[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a blow-through fireplace poker, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a blow-through fireplace poker showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary side elevational view of the lower end thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a fragmentary rear elevational view taken on the plane of line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary front elevational view taken on the plane of line 6—6 of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a fragmentary elevational view taken on the plane of line 7—7 of FIG. 1.
