DESCRIPTION

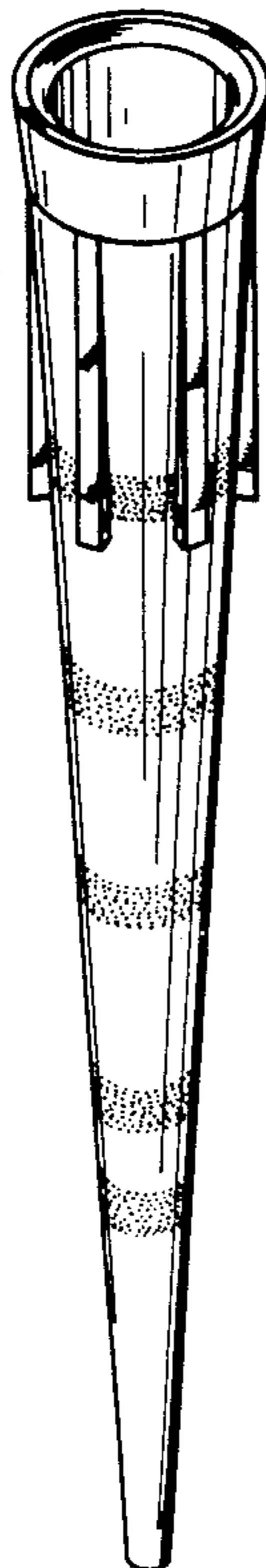
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pipette tip incorporating my design;

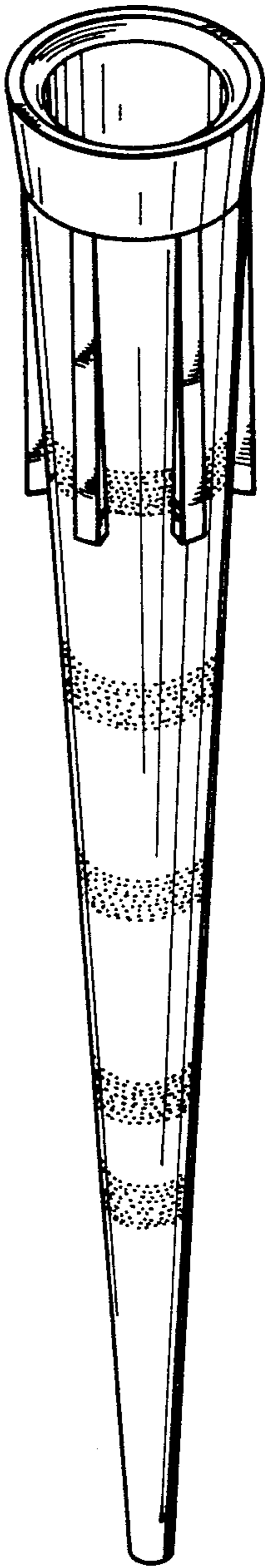
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

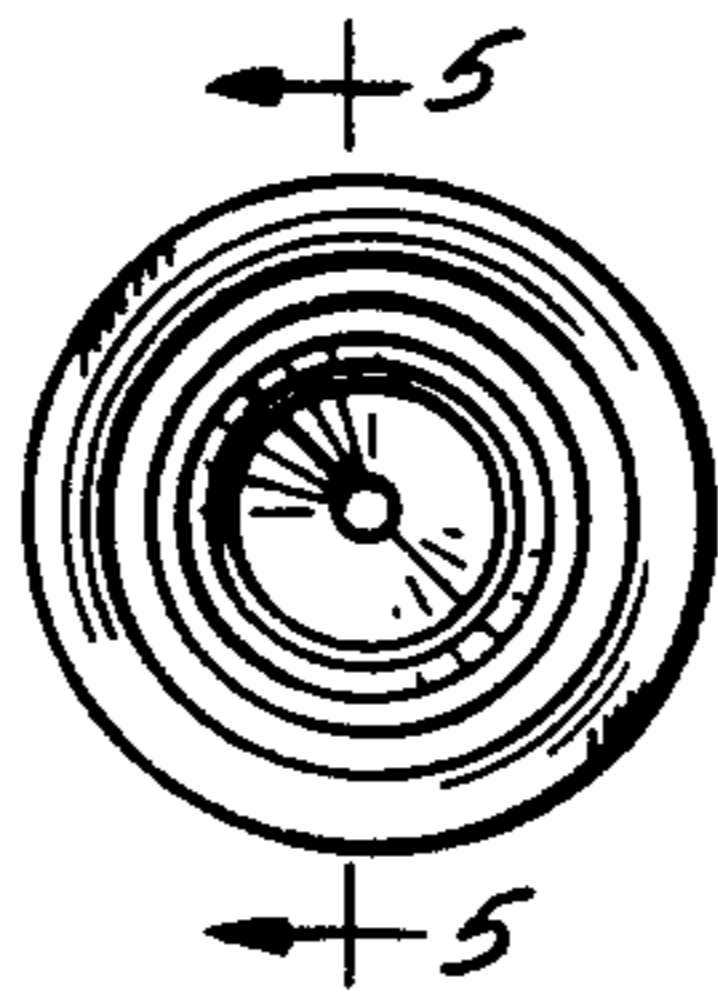
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a cross section taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 2.

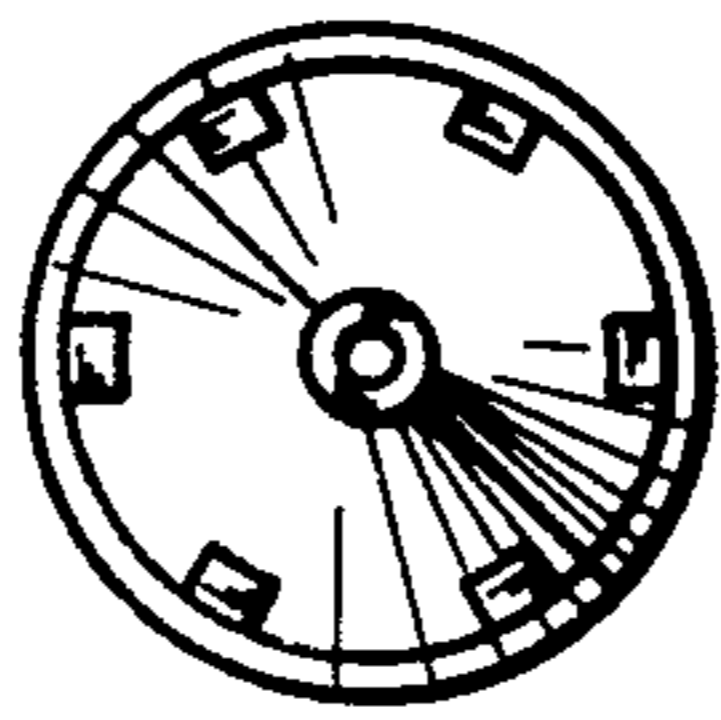




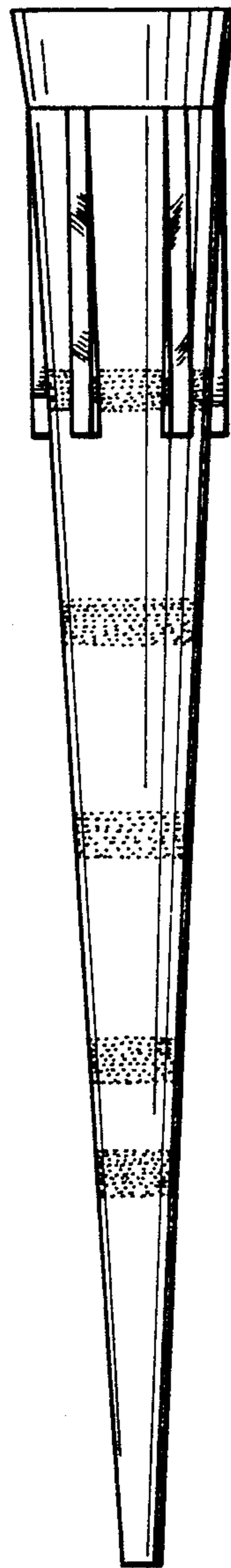

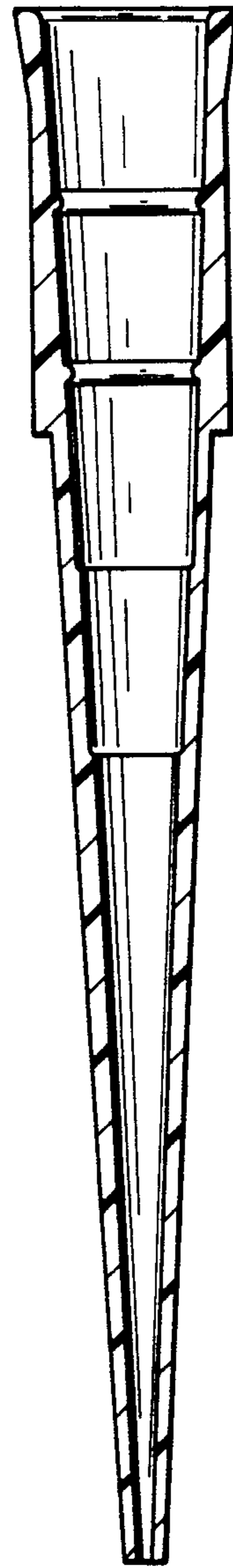
