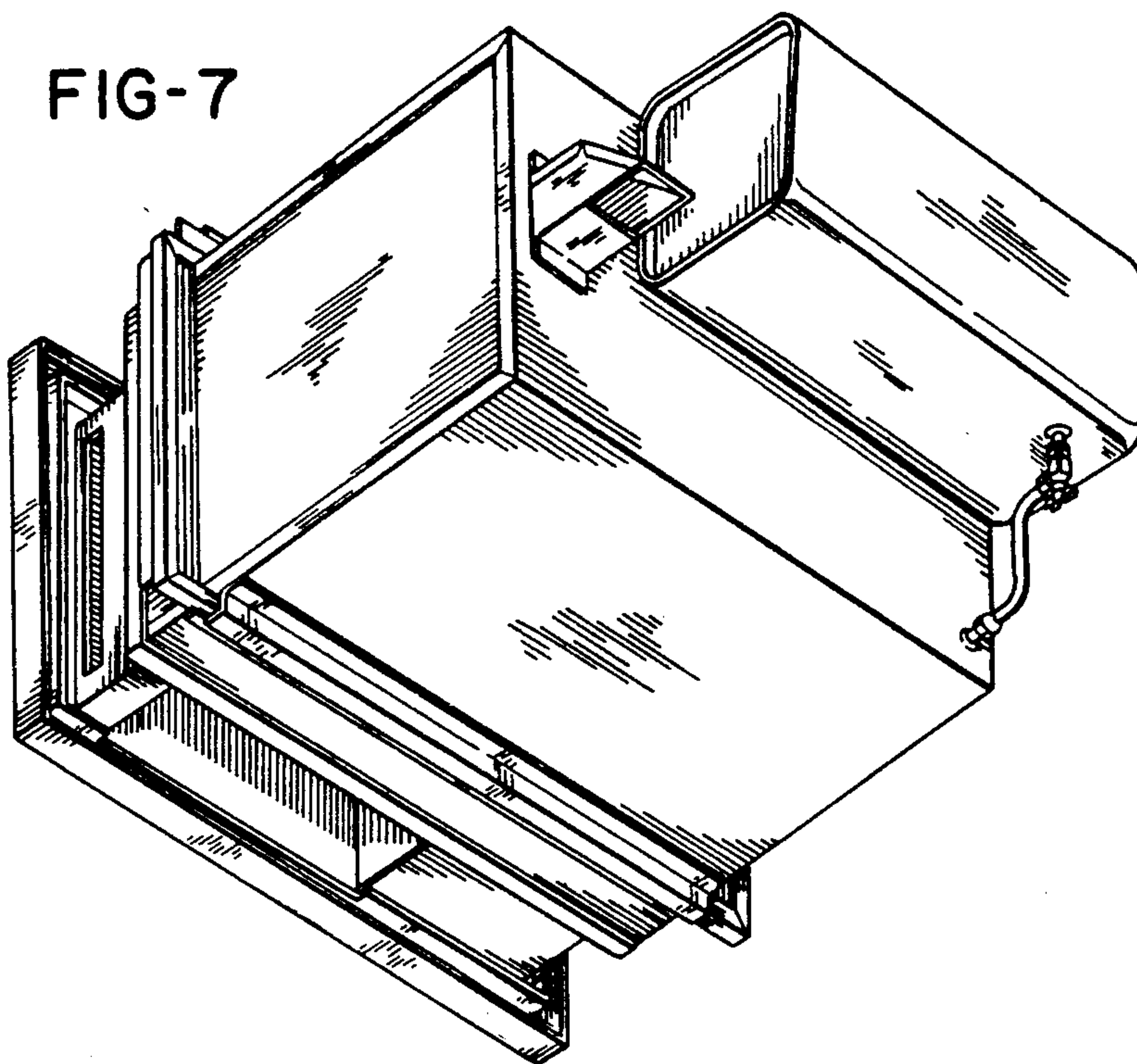
