FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a case for an electronic learning aid, game or similar apparatus showing our new design;

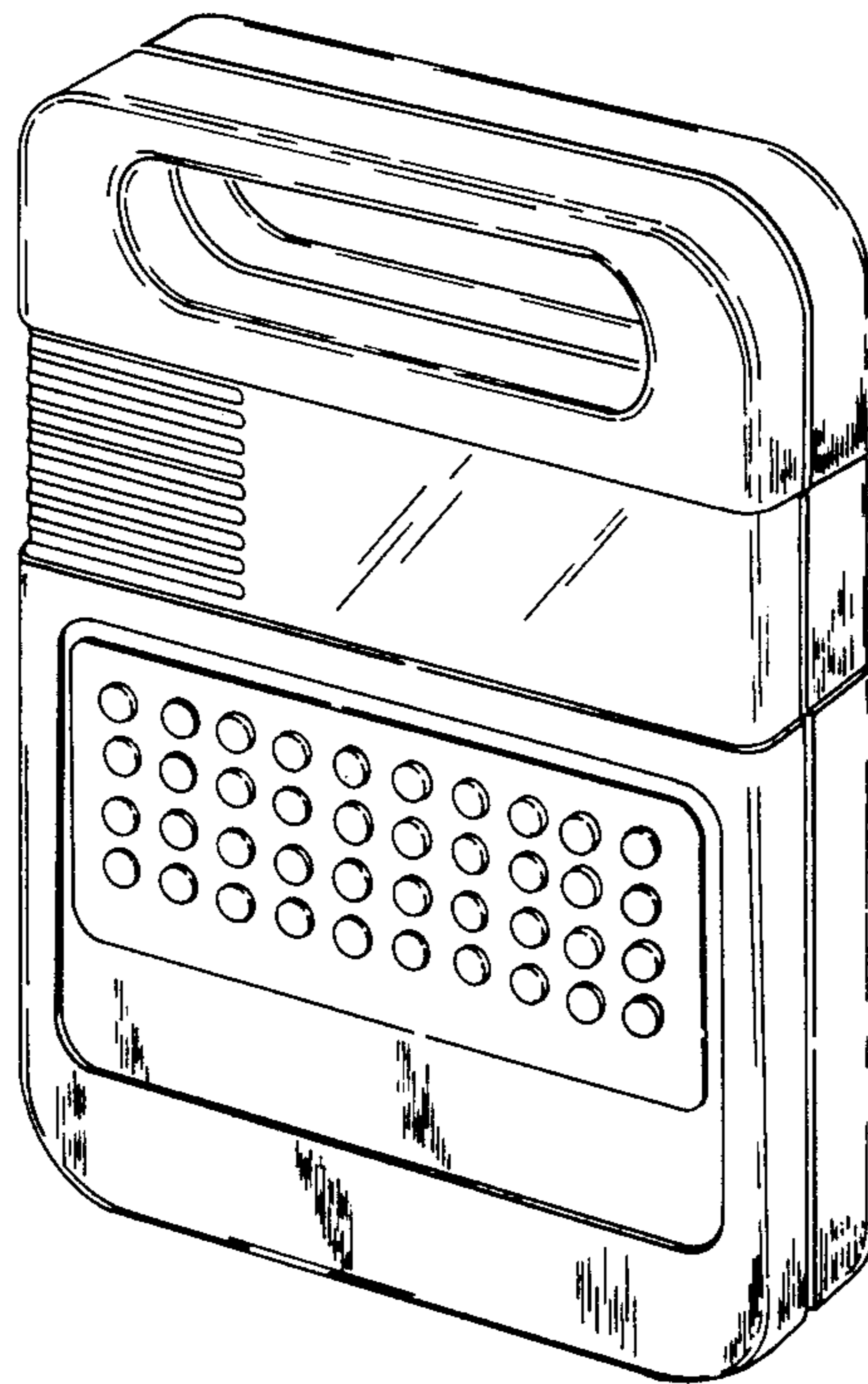
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

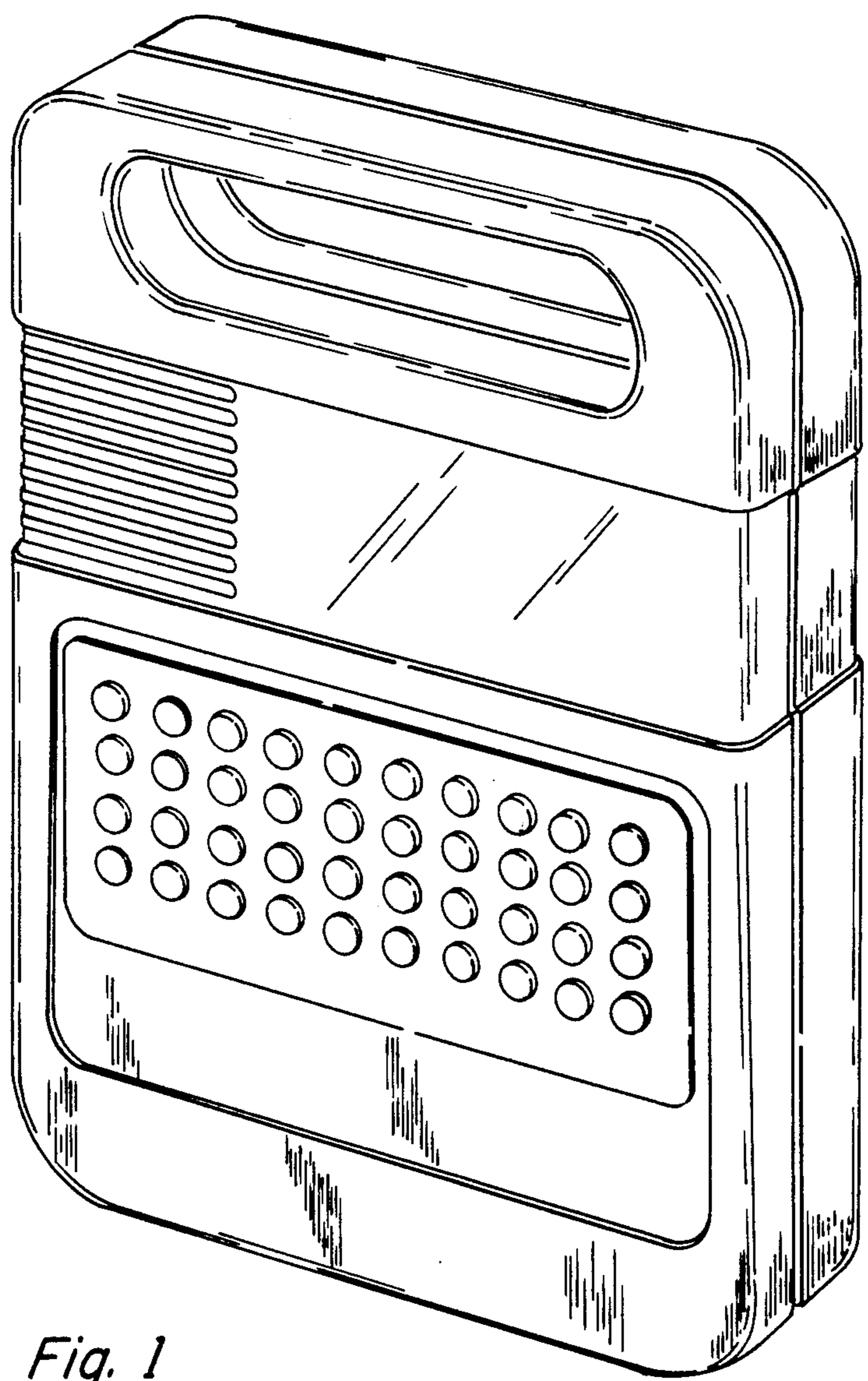
FIG. 3 is one side view thereof;

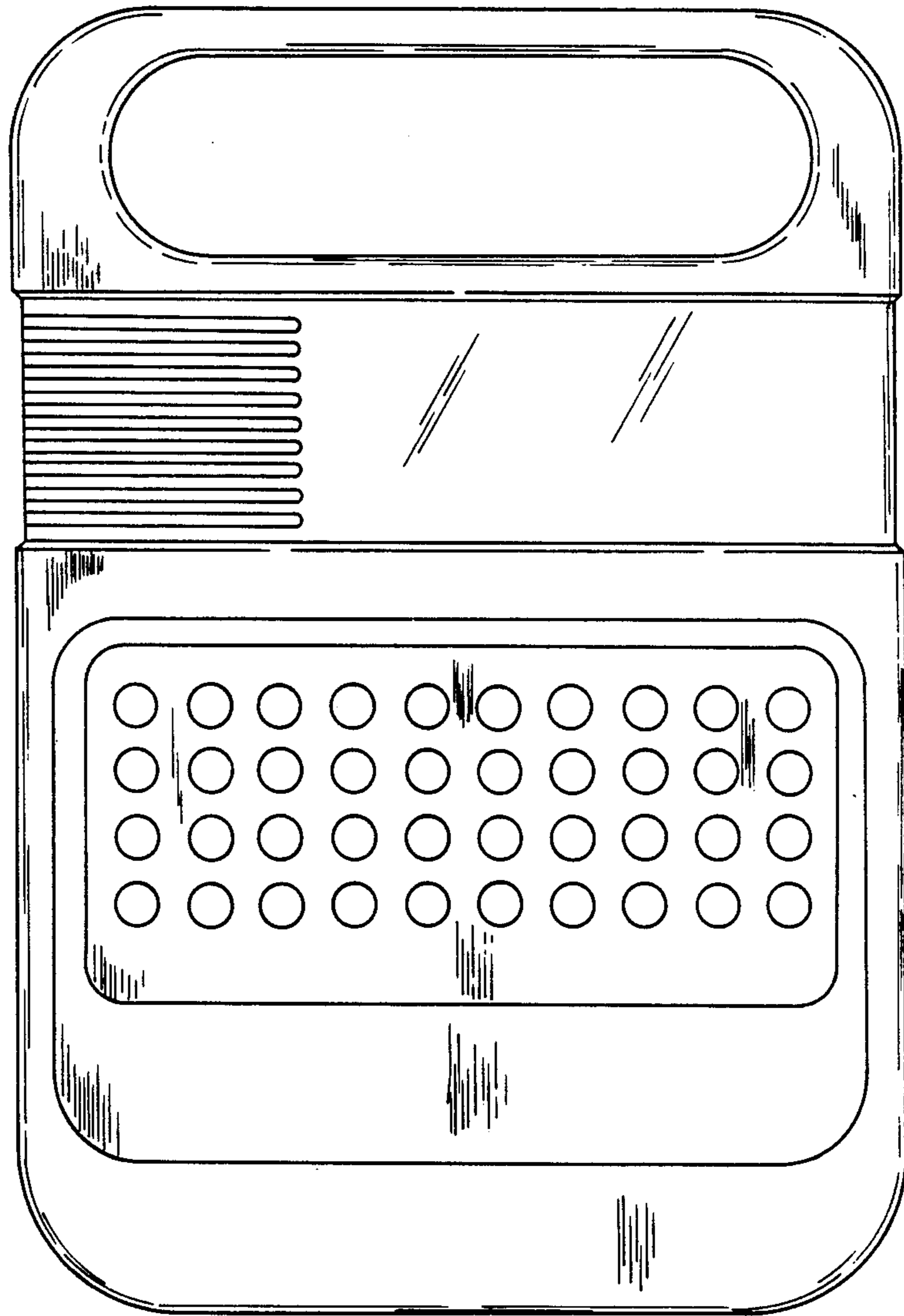

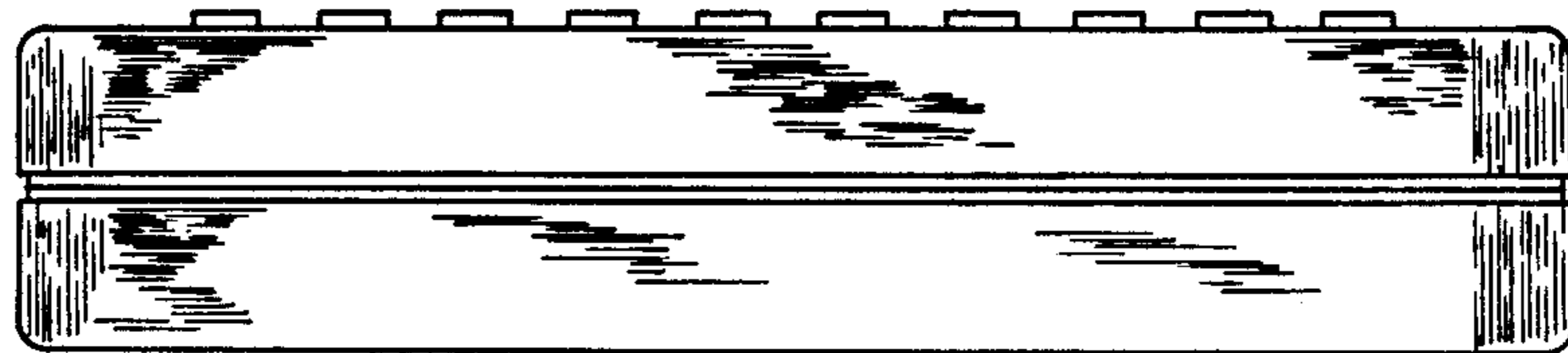
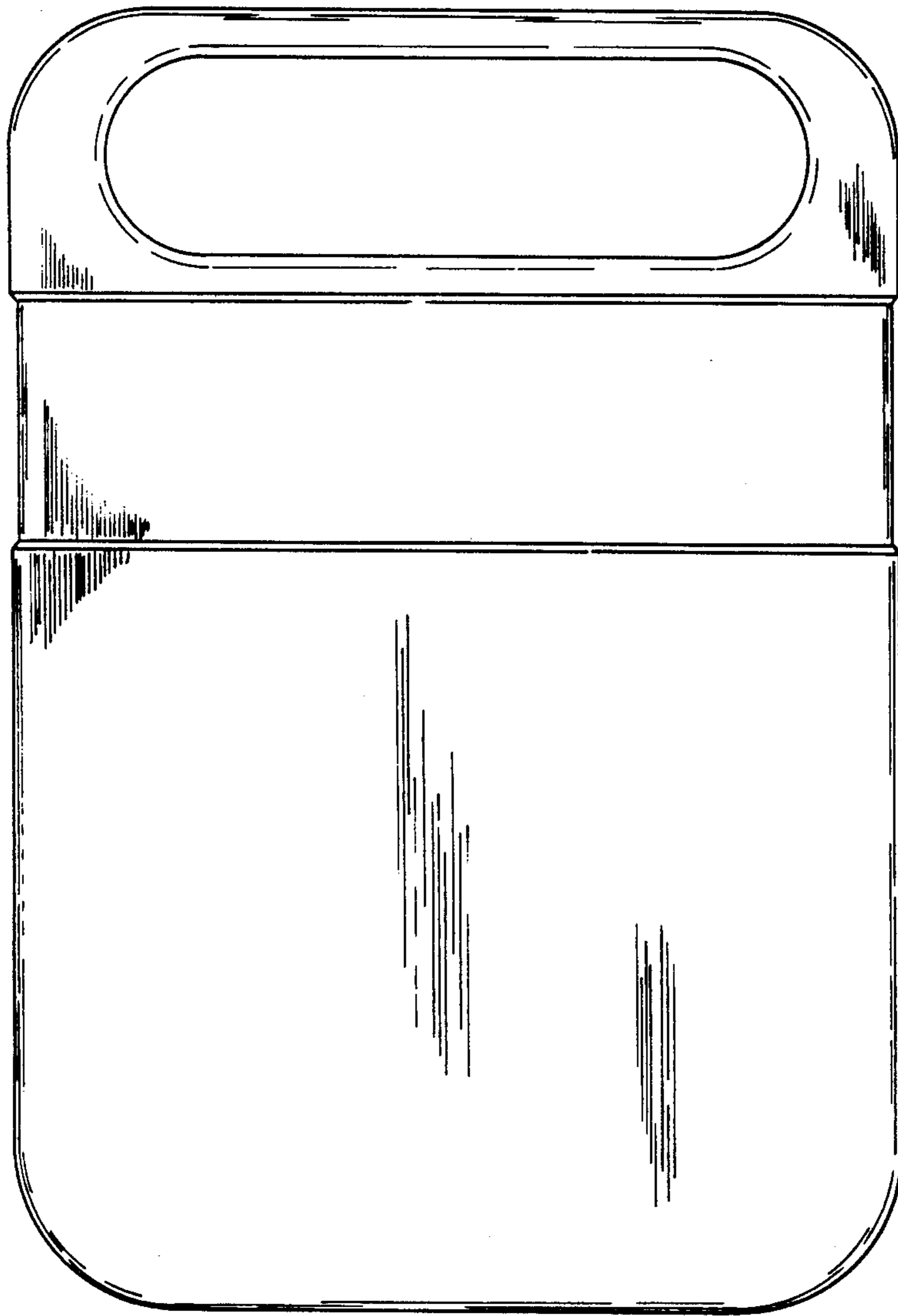
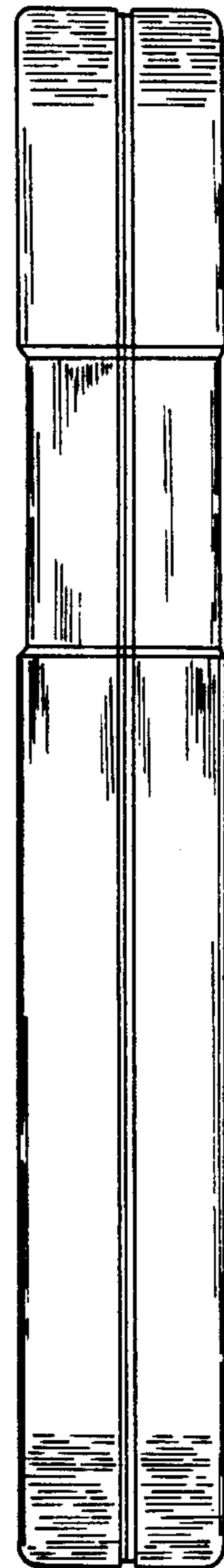
