DESCRIPTION

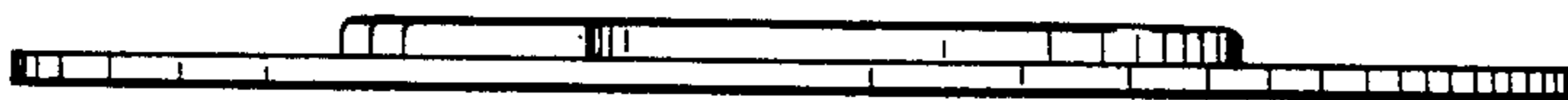
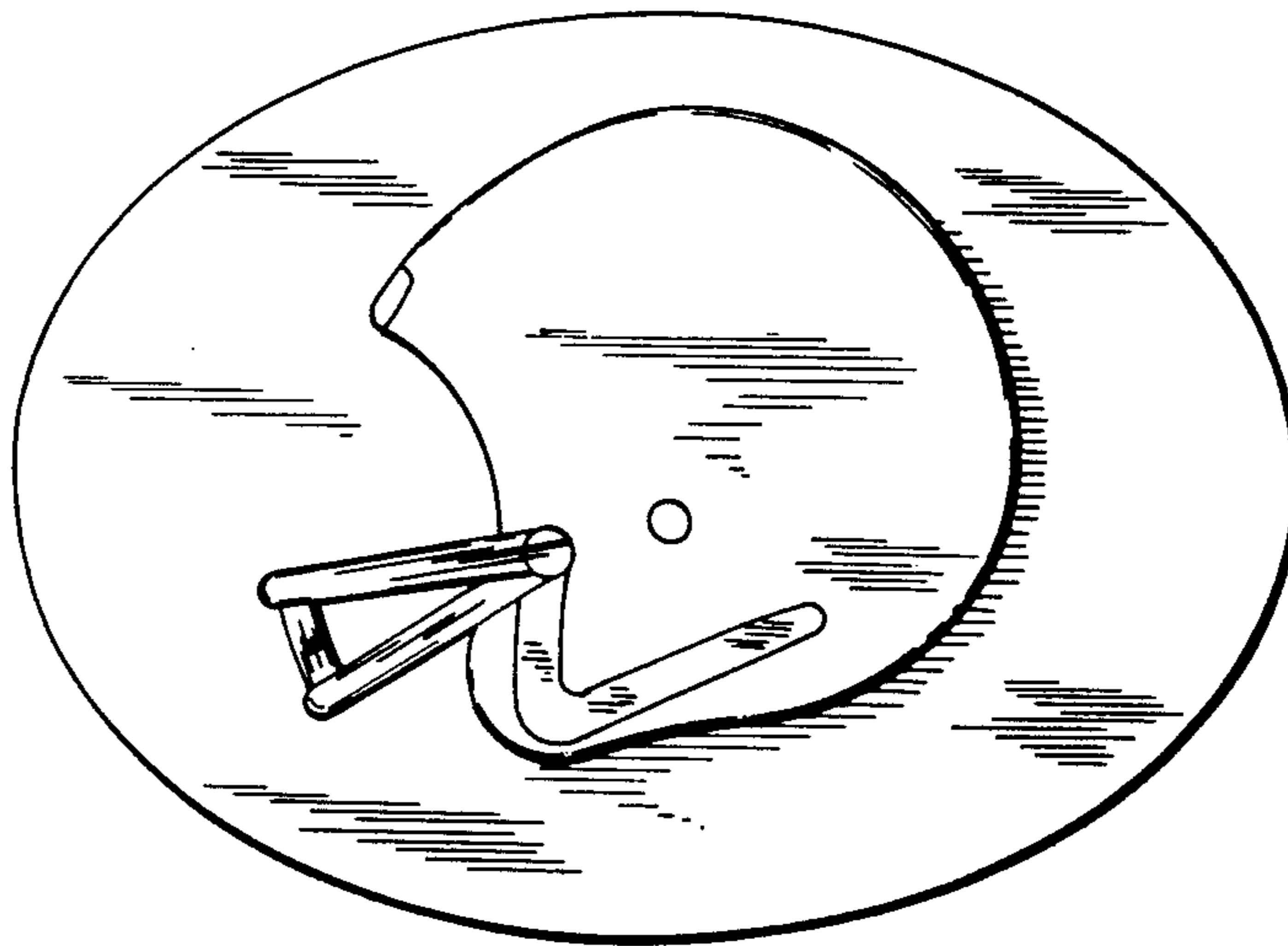
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the face plate for a belt buckle showing our new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



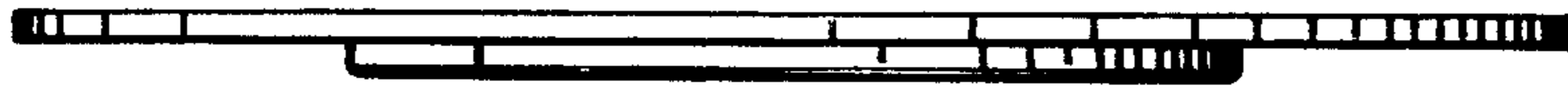

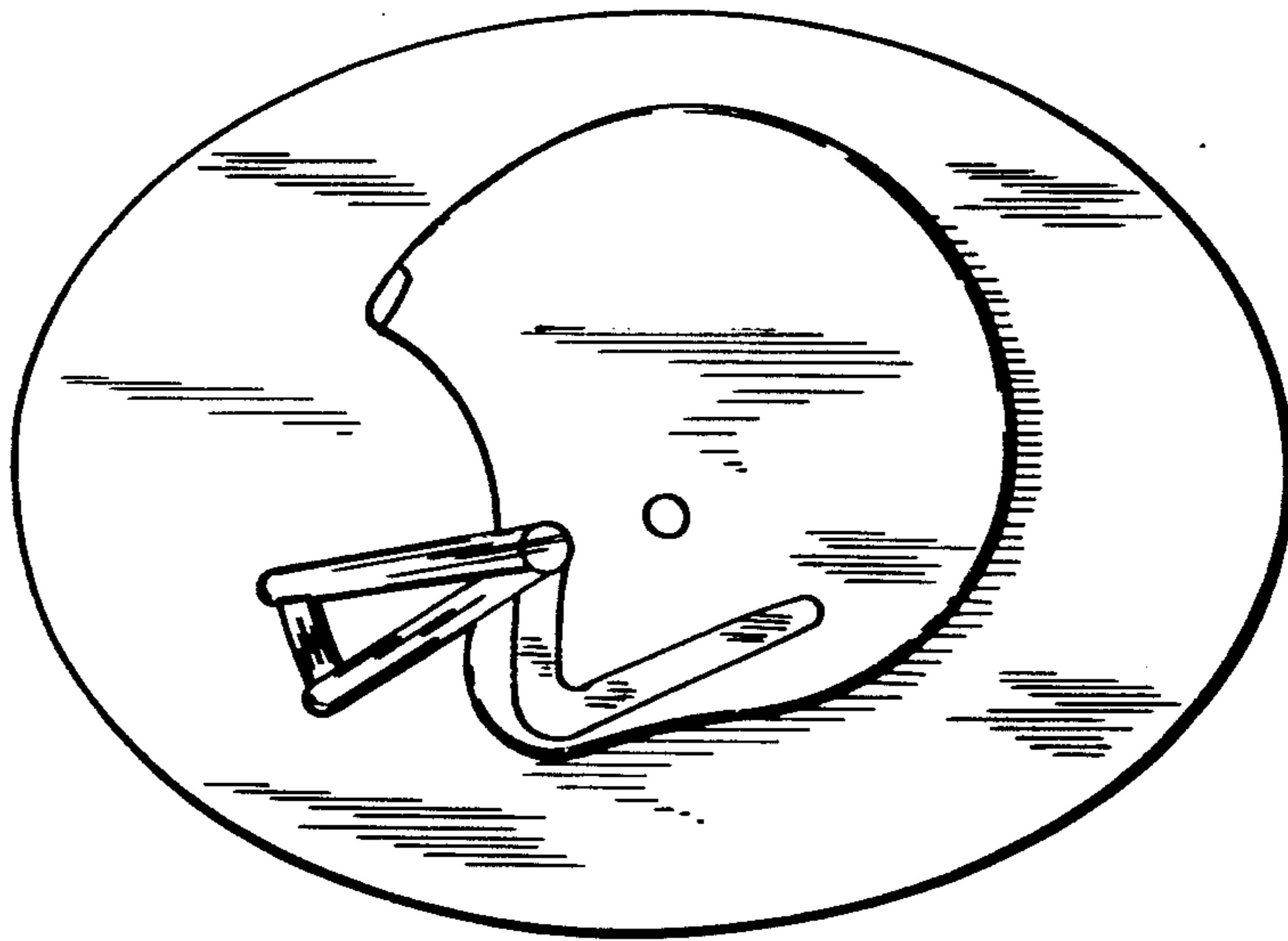

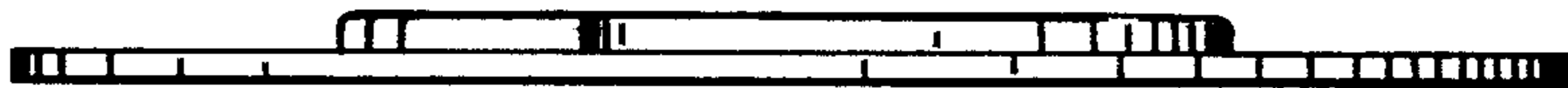
