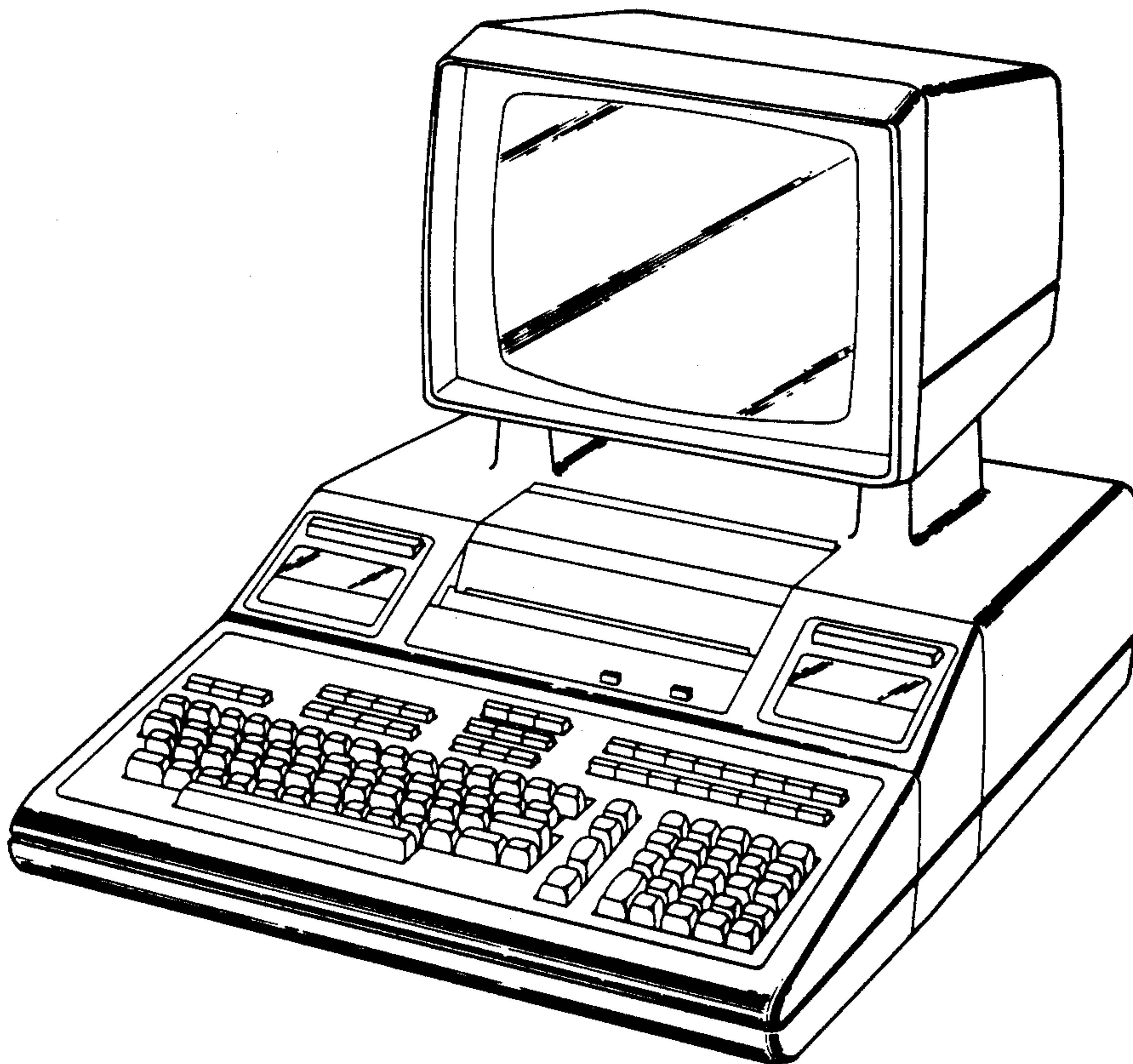

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a casing for an electronic calculator showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



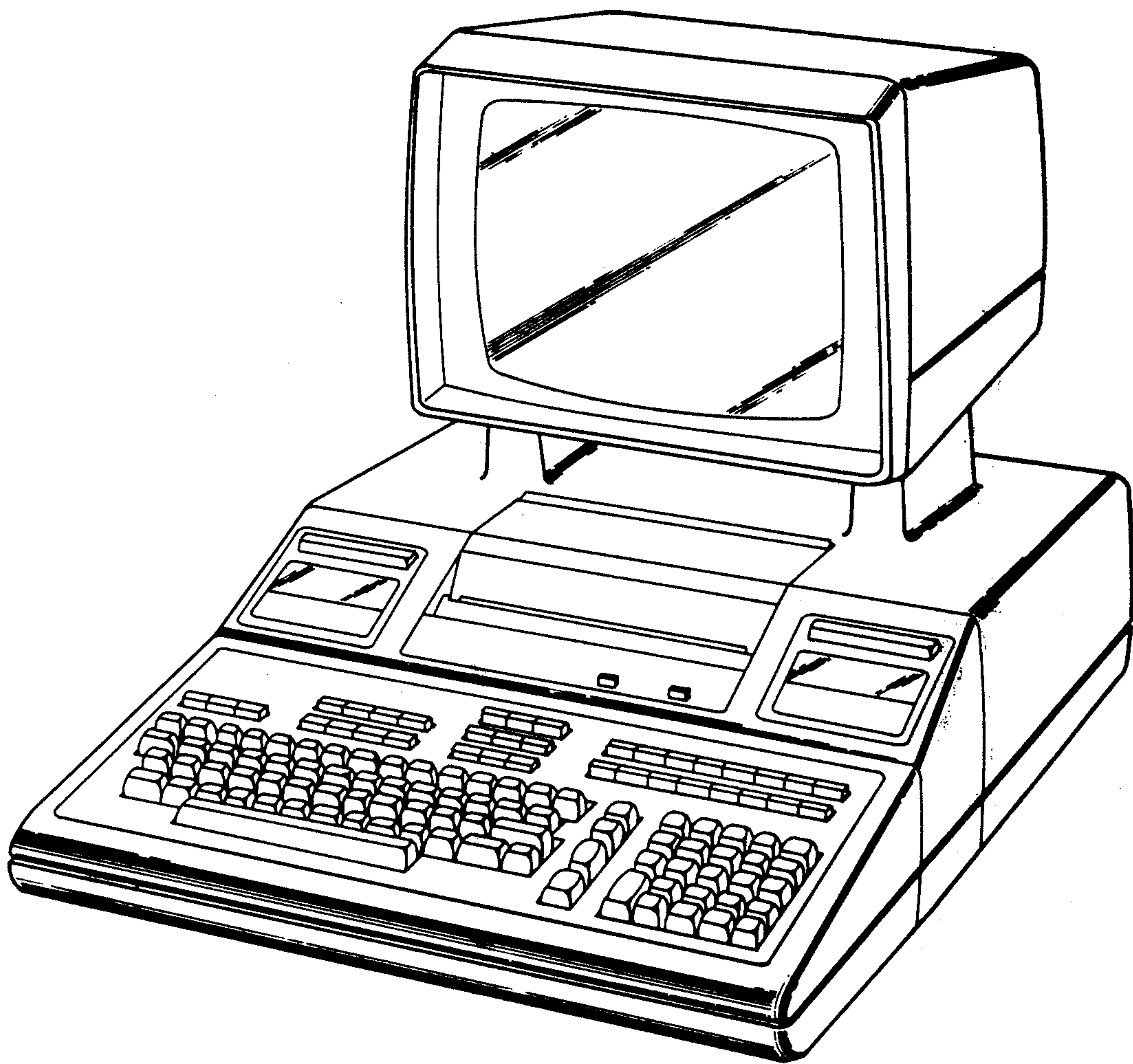

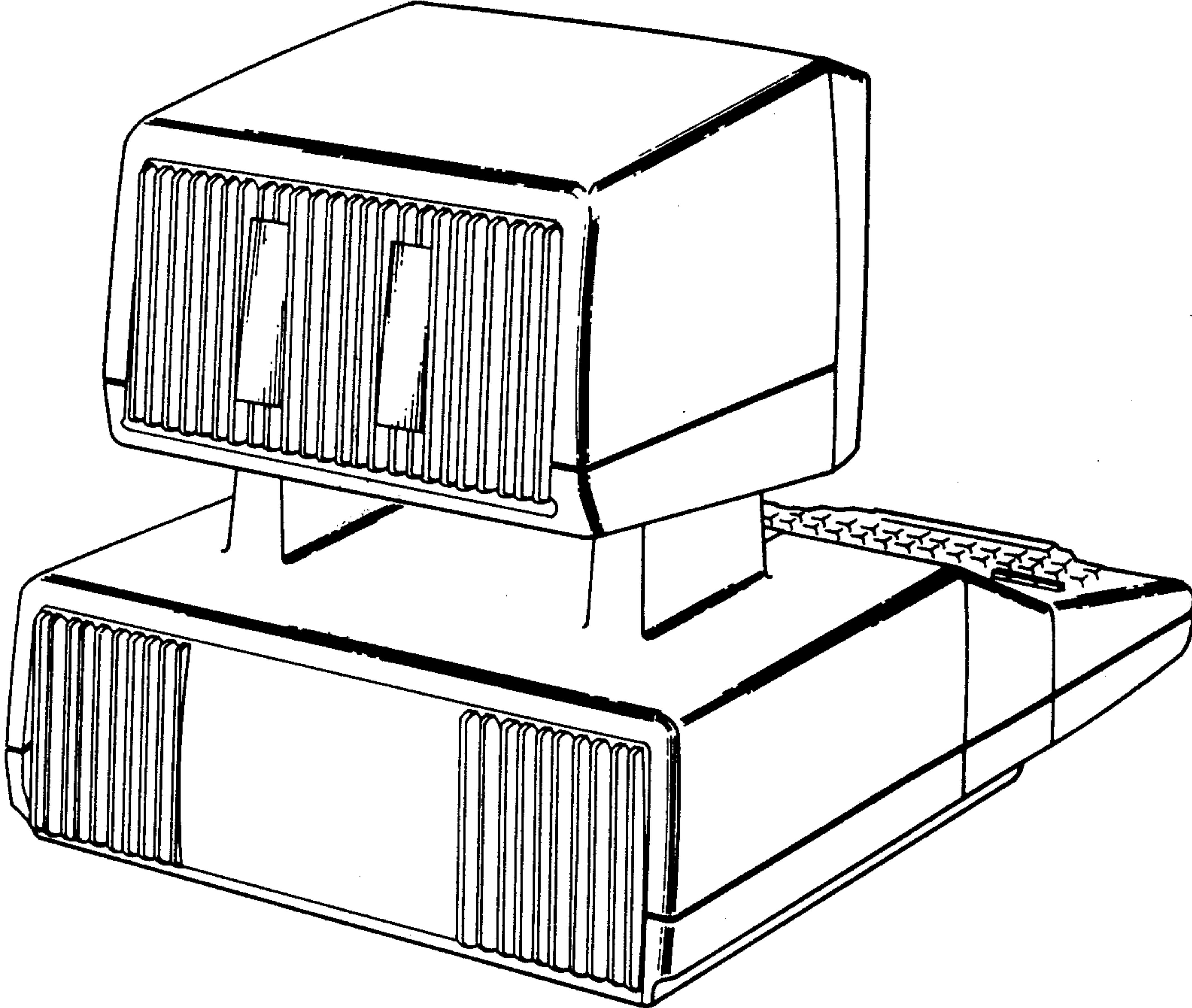
