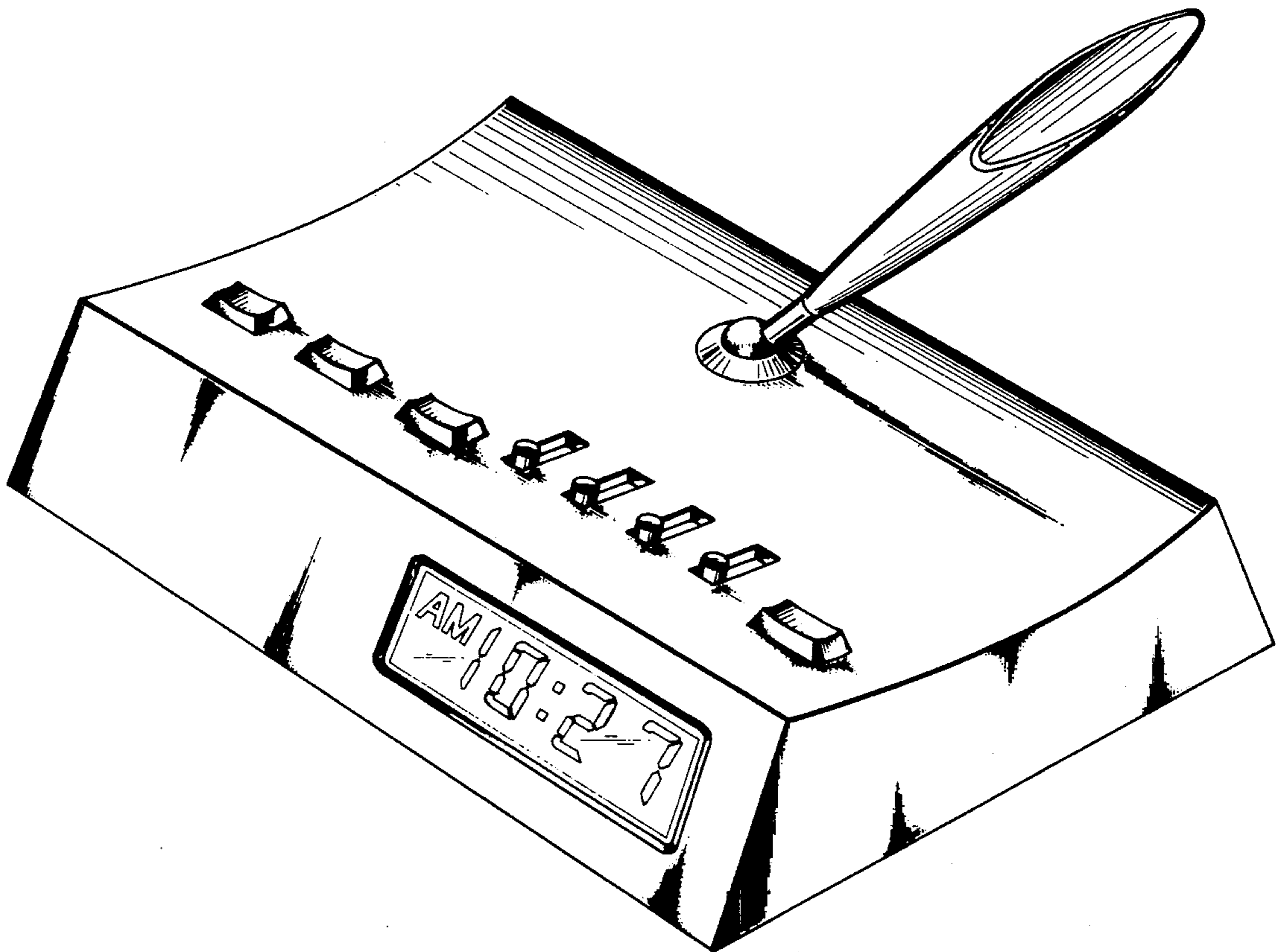

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined pen holder and clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined pen holder and clock showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view. The time indicia shown in the display window in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3 is representative only.



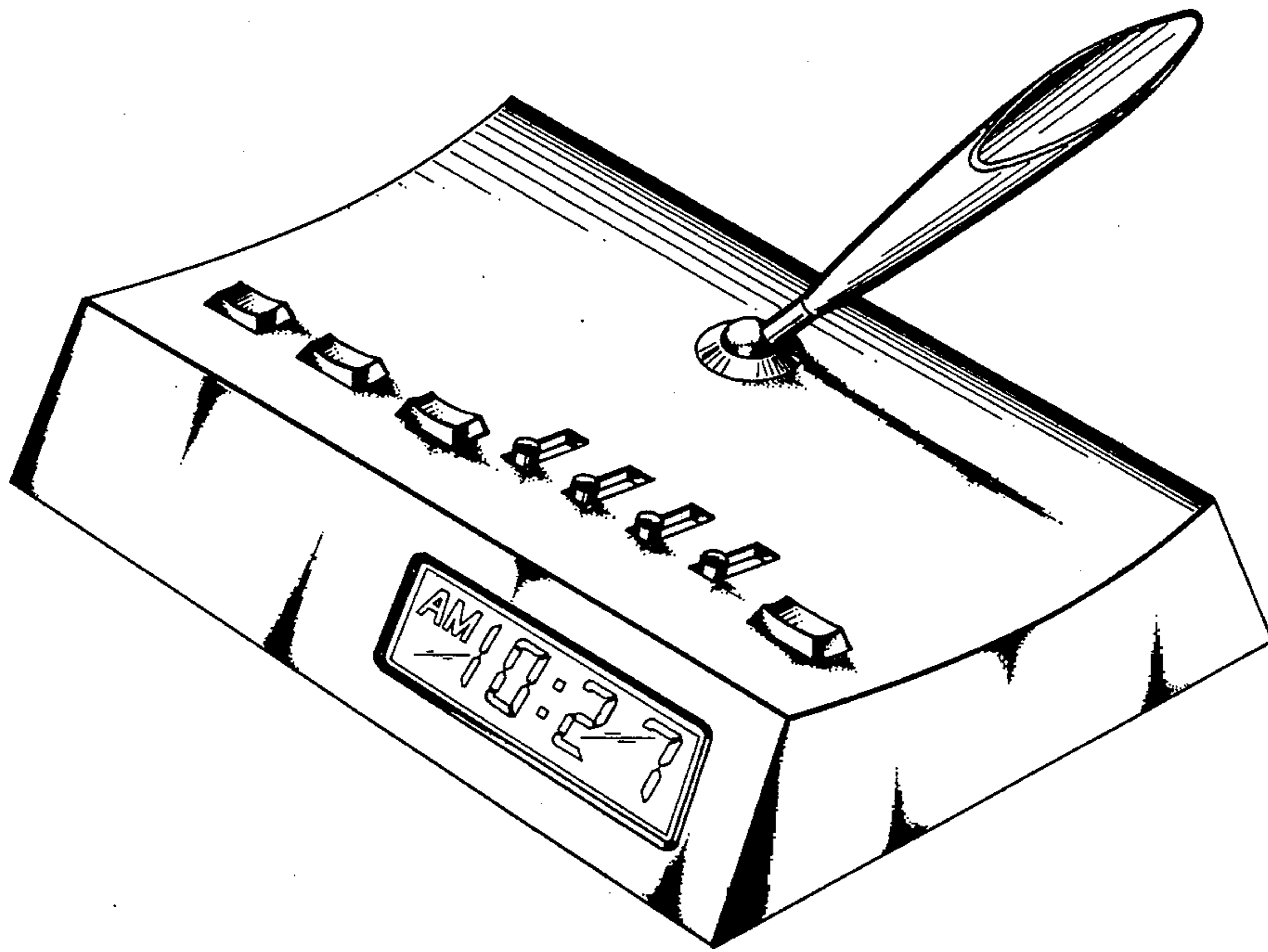

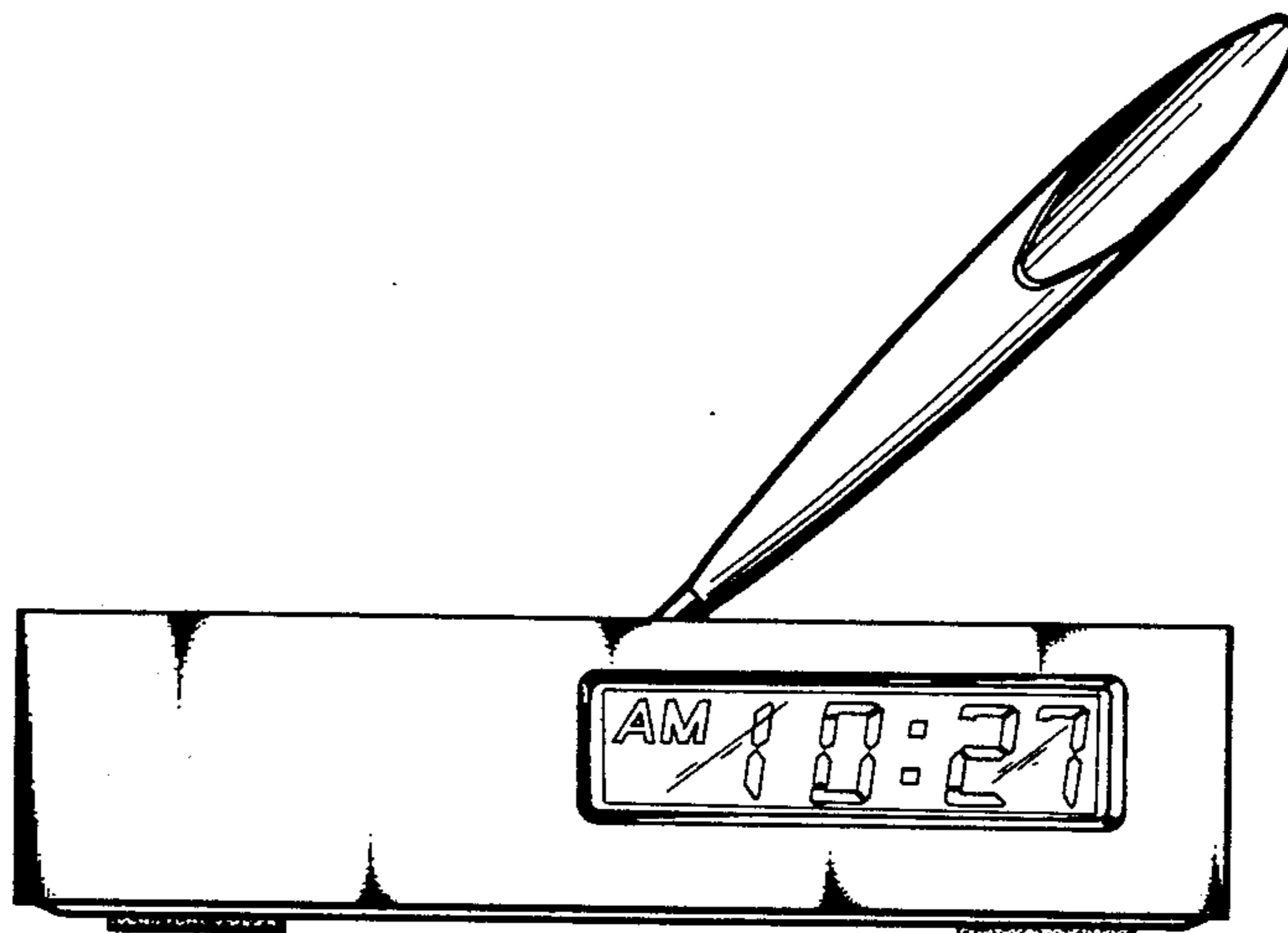

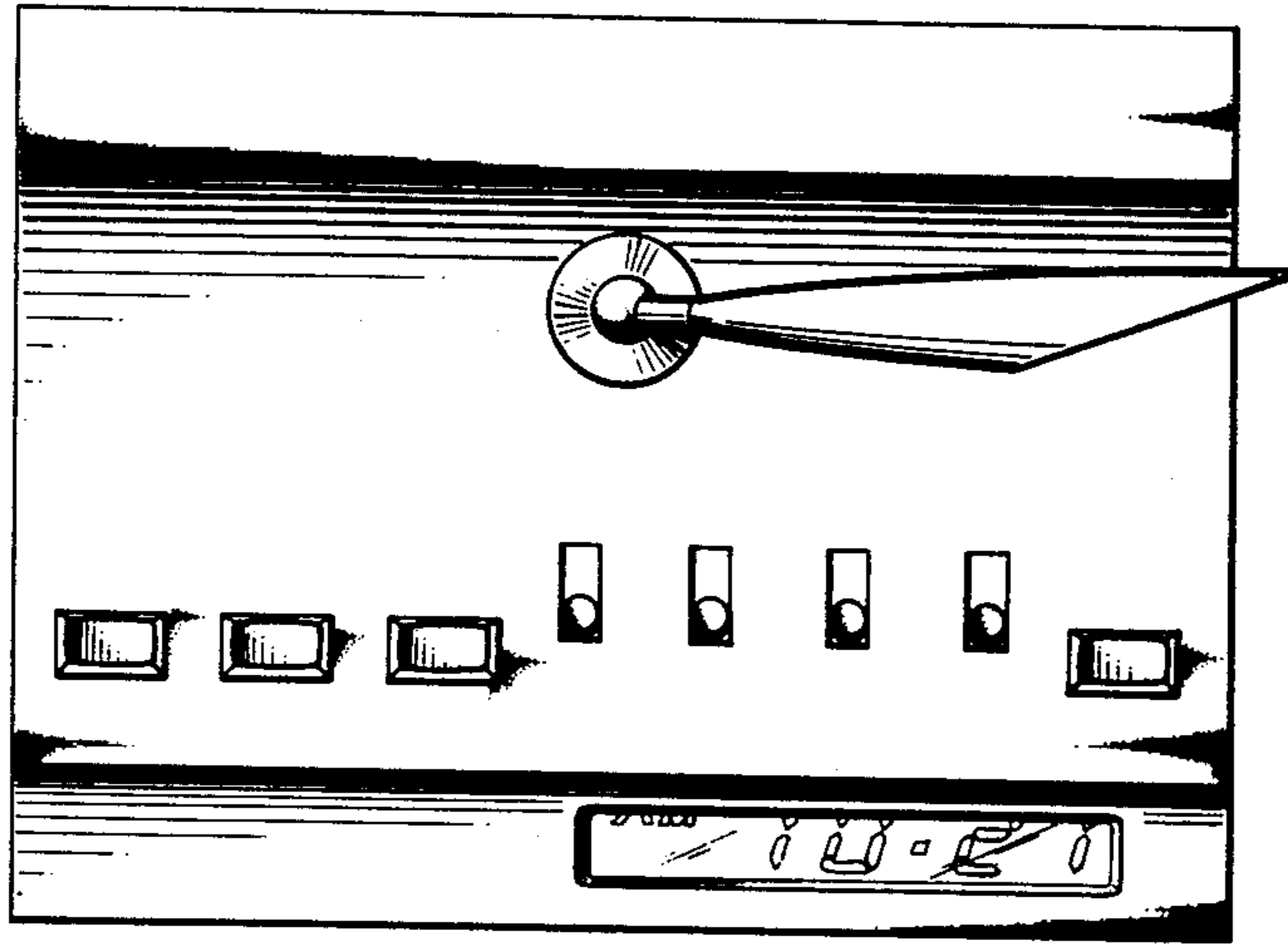

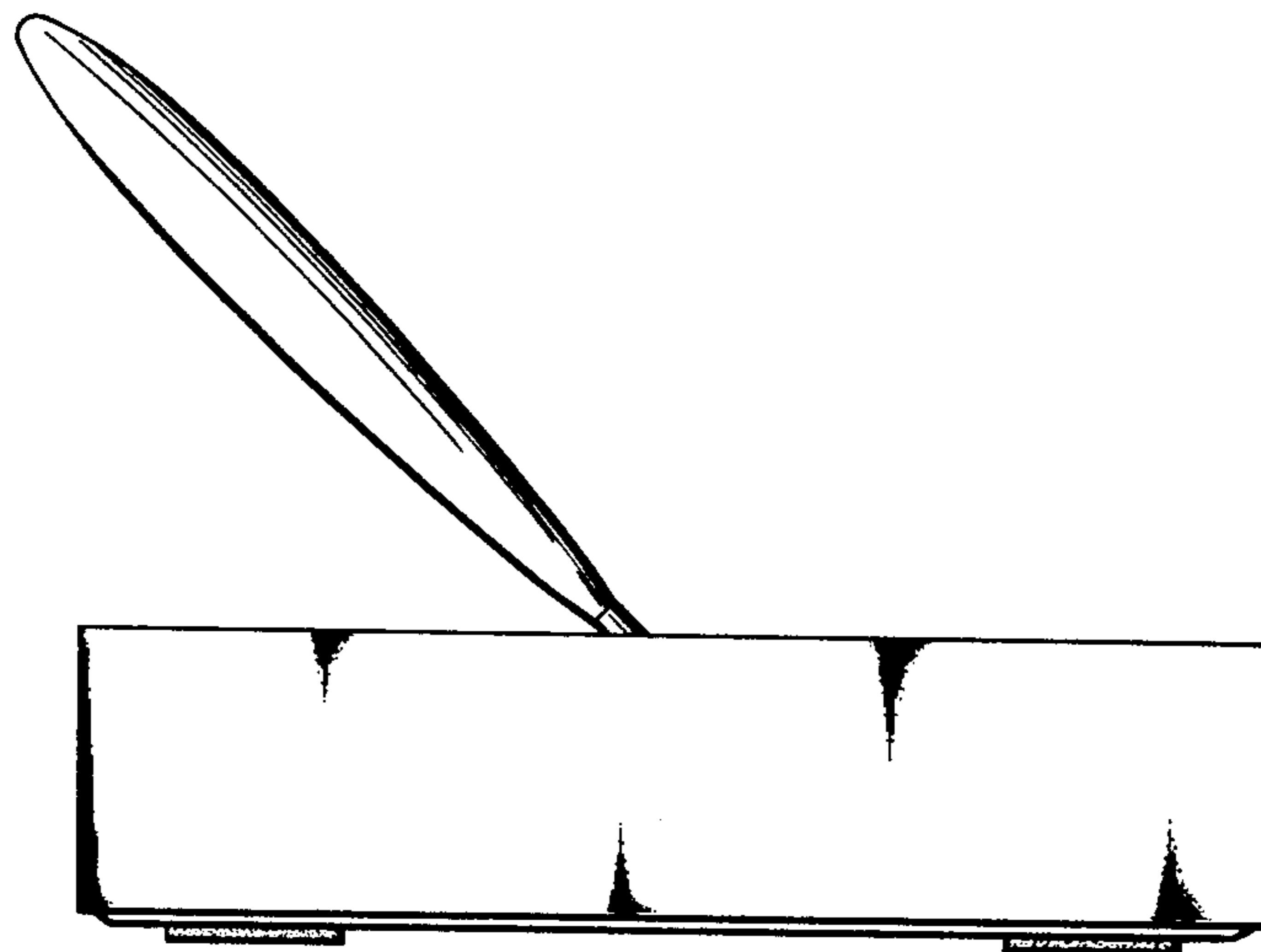

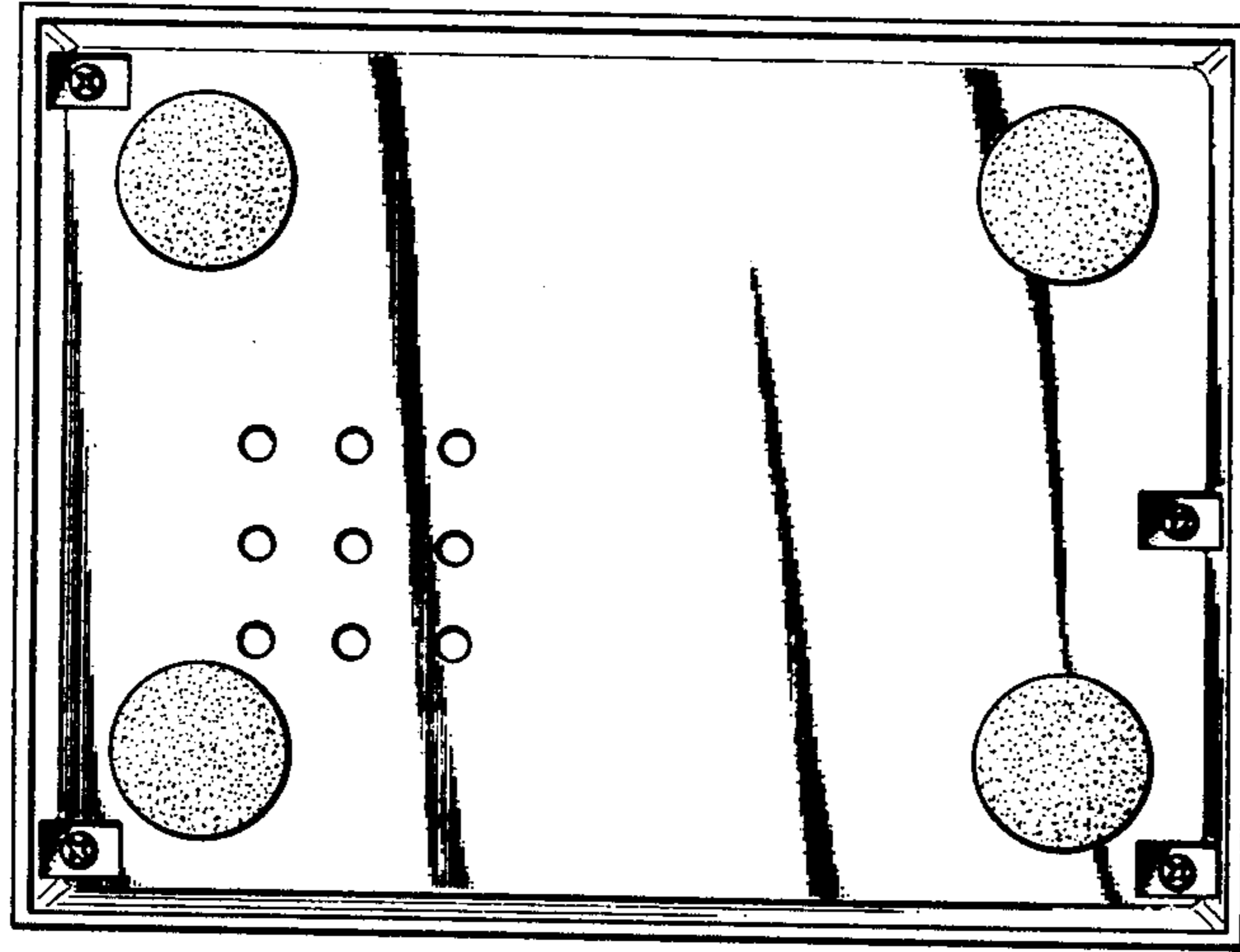

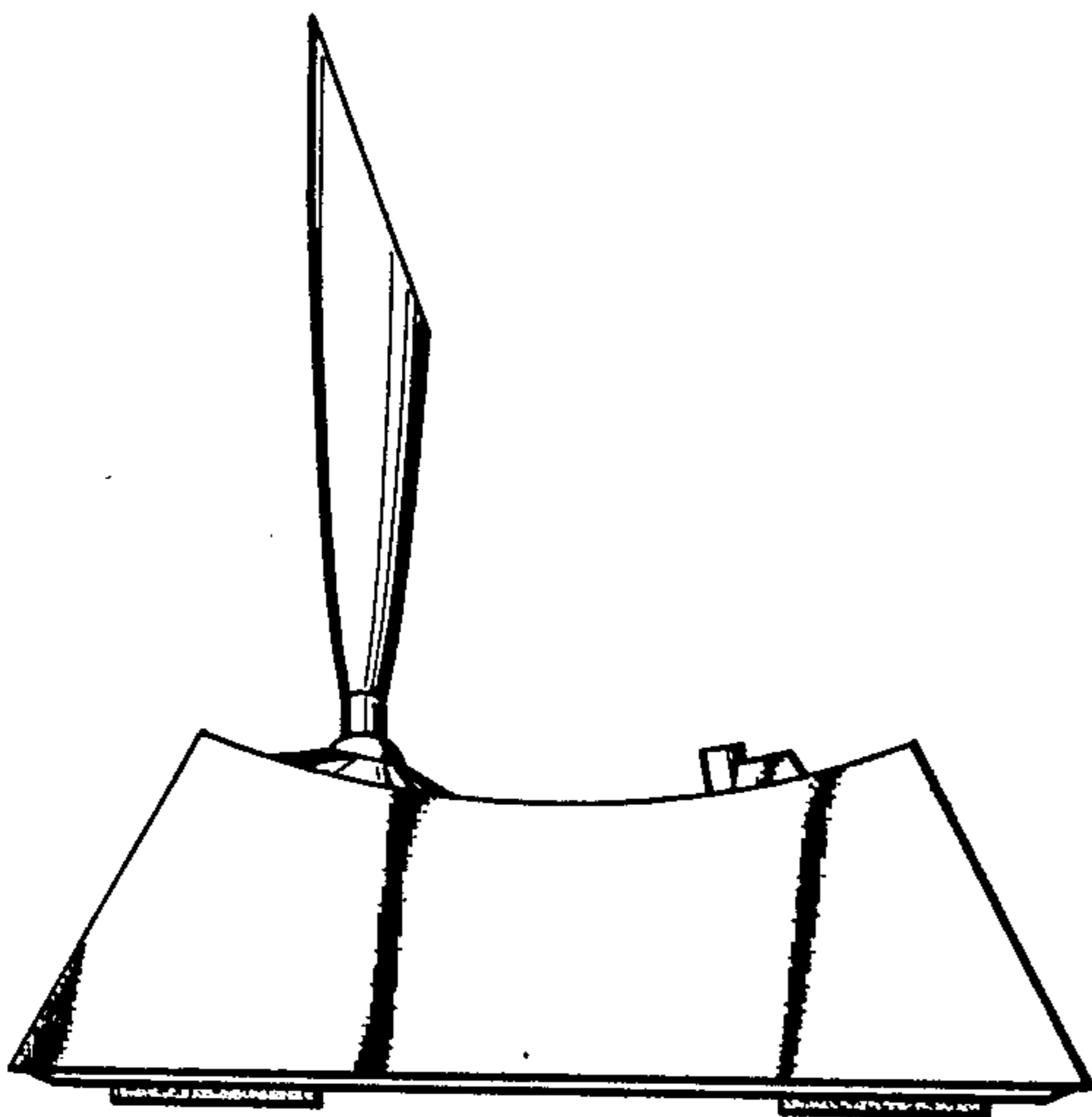

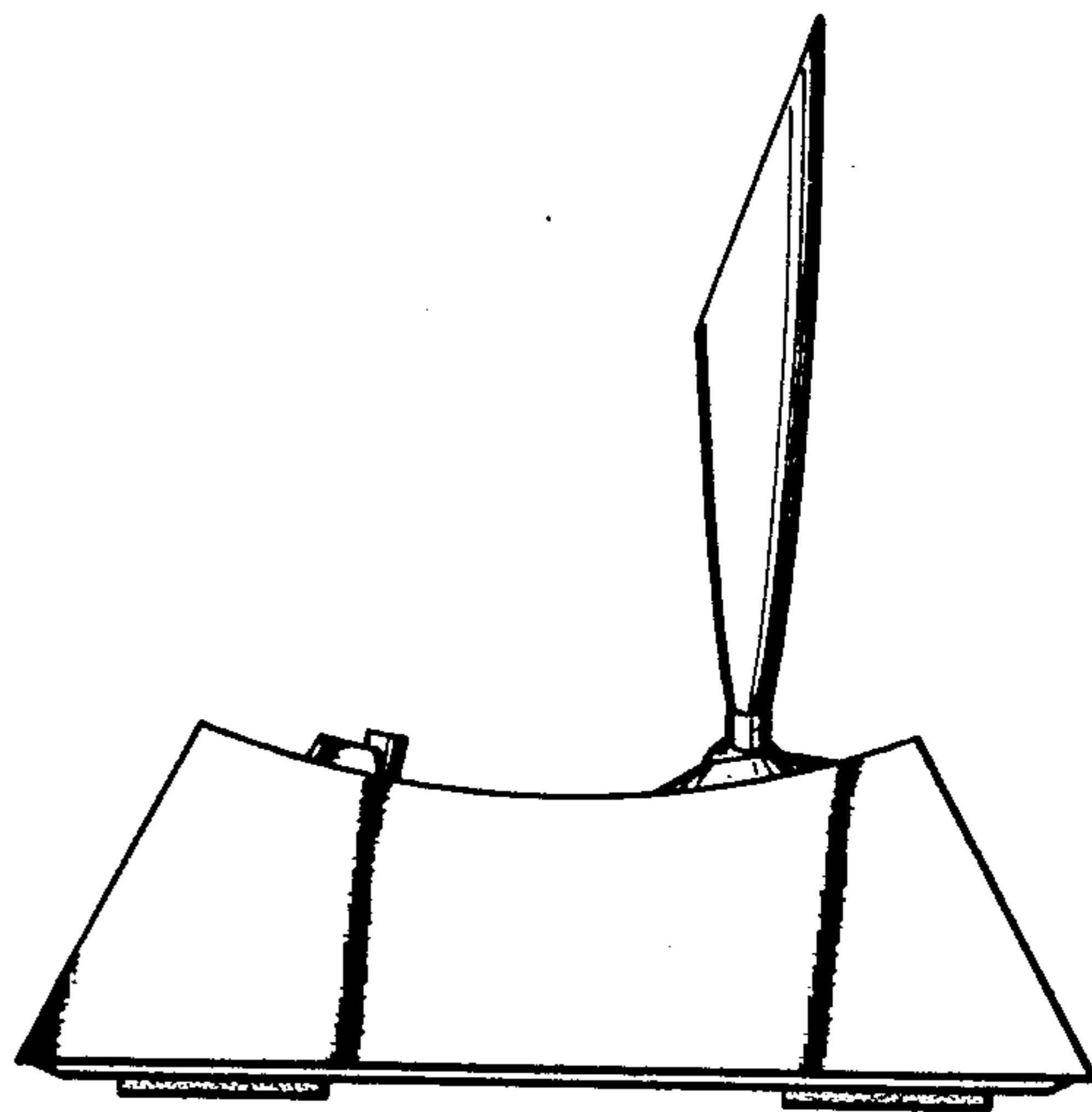
