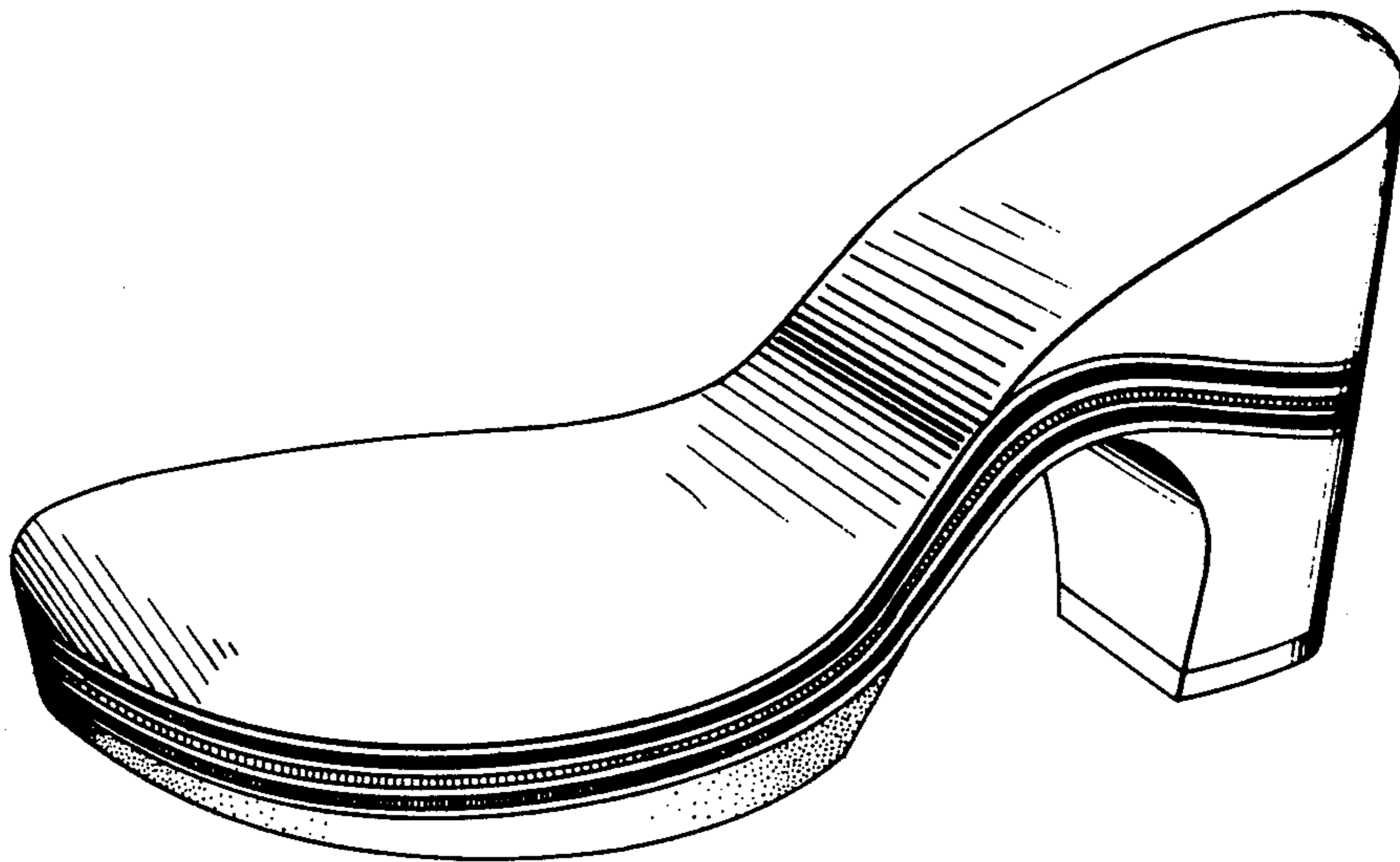

The ornamental design for a shoe bottom, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a shoe bottom showing my new design, the bottom being plain and unornamented. FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image thereto, FIG. 3 is a top and right side perspective view thereof, FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



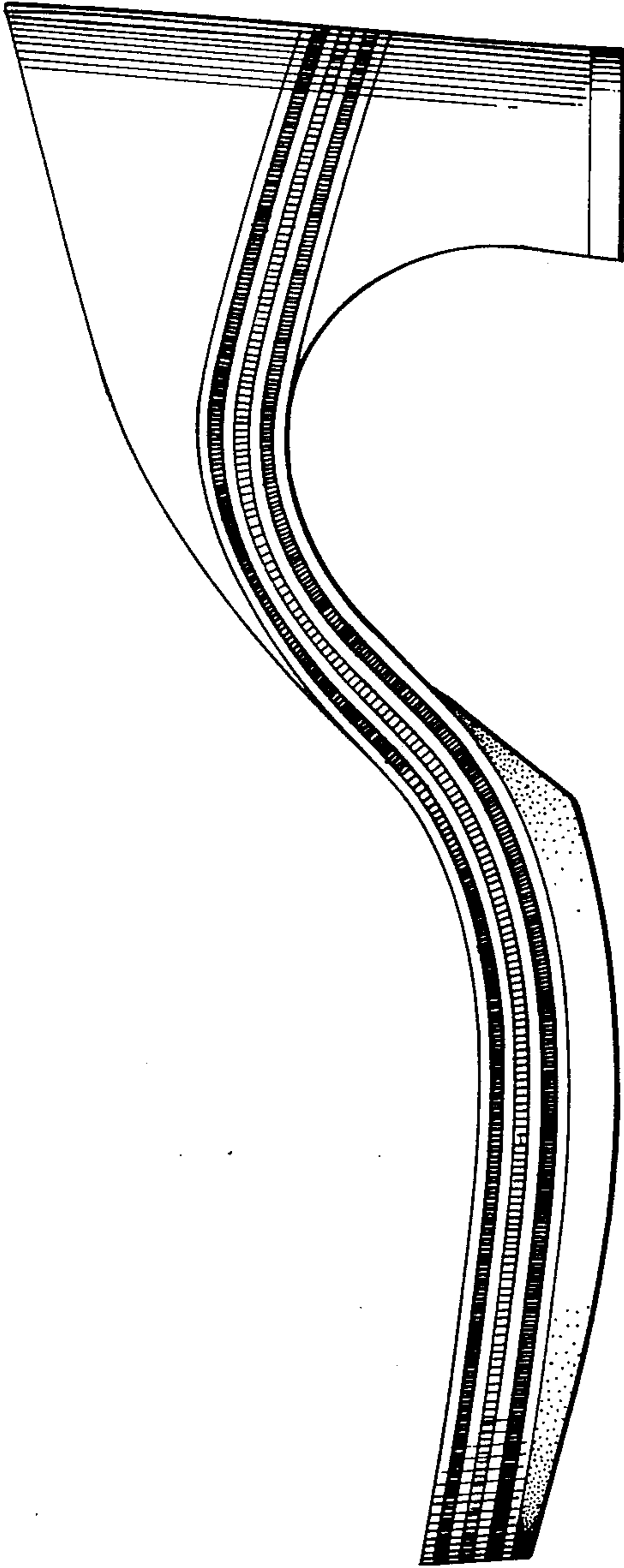

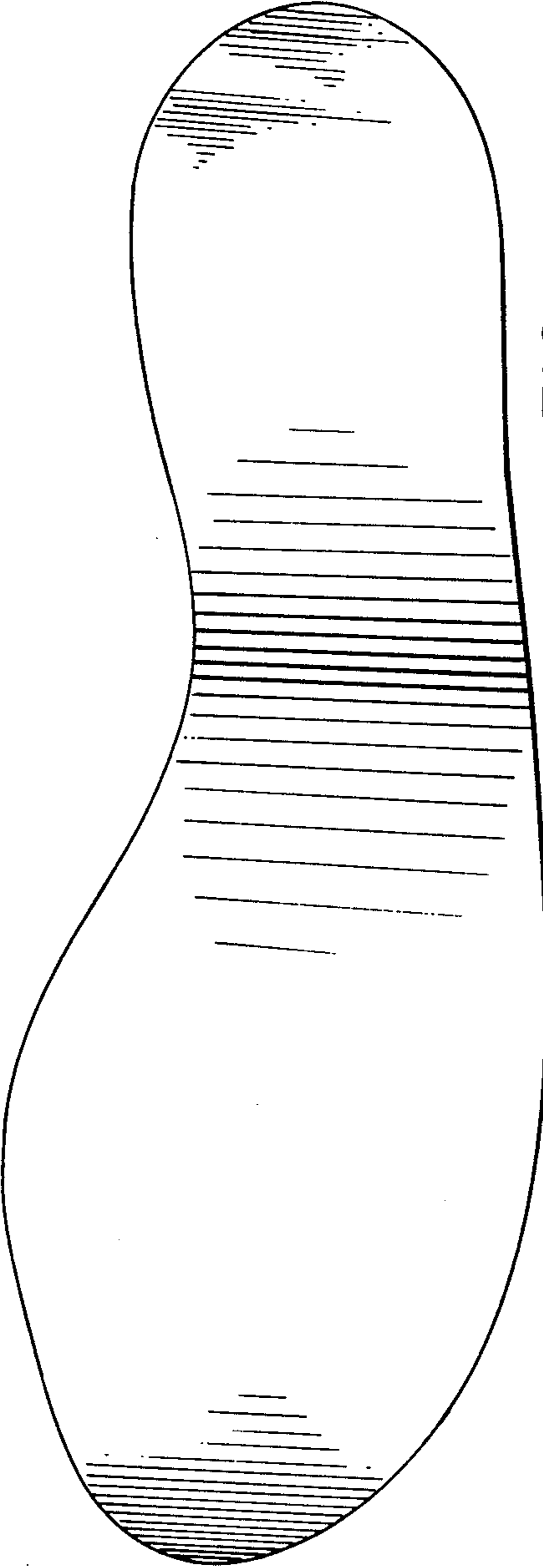

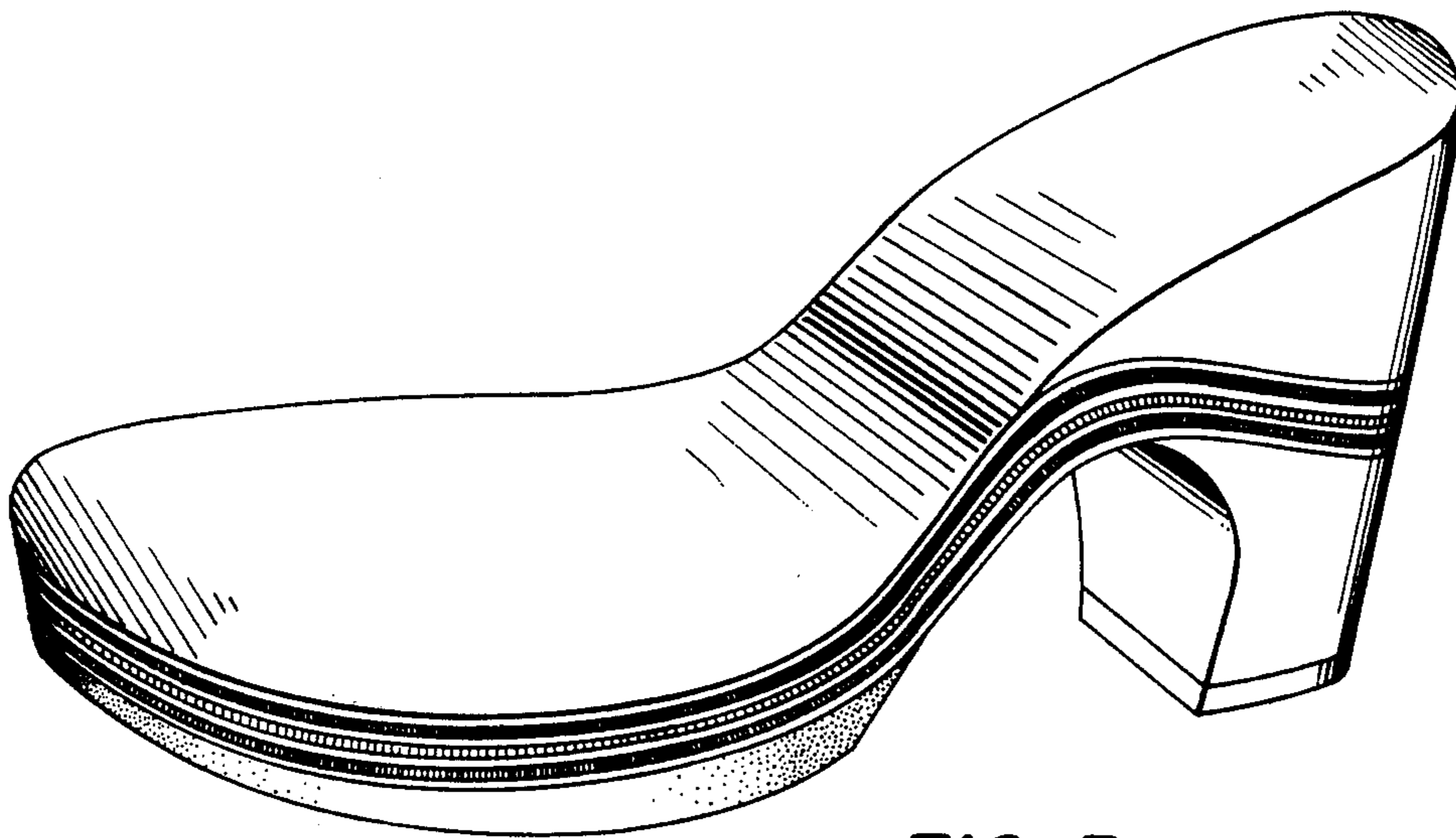

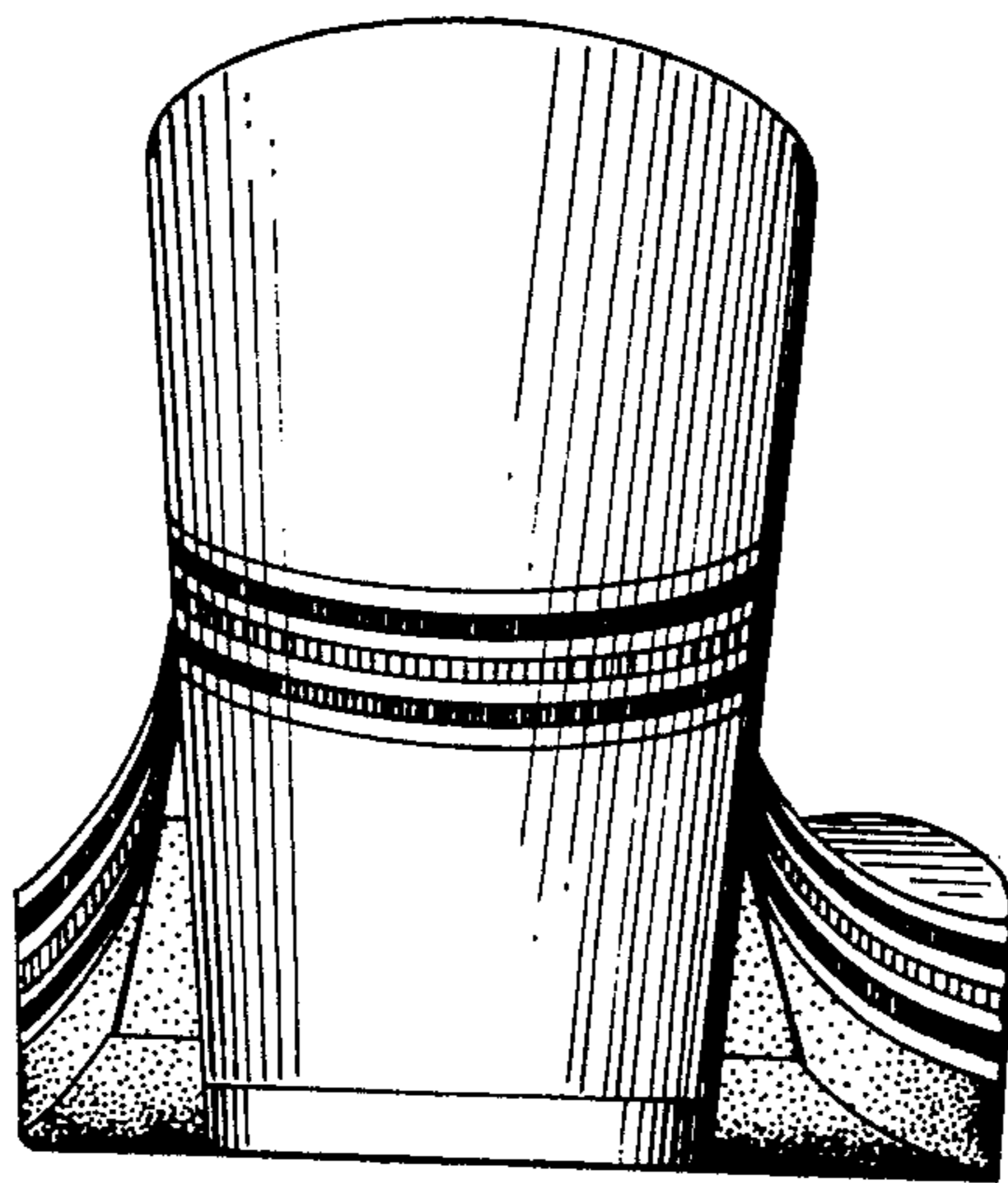
