FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the receiver in the condition in FIG. 1;

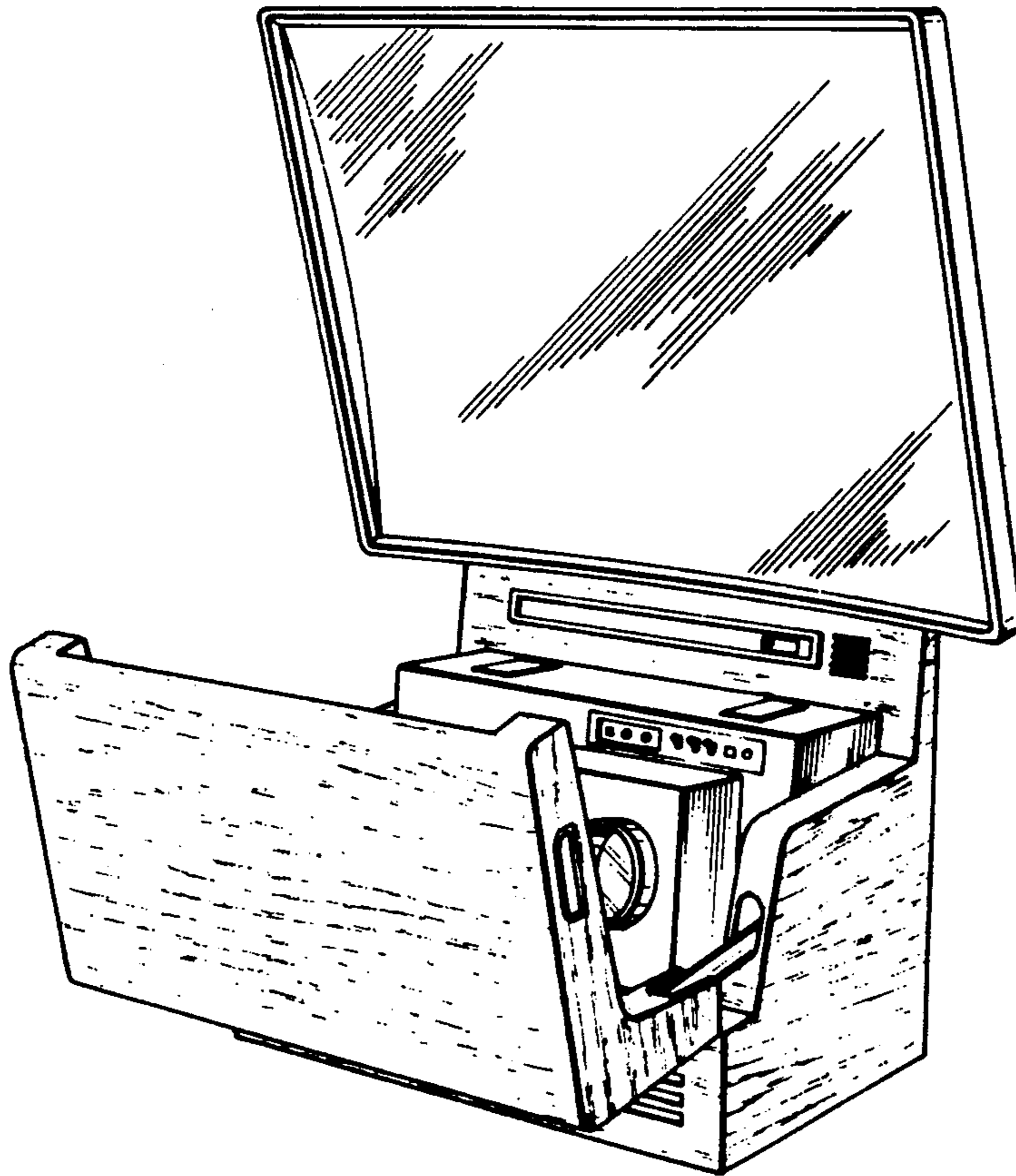
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 9 is a view similar to FIG. 7 of the receiver in the condition of FIG. 2.

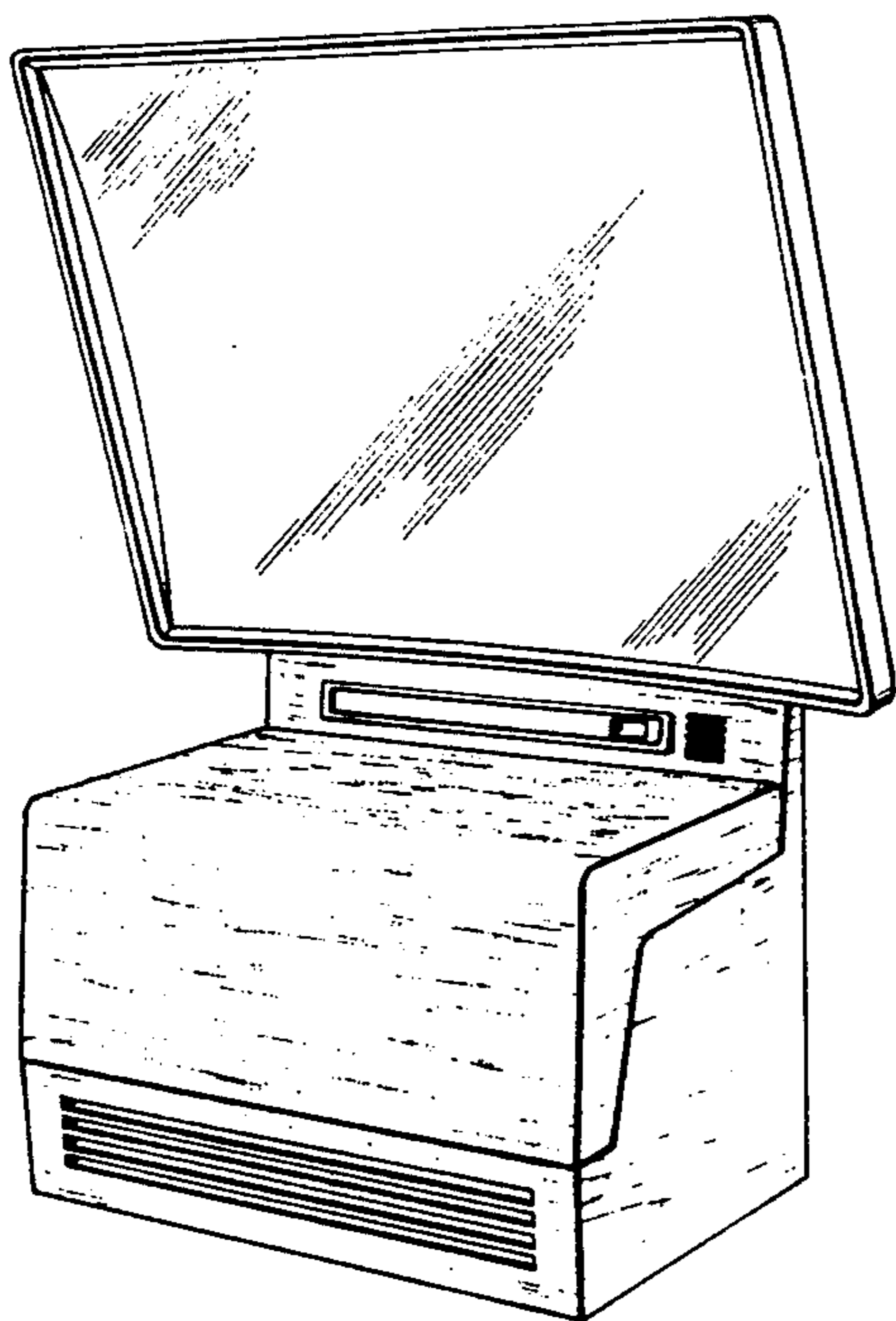

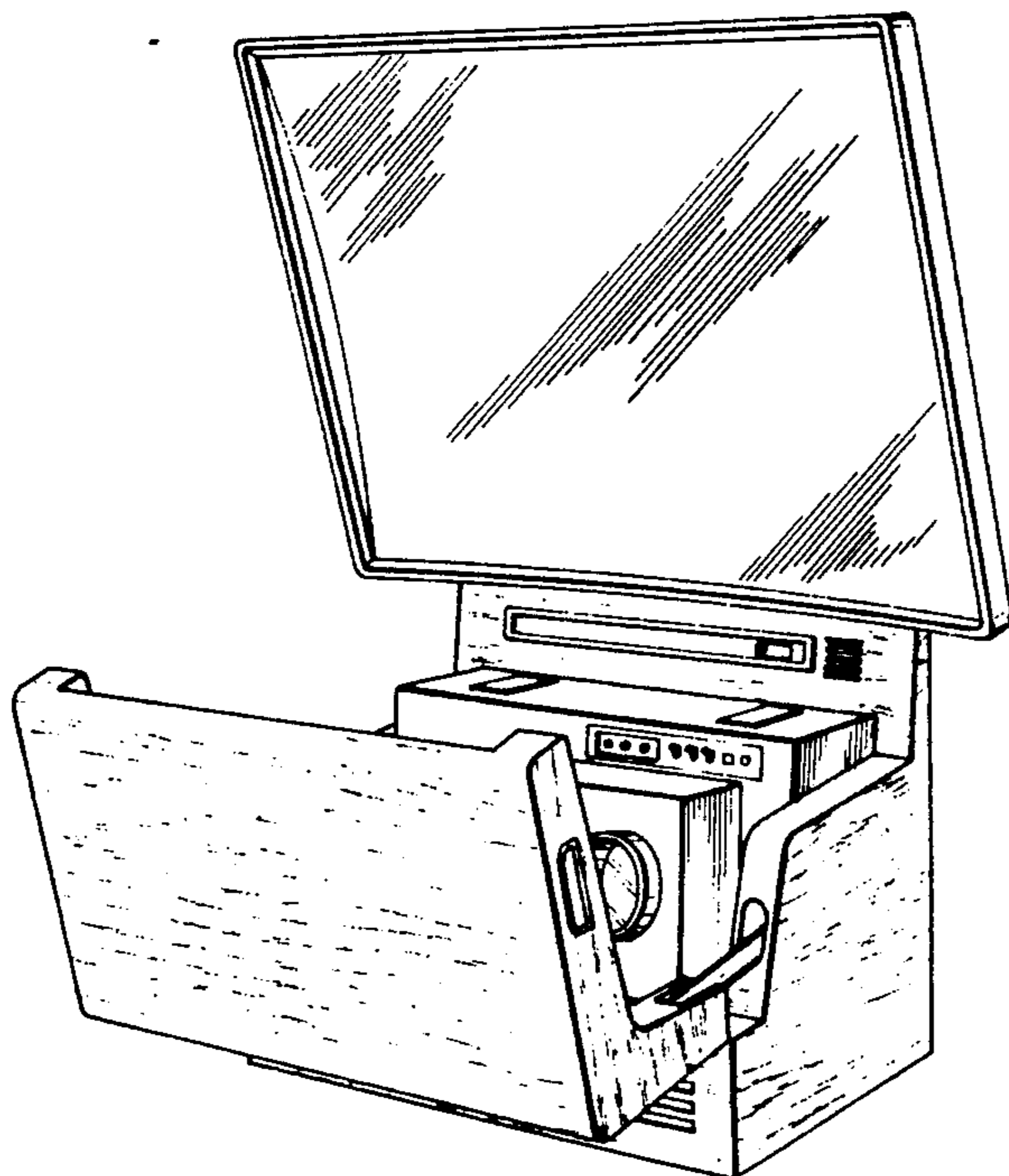

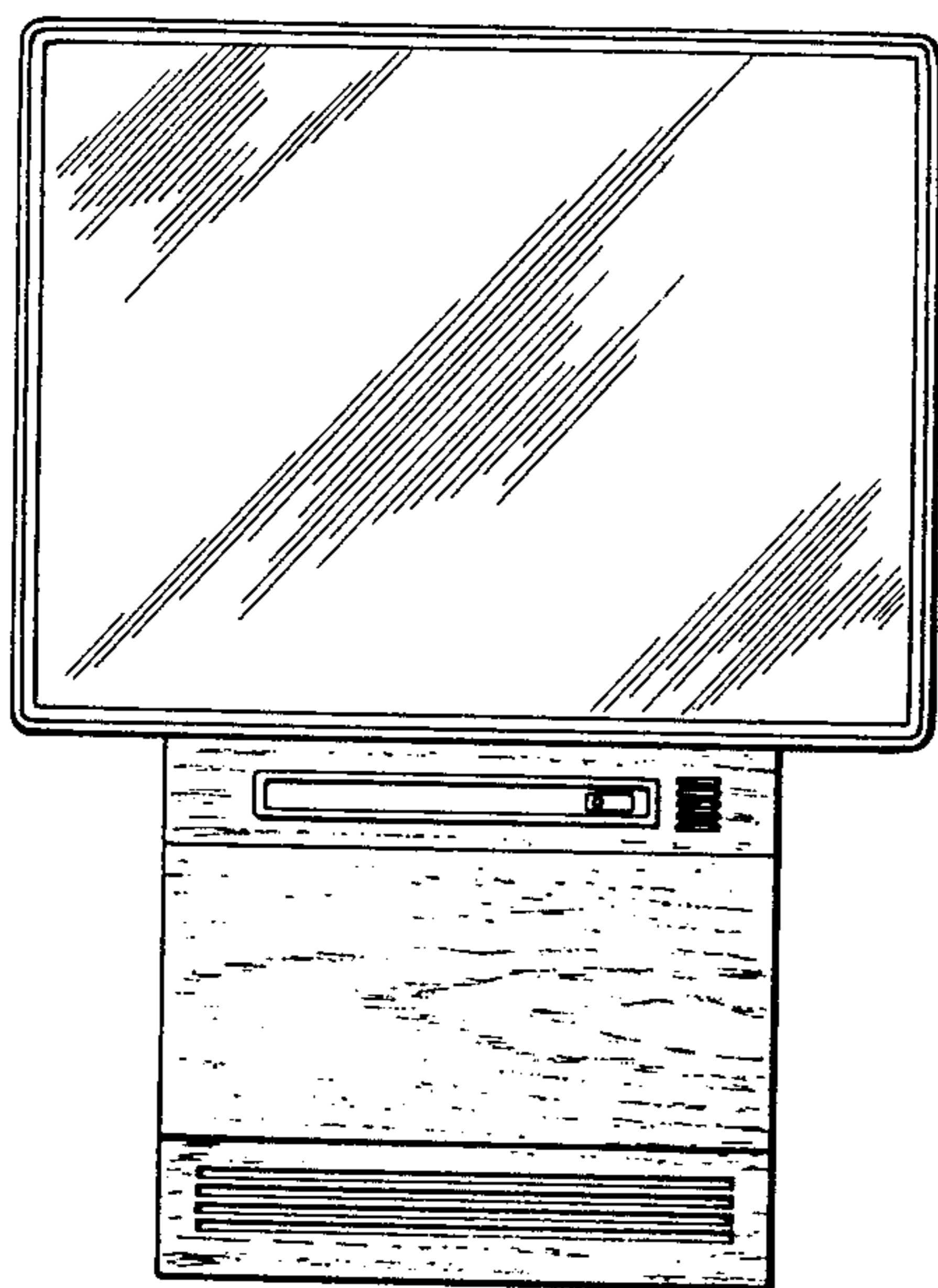

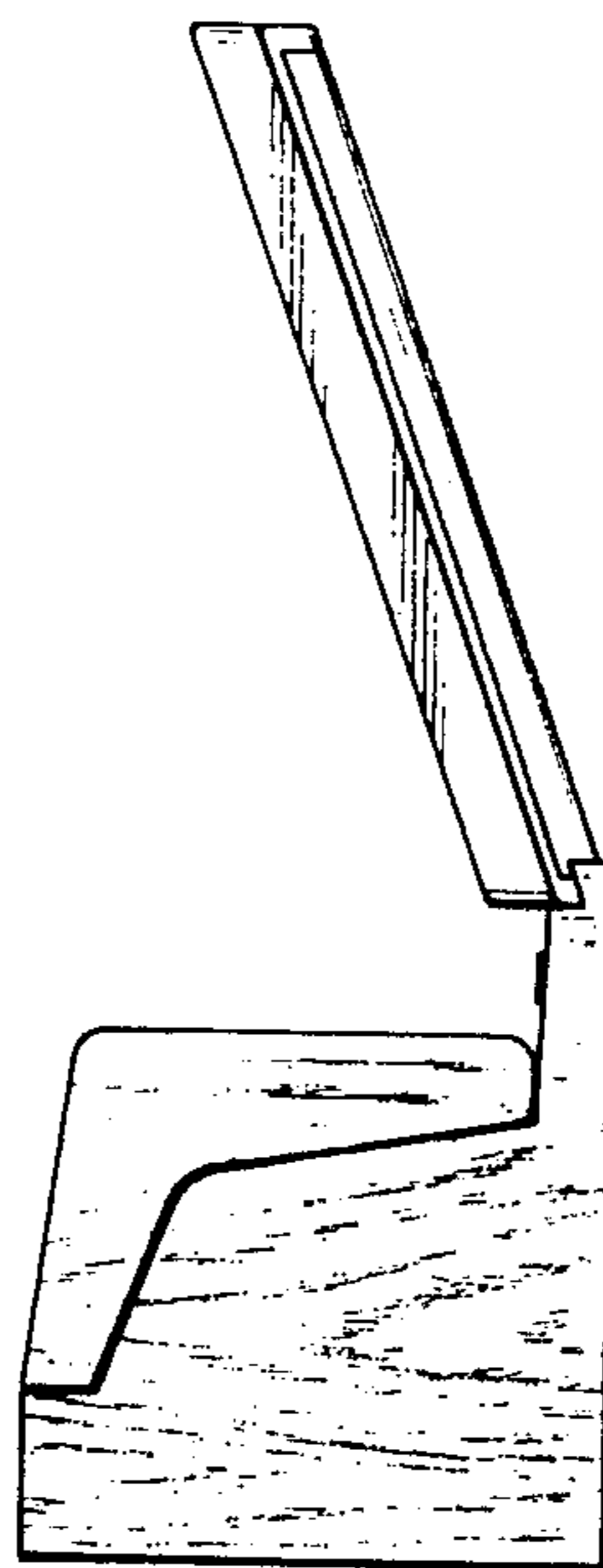

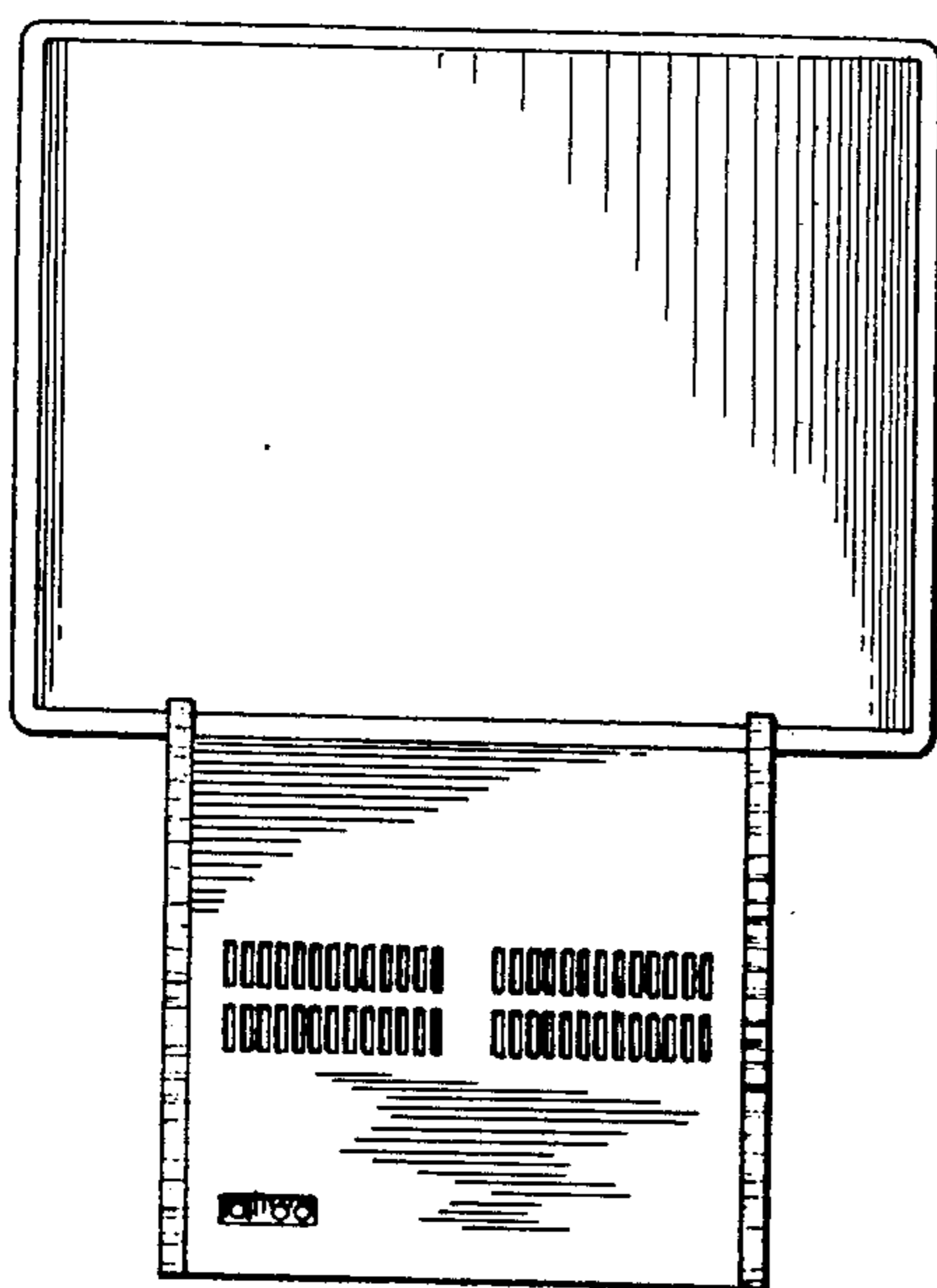
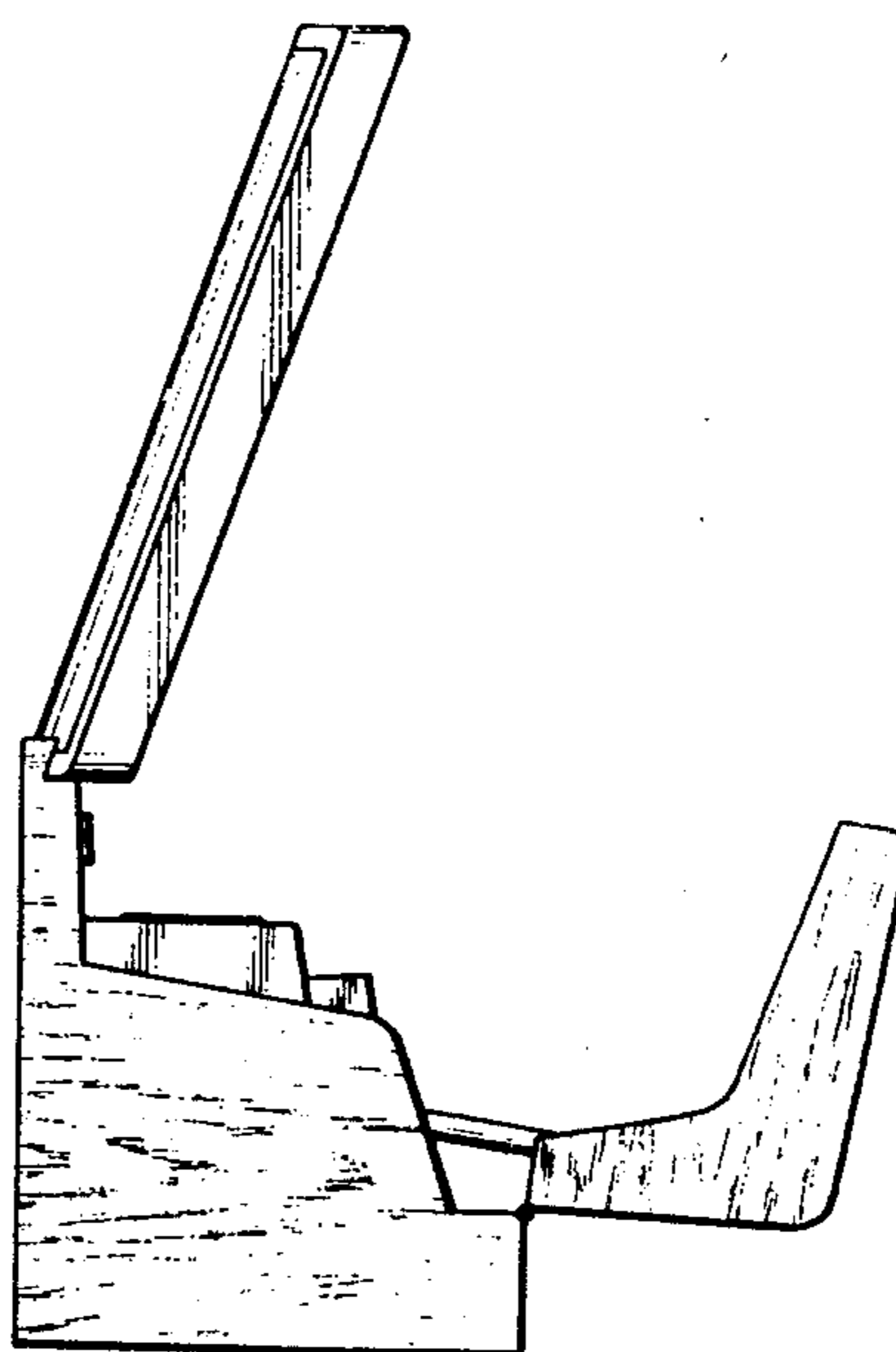
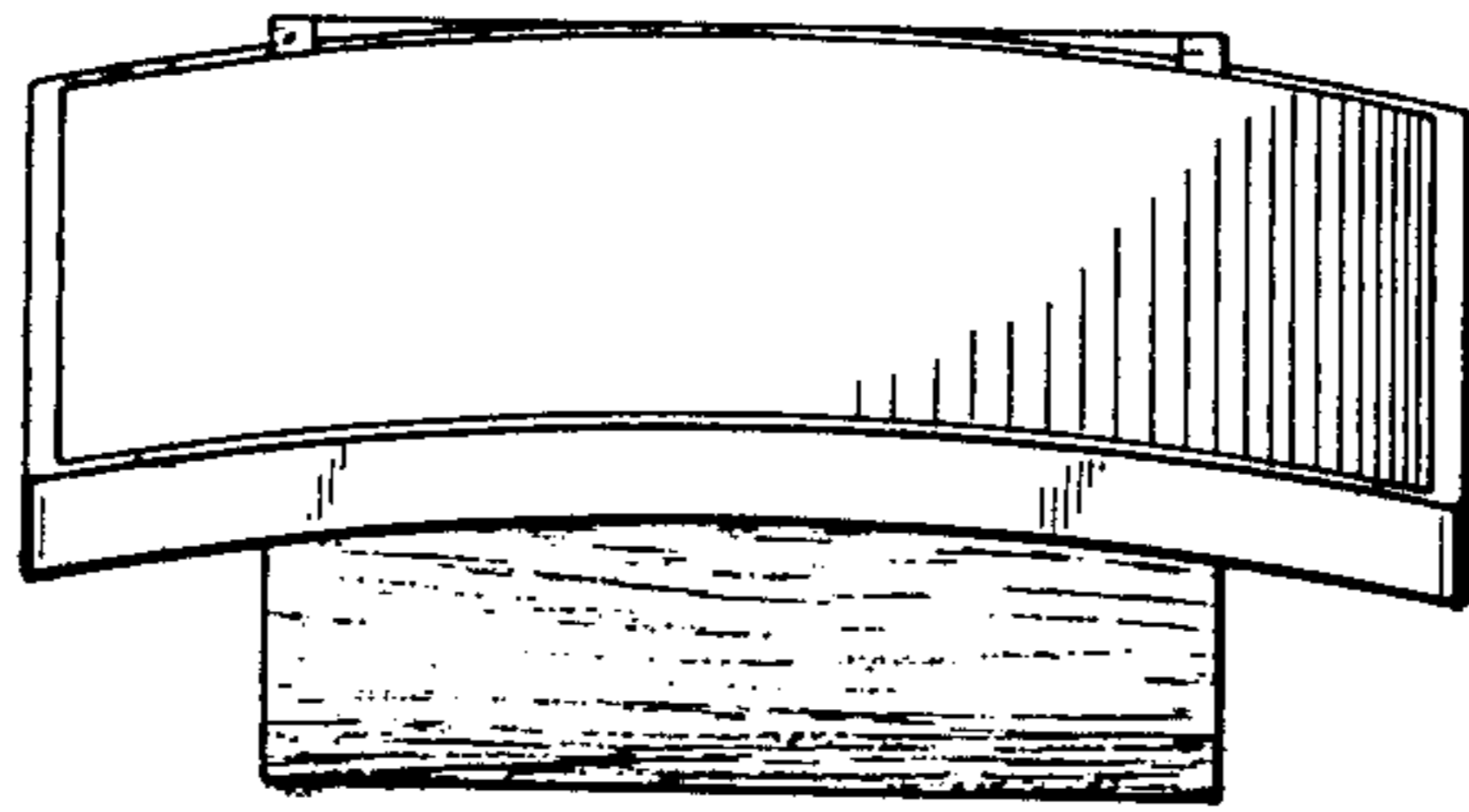


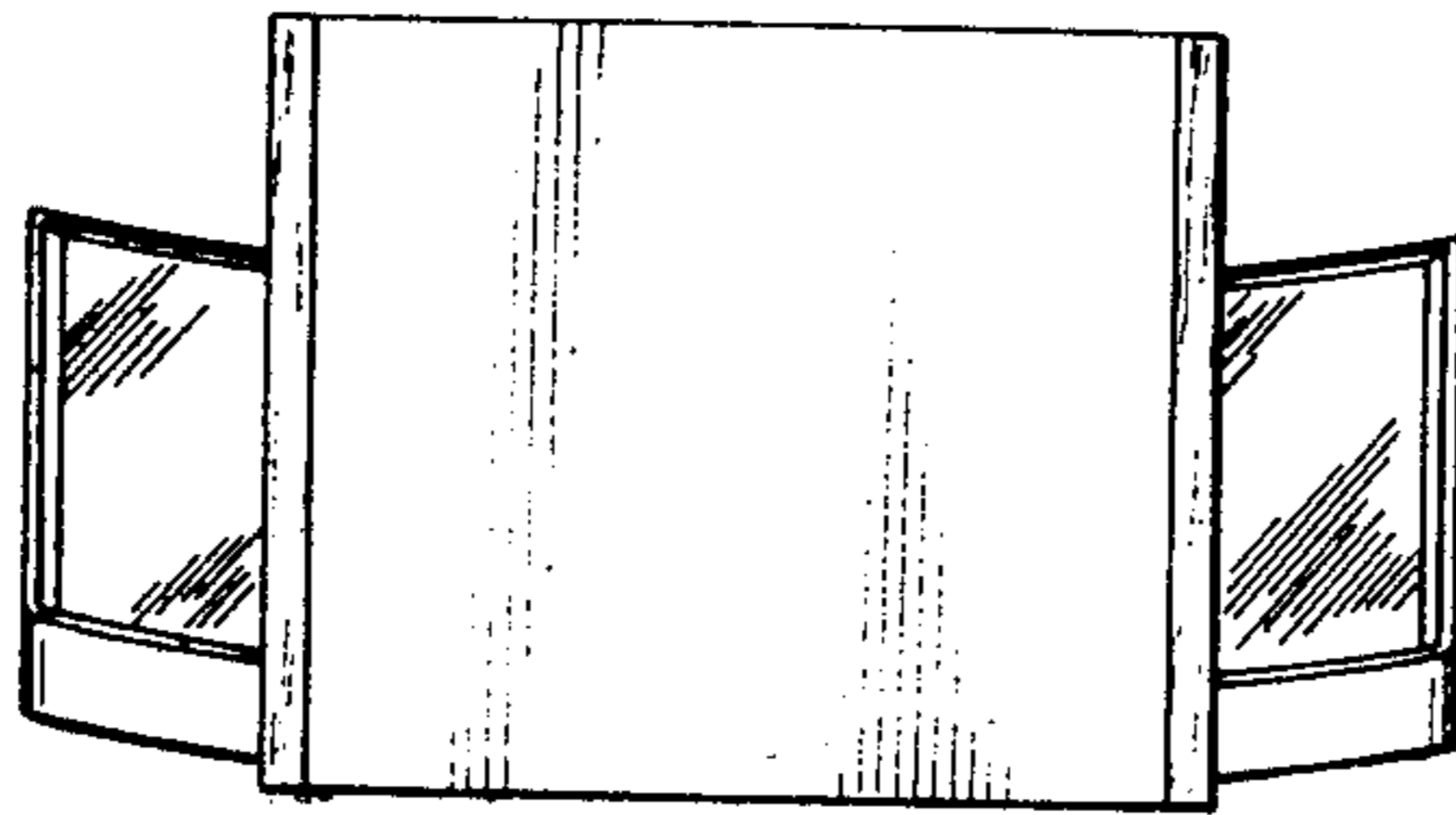
