DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined radio and walkie talkie or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

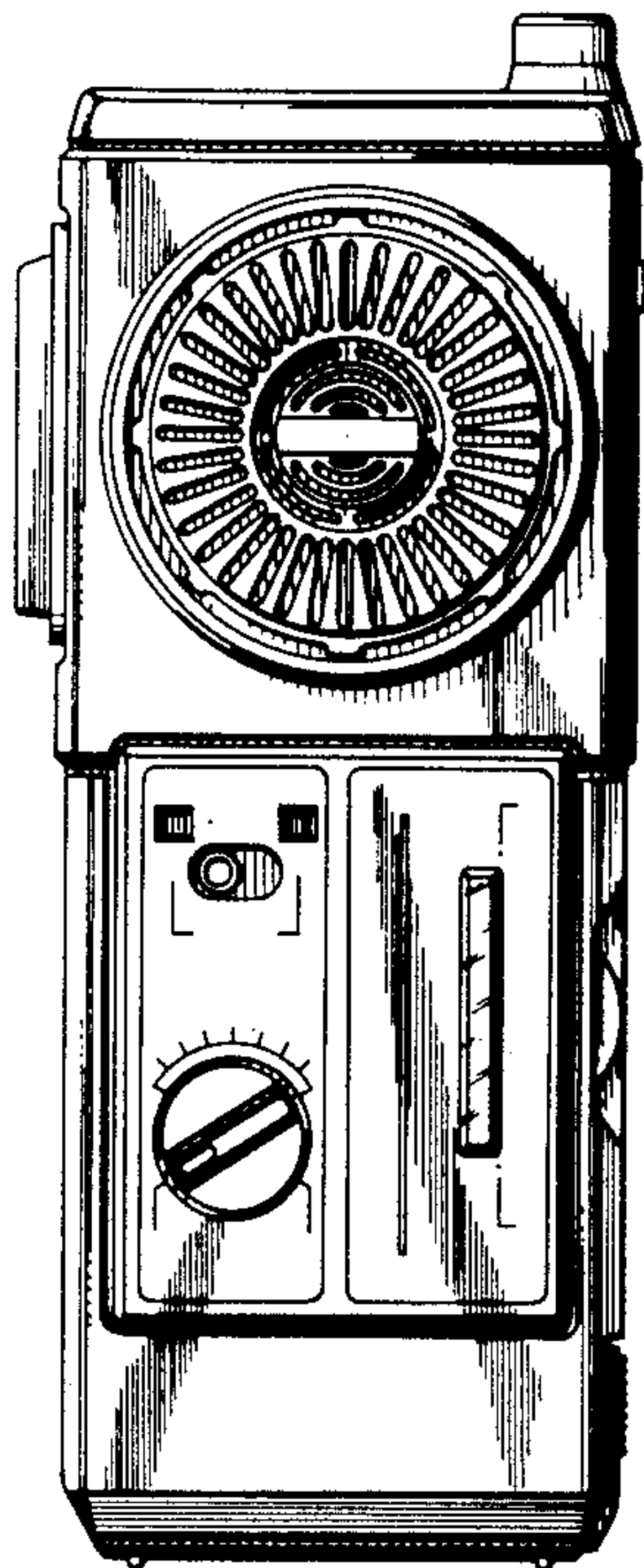

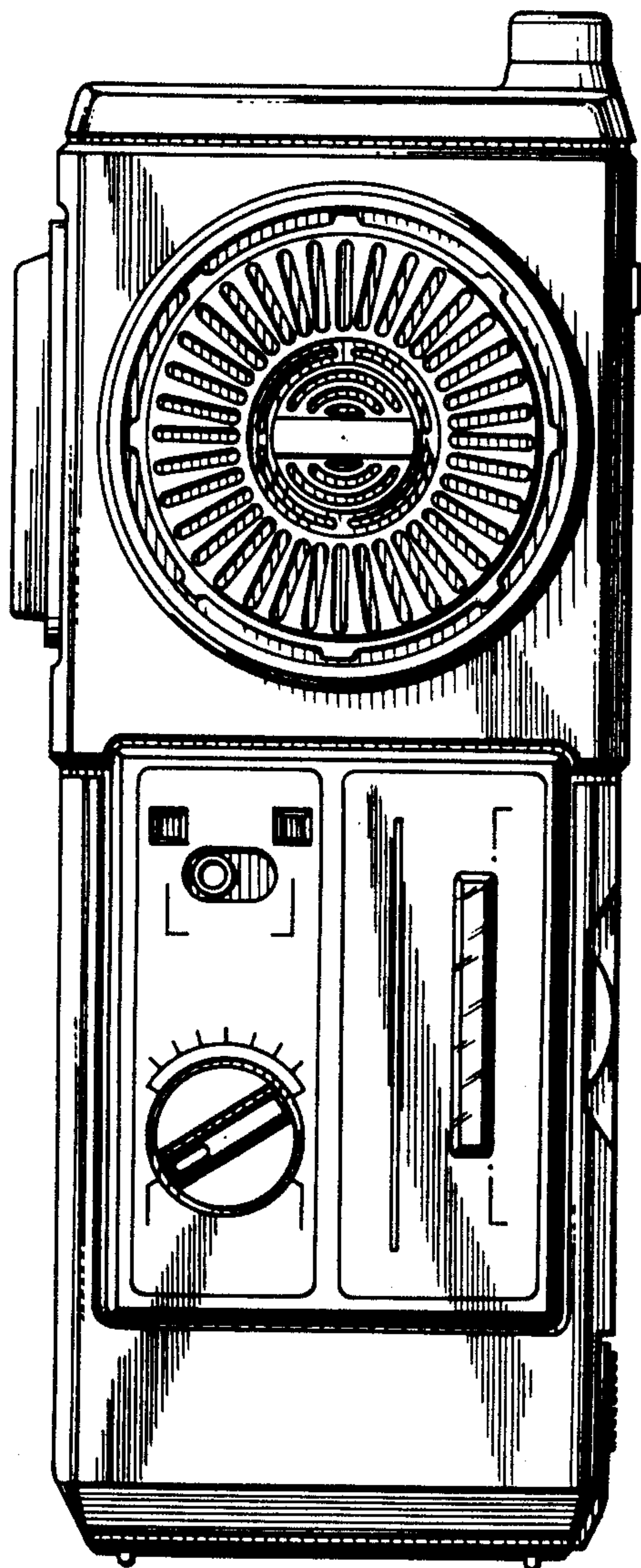

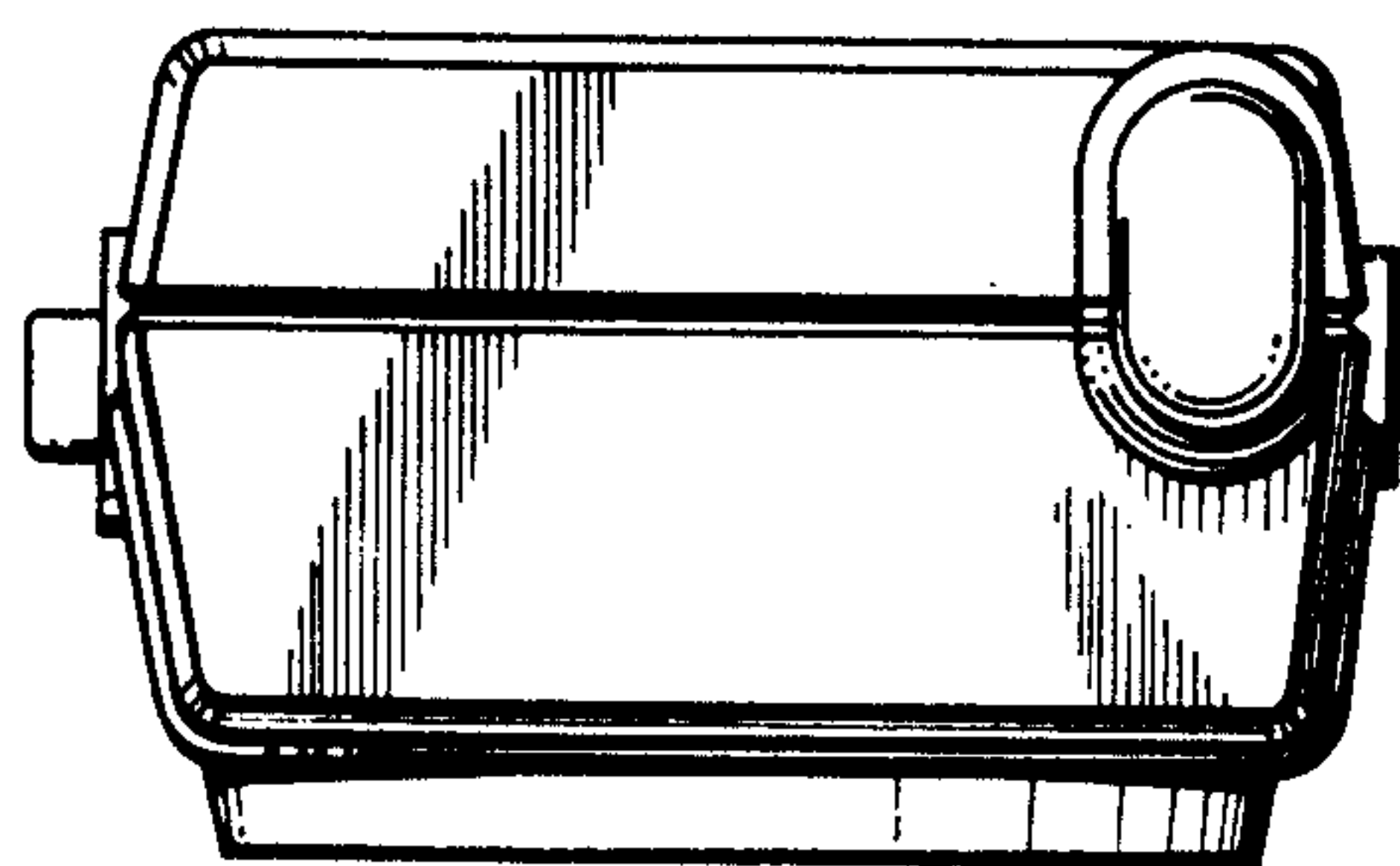
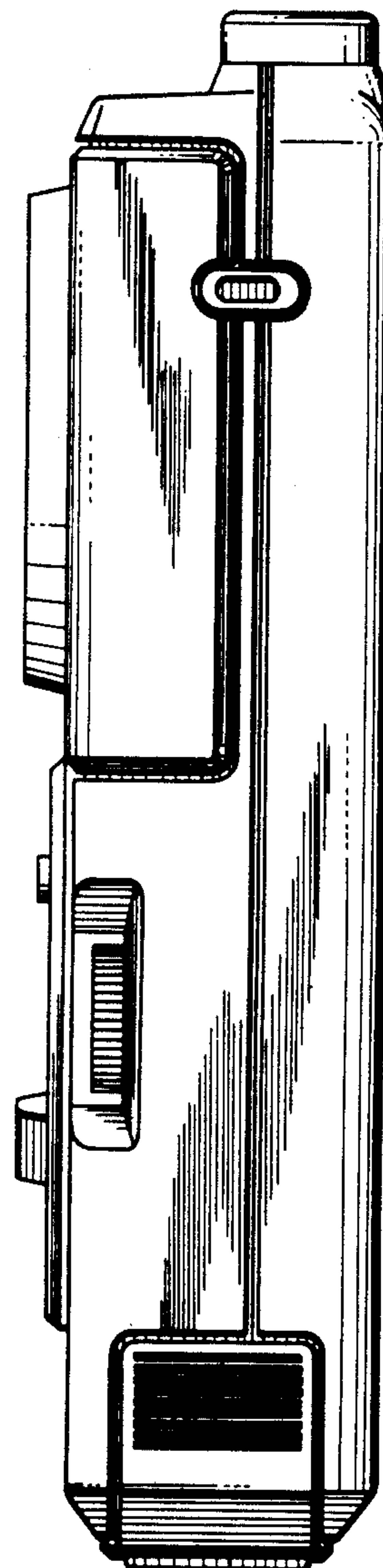

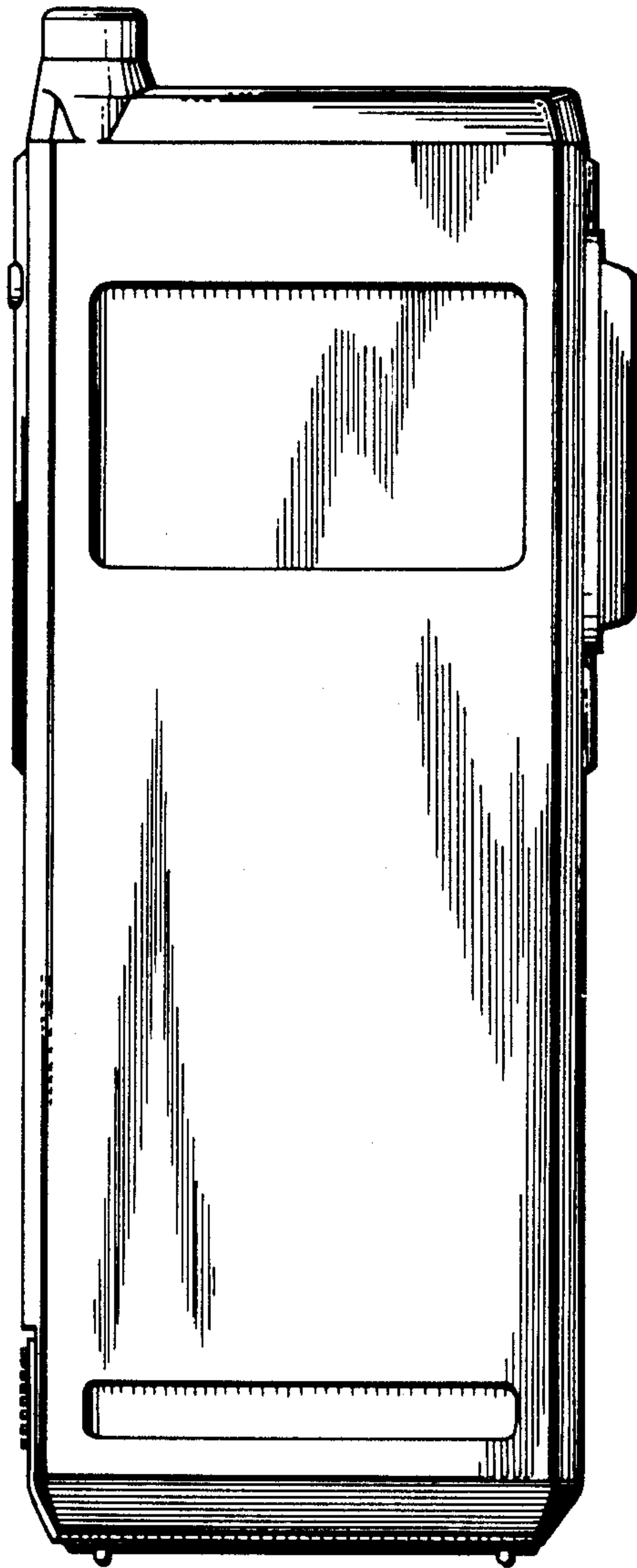

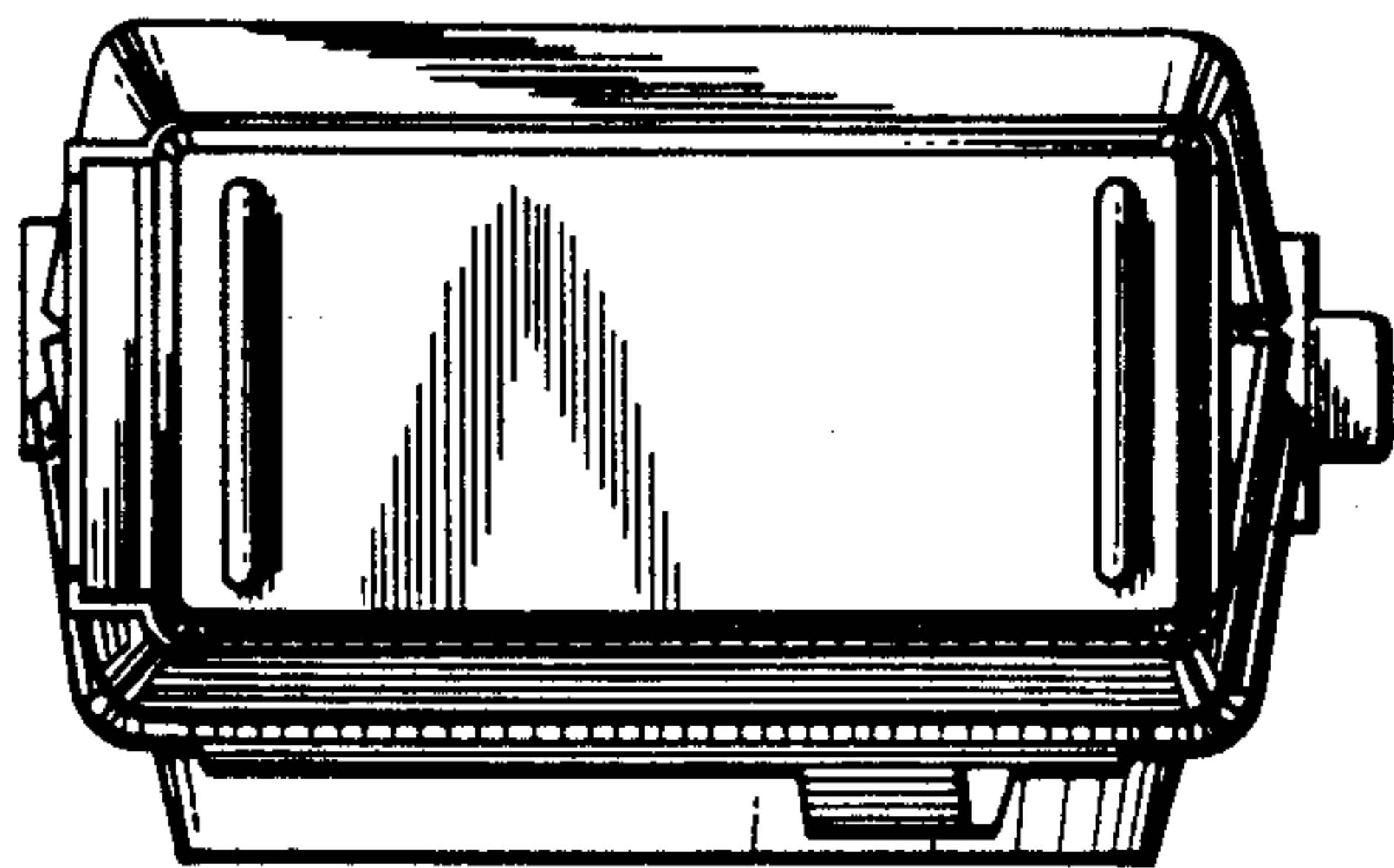
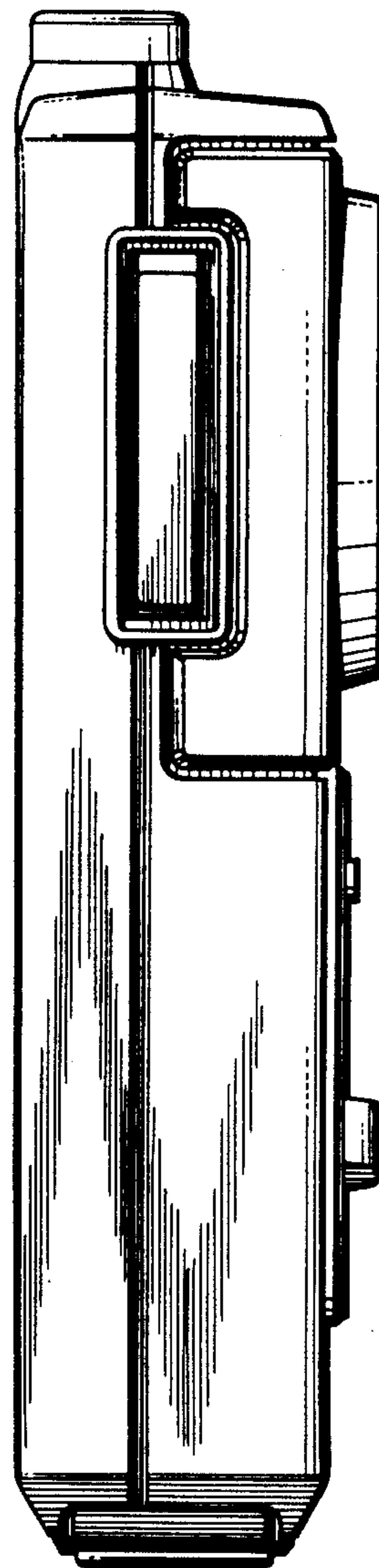
