DESCRIPTION

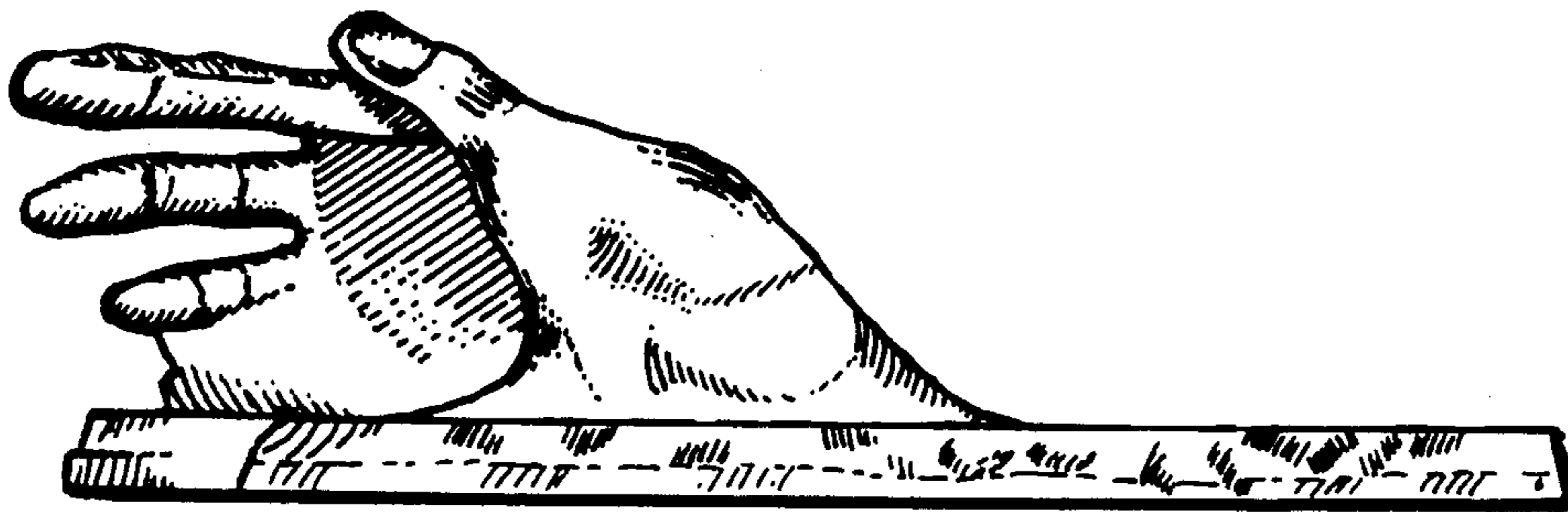
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a boot remover showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



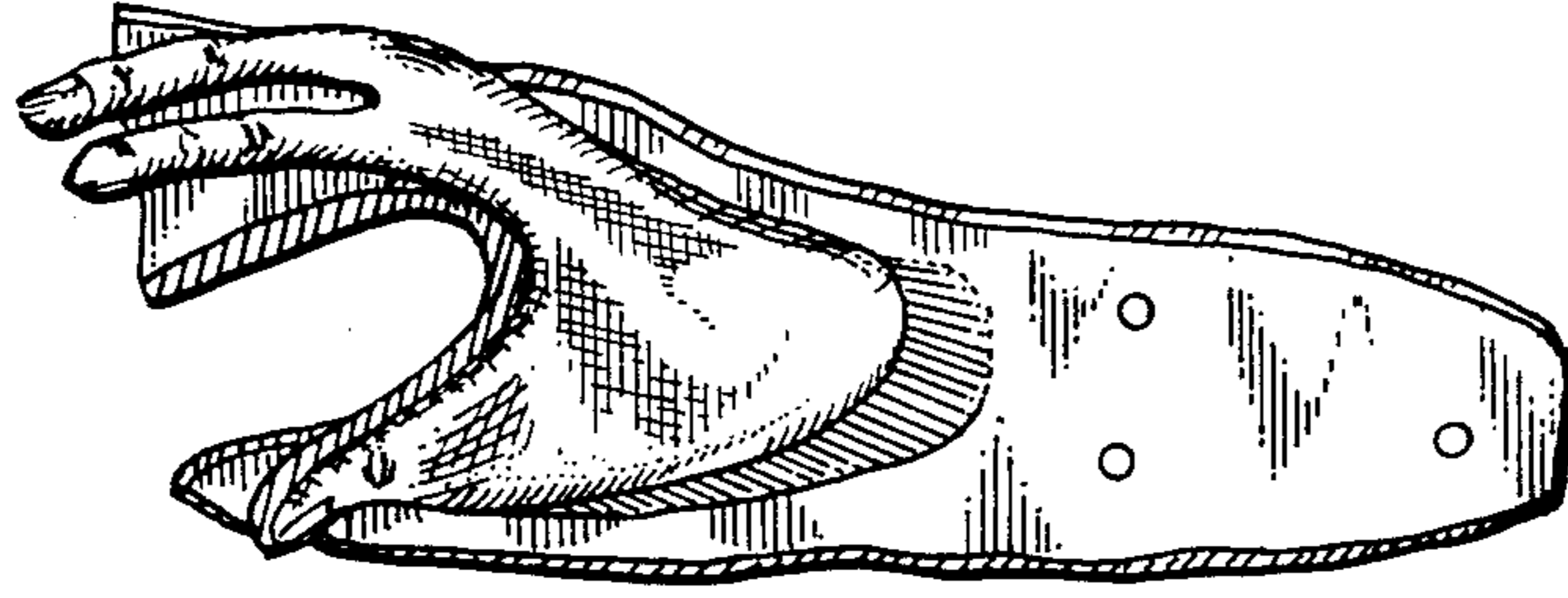

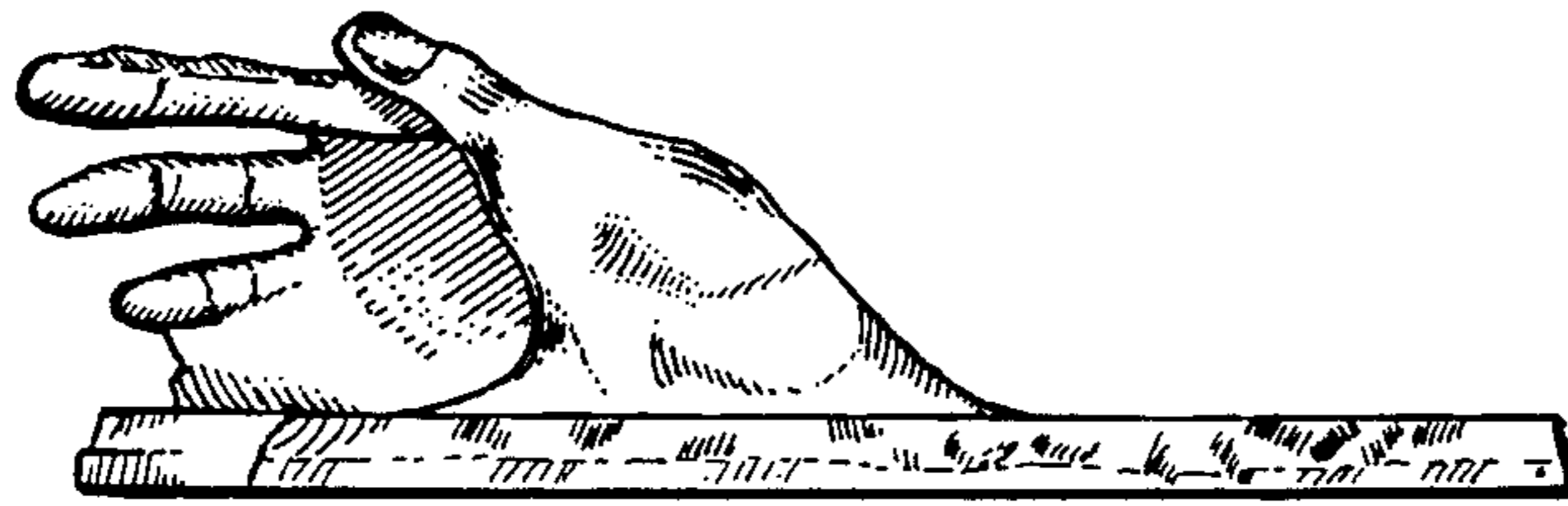

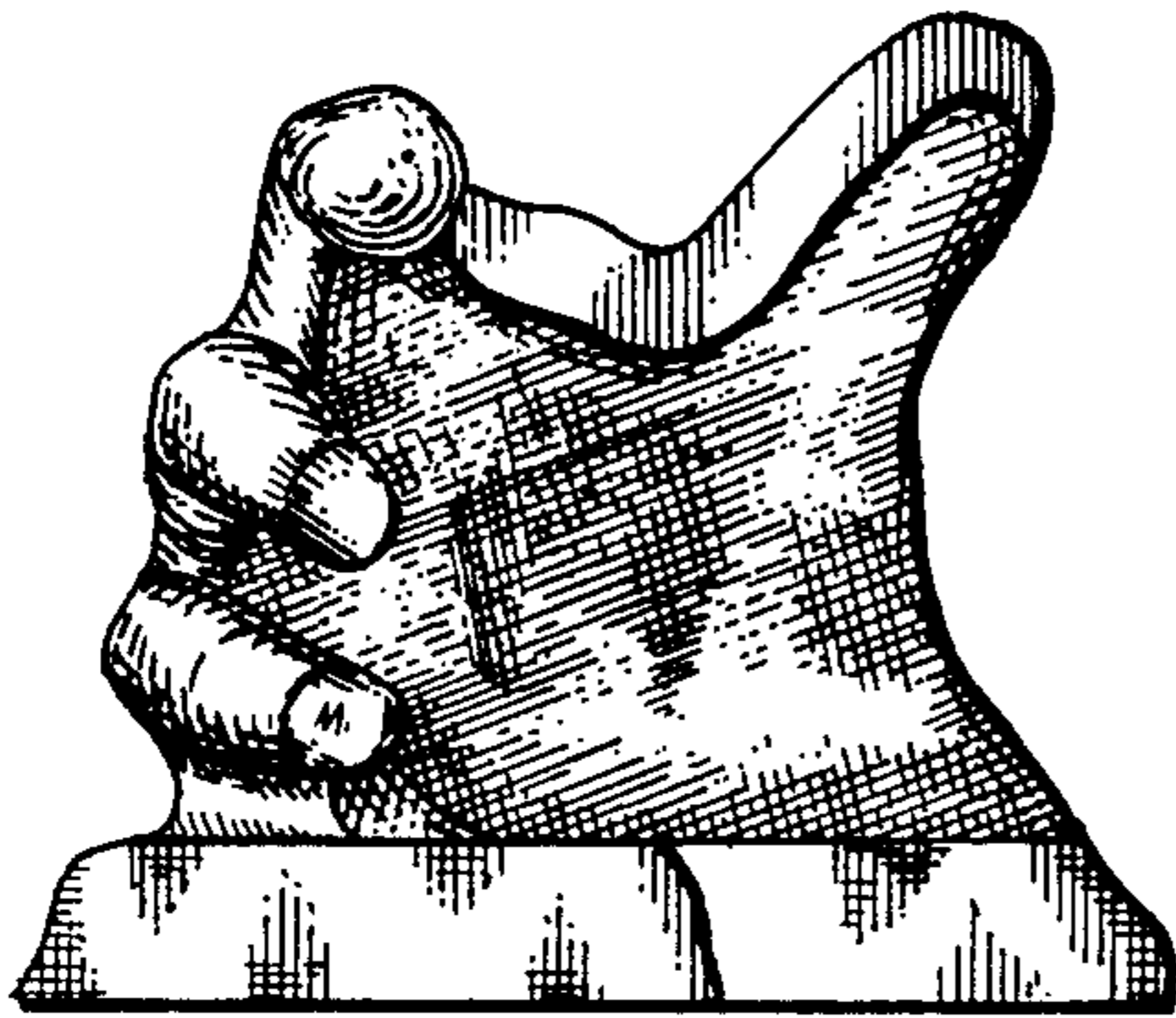

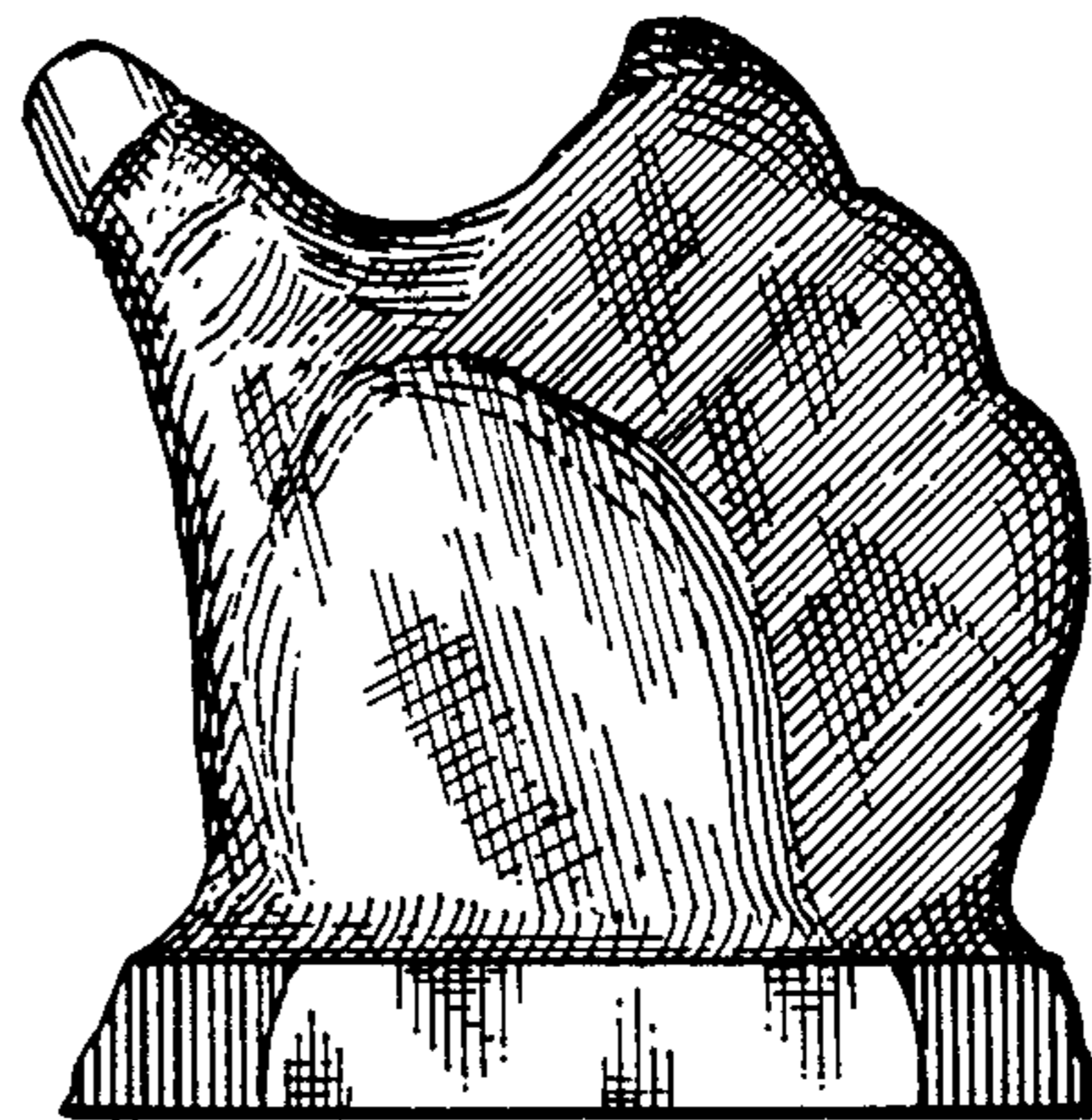

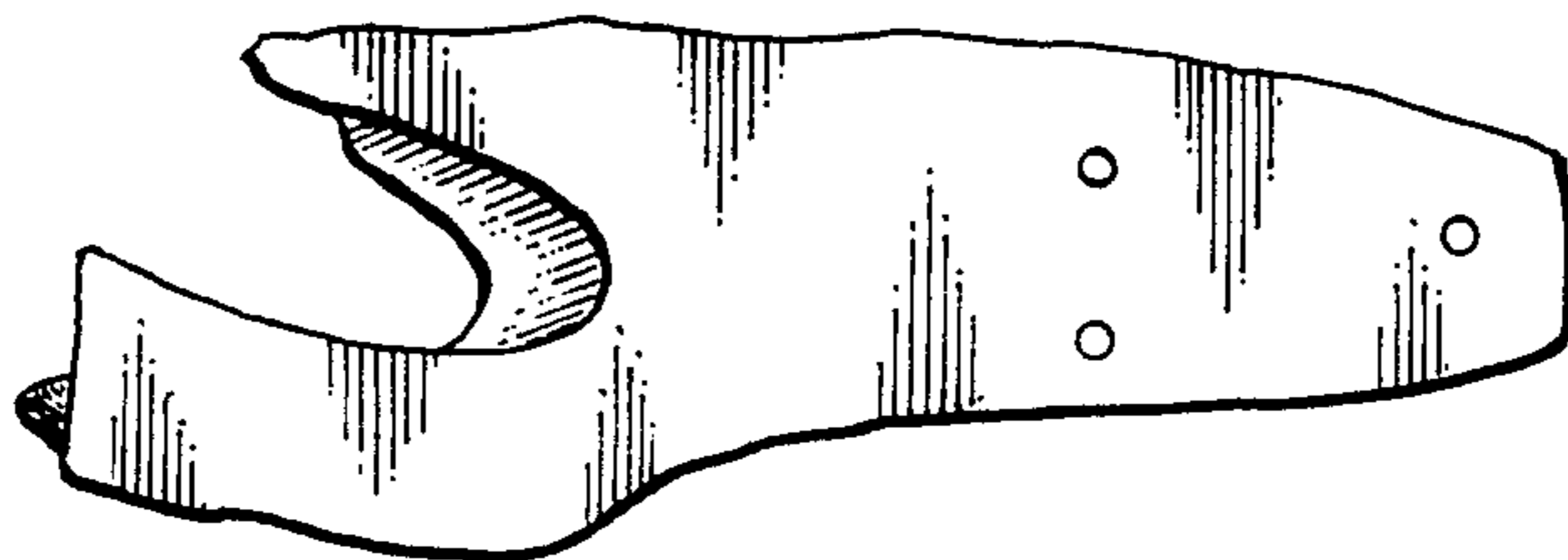
