

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a snubber for a retractable boat daggerboard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a snubber for a retractable boat dagger board showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is an elevational view of one side of FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image, the broken horizontal line representing the deck of a boat and the broken vertical line representing the adjacent surface of a daggerboard being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the design; and FIG. 7 is a median vertical sectional view taken on the line 7—7 in FIG. 2, but with the cam rocked forwardly for jamming engagement between the resilient teeth on the front of the cam and the adjacent surface of a daggerboard represented by the broken vertical line, the broken vertical line and the broken horizontal line forming no part of the design.













