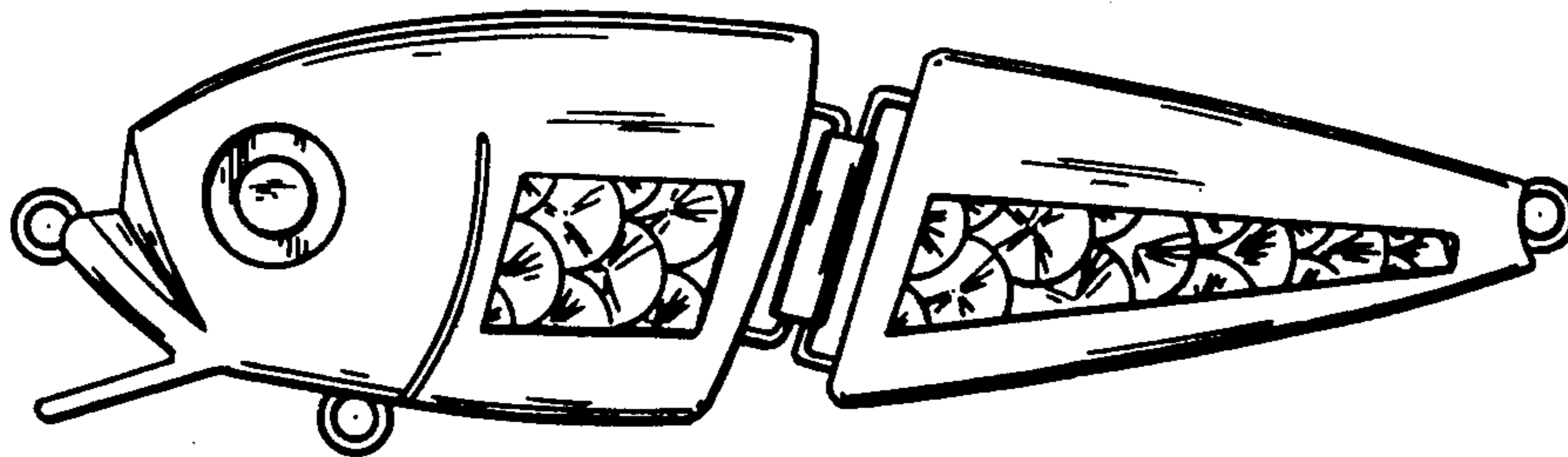

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the tail of the inventive lure.



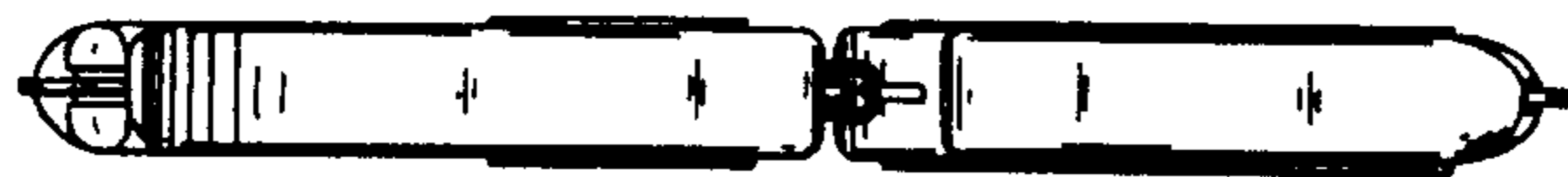

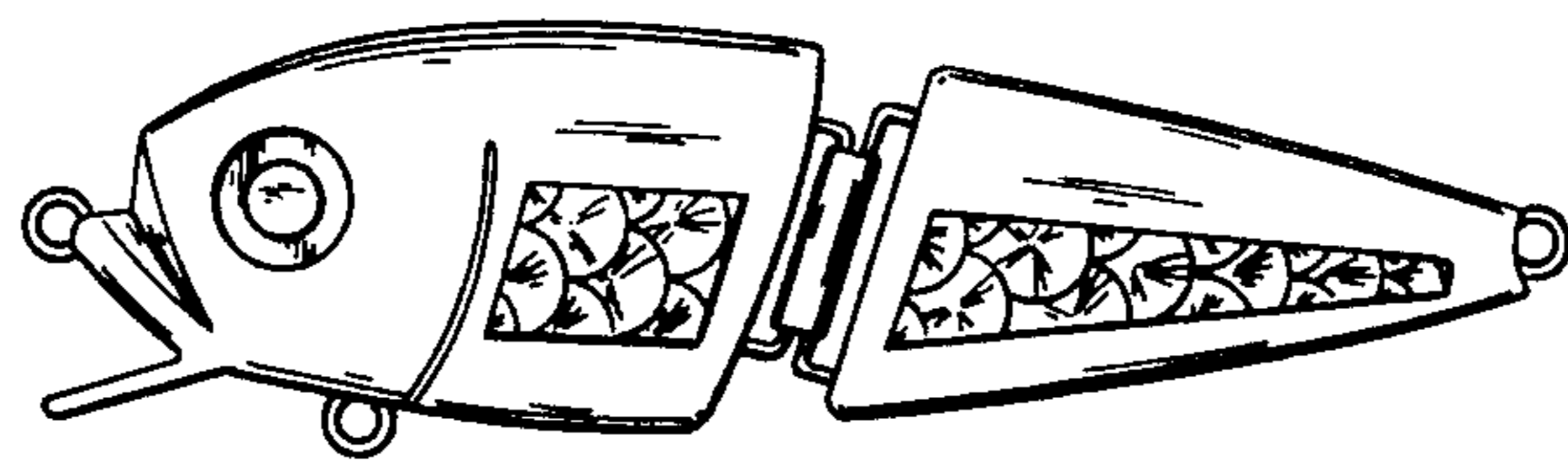
