The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of the left side of the inventive fish lure (the right side of the lure being a mirror image of FIG. 1);

FIG. 2 is a plan view looking down on the top of the inventive lure;

FIG. 3 is a plan view looking up toward the bottom of the inventive lure;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the head of the inventive lure; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the tail of the inventive lure.




