DESCRIPTION

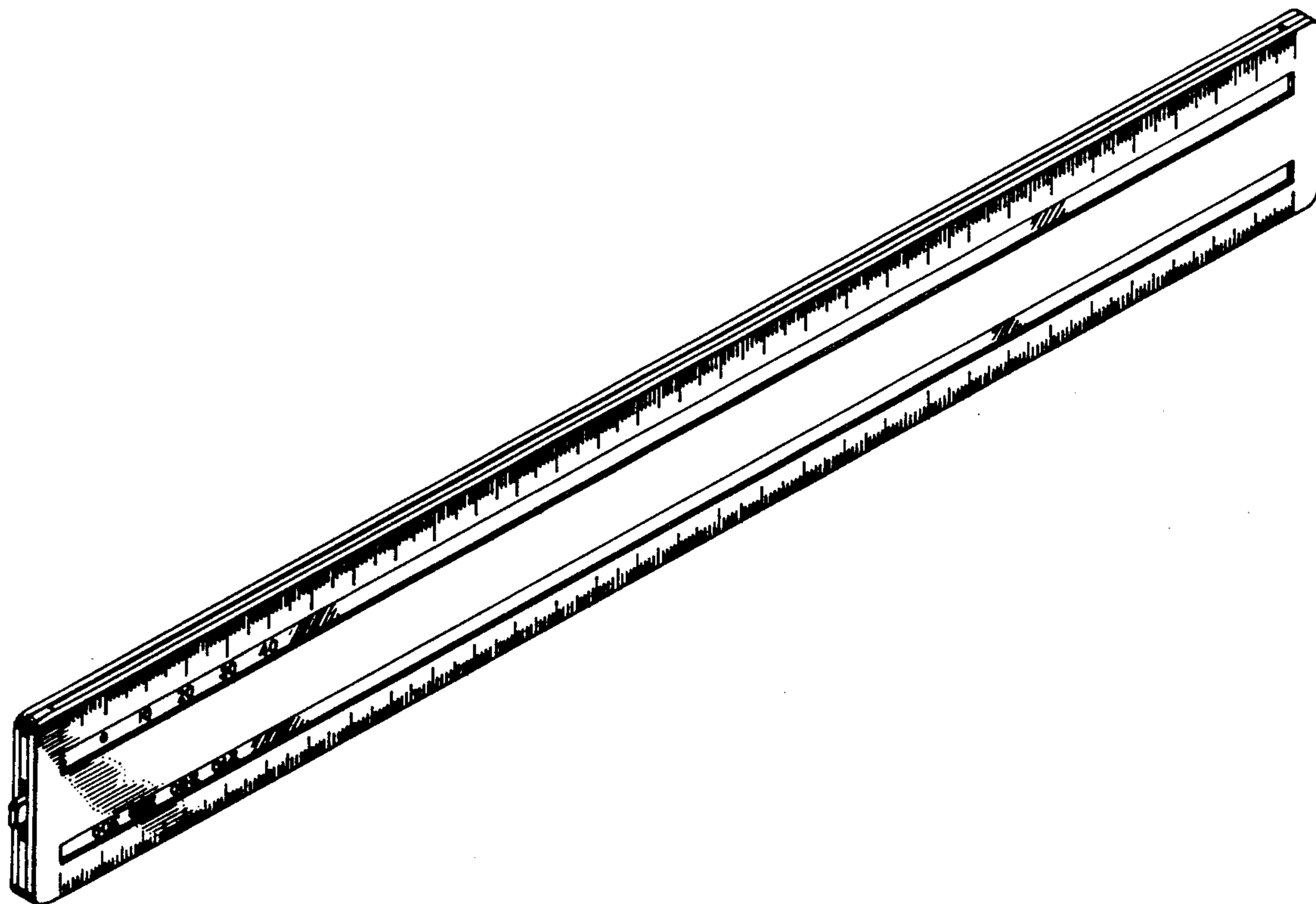
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a multiple scale rule showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 6—6 of FIG. 4.



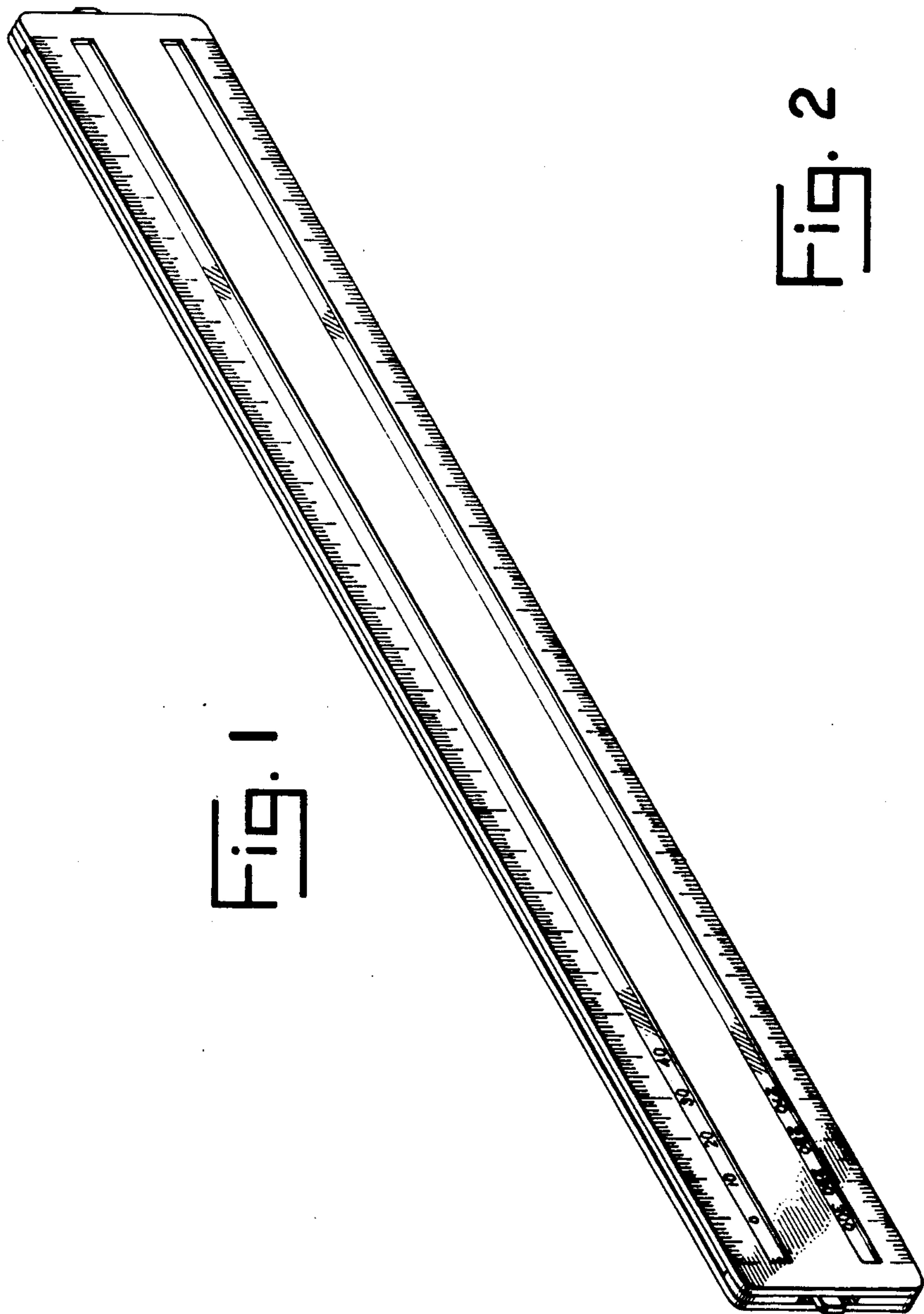

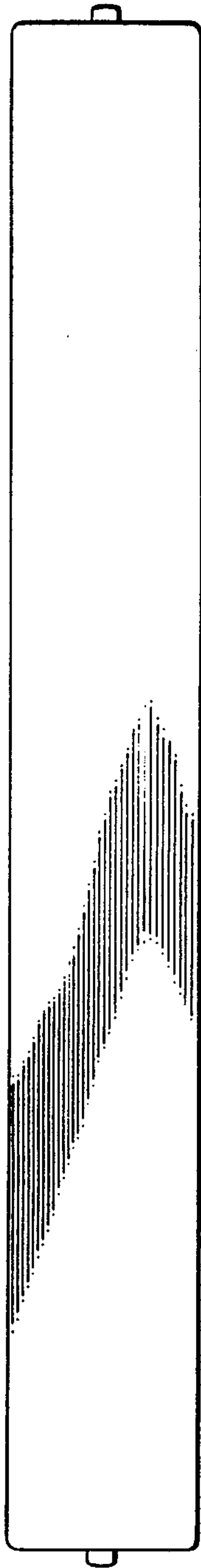
