[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined display and self-service merchandising cabinet for food products, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a combined display and self-service merchandising cabinet for food products showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

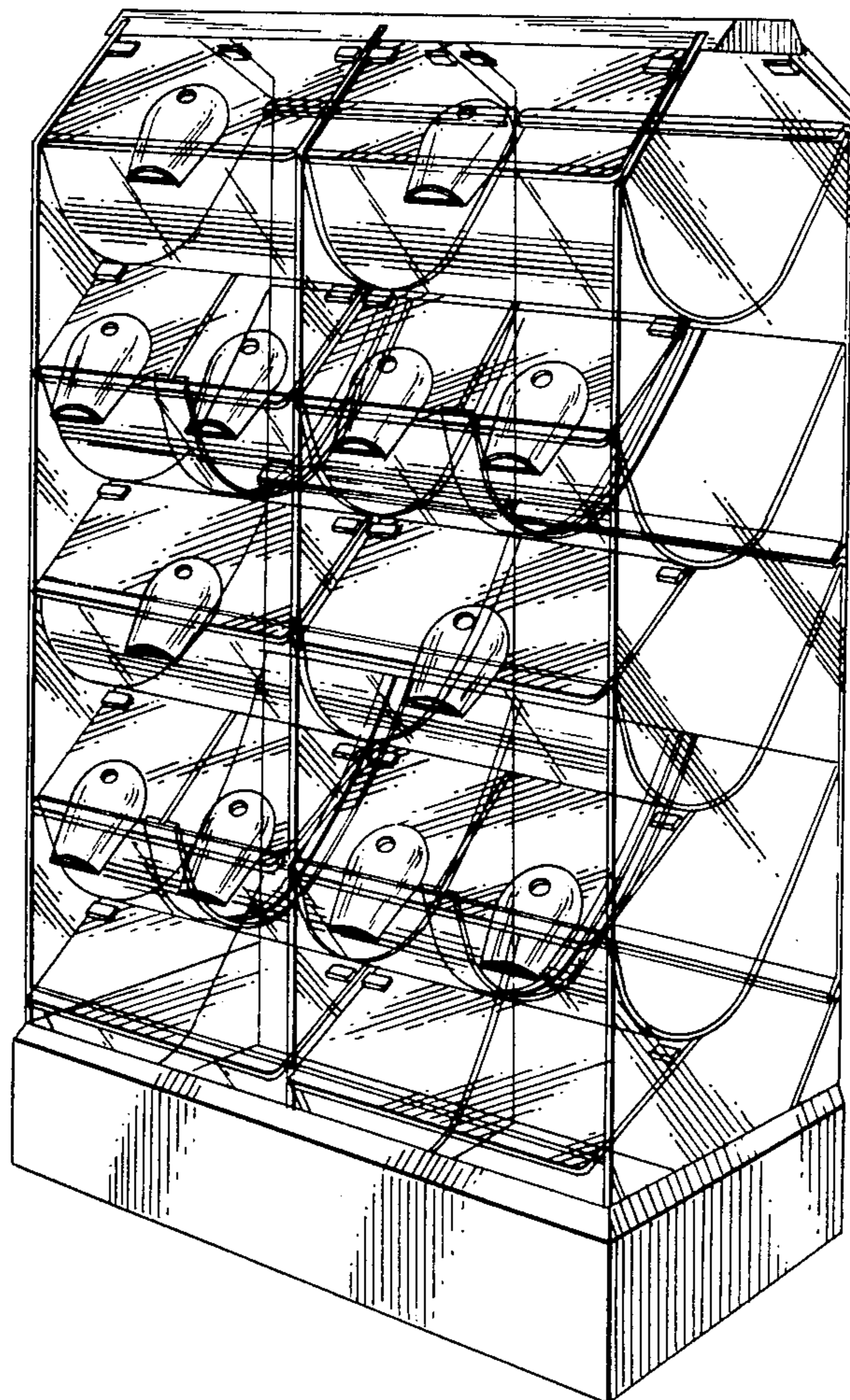

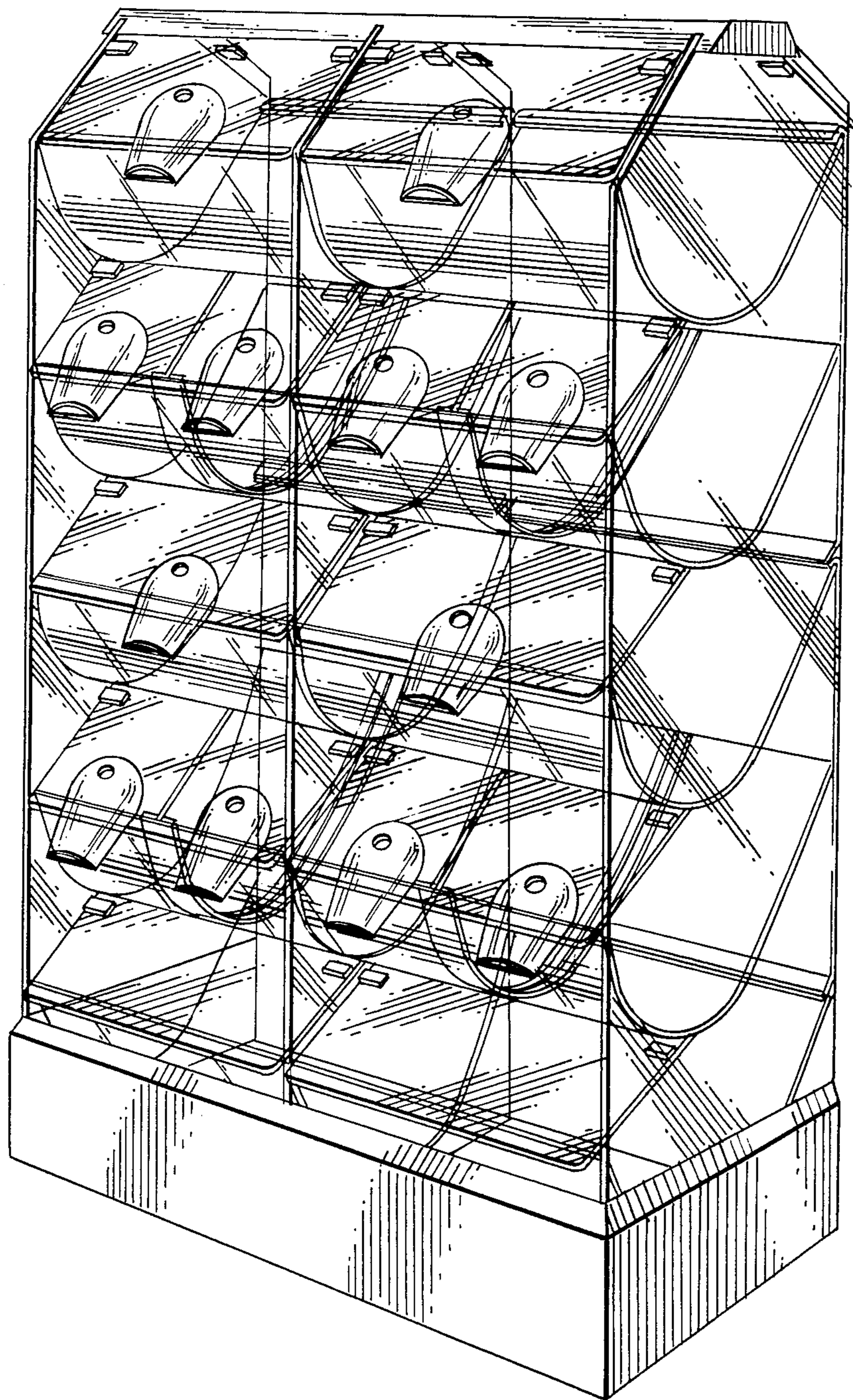

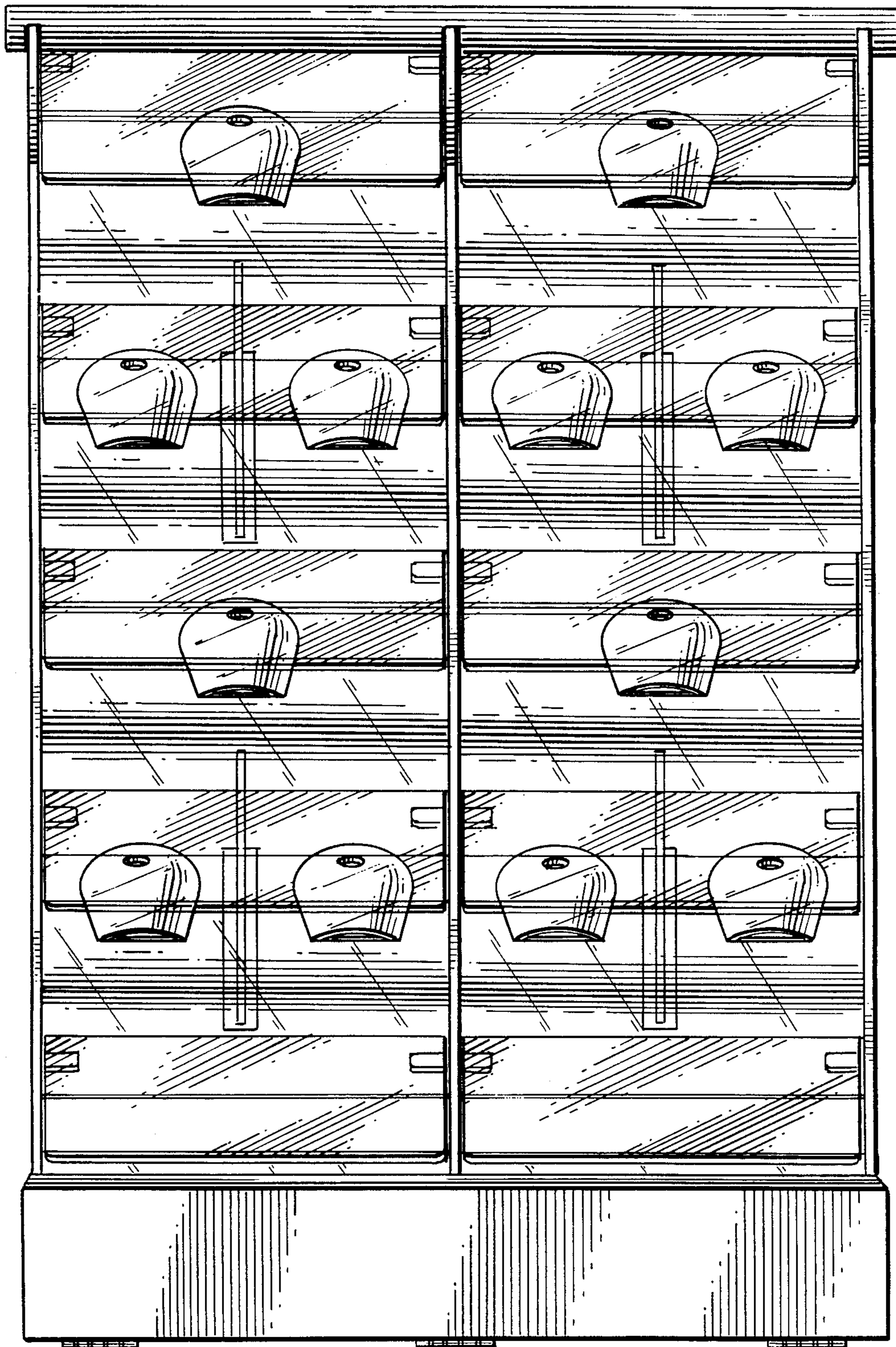

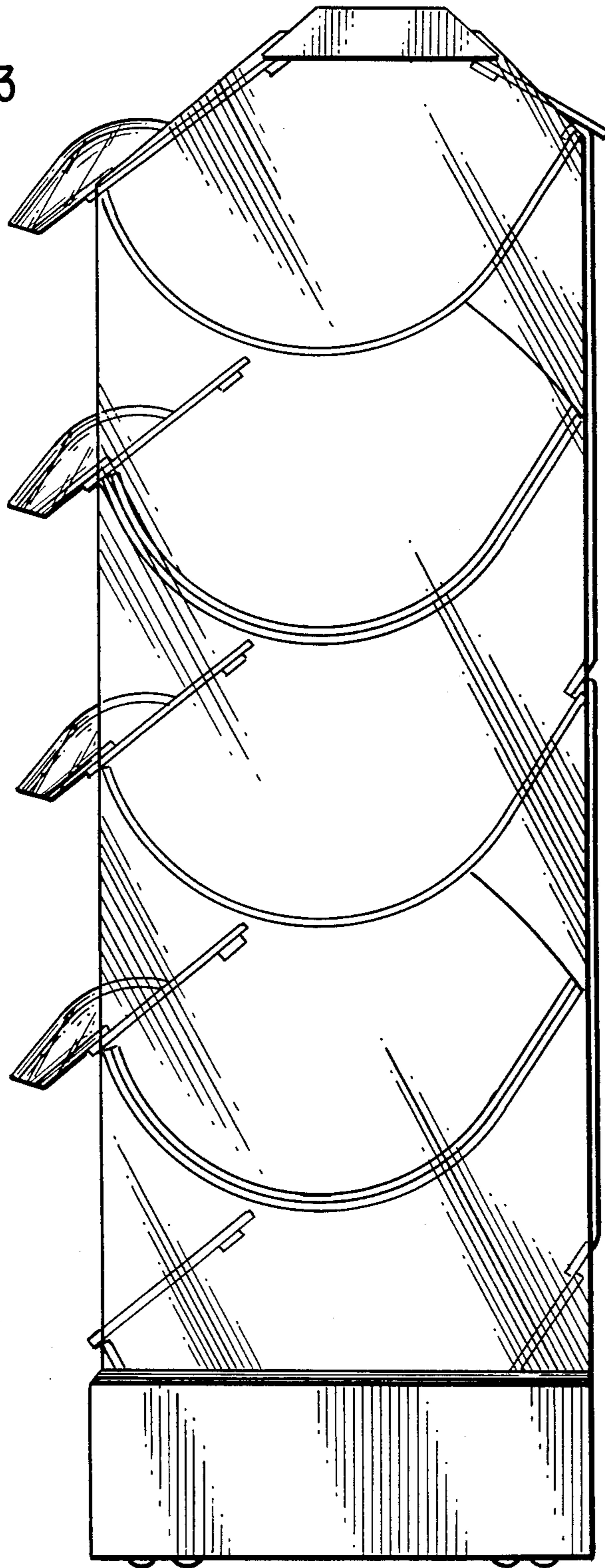

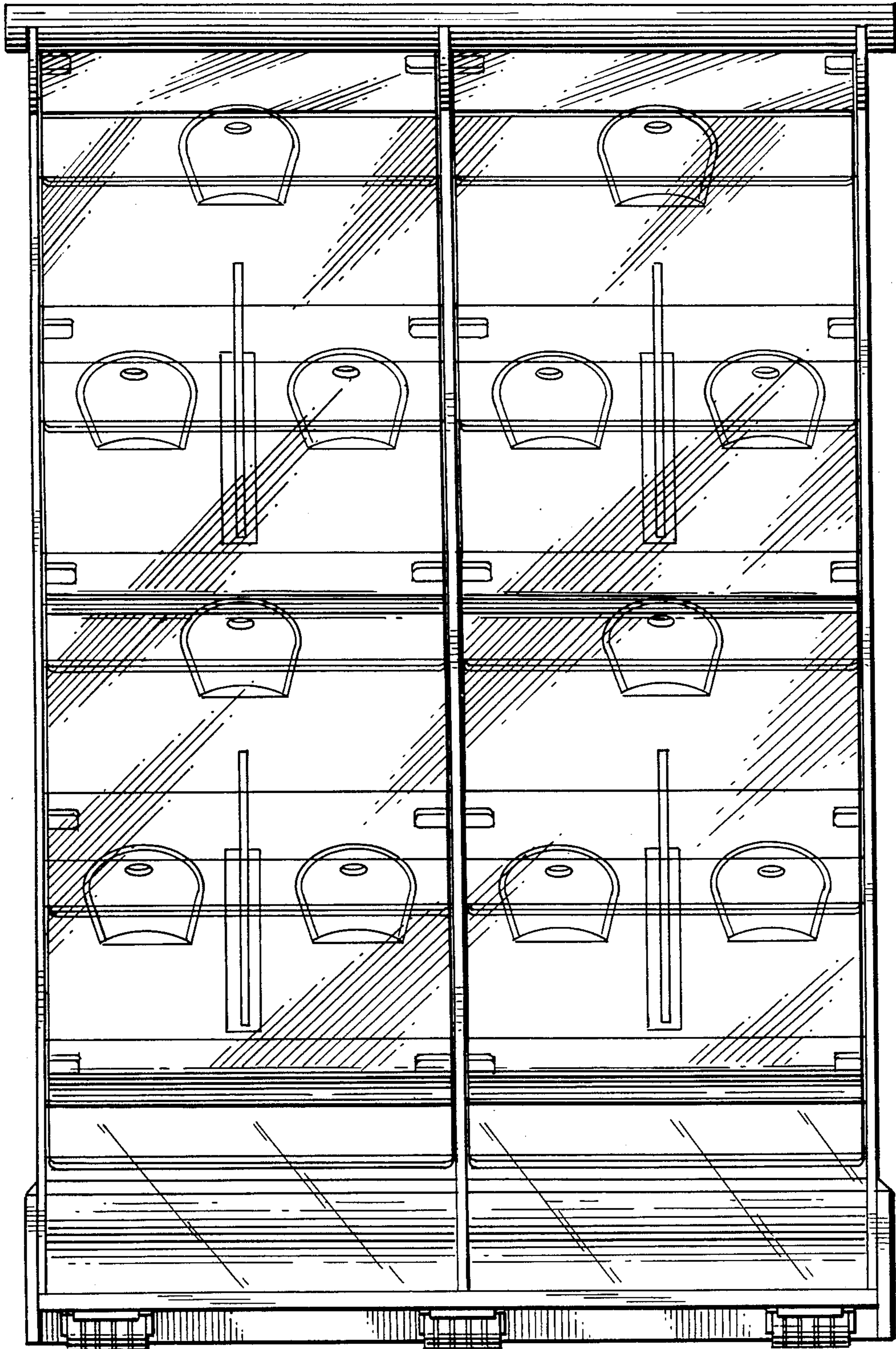
