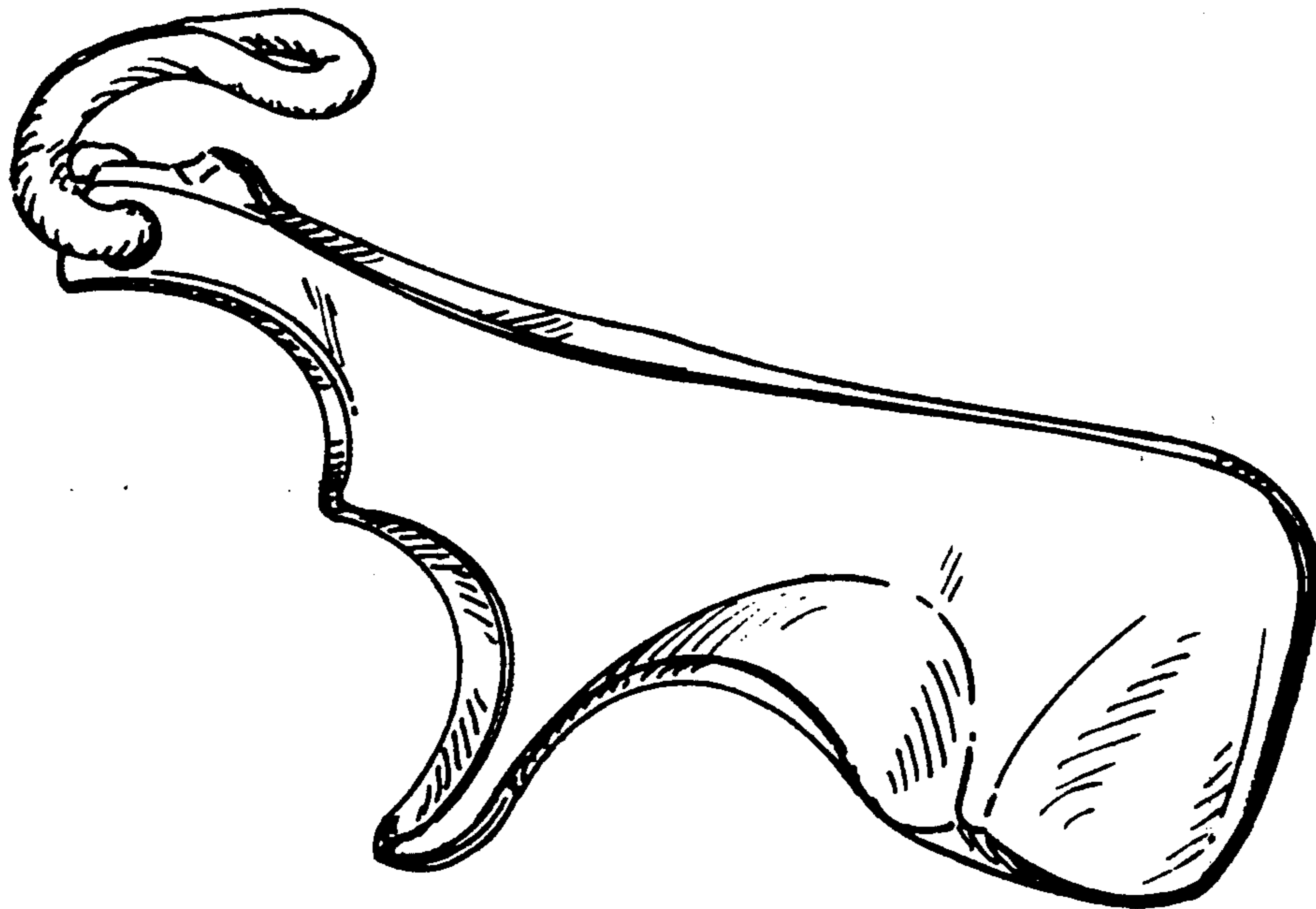

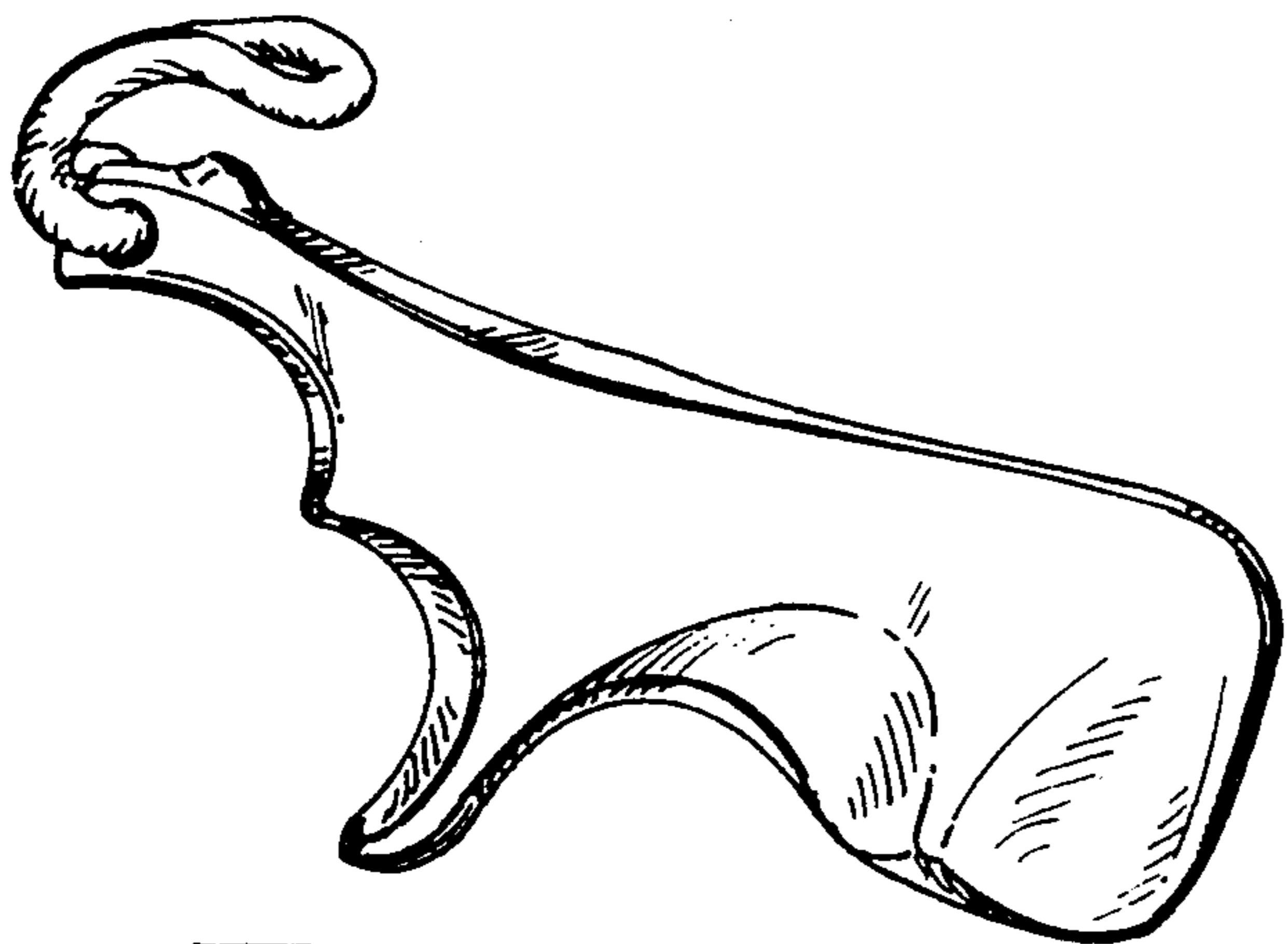
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an archery bow string release grip, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an oblique, right-front, perspective view of an archery bow string release grip showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.





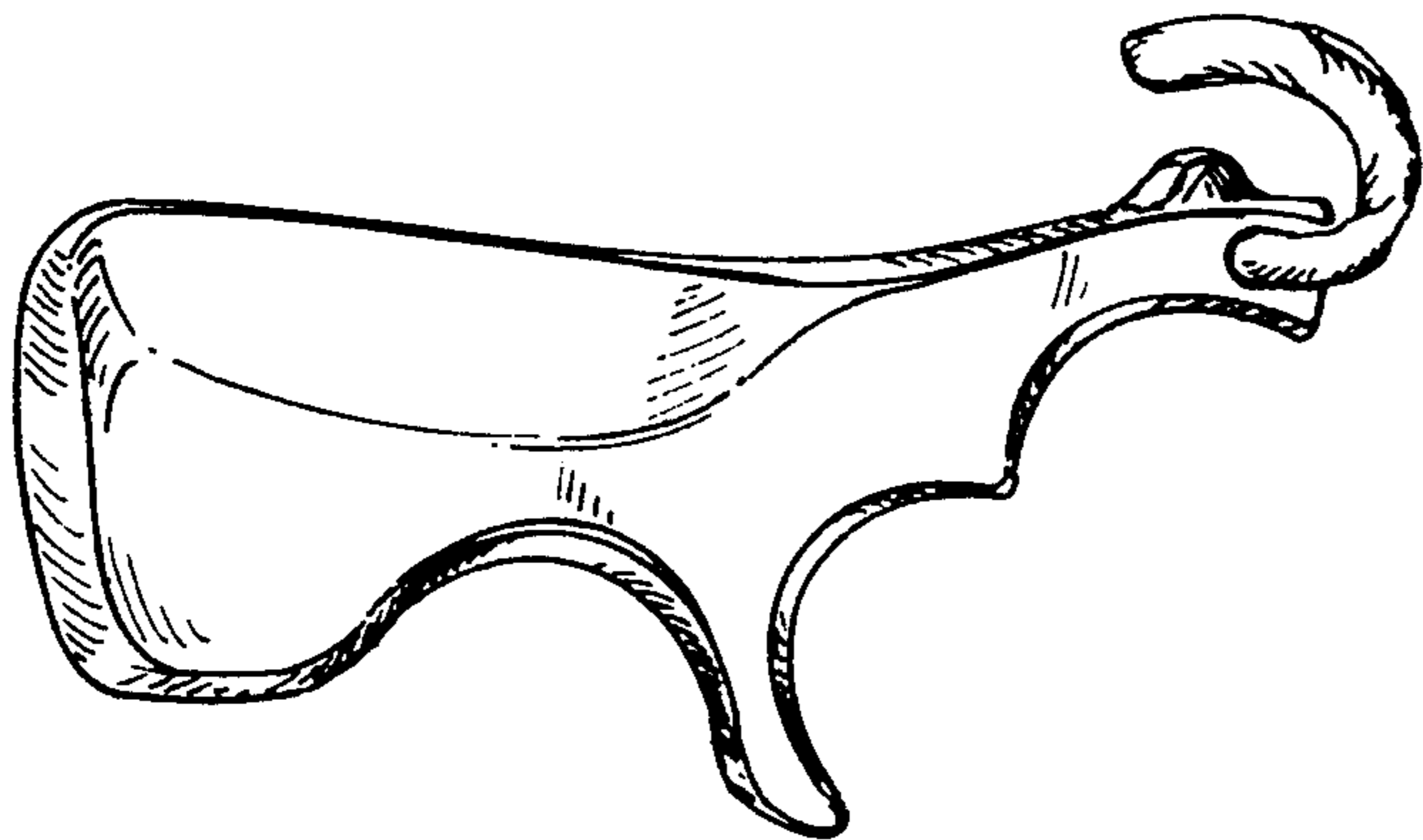

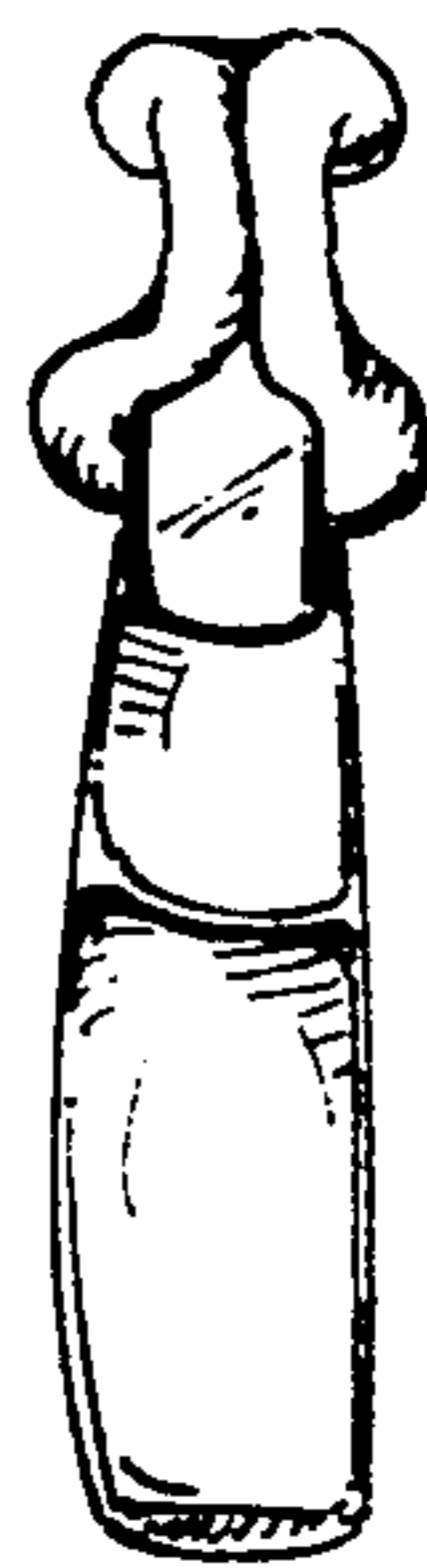
