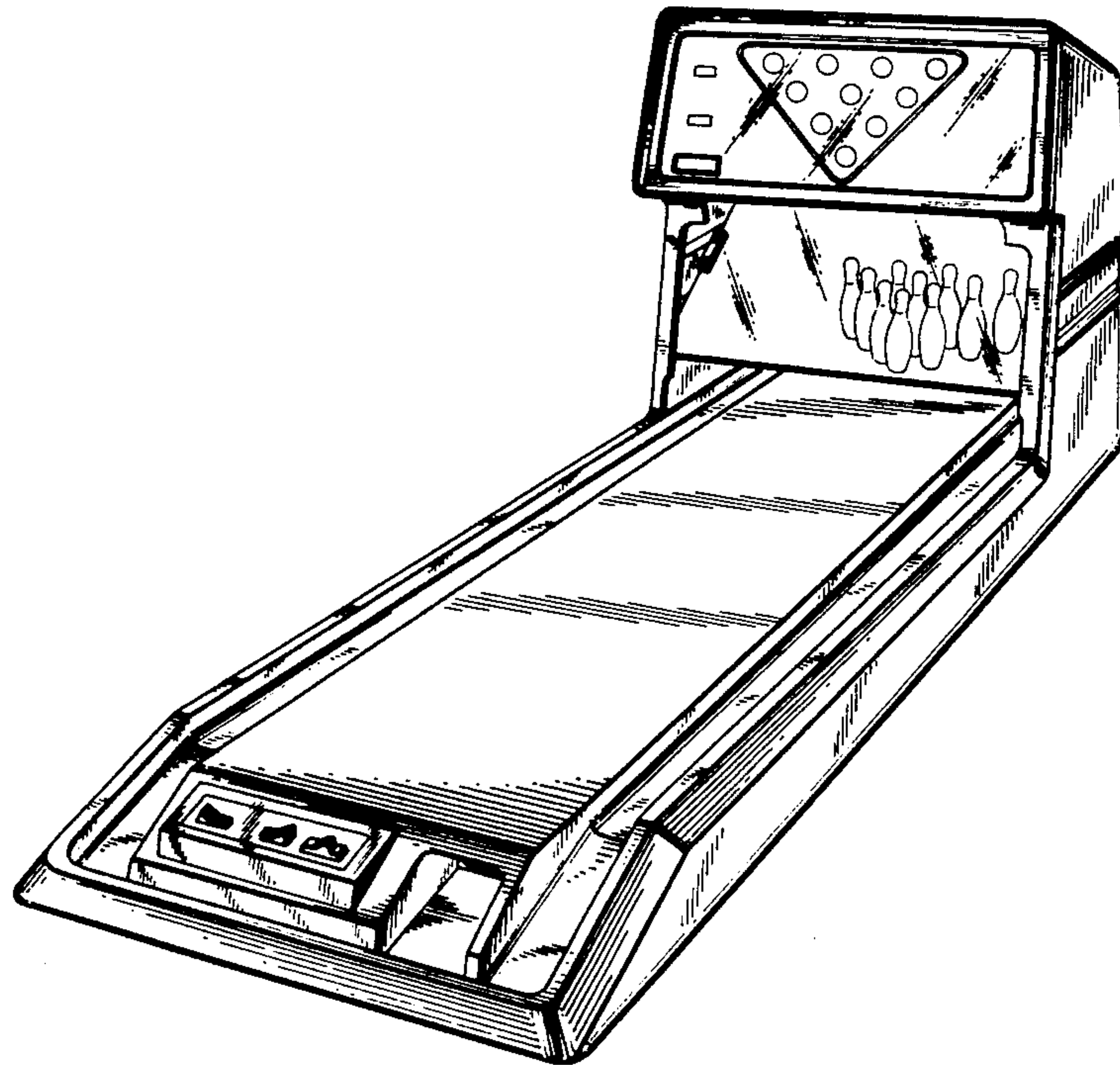

DESCRIPTION

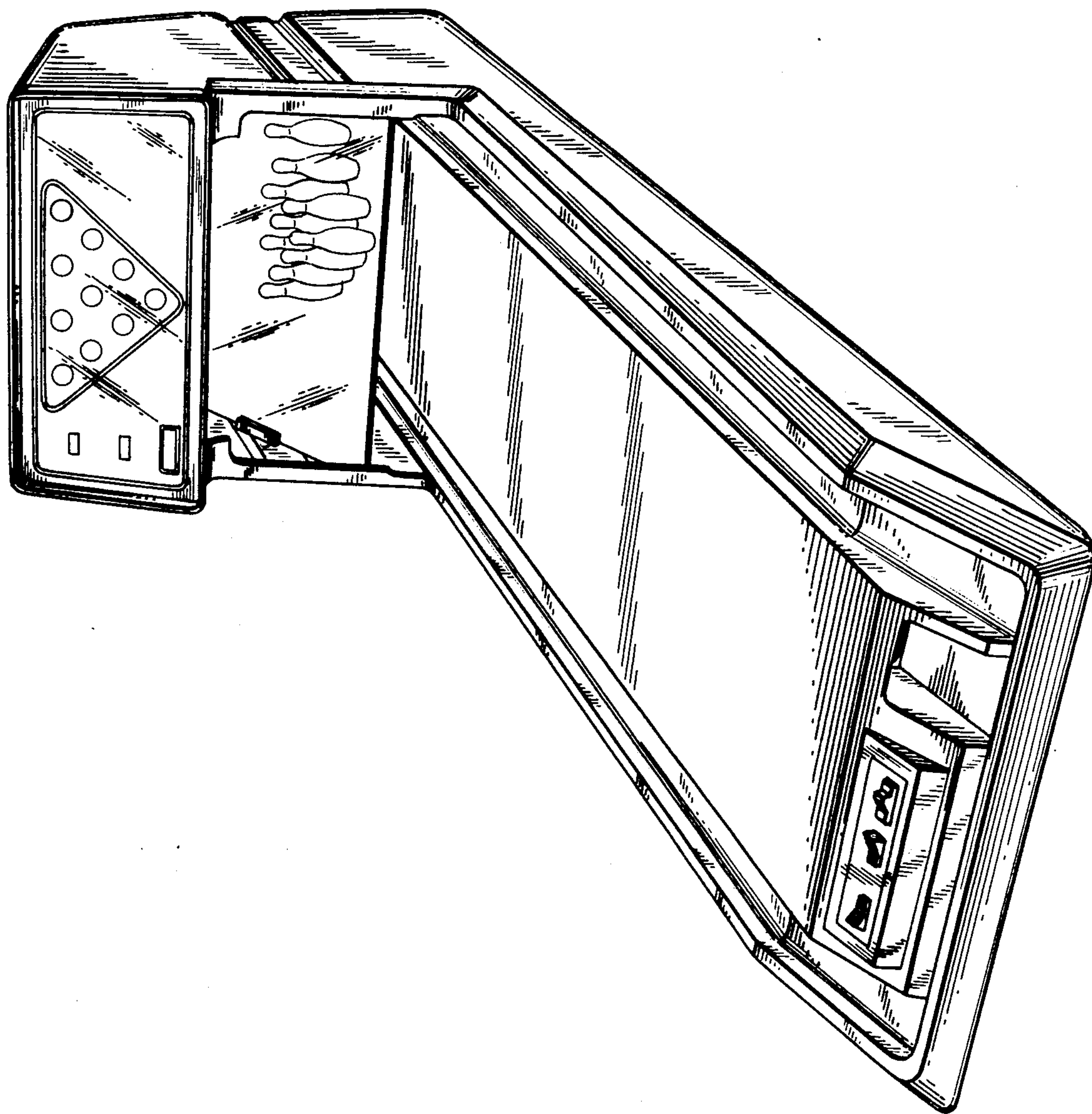

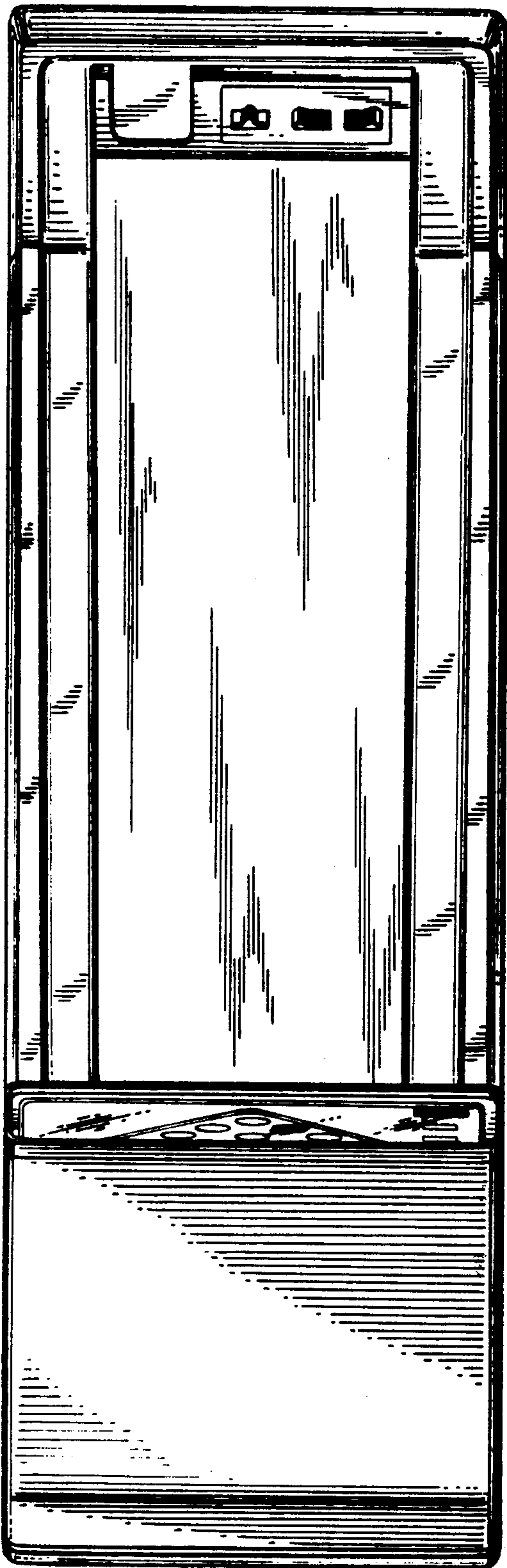

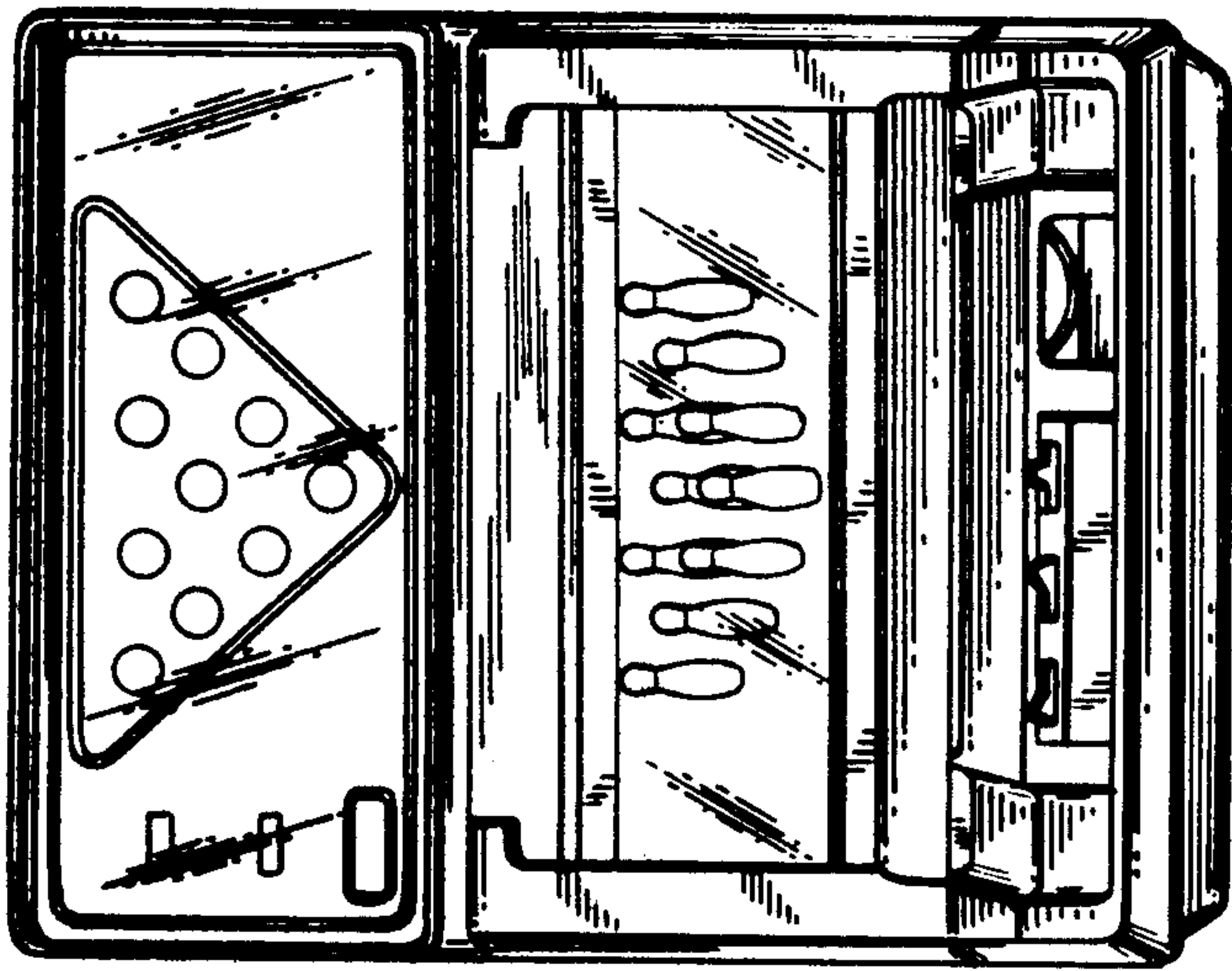
