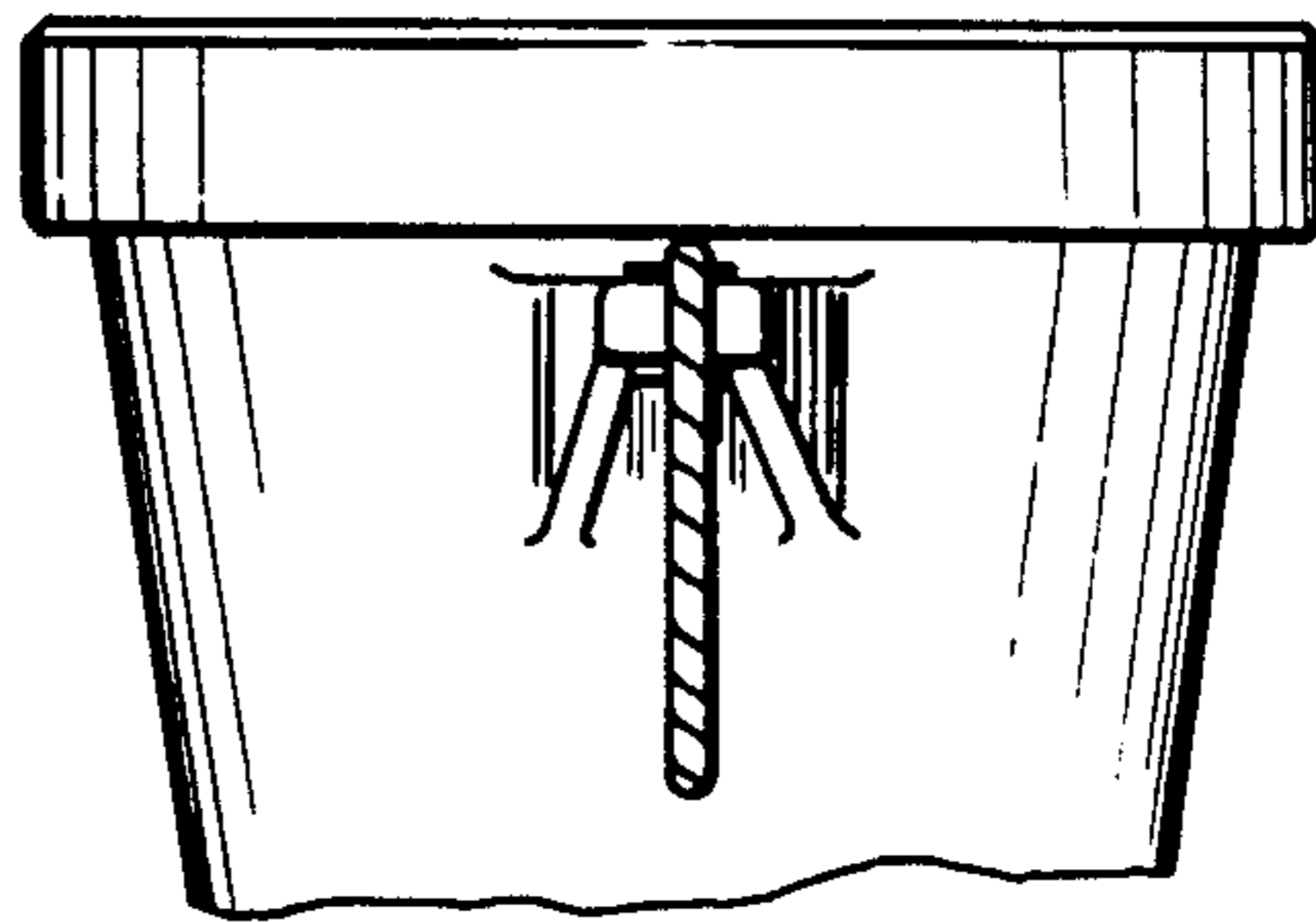
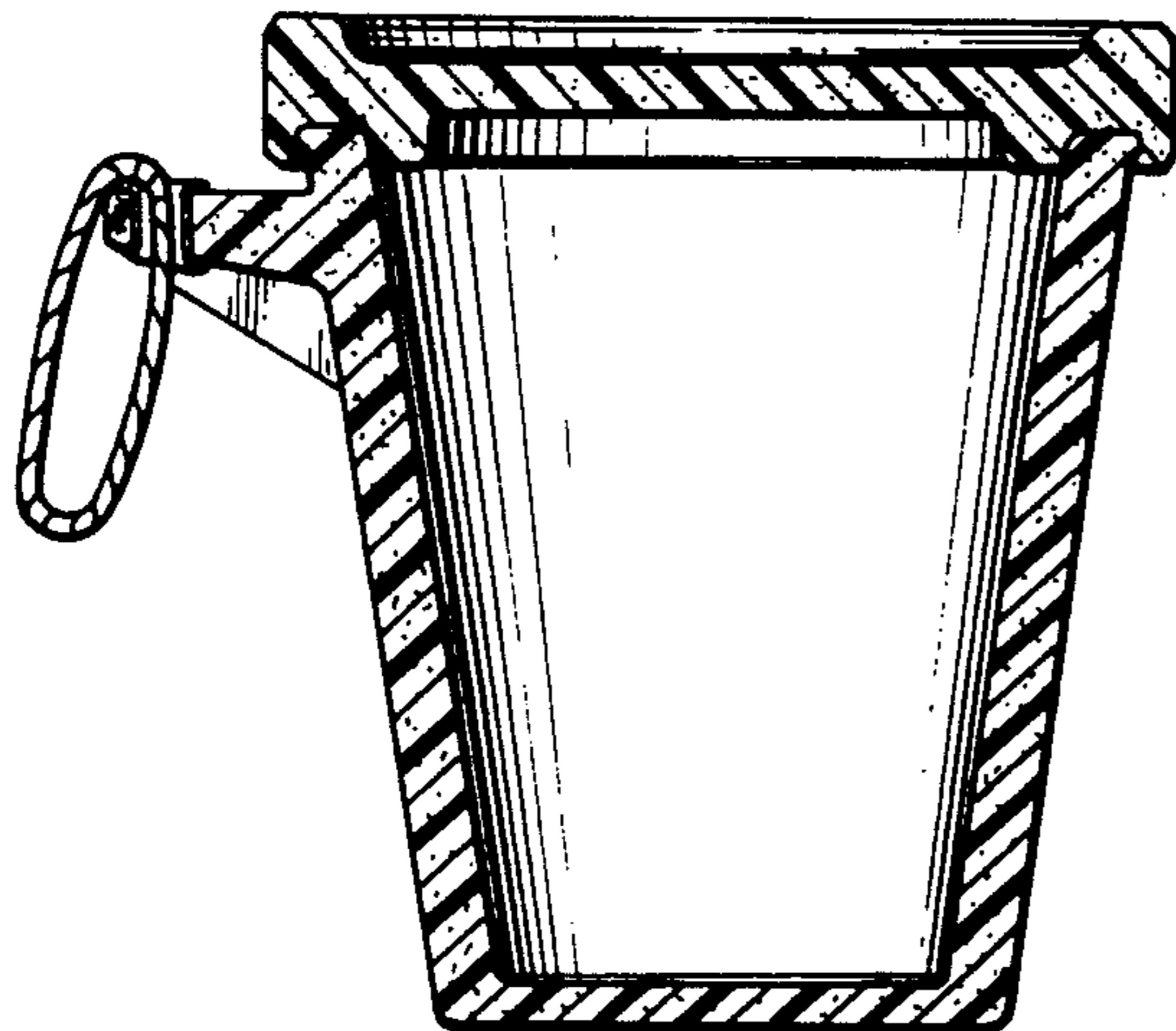

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a receptacle for storing a yogurt container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a receptacle for storing a yogurt container showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 2-2 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a partial left side elevational view thereof.



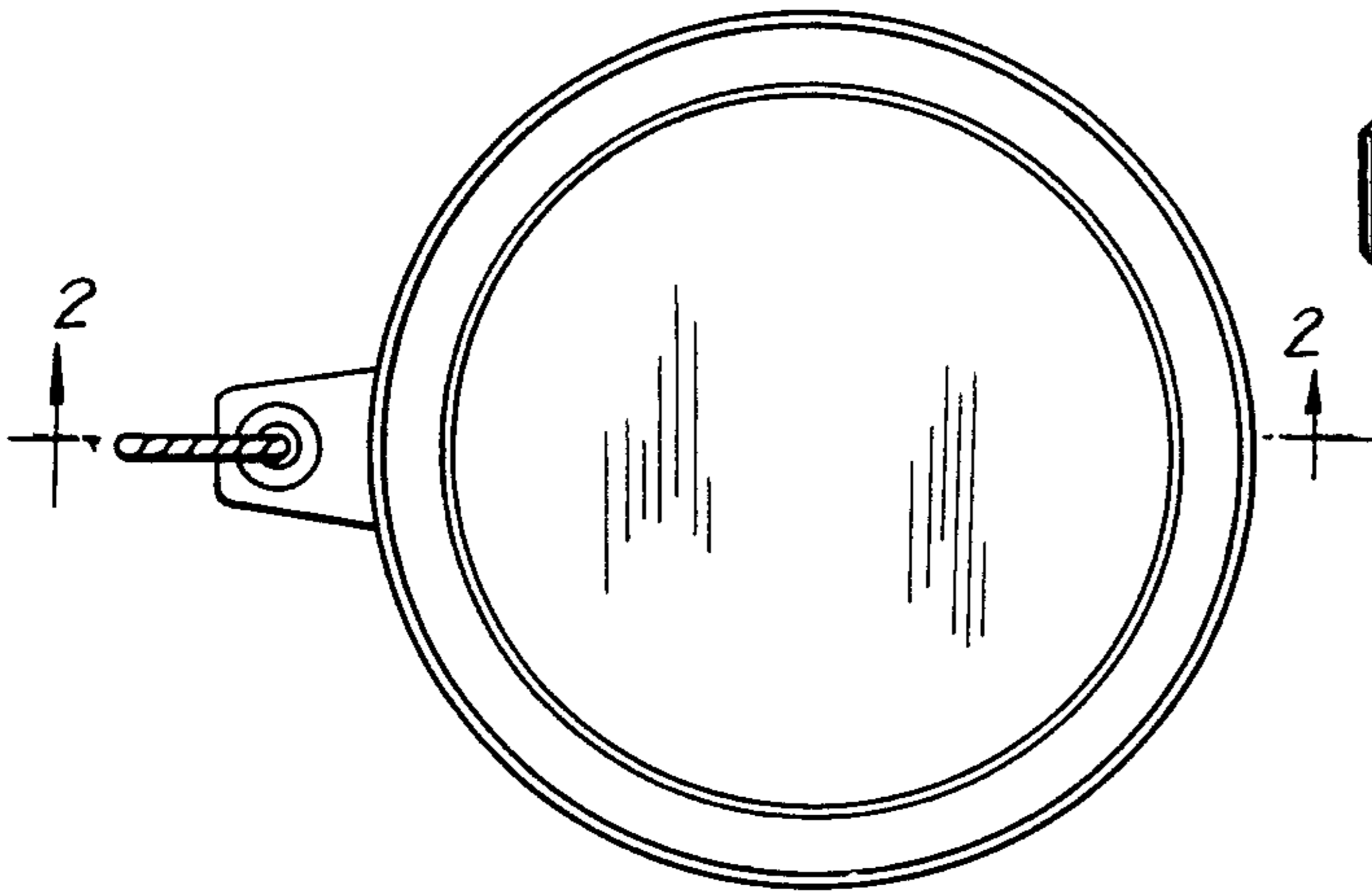

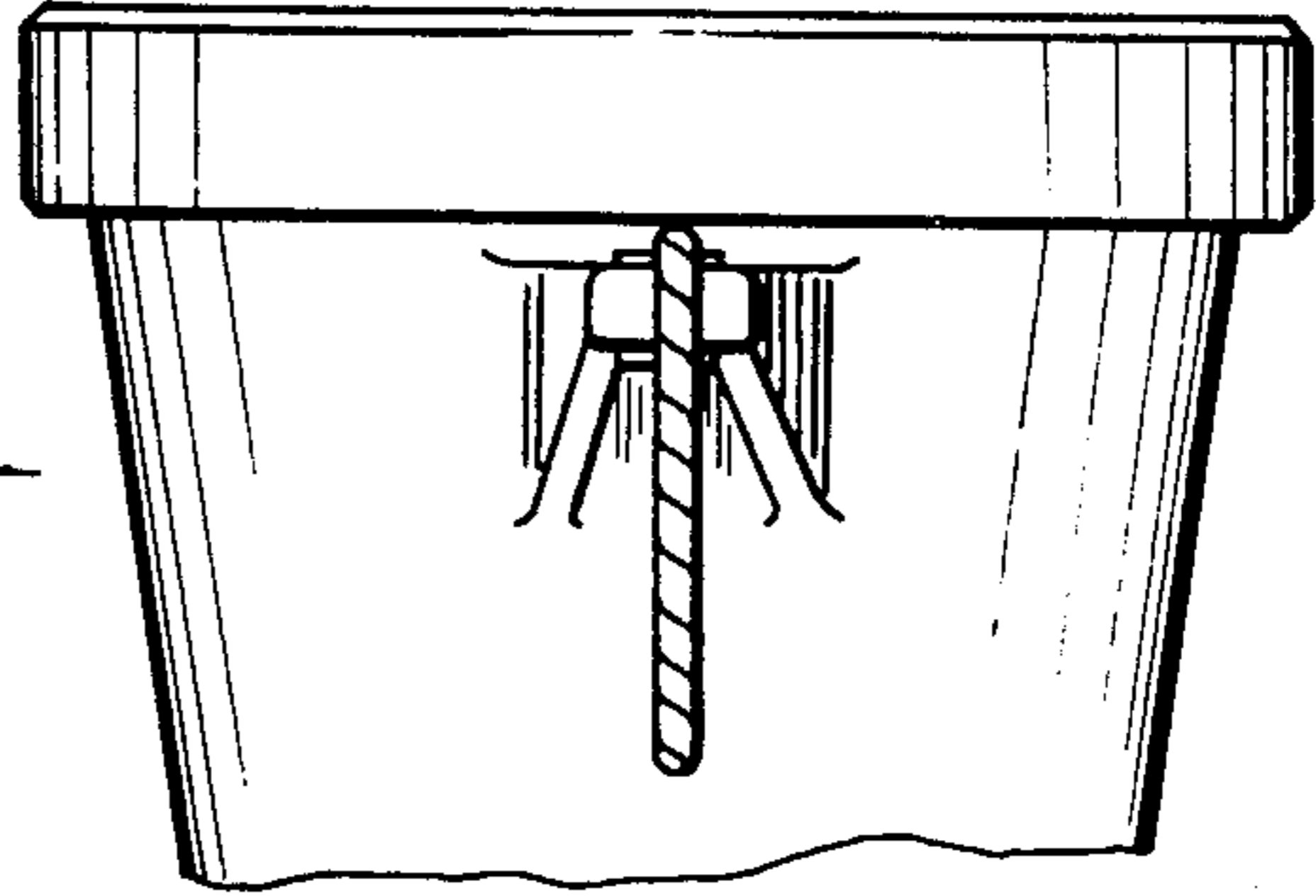

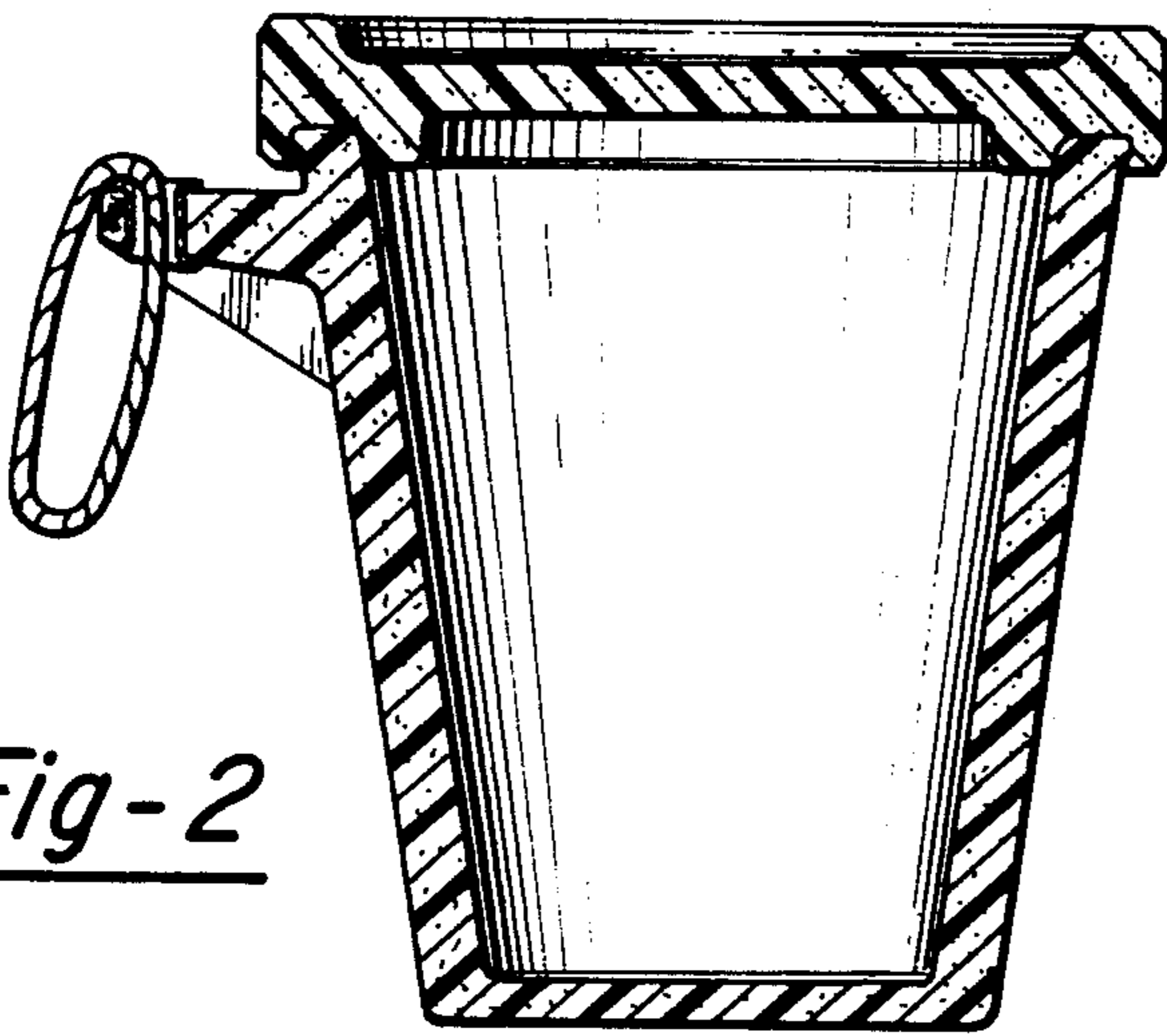

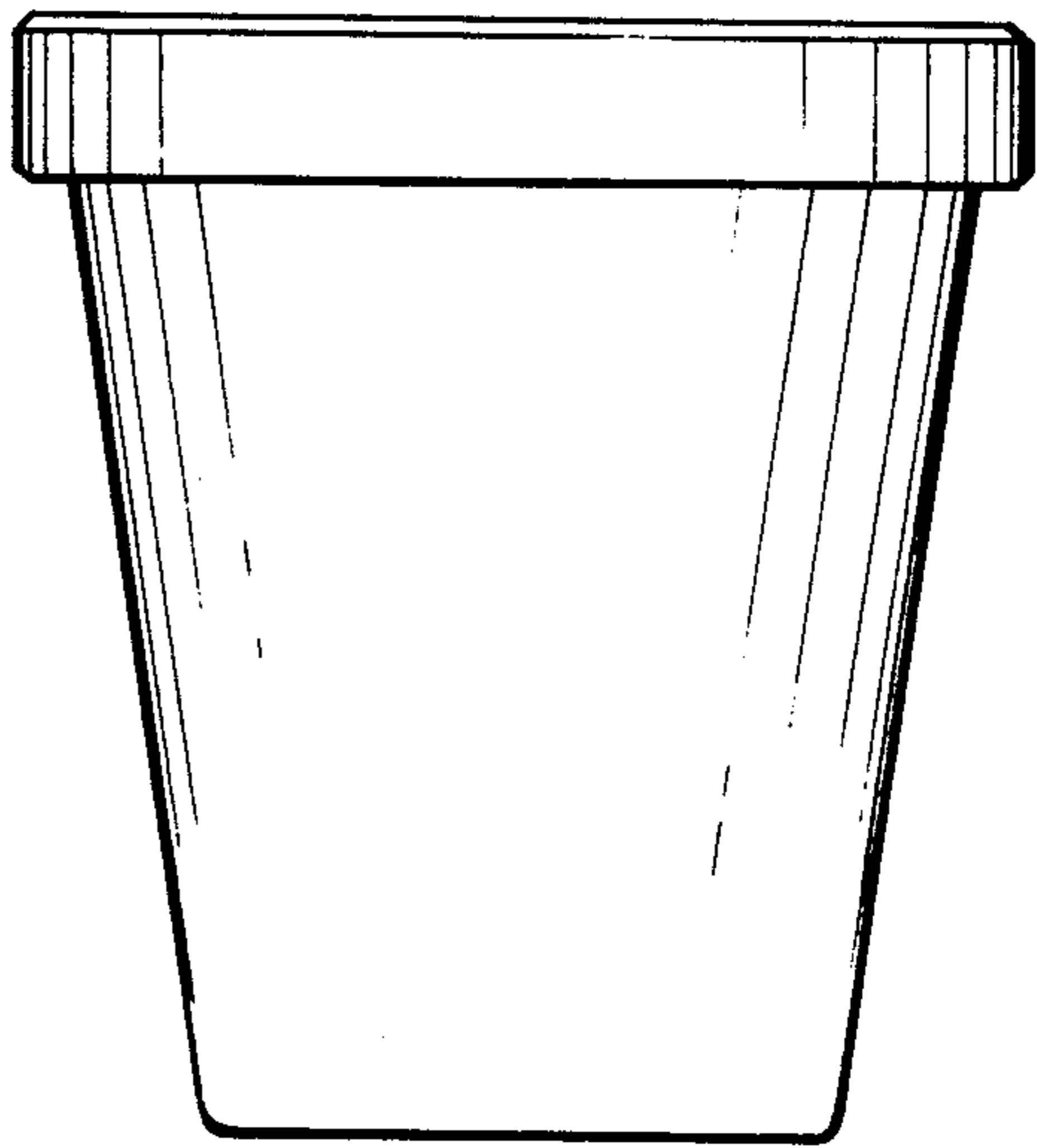

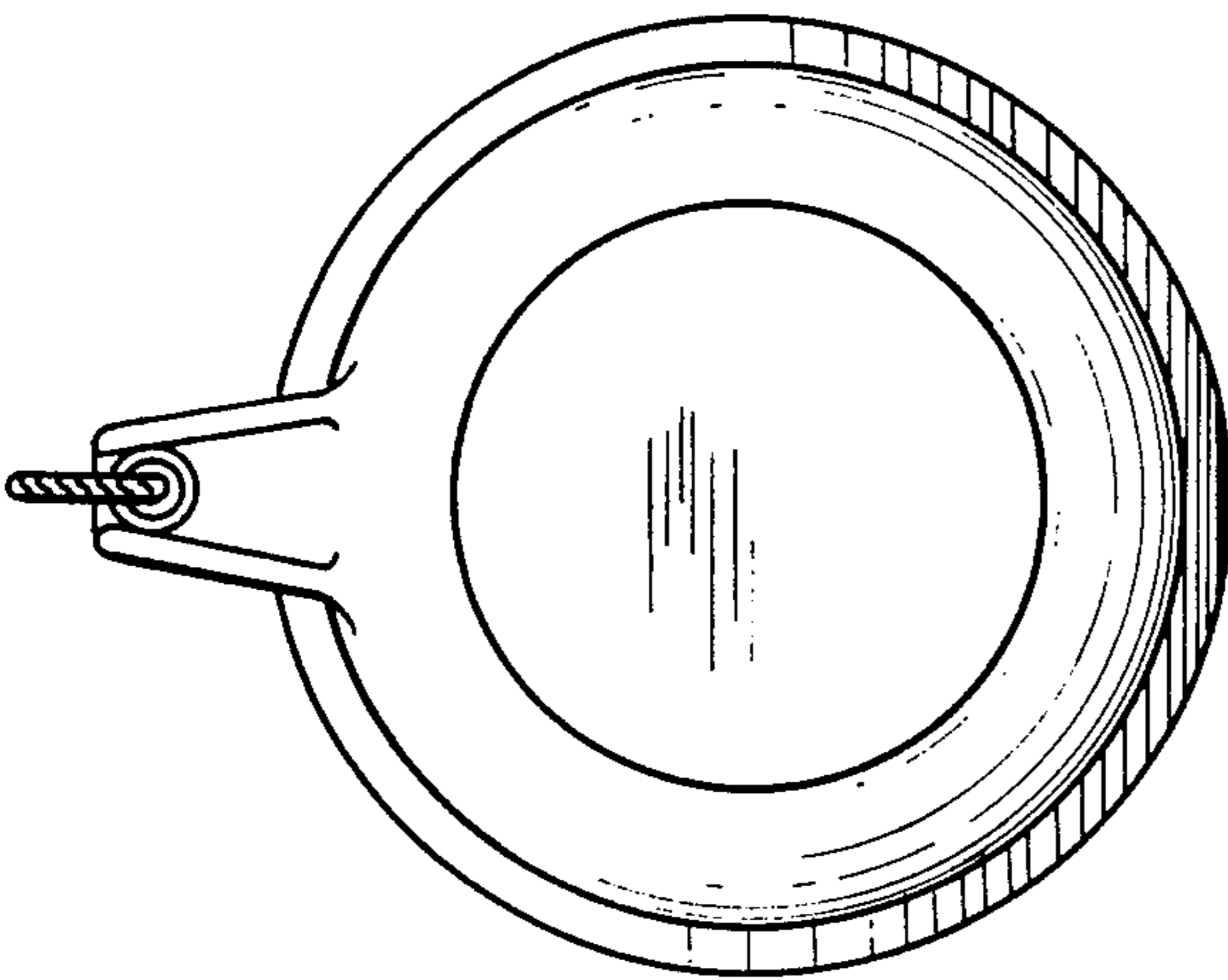
