DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lighted traveling mirror showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof in an open position;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof in another open position; and
FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof in still another open position.

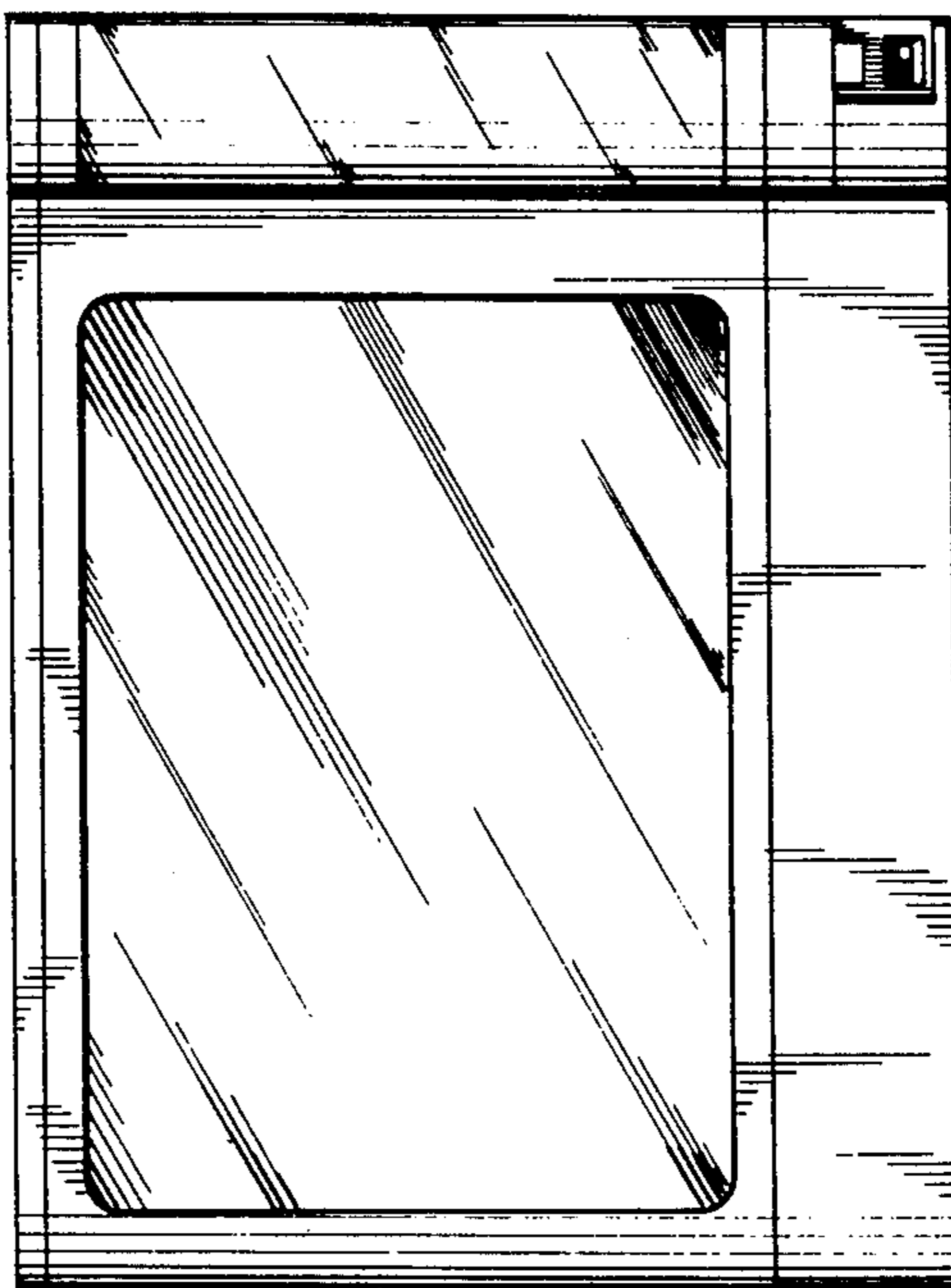

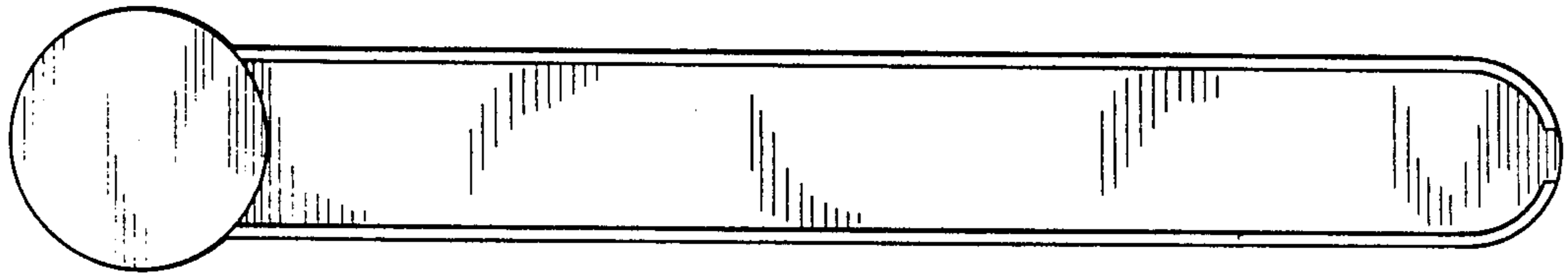

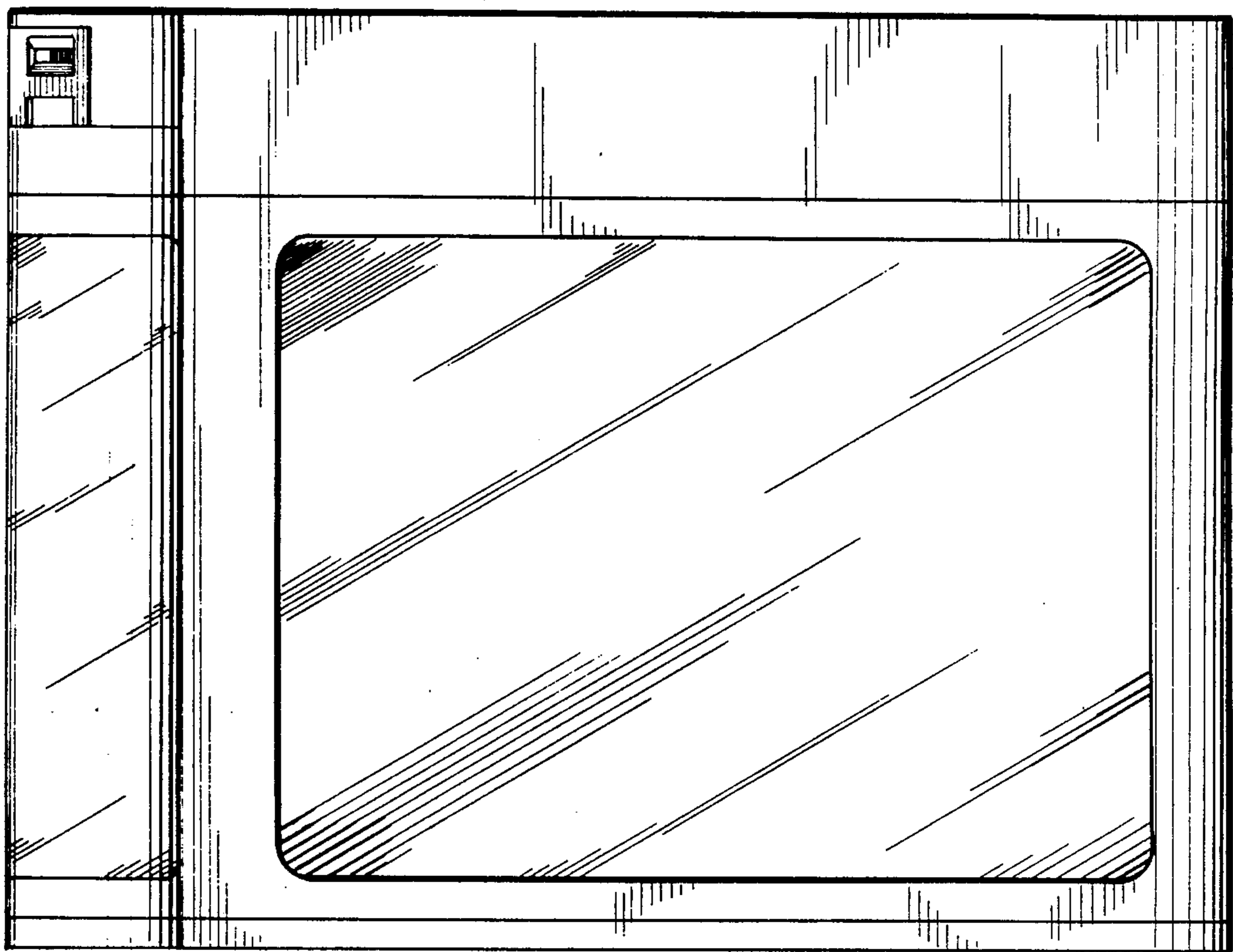

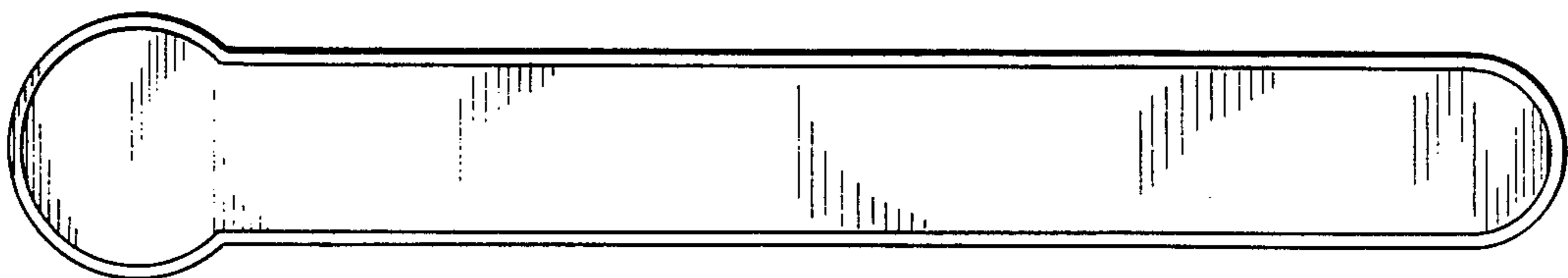

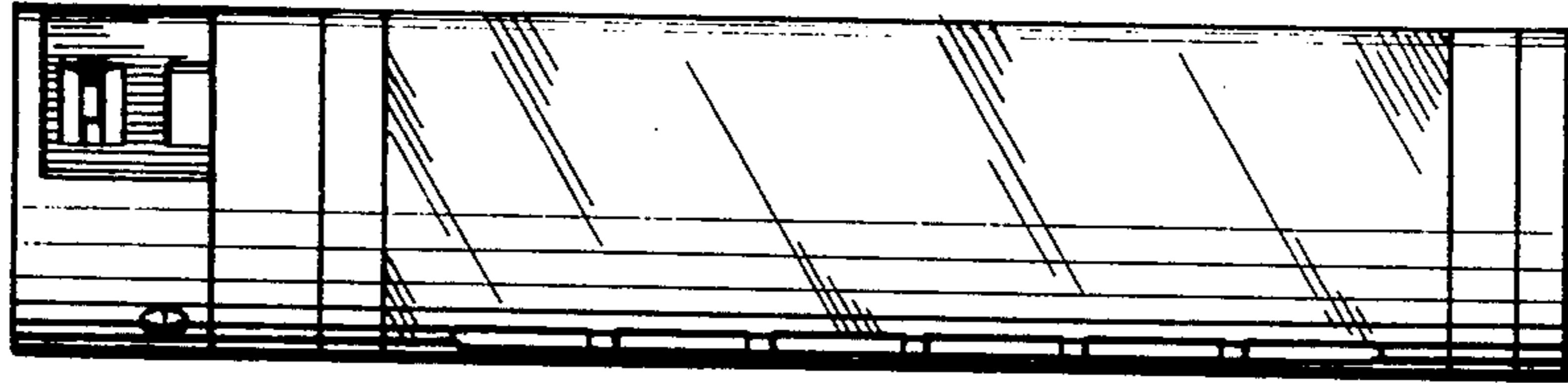

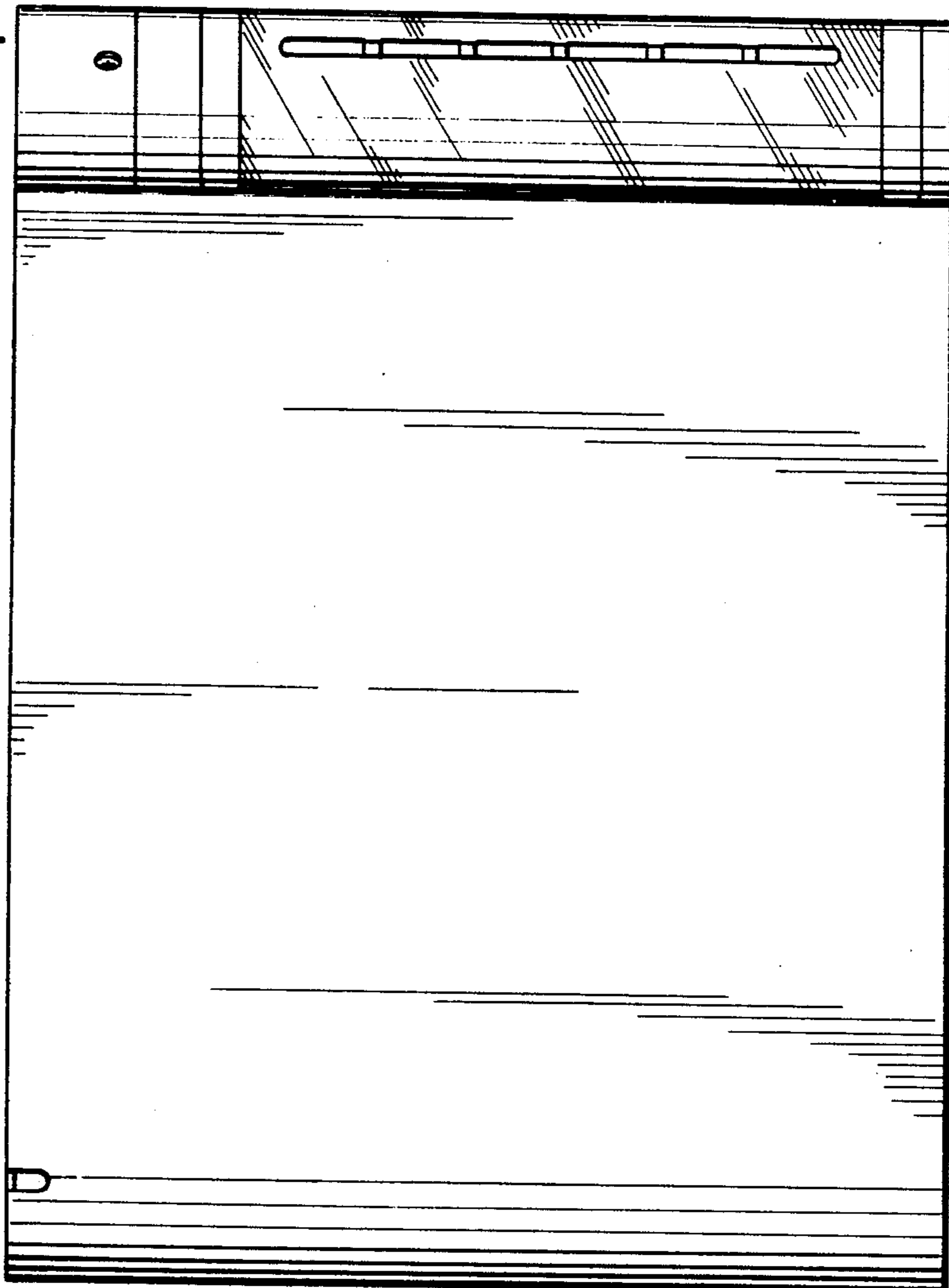

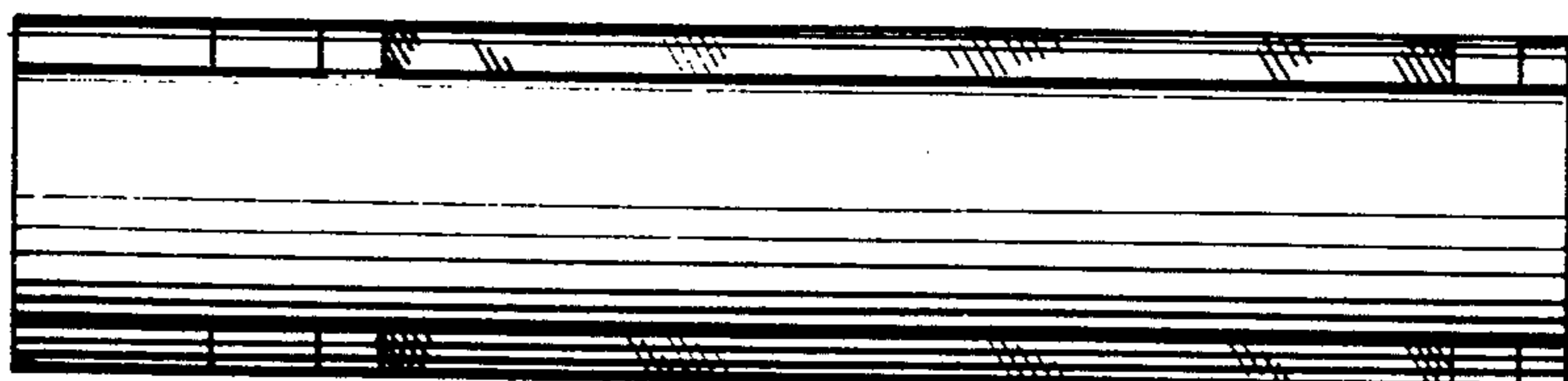

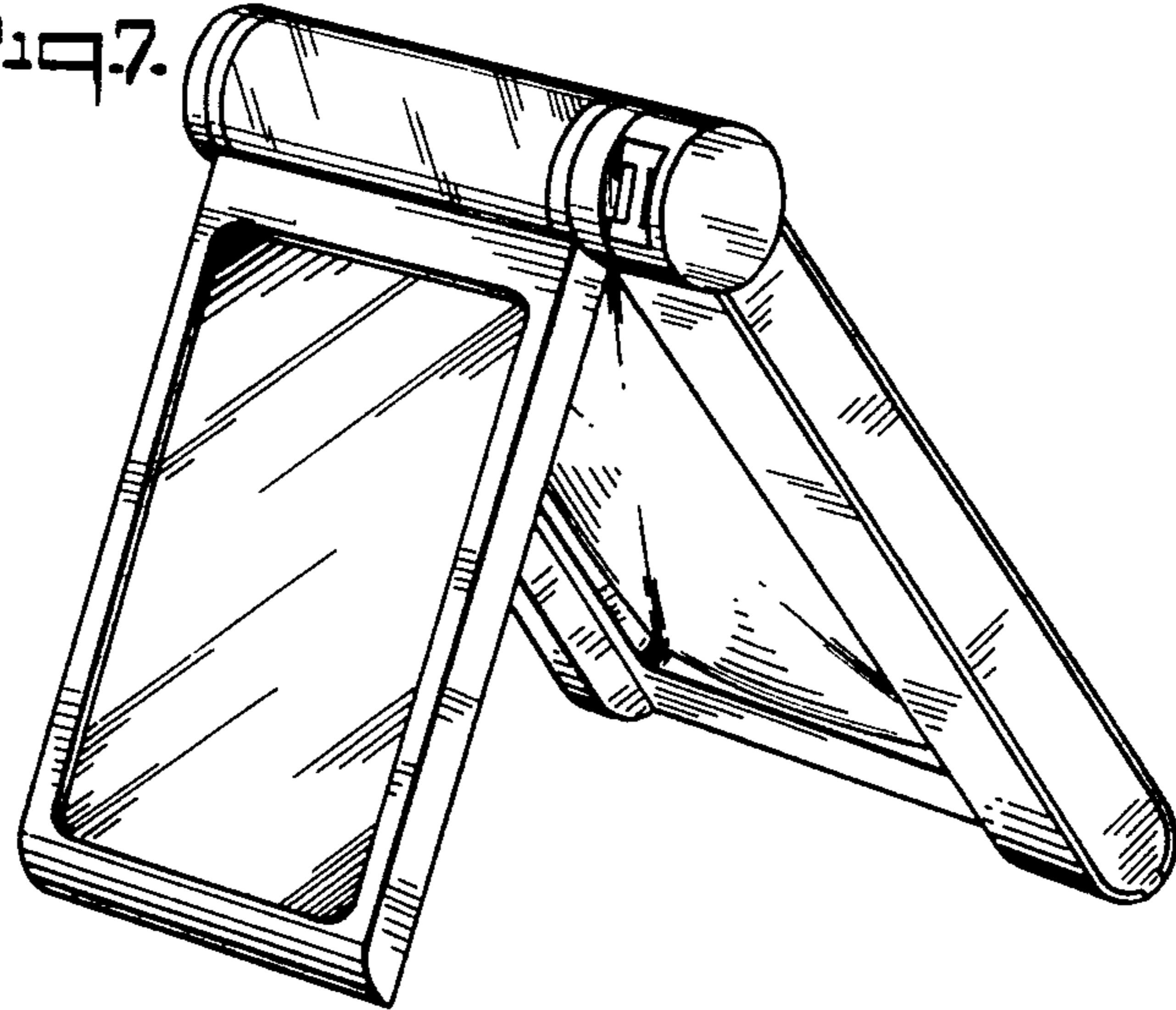

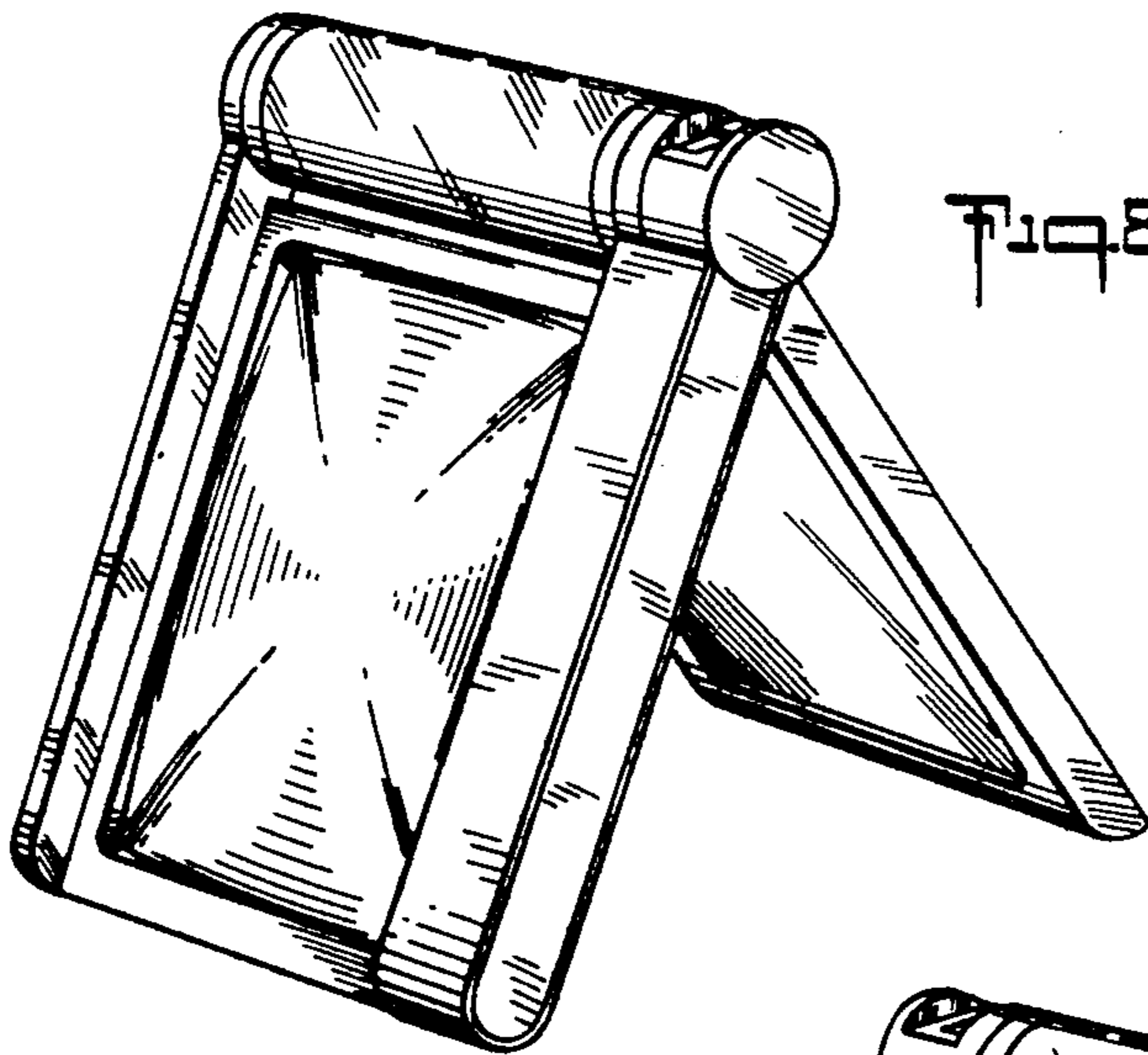
