[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dollhouse, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first perspective view of a dollhouse embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof shown on a reduced scale.

The surface textures partially indicated on the roof and exterior wall members represent an overall pattern on those surfaces.

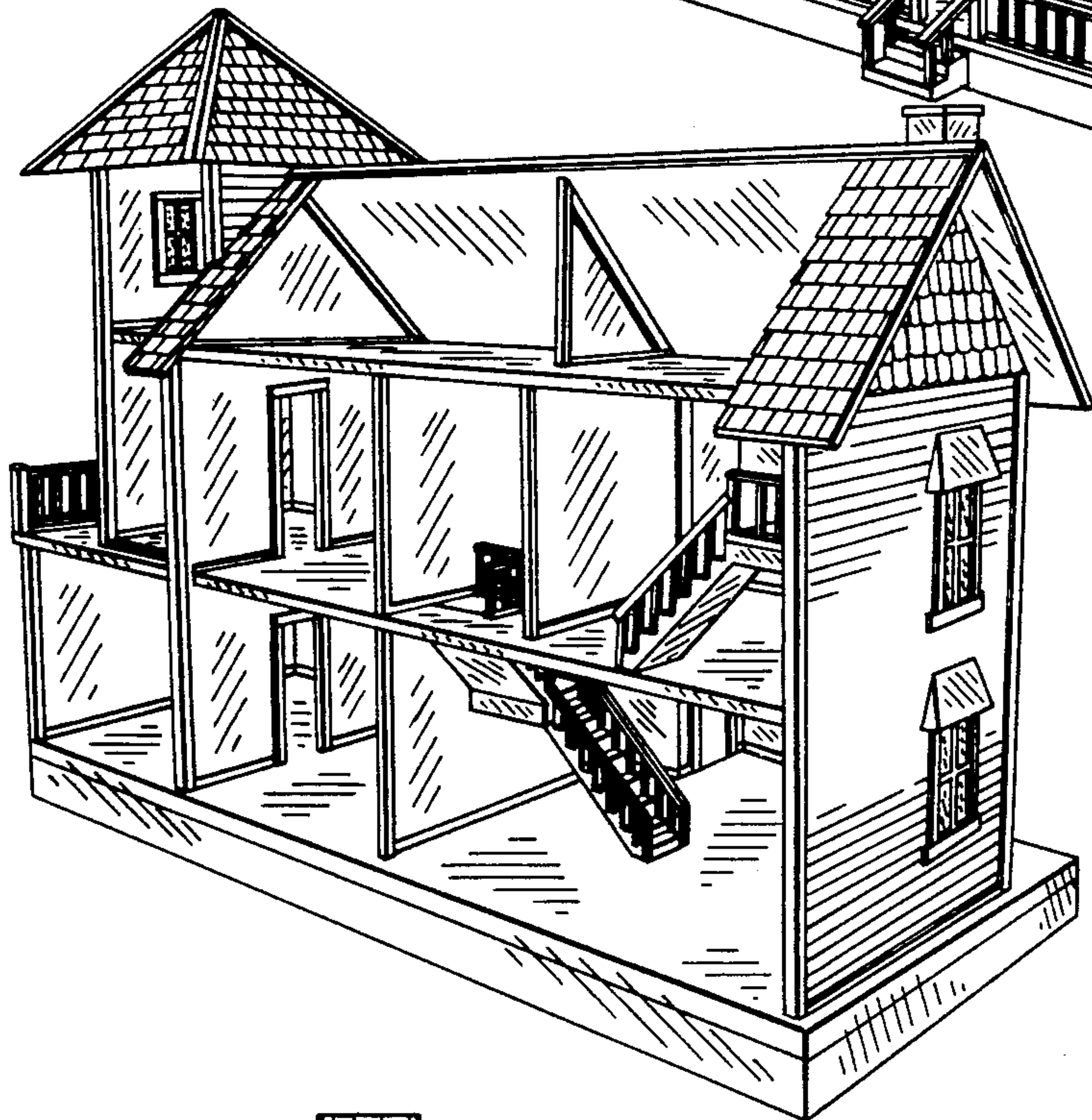
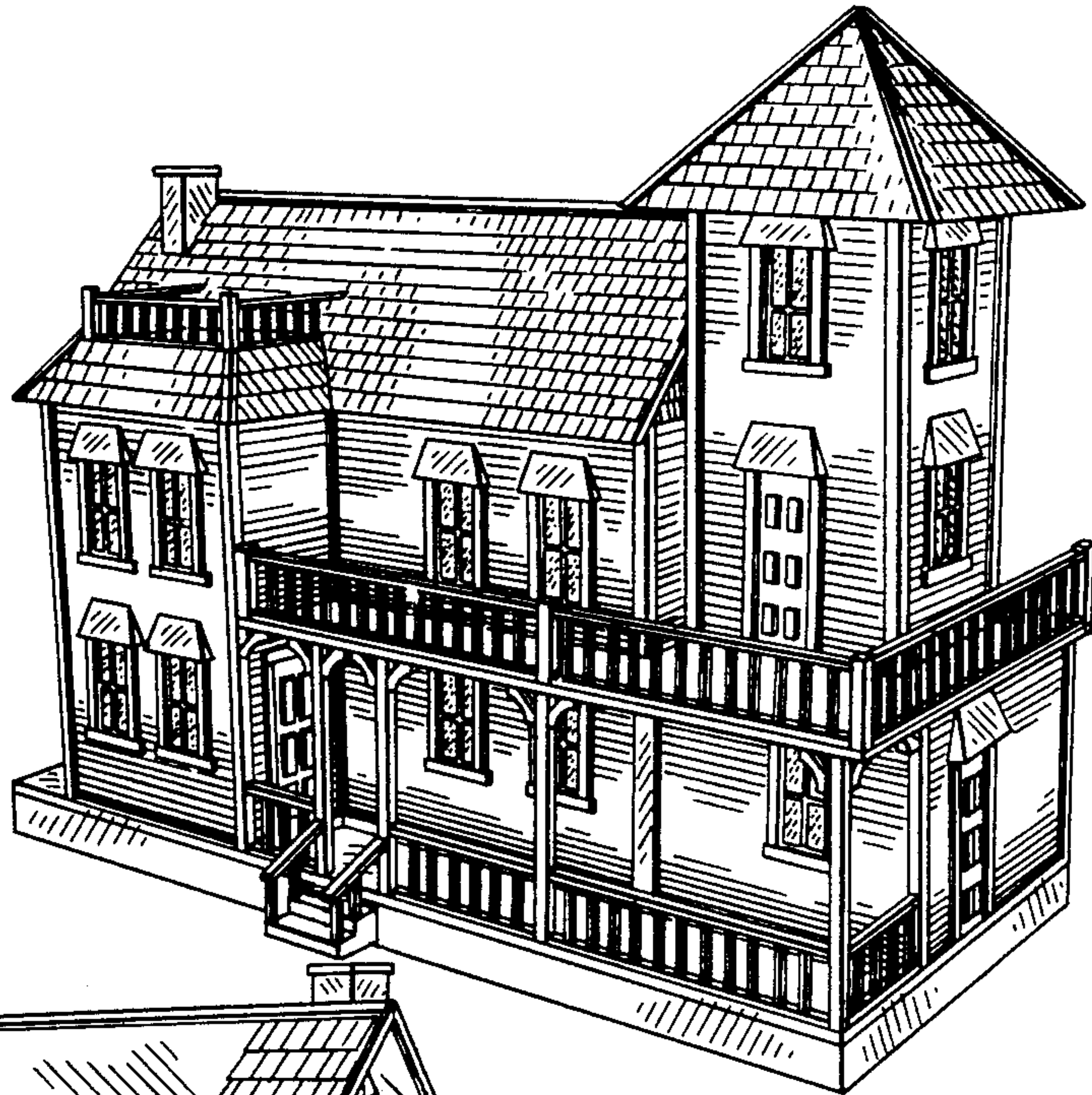

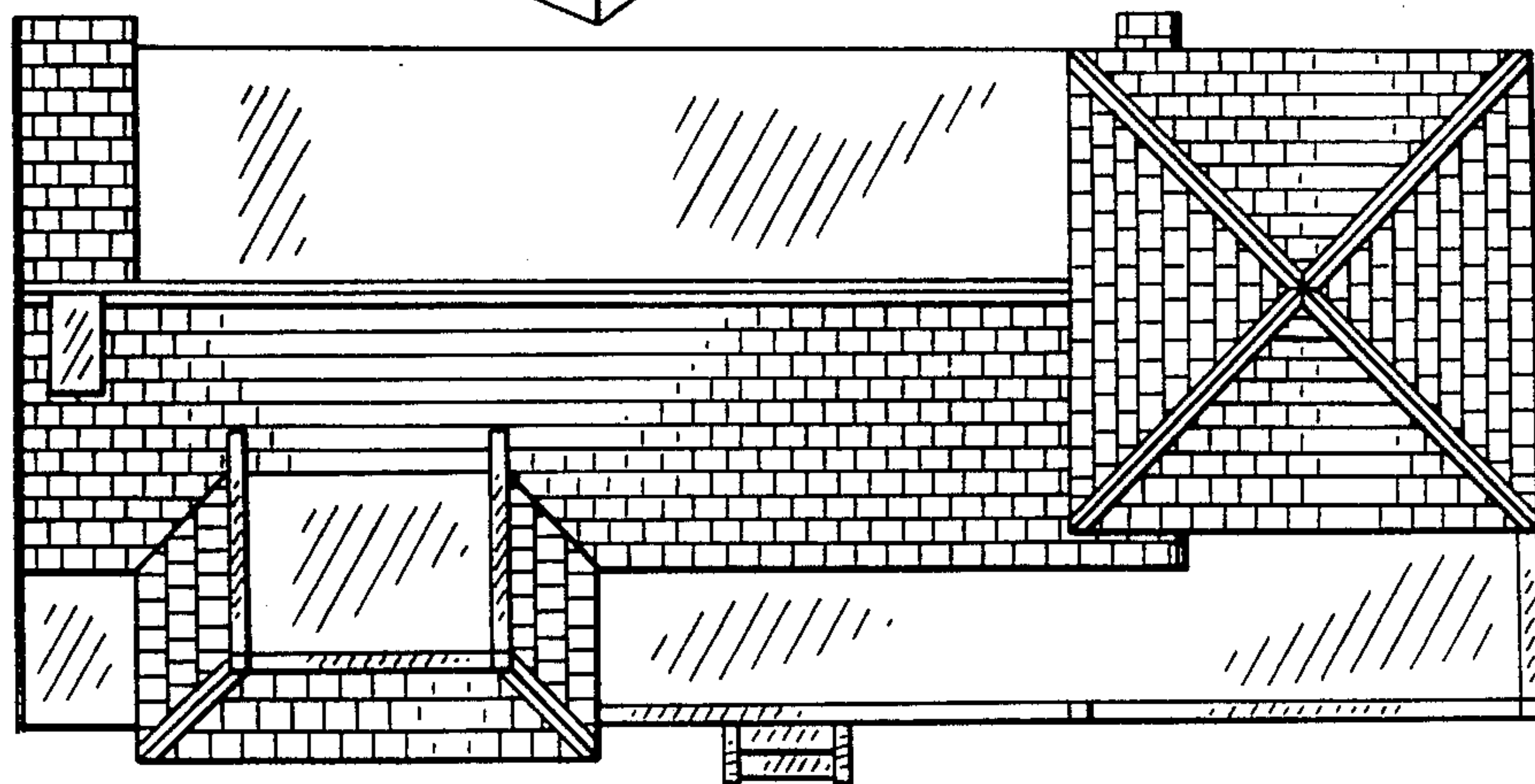

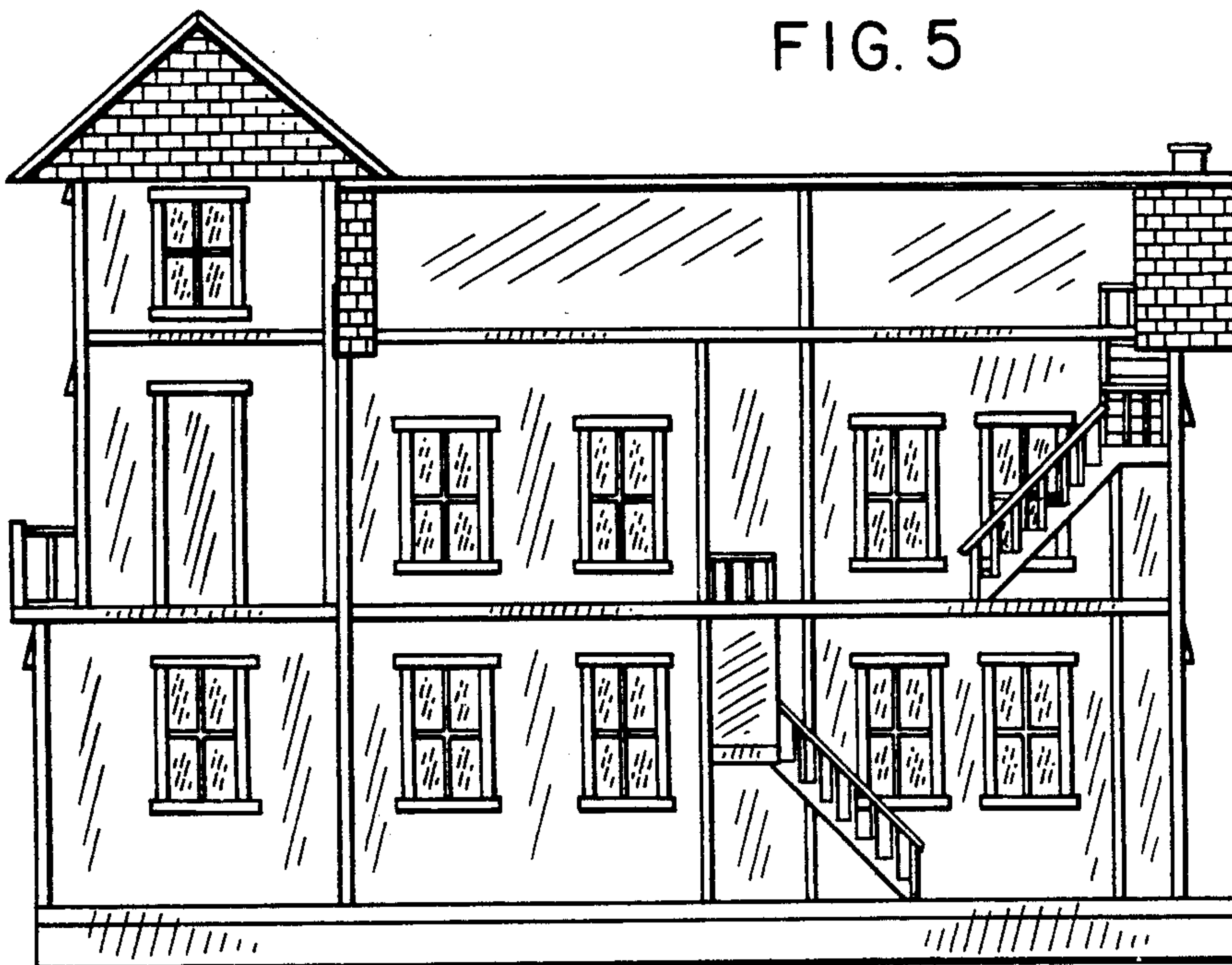

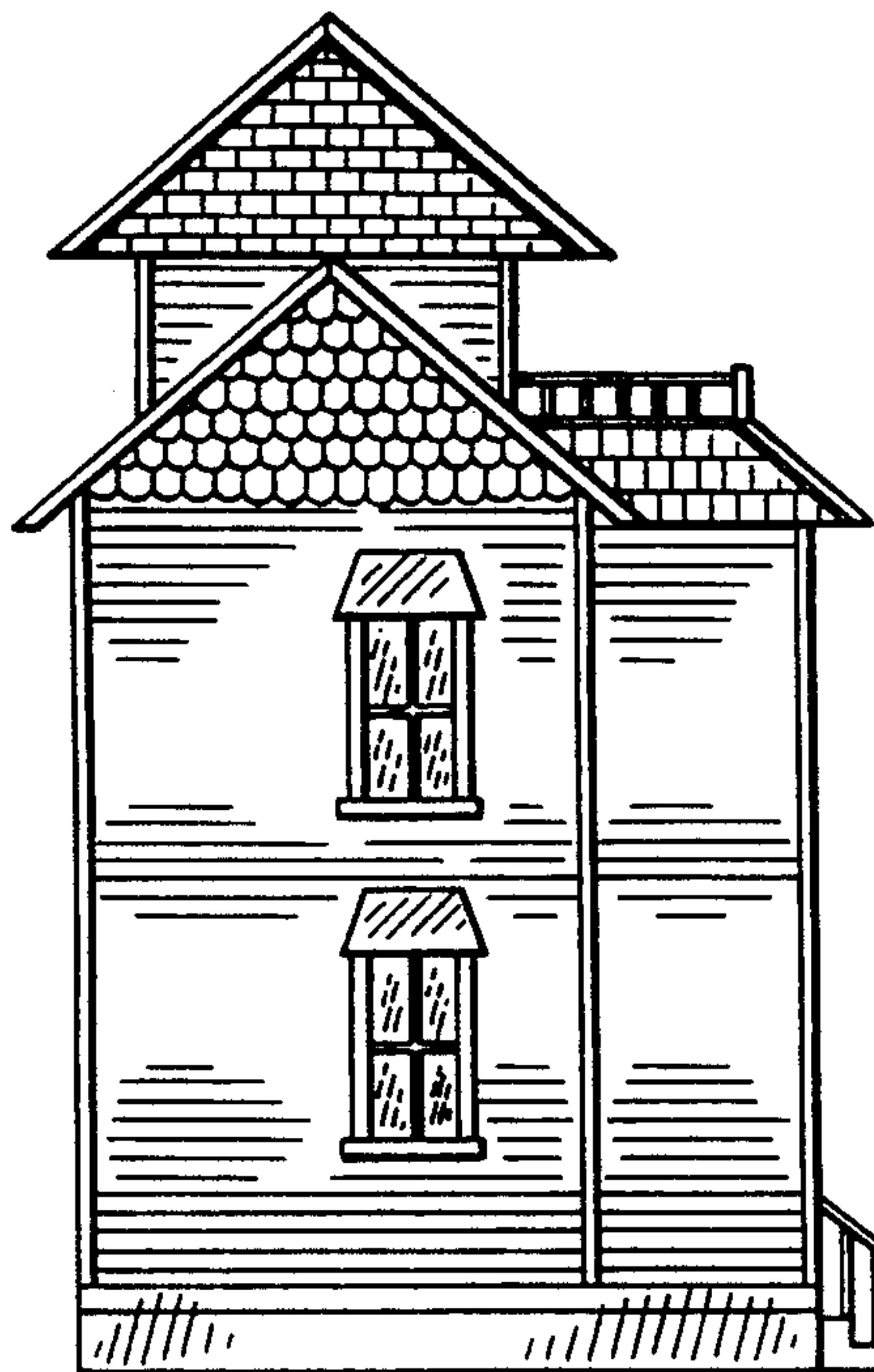
