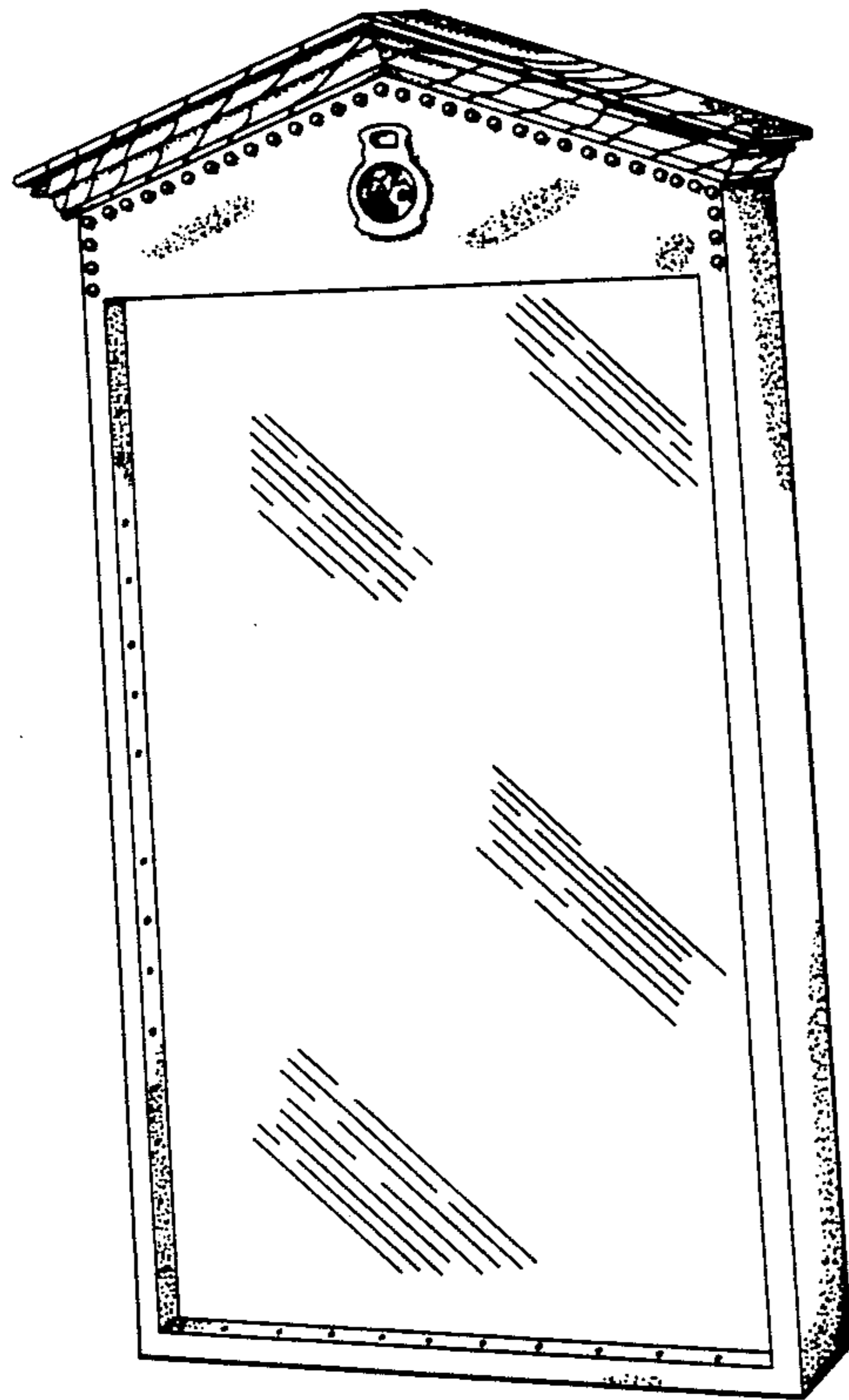
FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken through lines 2-2 of FIG. 1 thereof;

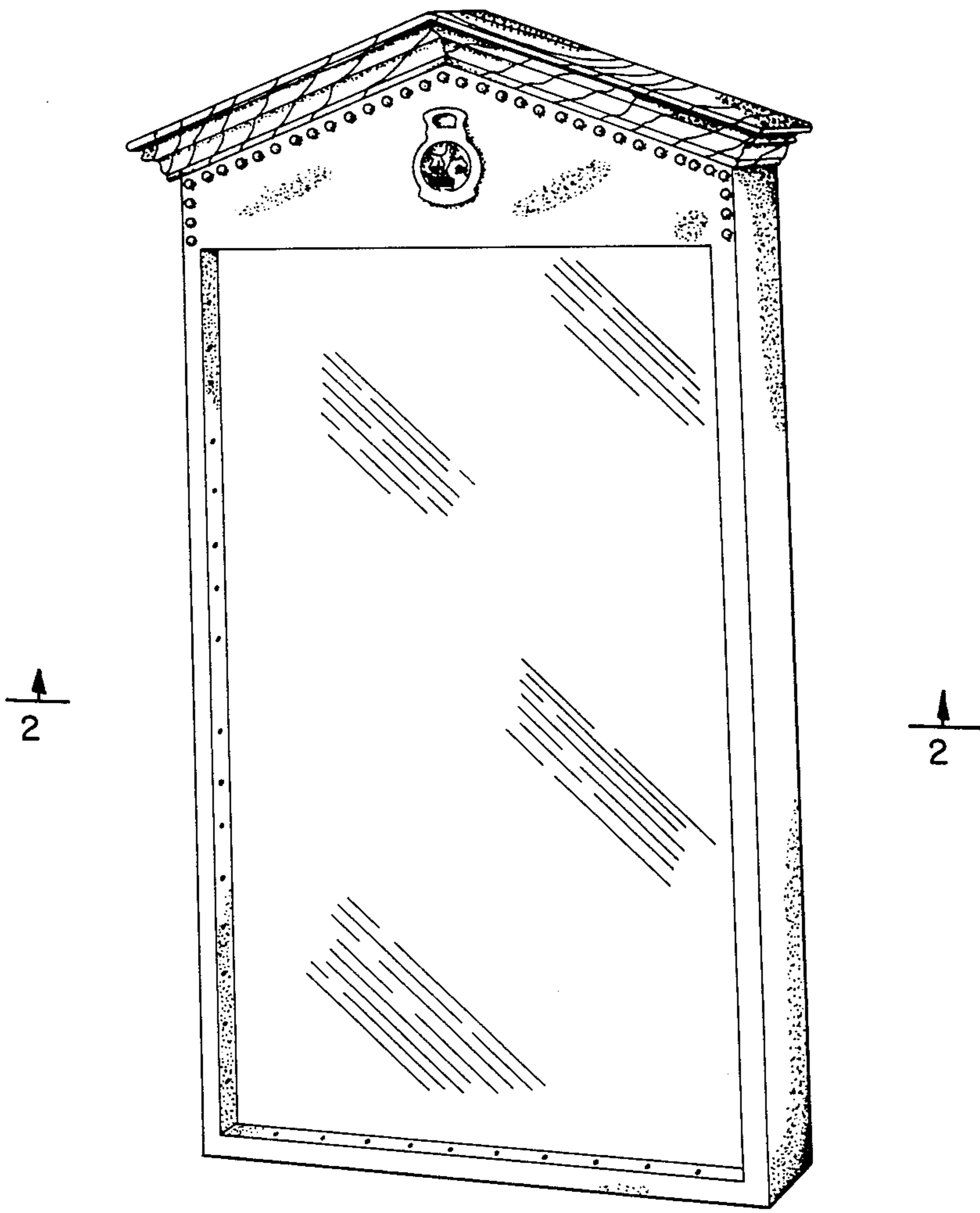

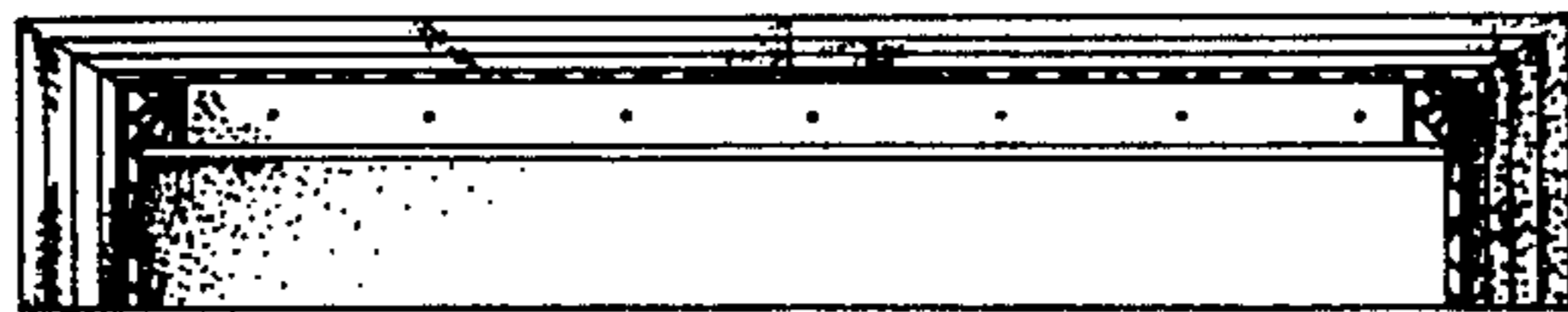

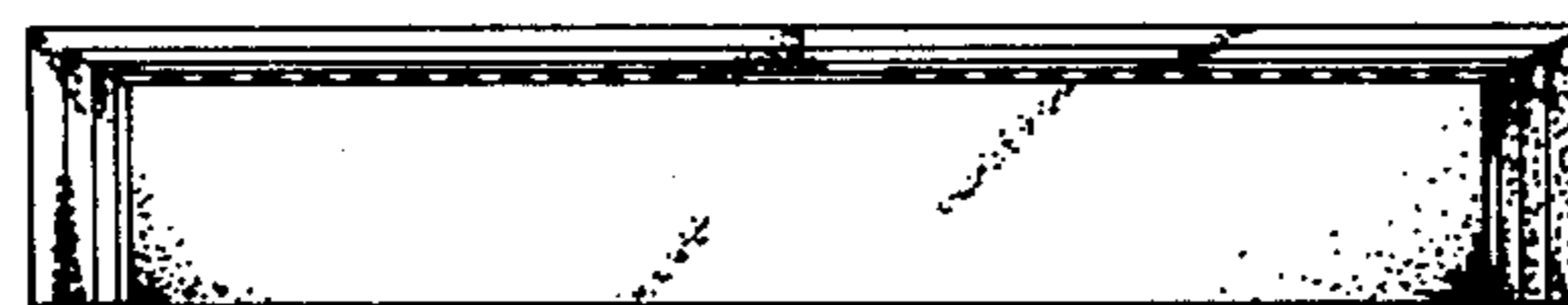
