FIG. 1 is a top view of the lapidary machine showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof, with the housing being shown partially broken away for clarity of disclosure;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 7—7 of FIG. 5.

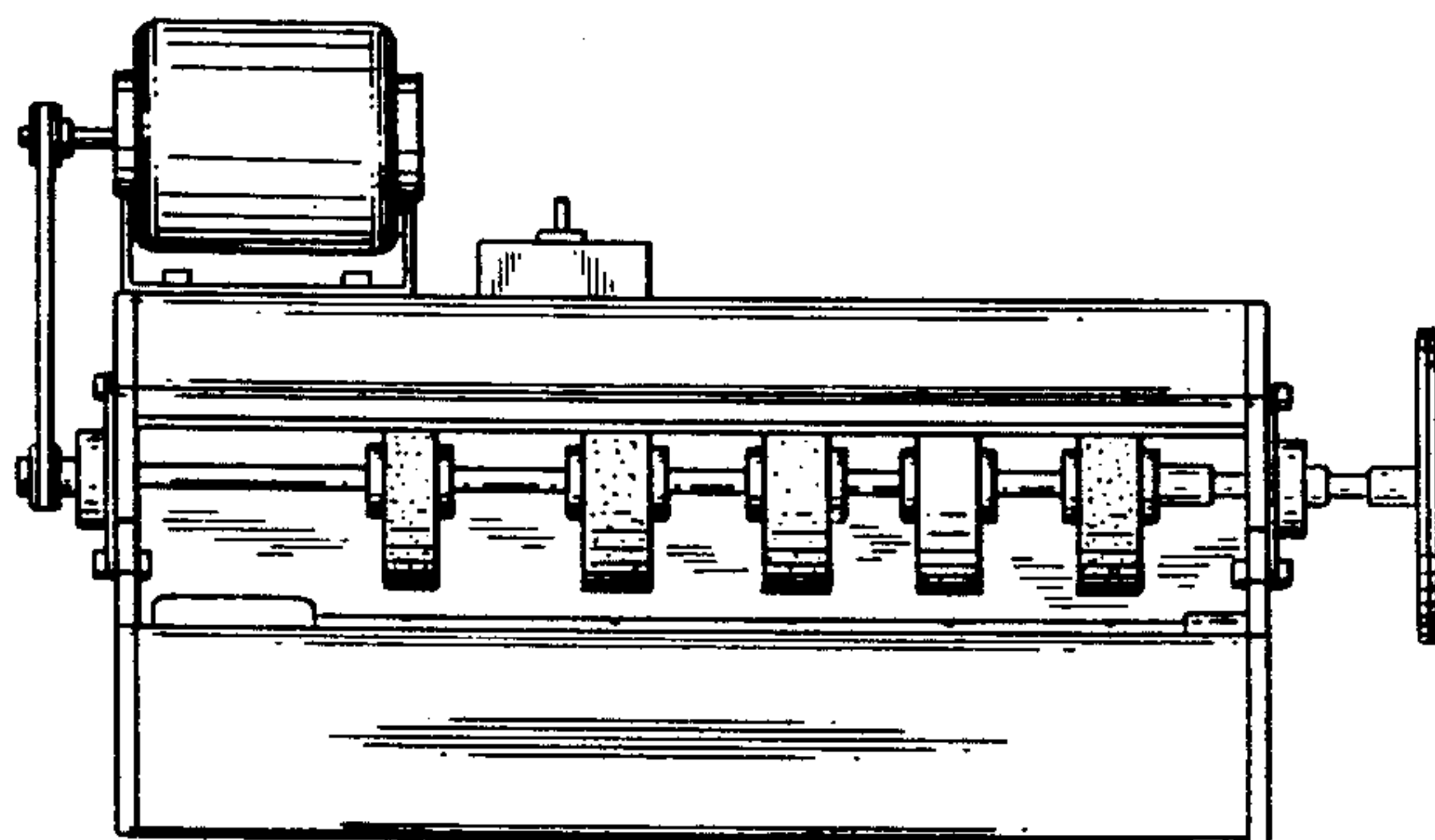
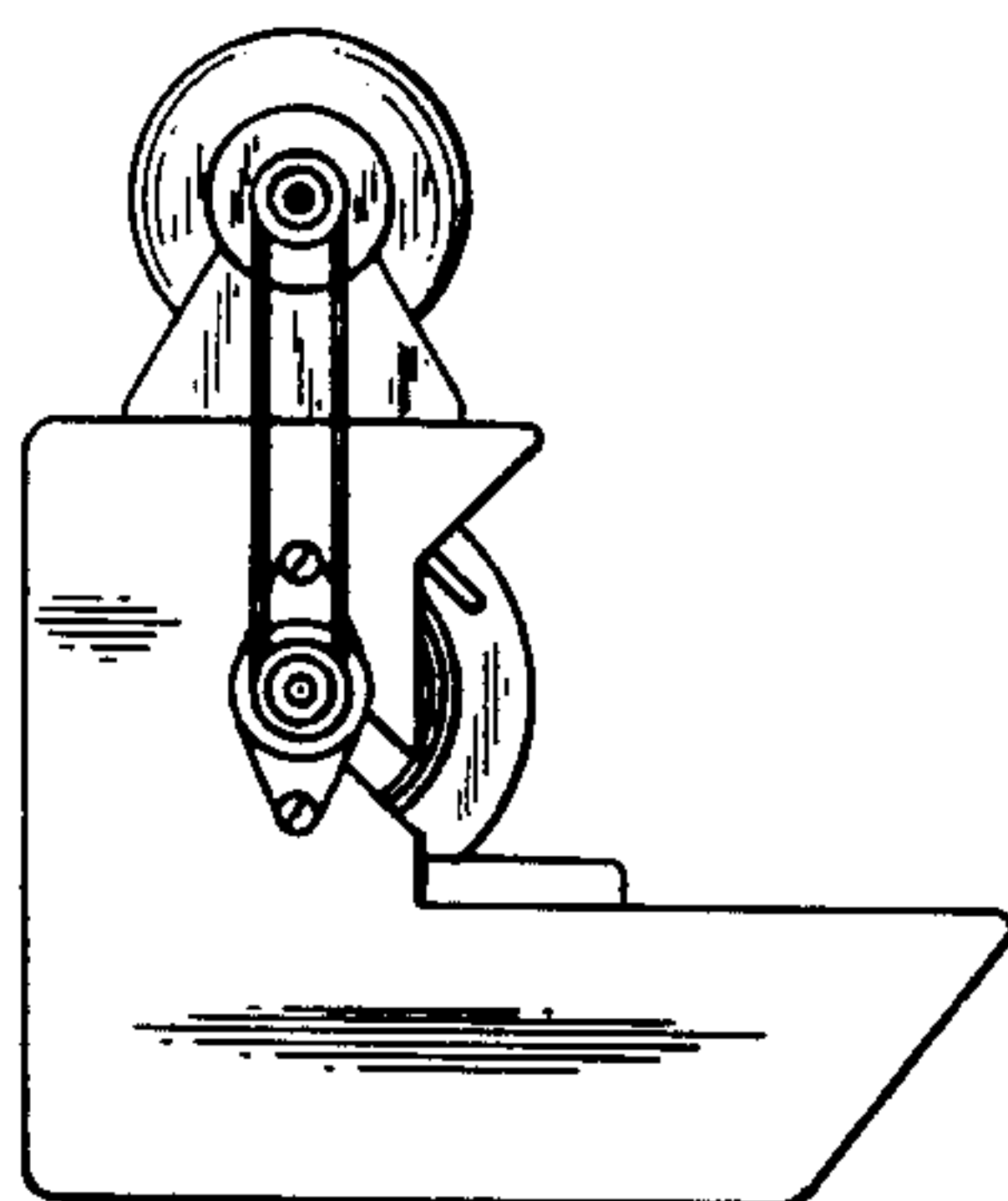

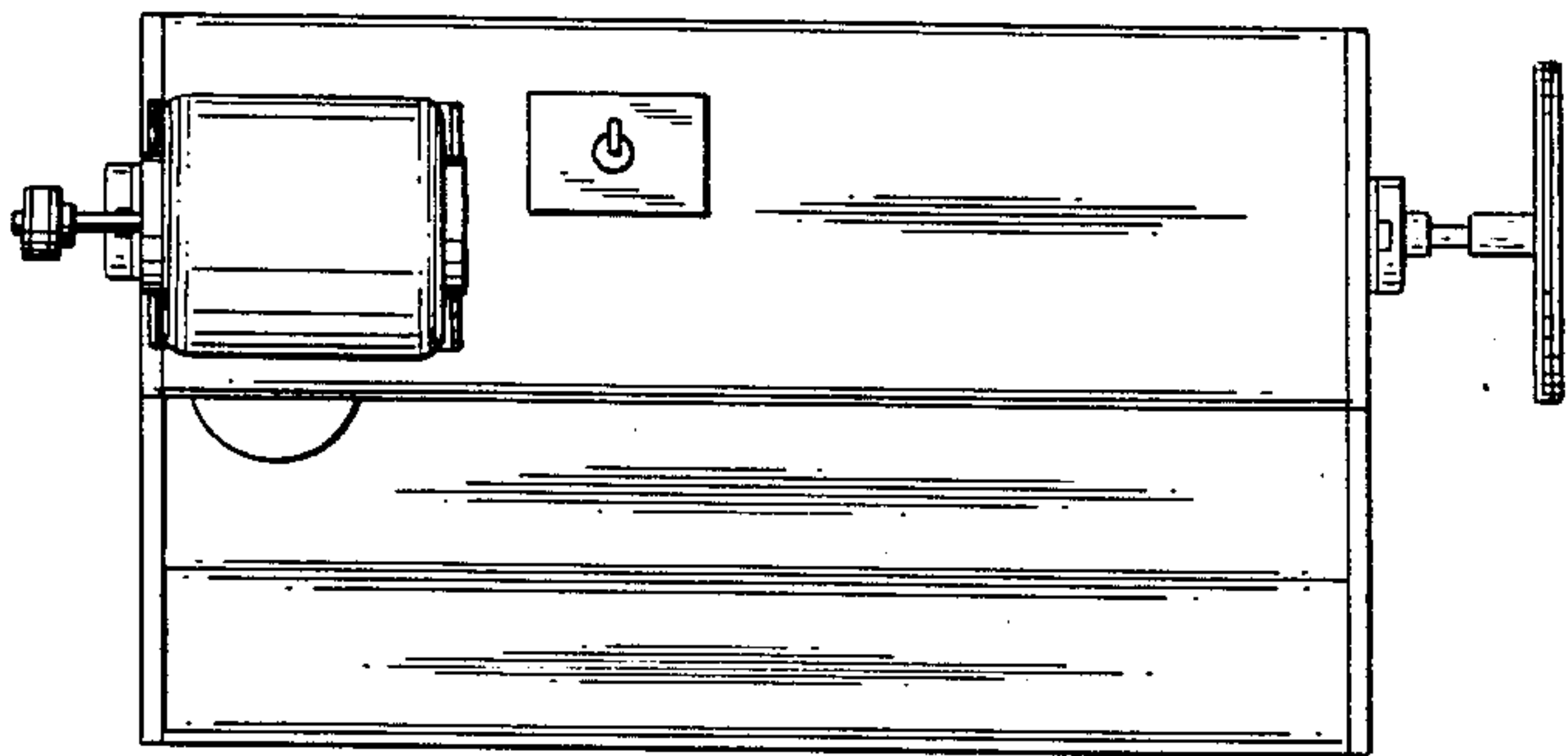

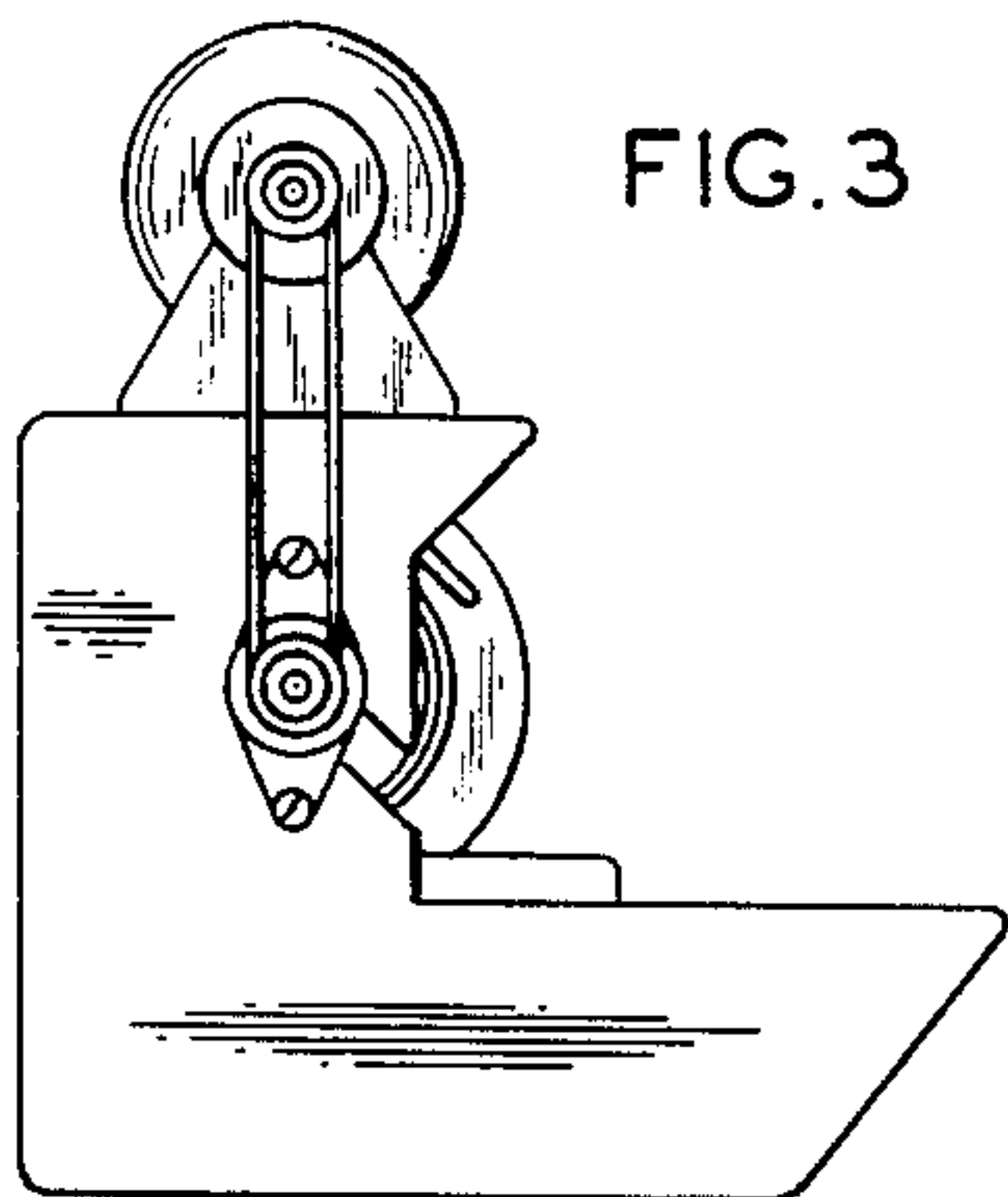

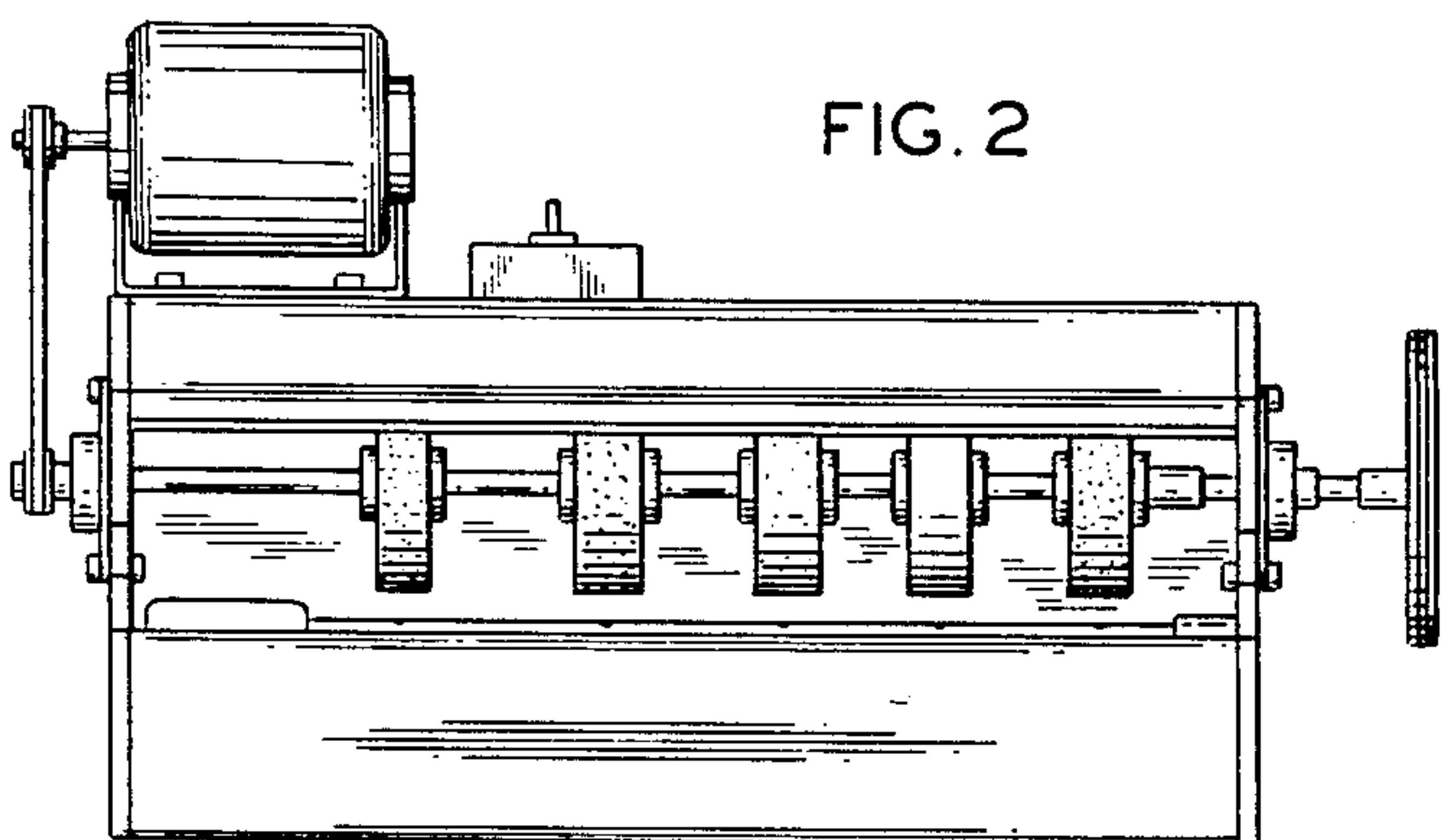

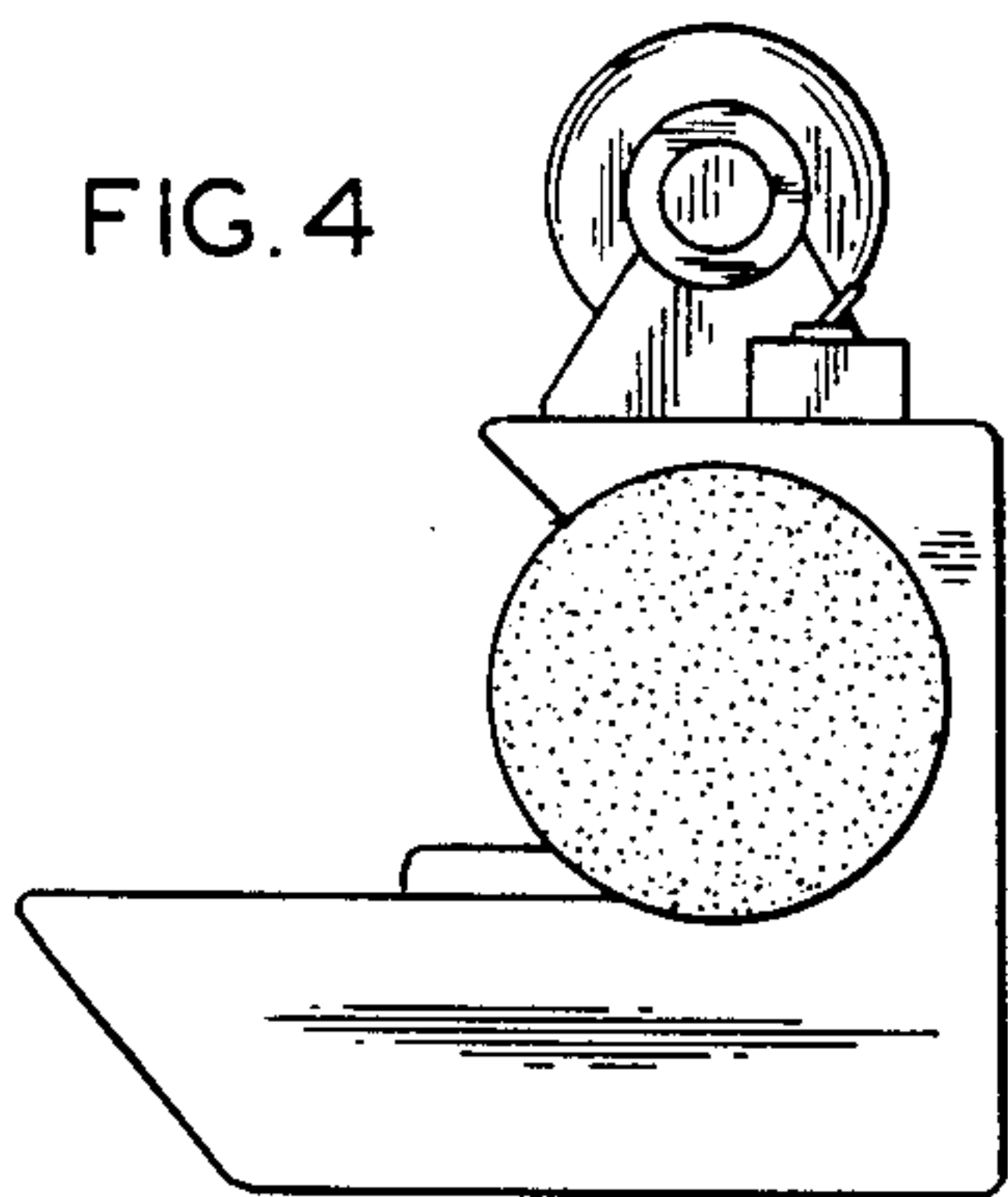

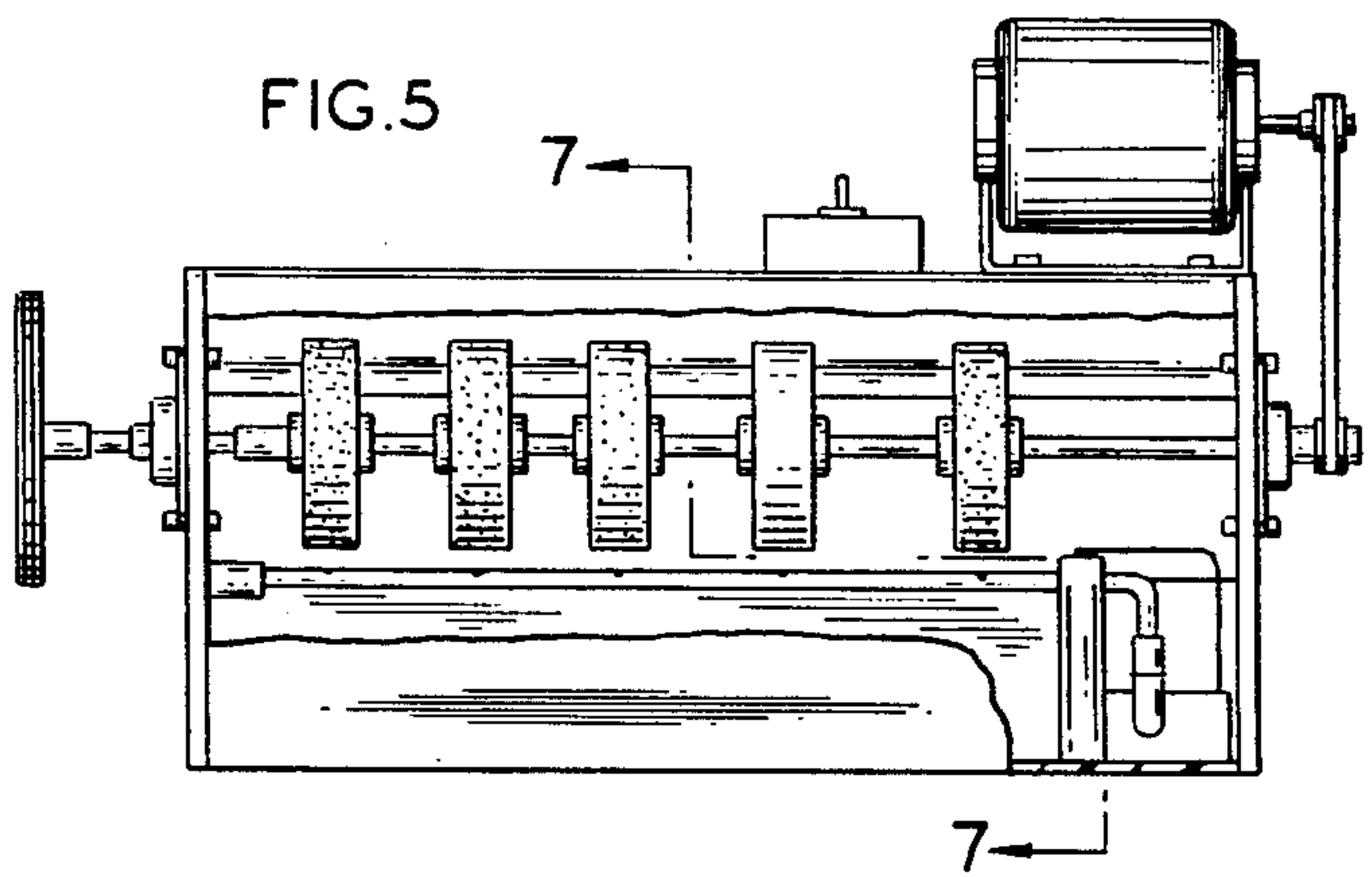

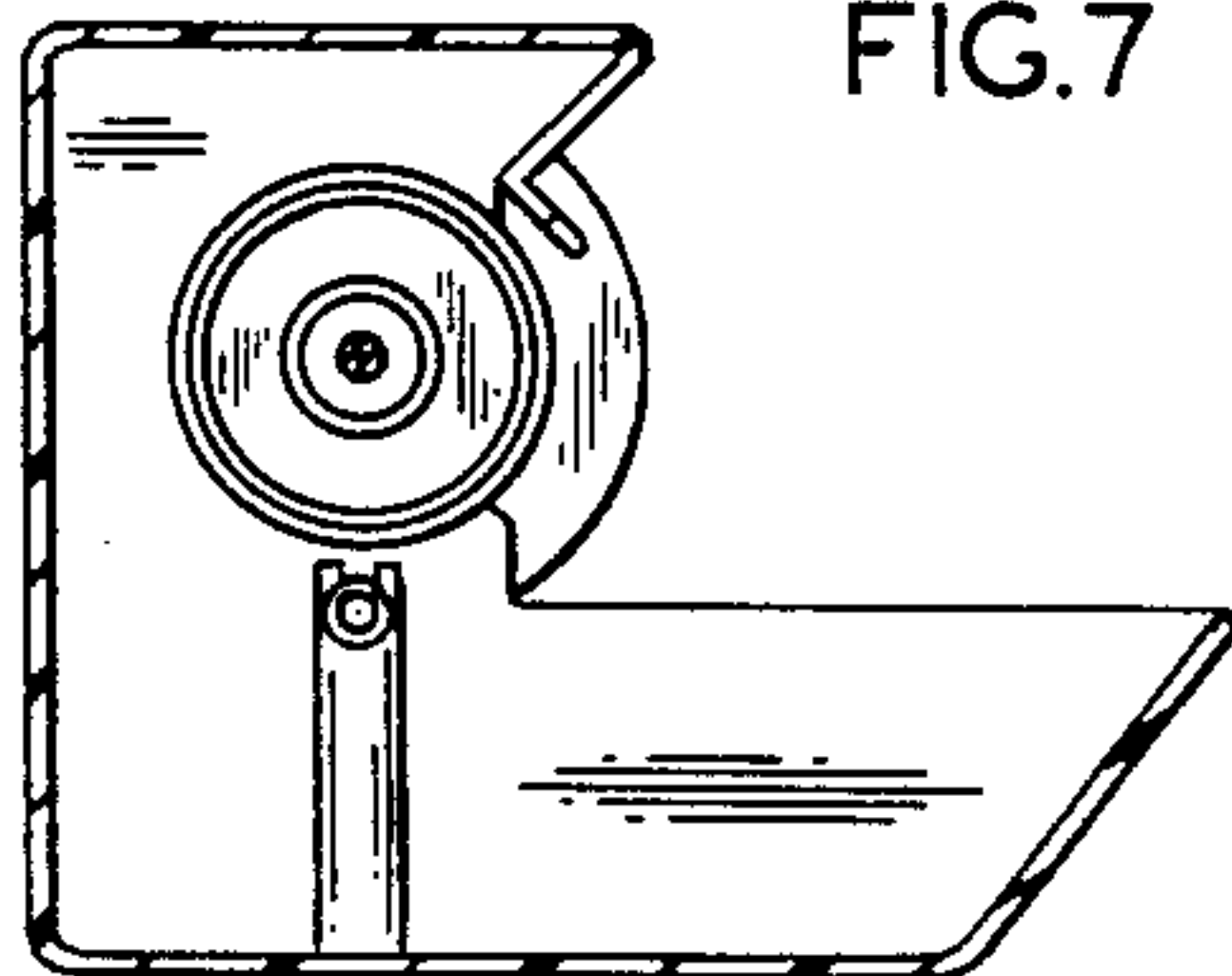
