The ornamental design for a planter bowl, substantially as shown.

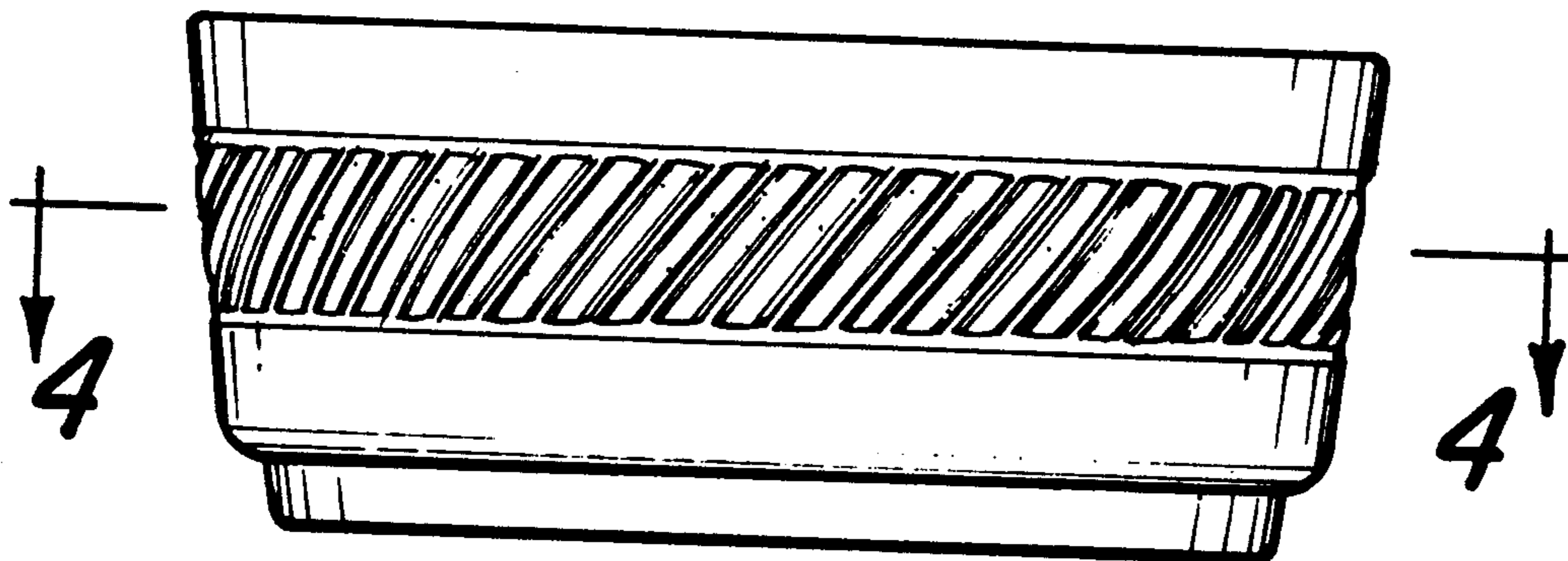
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a planter bowl embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, all sides being substantially identical;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 3.



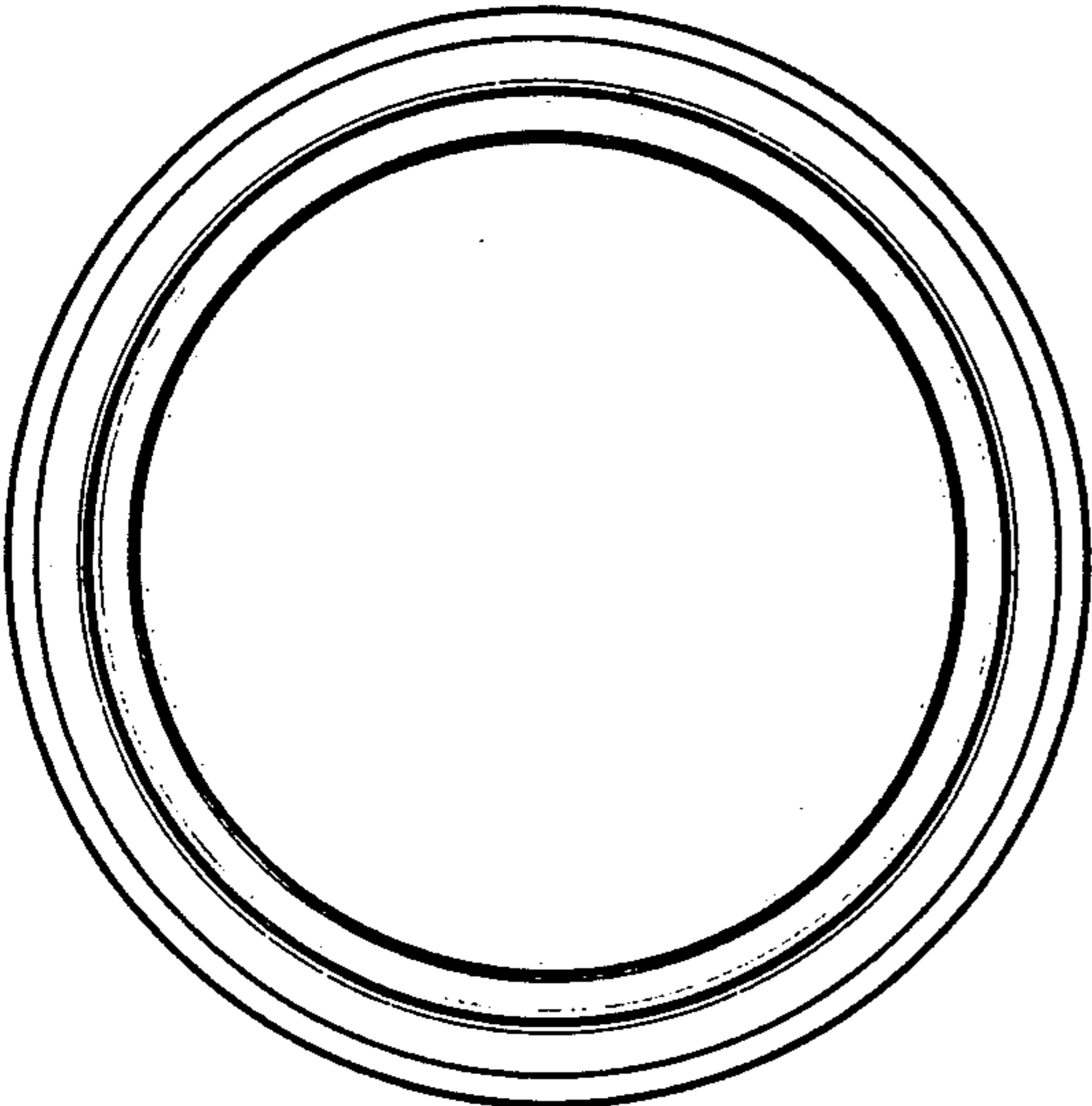

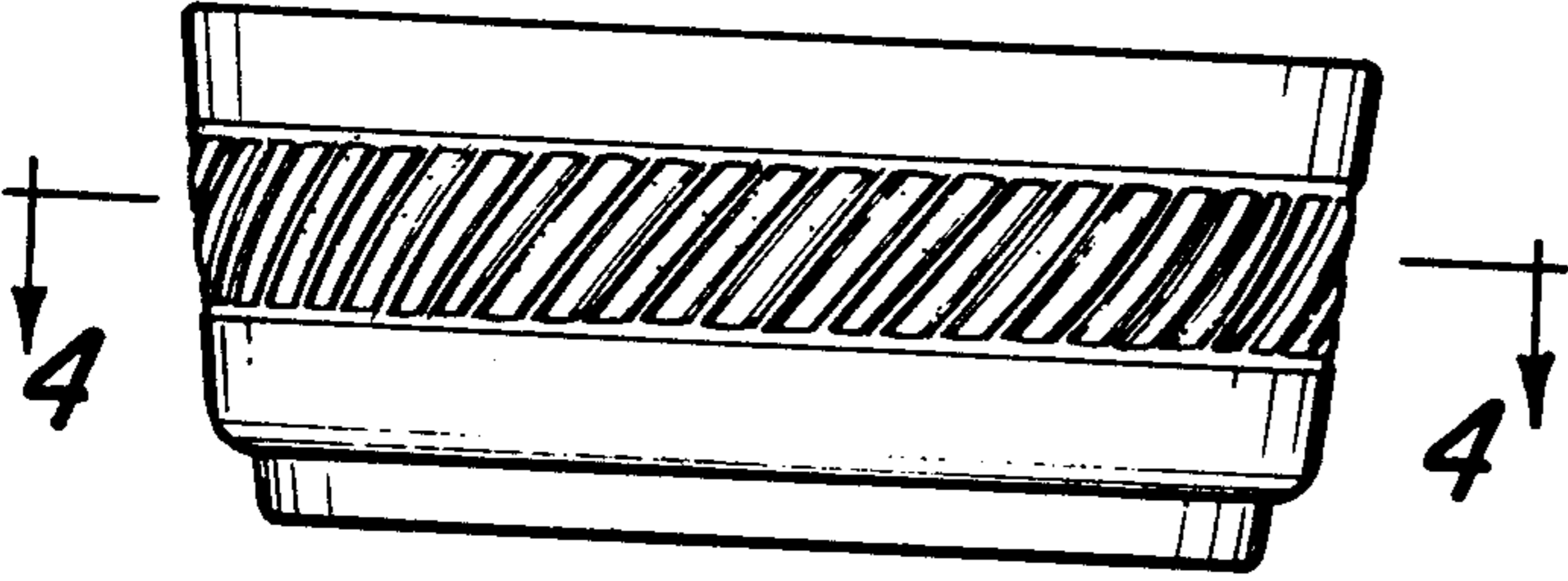
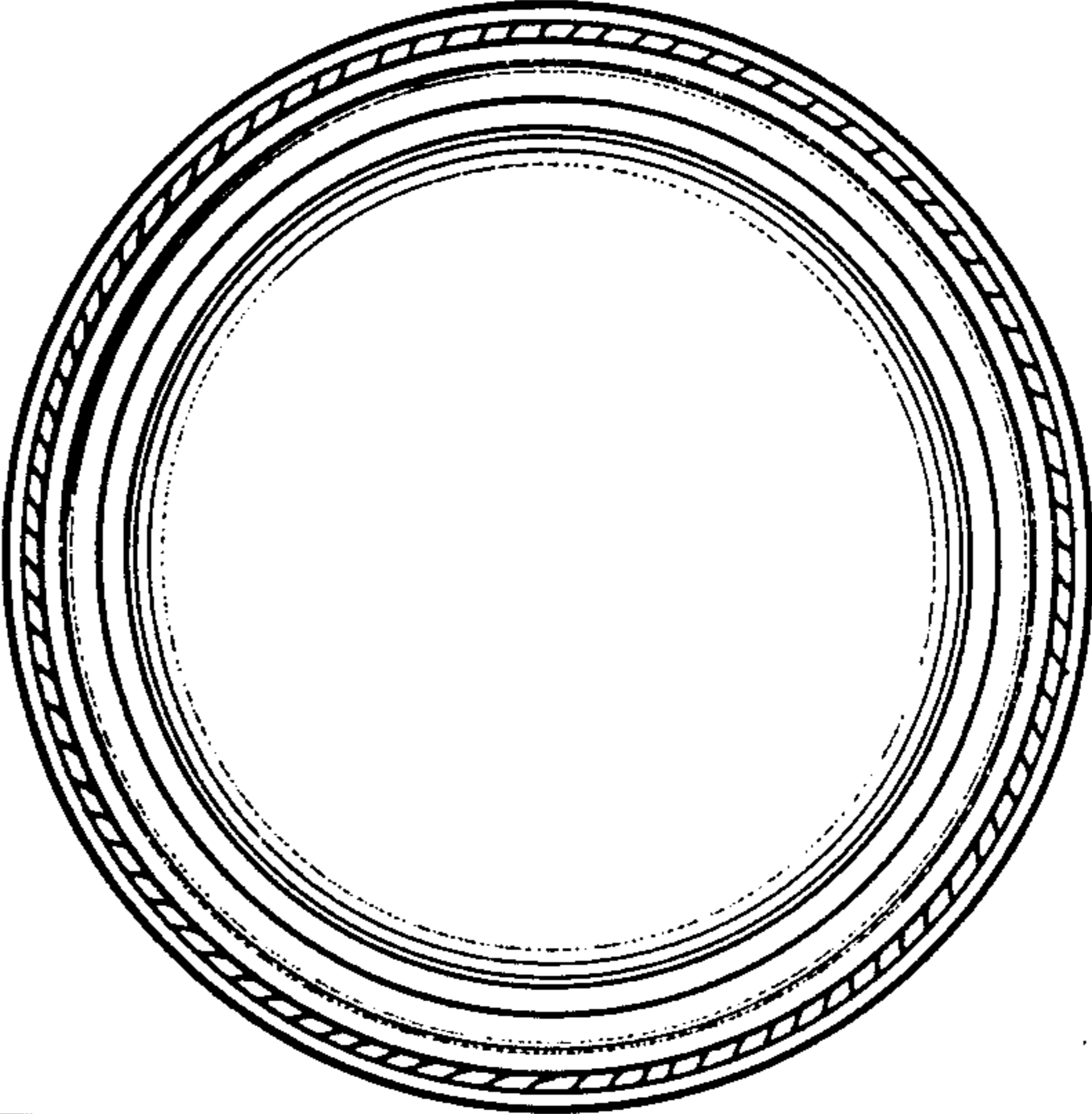
