The ornamental design for a mute for brass instruments, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a mute for brass instruments showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4—4 in FIG. 1.

The characteristic feature of my design is the outward curvature of the bottom portion of the upper member of the mute, to a diameter greater than that of the intermediate rim of the upper member, which curvature is reentrant to the central shaft of the lower member of the mute.
