[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for non-woven sheet material or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The single FIGURE is a plan view of the non-woven sheet material or the like showing our new design, the design unit being shown within the broken lines, which unit is repeated in regular succession as is indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.
