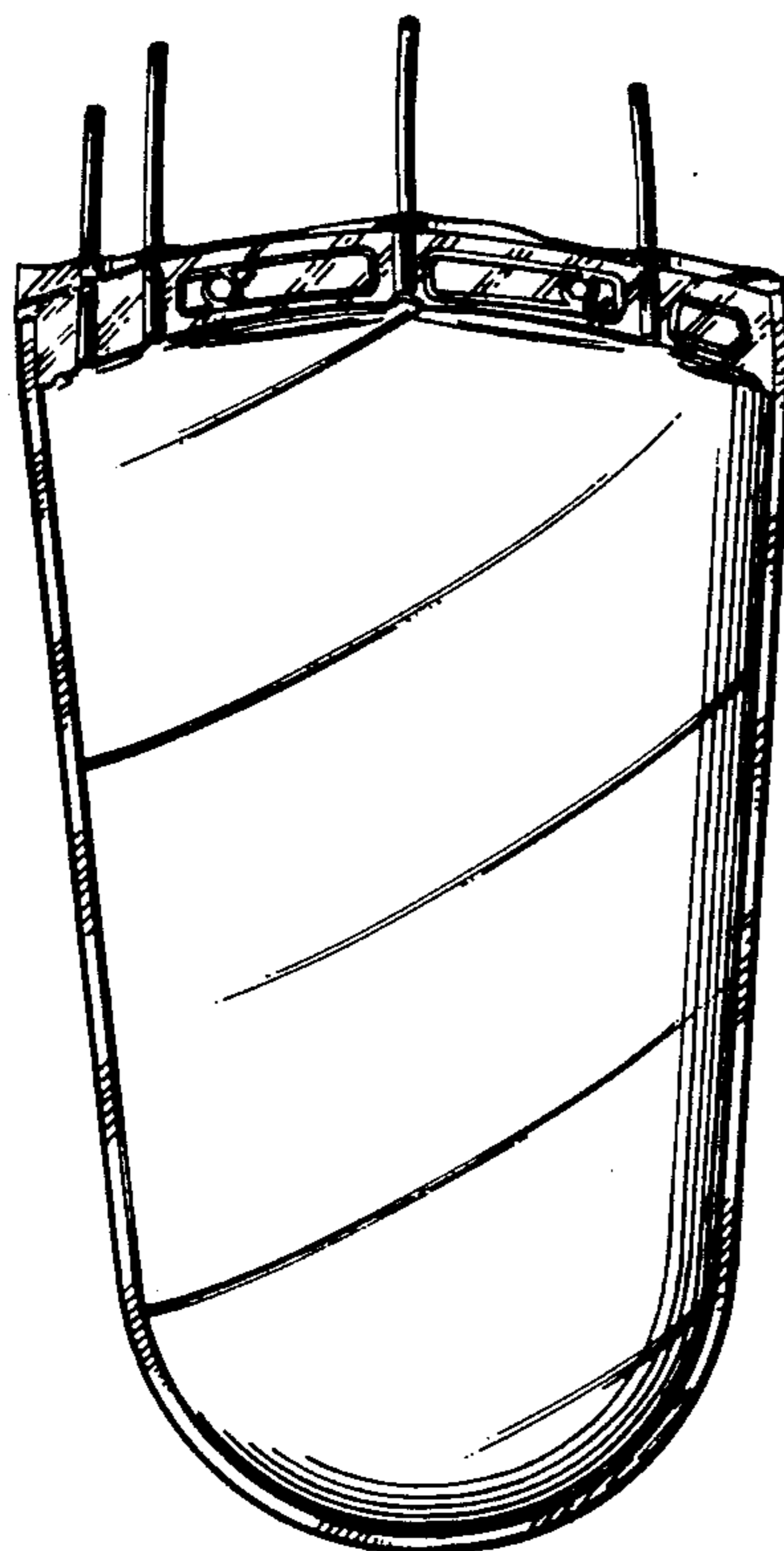

FIG. 1 is a front view of our ornamental design for a blood processing container; FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.



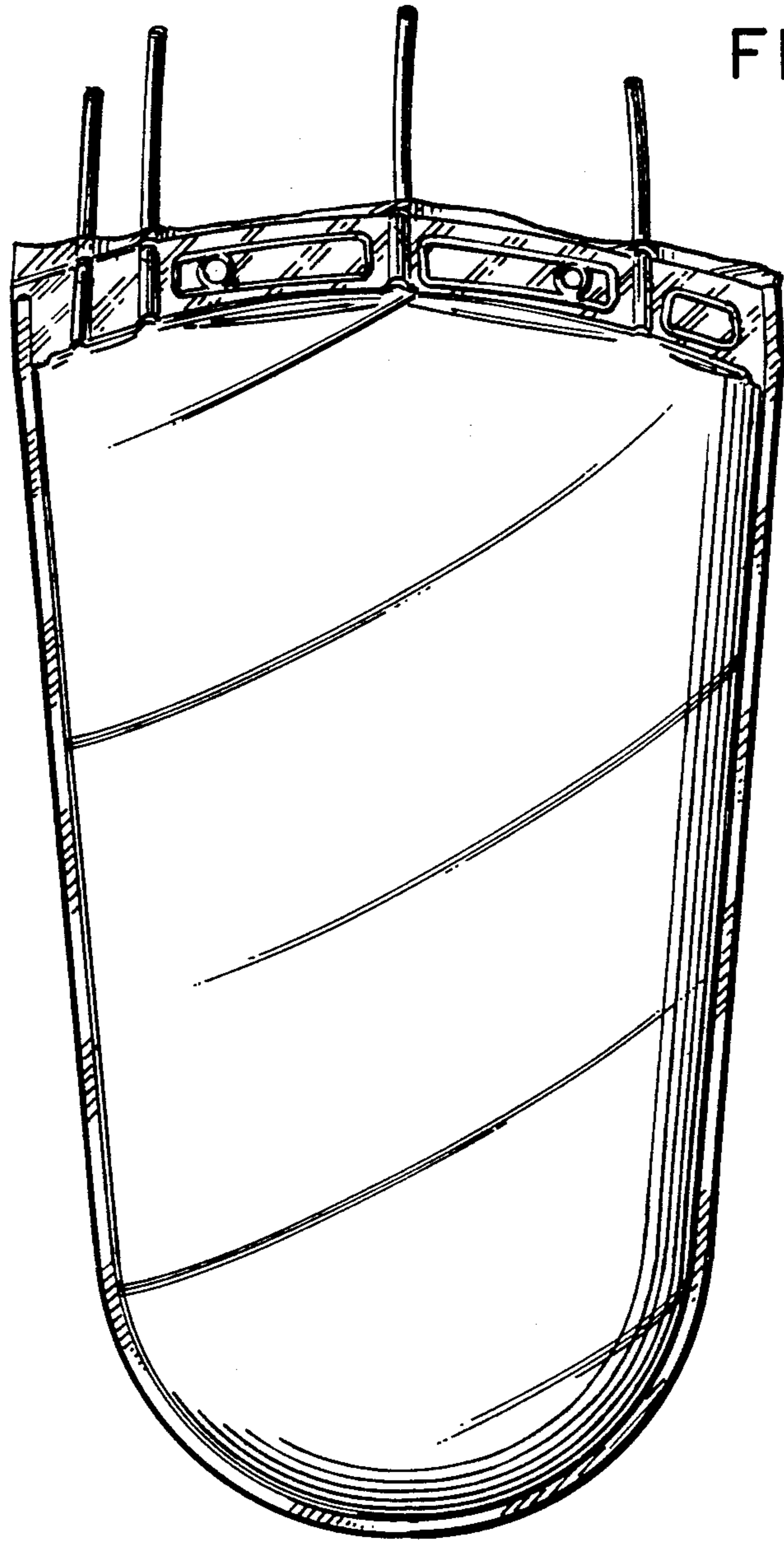
