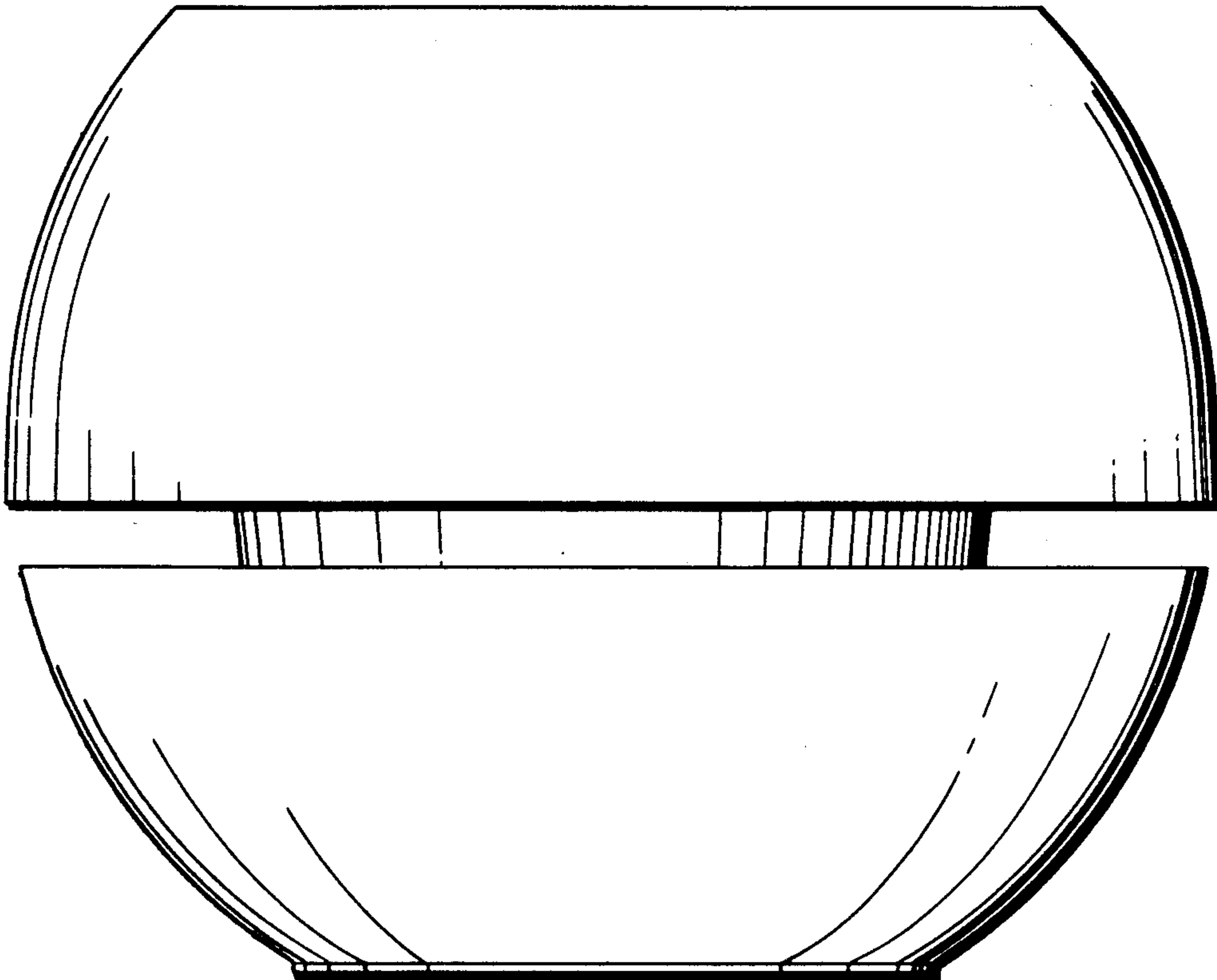

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined flower pot and saucer or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 3.



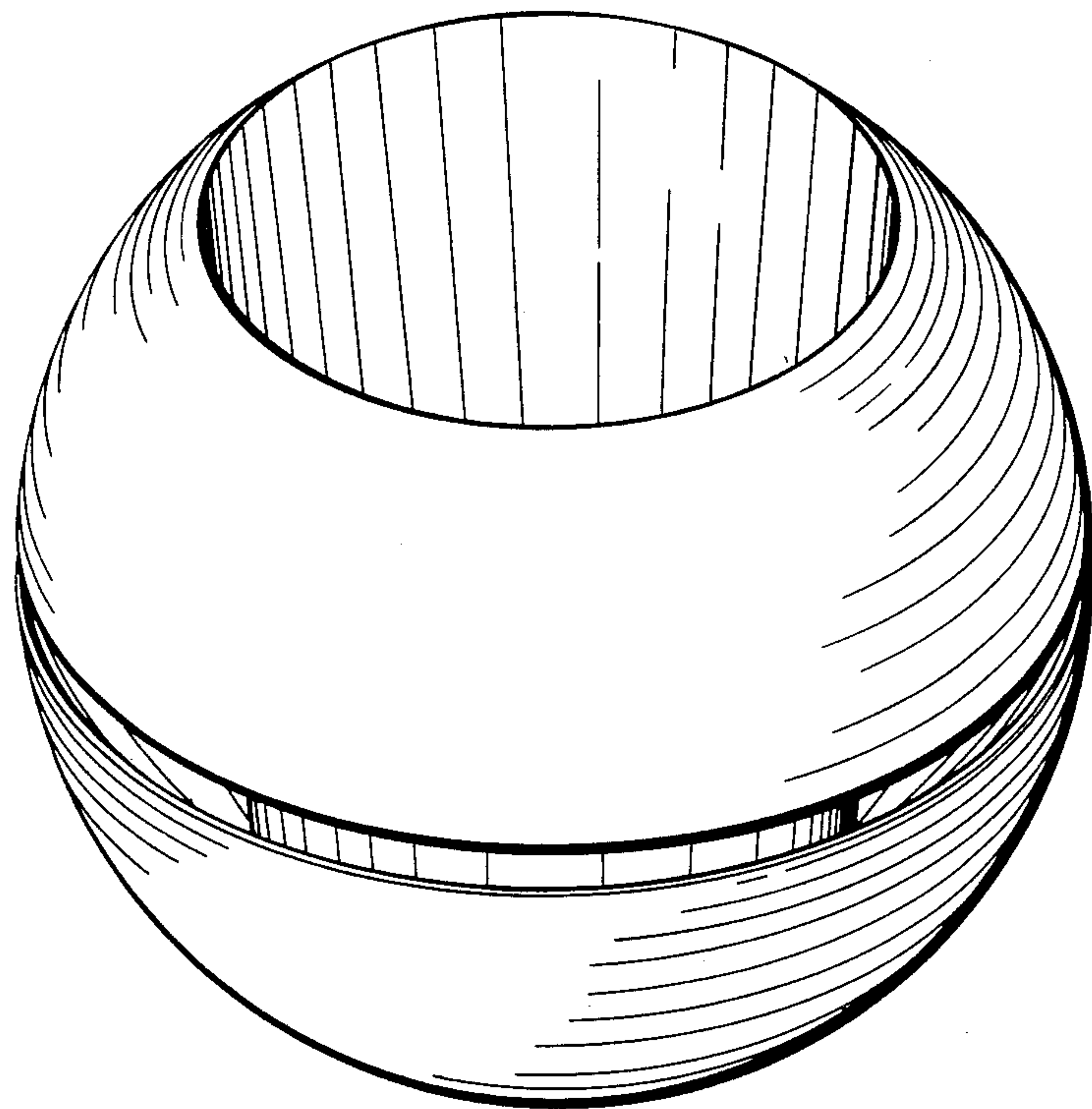

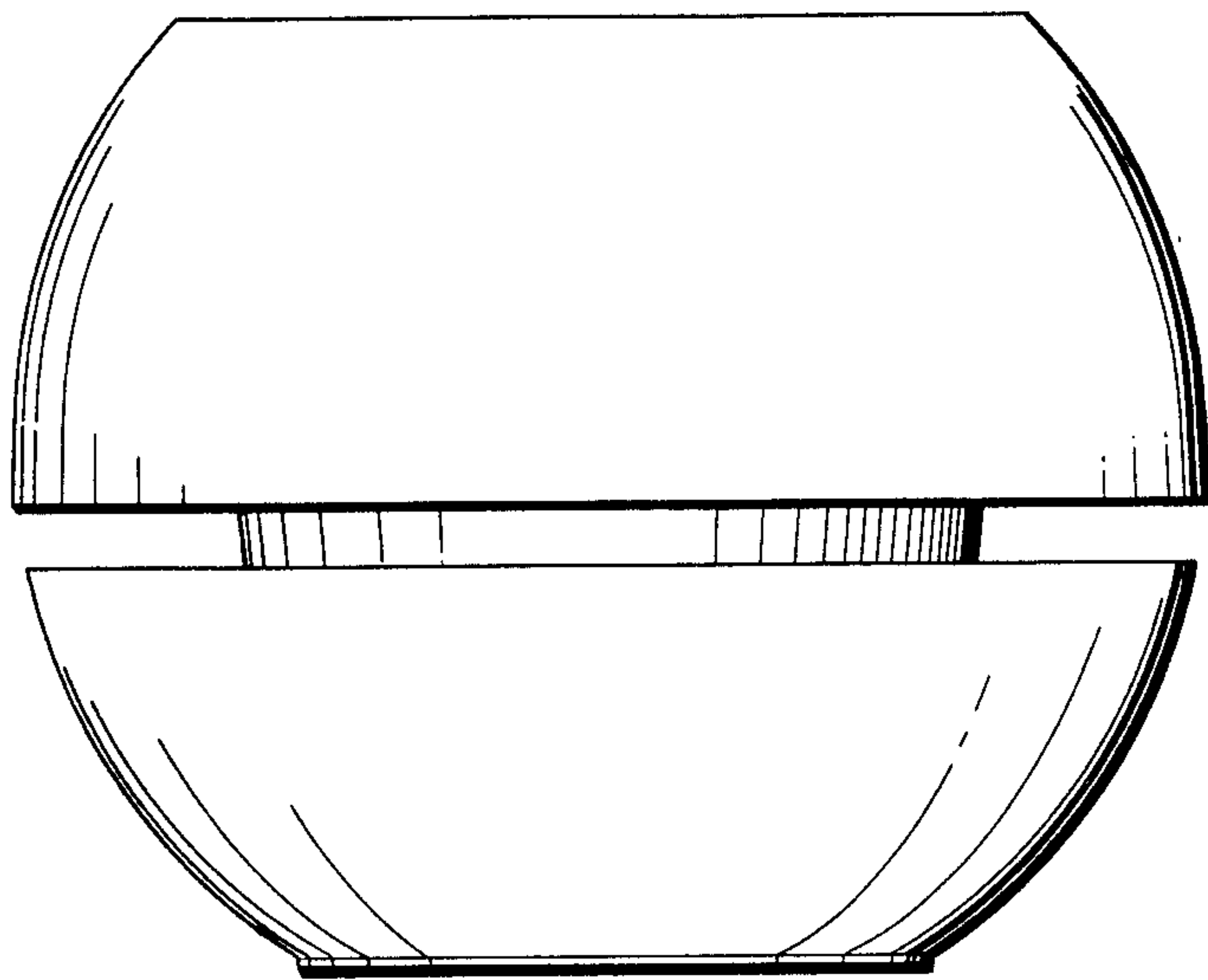

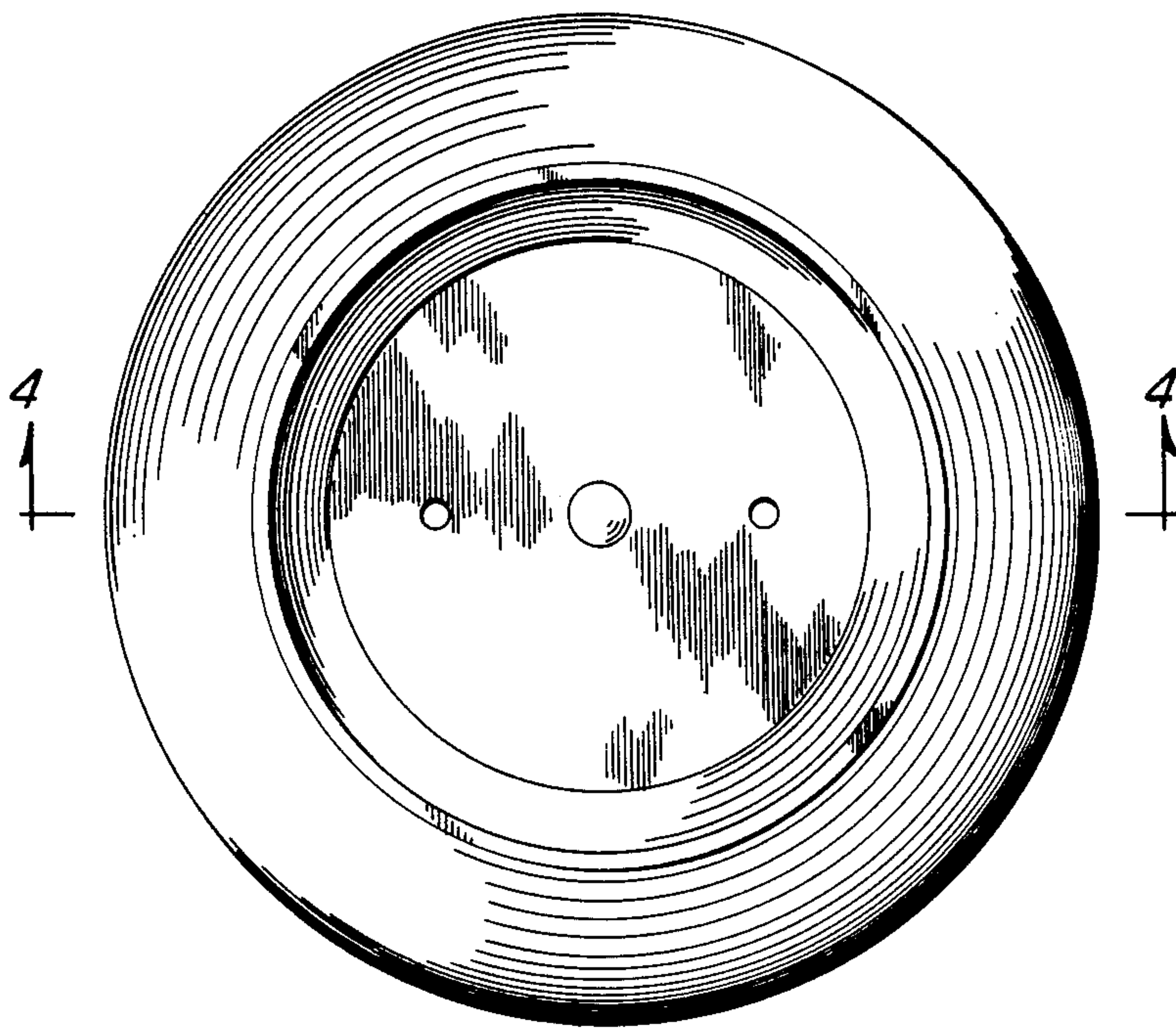

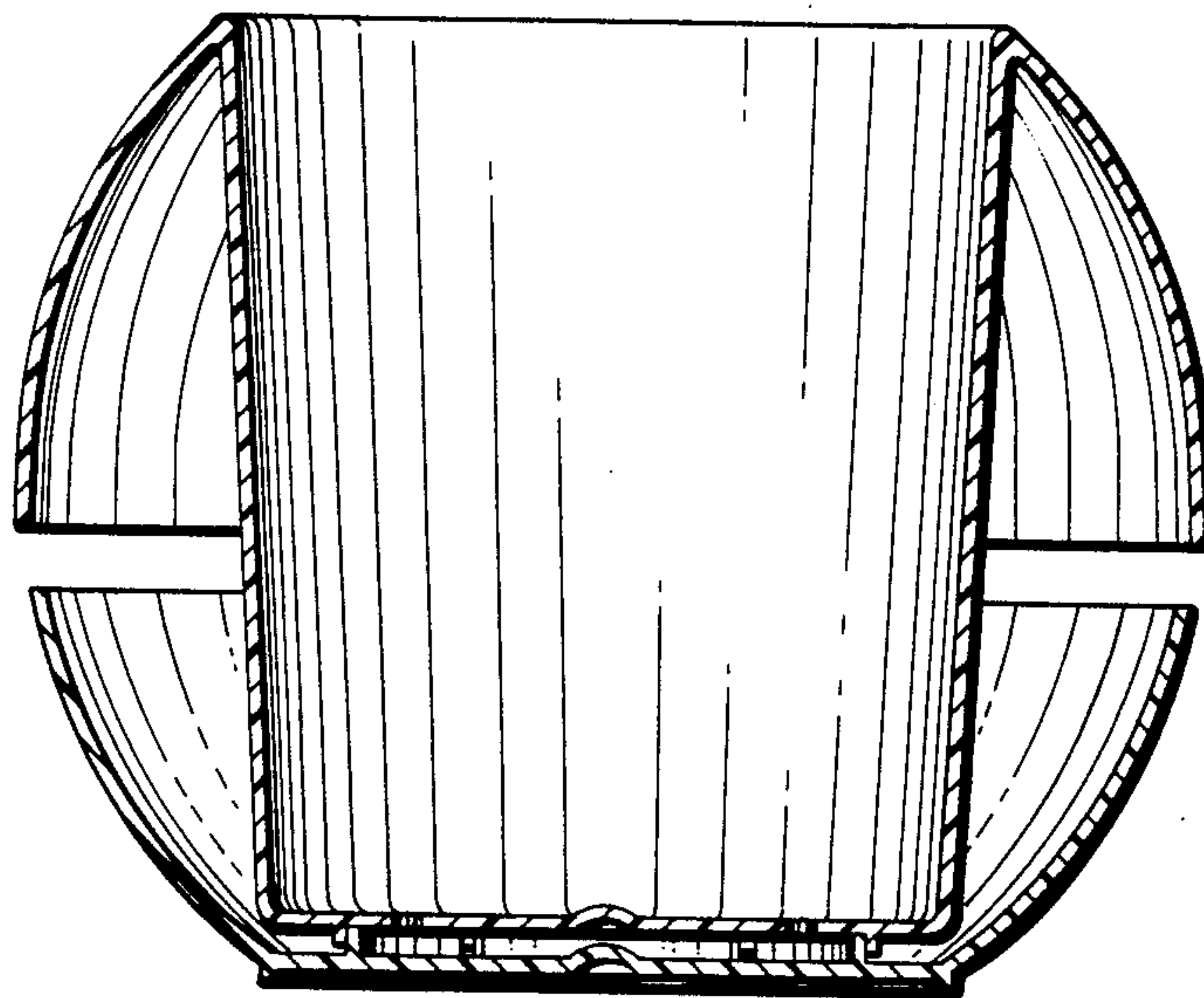
