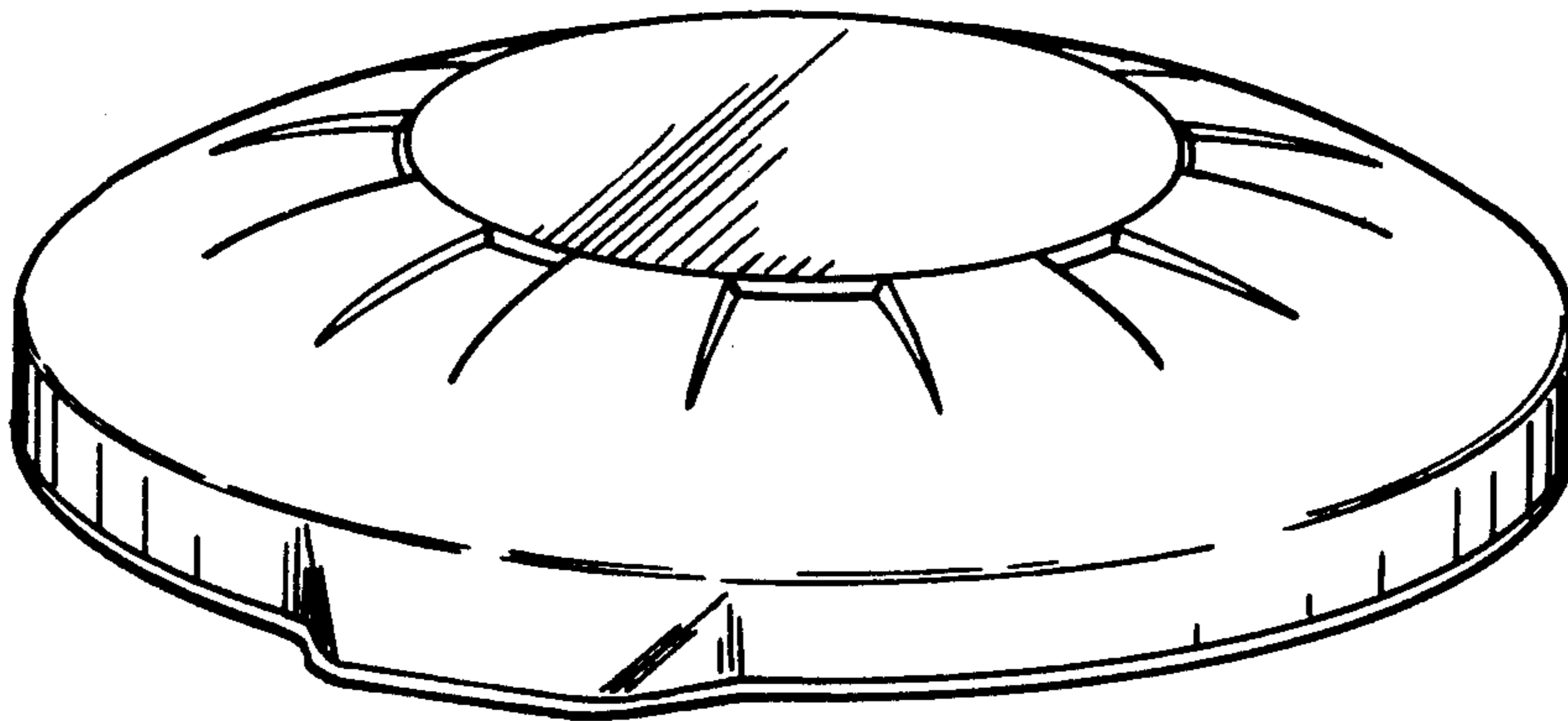

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a lid for a compost bin showing my new design, and FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



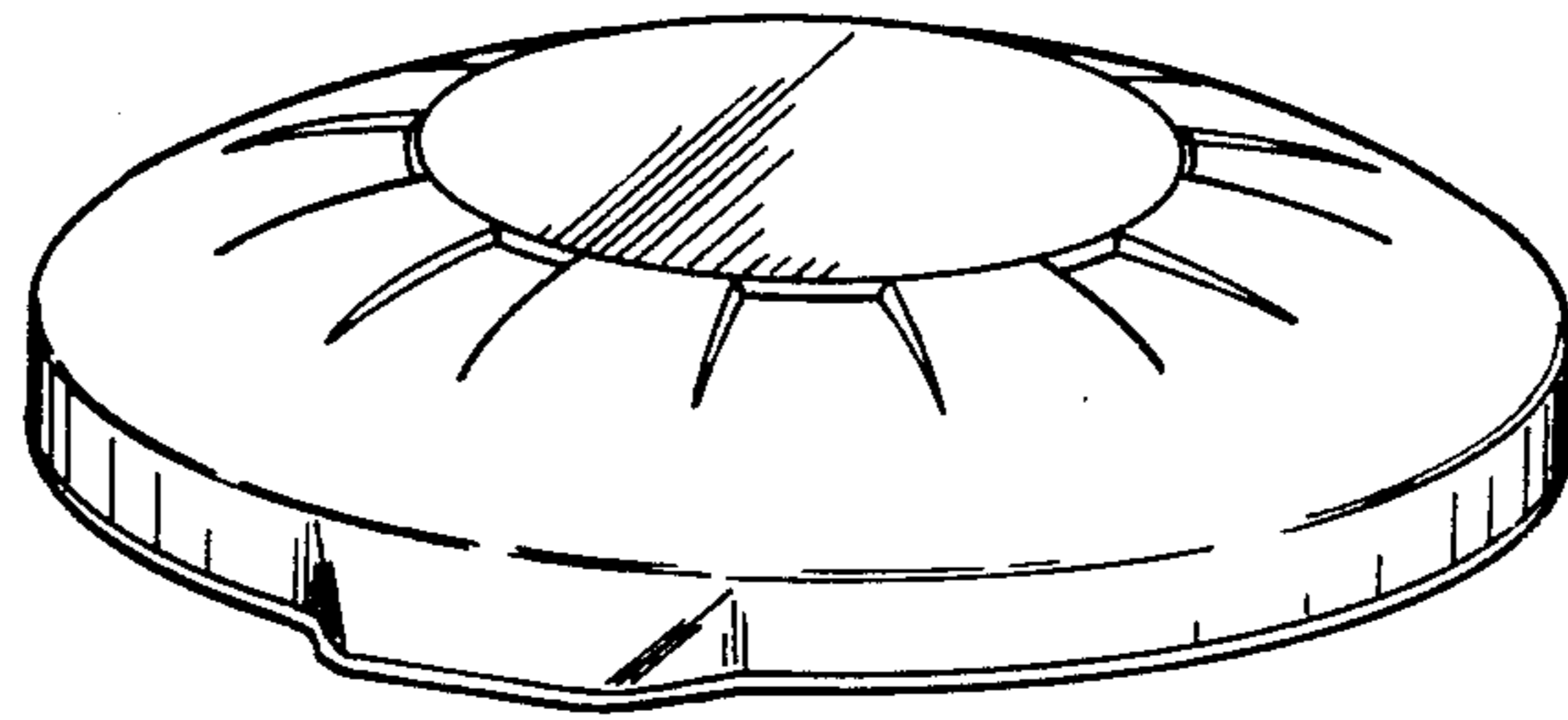

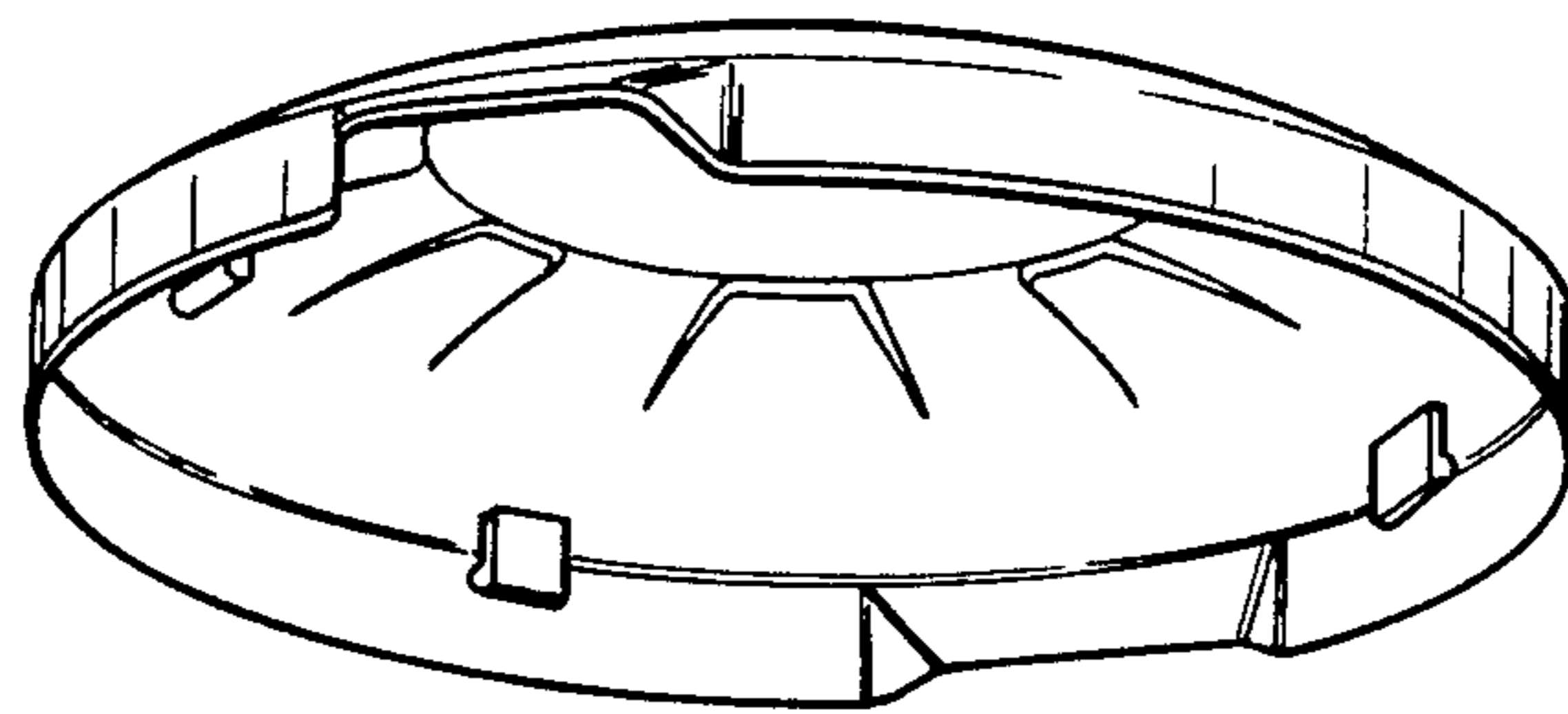
