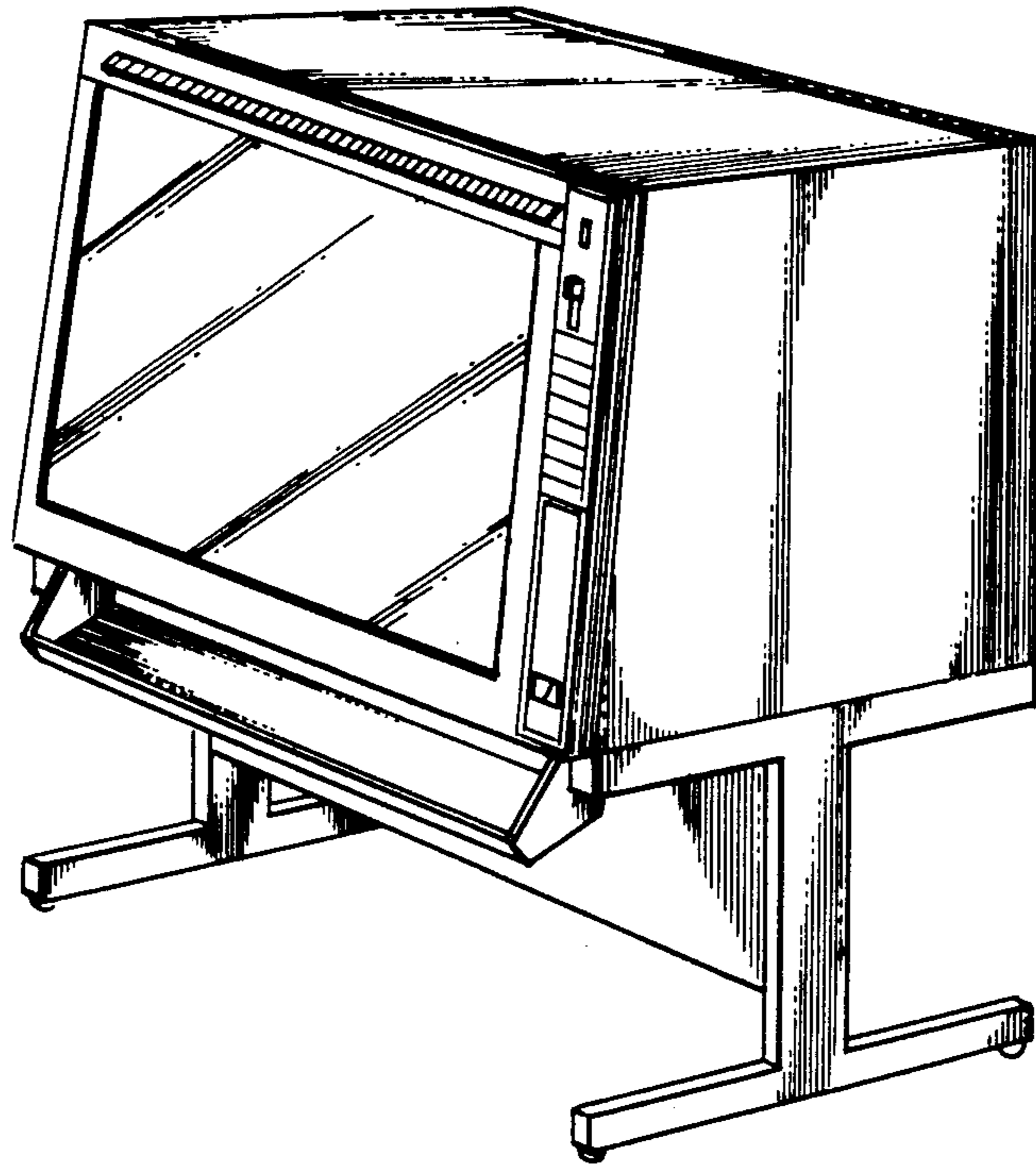

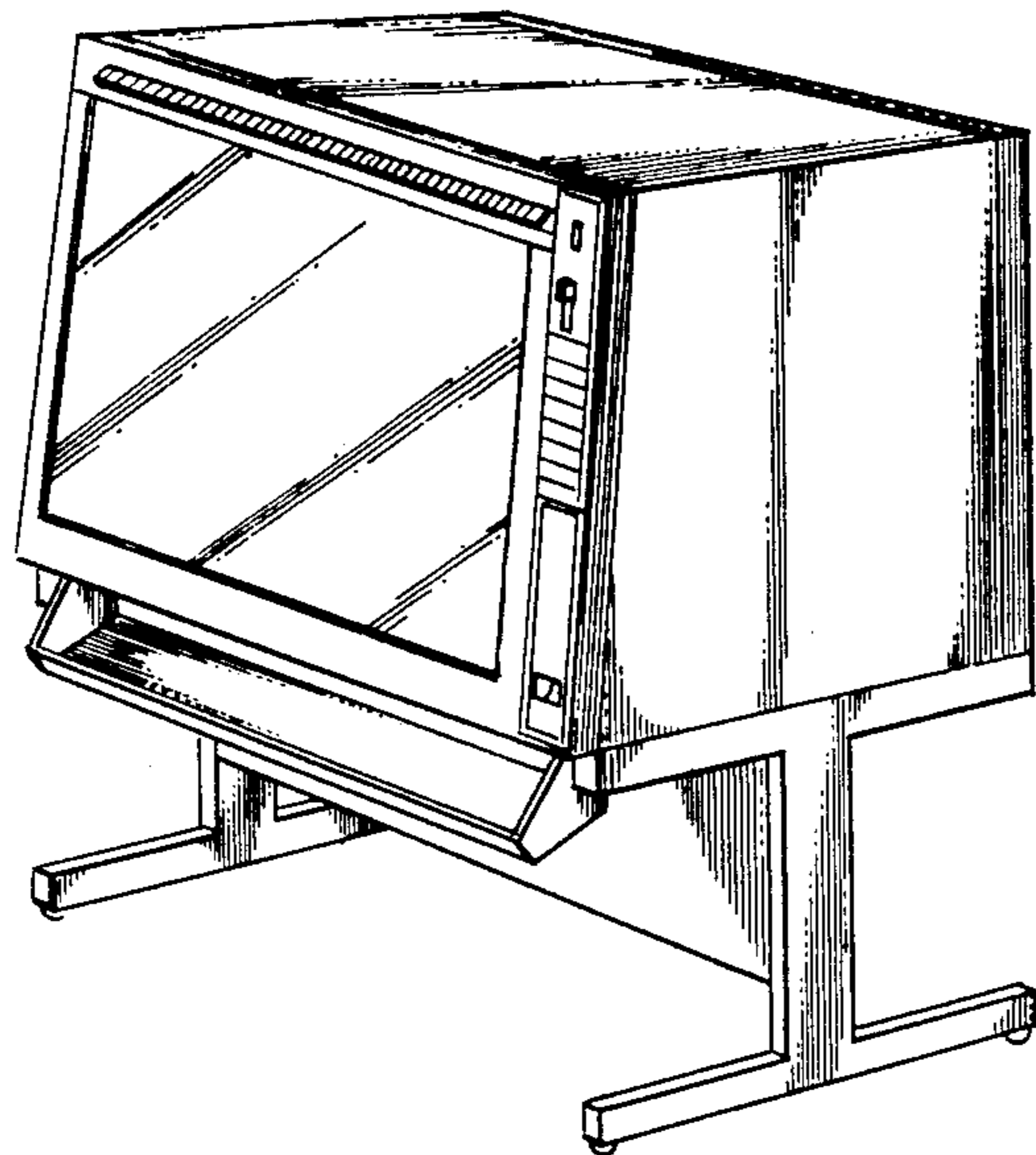
The ornamental design for a vending machine, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

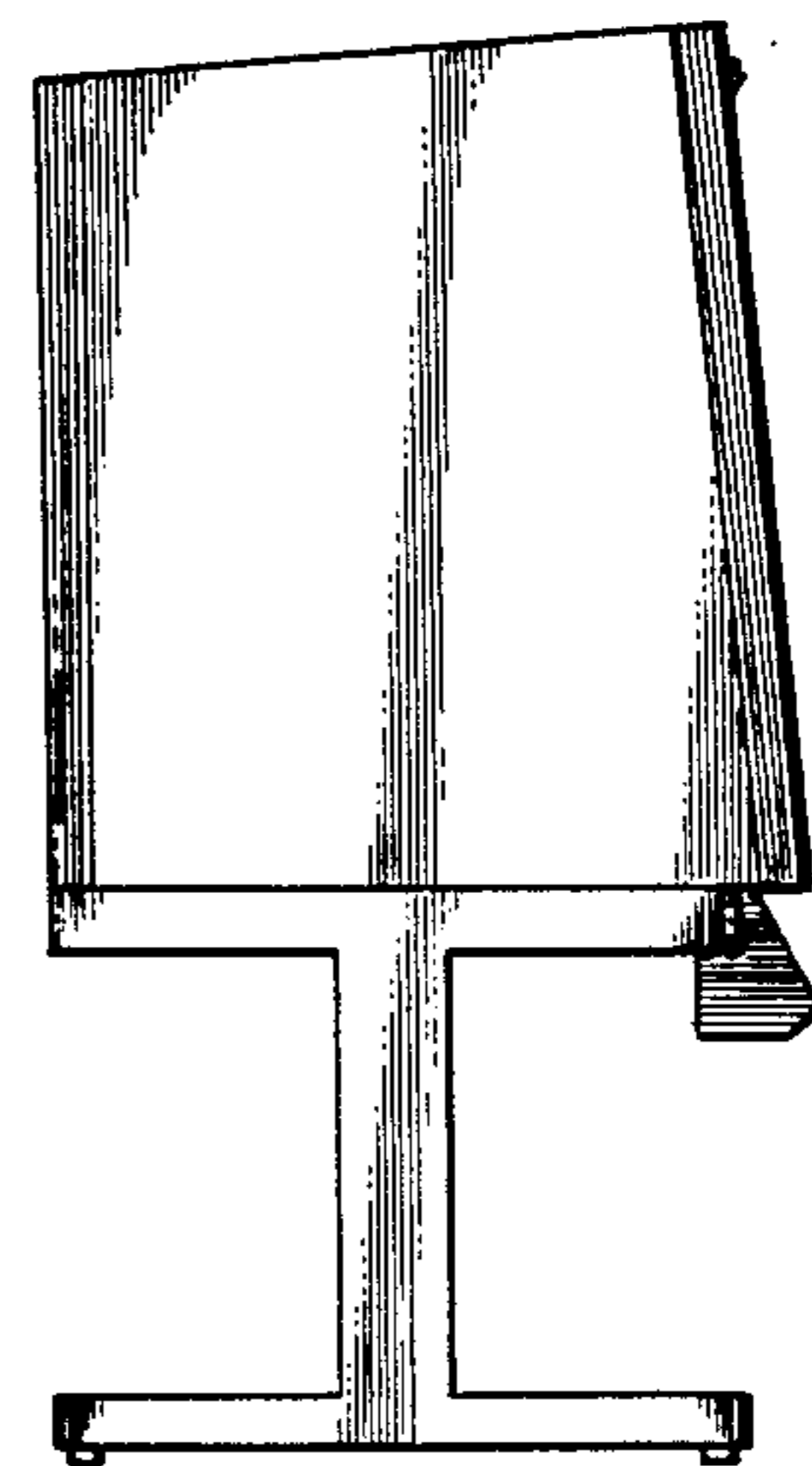
FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a vending machine showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



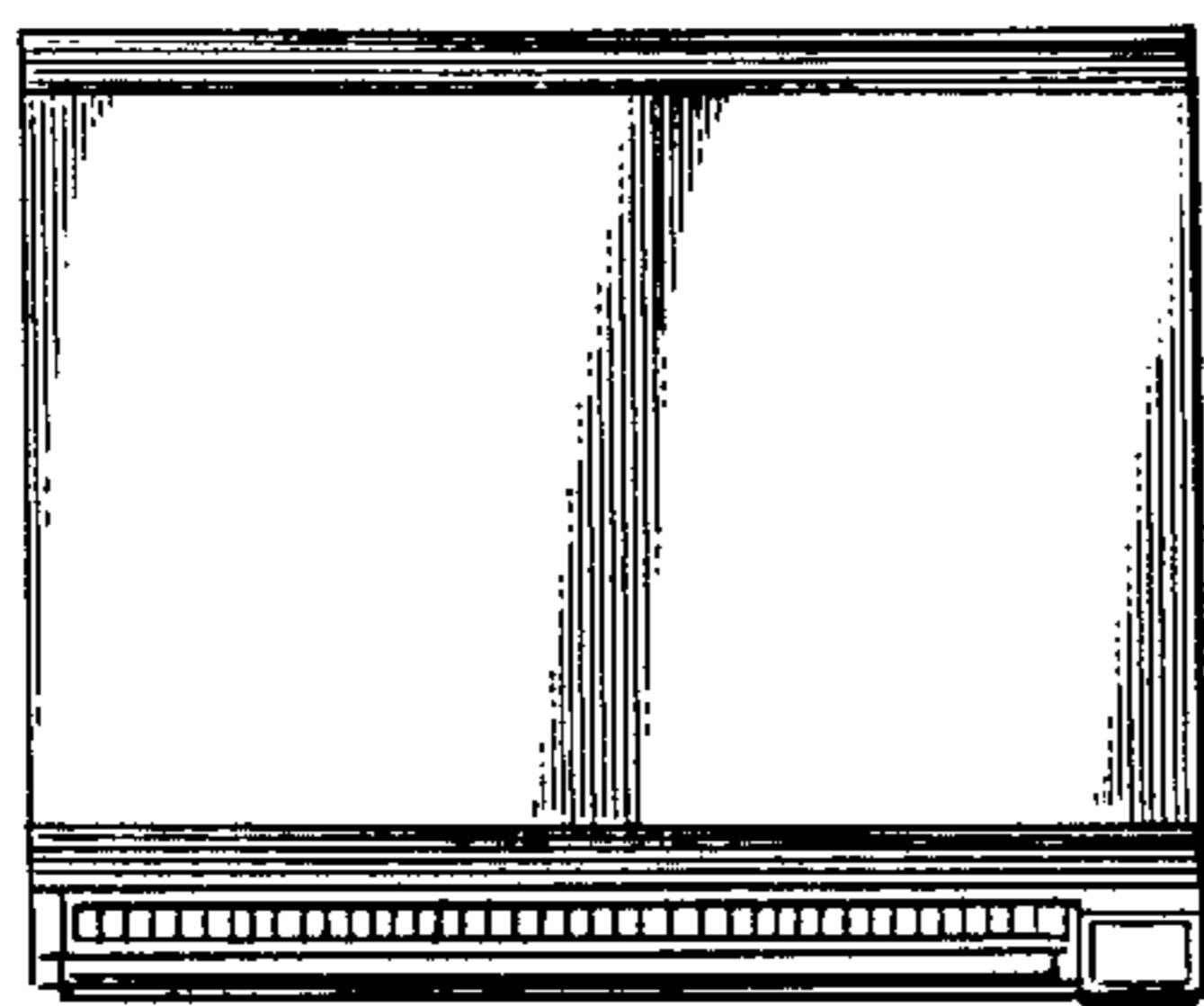

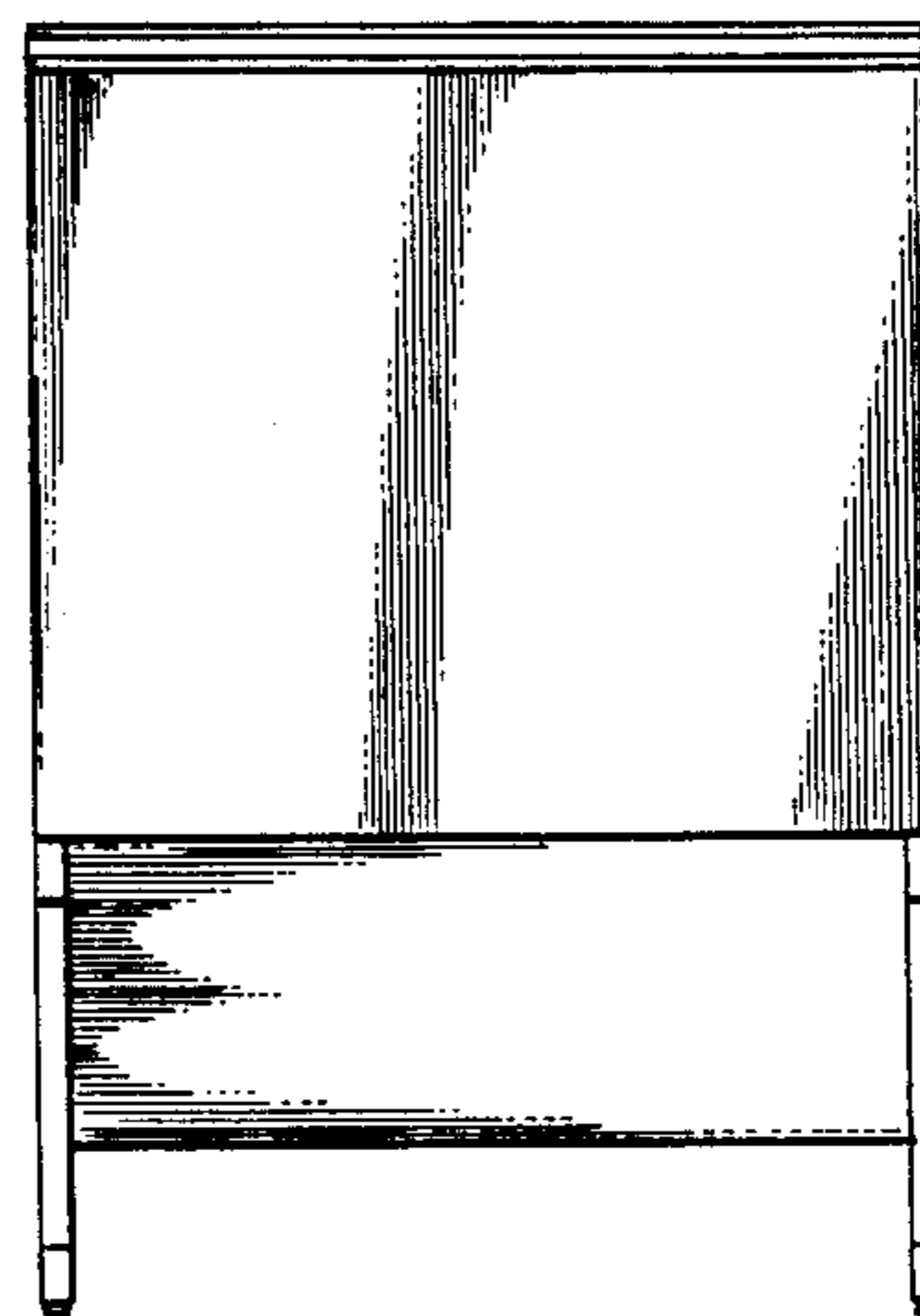
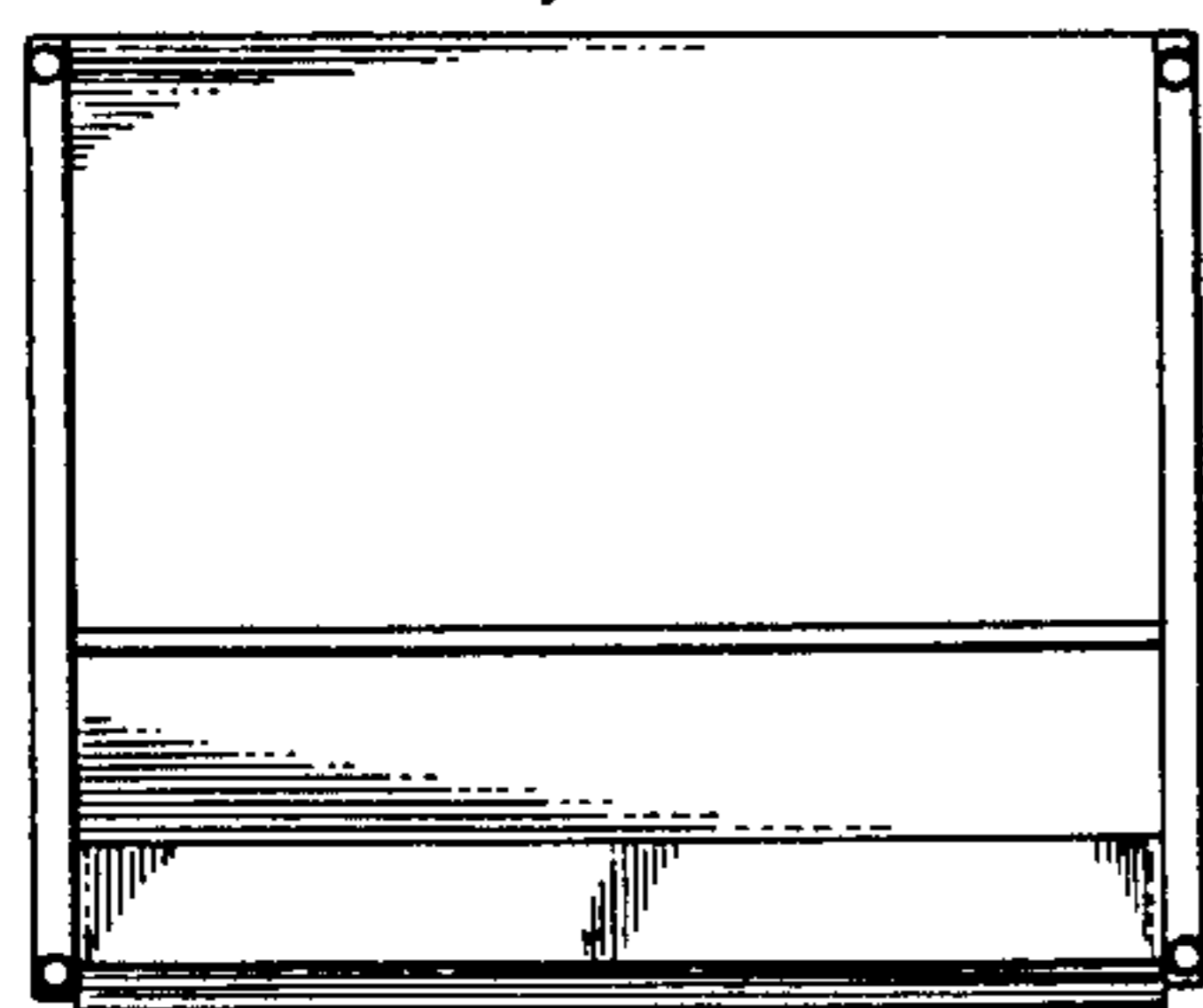
