[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container for a toiletry stick, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a container for a toiletry stick embodying my new design, the side opposite this view having the same configuration;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 4 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1, the side opposite this view having the same configuration; and
 FIG. 5 is an exploded perspective view with the cap removed.
